### BELIEF

Abram said, Behold, to me thou hast given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir. And, behold, the word of the LORD came unto him, saying, This shall not be thine heir; but he that shall come forth out of thine own bowels shall be thine heir. He brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if thou be able to number them: and he said unto him, So shall thy seed be. And he believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness. Genesis 15:5-6

Joseph is yet alive, and he is governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he **believed** them not. Genesis 45:26

And Moses answered and said, But, behold, they will not believe me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD hath not appeared unto thee...and the LORD said unto Moses, Put forth thine hand, and take it by the tail. And he put forth his hand, and caught it, and it became a rod in his hand: That they may believe that the LORD God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, hath appeared unto thee. Exodus 4:1, 4-5

And it shall come to pass, if they will not **believe** thee, neither hearken to the voice of the first sign, that they will **believe** the voice of the latter sign. And it shall come to pass, if they will not **believe** also these two signs, neither hearken unto thy voice, that thou shalt take of the water of the river, and pour it upon the dry land: and the water which thou takest out of the river shall become blood upon the dry land. Exodus 4:8-9

And the people **believed**: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that he had looked upon their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshipped. Exodus 4:31

And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the LORD, and **believed** the LORD, and his servants Moses. Exodus 14:31

And the LORD said unto Moses, Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with thee, and **believe** thee for ever. And Moses told the words of the people unto the LORD. Exodus 19:9

How long will this people provoke me? And how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them? Nu 14:11

The LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron, Because ye **believed** me not, to sanctify me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore ye shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them. Numbers 20:12

Yet in this thing ye did not **believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to shew you by what way ye should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and sware, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers. Deuteronomy 1:32

Likewise when the LORD sent you from Kadesh-barnea, saying, Go up and possess the land which I have given you; then ye rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God, and ye **believed** him not, nor hearkened to his voice. Deuteronomy 9:23

Achish **believed** David, saying, He hath made his people Israel utterly to abhor him; therefore he shall be my servant for ever. 1 Samuel 27:12

When the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD, she came to prove him with hard questions...and Solomon told her all her questions: there was not any thing hid from the king, which he told her not...Howbeit I **believed** not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard. 1 Kings 10:1, 3, 7

Notwithstanding they would not hear, but hardened their necks, like to the neck of their fathers, that did not **believe** in the LORD their God. 2 Kings 17:14

Howbeit I **believed** not their words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the one half of the greatness of thy wisdom was not told me: for thou exceedest the fame that I heard. 2 Chronicles 9:6

They rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem; **Believe** in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; **believe** his prophets, so shall ye prosper. 2 Chronicles 20:20

Now therefore let not Hezekiah deceive you, nor persuade you on this manner, neither yet **believe** him: for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver his people out of mine hand, and out of the hand of my fathers: how much less shall your God deliver you out of mine hand? 2 Chronicles 32:15

If I had called, and he had answered me; yet would I not **believe** that he had hearkened unto my voice. Job 9:16

Wilt thou **believe** him, that he will bring home thy seed, and gather it into thy barns? Job 39:12

I had fainted, unless I had **believed** to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. Psalm 27:13

Therefore the LORD heard this, and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel; Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his salvation... Psalm 78:21-22

For all this they sinned still, and **believed** not for his wondrous works. Therefore their days did he consume in vanity, and their years in trouble. When he slew them, then they sought him: and they returned and inquired early after God. Psalm 78:32-34

Then believed they his words; they sang his praise... Psalm 106:12

Yea, they despised the pleasant land, they **believed** not his word; but murmured in their tents, and hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD. Psalm 106:24-25

Ibelieved, therefore have I spoken: I was greatly afflicted: Psalms 116:10

Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have **believed** thy commandments. Psalm 119:66

The simple **believeth** every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going. Proverbs 14:15

Burning lips and a wicked heart are like a potsherd covered with silver dross. He that hateth dissembleth with his lips, and layeth up deceit within him; When he speaketh fair, **believe** him not: for there are seven abominations in his heart. Proverbs 26:23-25

Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD, Behold, I lay in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious corner stone, a sure foundation: he that **believeth** shall not make haste. Isaiah 28:16

Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and **believe** me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. Isaiah 43:10

Who hath **believed** our report? And to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. He was despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities... Isaiah 53:1-5

For even thy brethren, and the house of thy father, even they have dealt treacherously with thee; yea, they have called a multitude after thee: **believe** them not, though they speak fair words unto thee. Jeremiah 12:6

And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam **believed** them not. Jeremiah 40:14

Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he **believed** in his God. Daniel 6:23

The kings of the earth, and all the inhabitants of the world, would not have **believed** that the adversary and the enemy should have entered into the gates of Jerusalem. Lamentations 4:12

The people of Nineveh **believed** God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. Jonah 3:5

Behold ye among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvellously: for I will work a work in your days, which ye will not **believe**, though it be told you. Habakkuk 1:5

Speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth it...And Jesus said unto the centurion, Go thy way; and as thou hast **believed**, so be it done unto thee. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour. Matthew 8:8-9, 13

When he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, **Believe** ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. Matthew 9:28

But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which **believe** in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea. Matthew 18:6

Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive. Matthew 21:21-22

The baptism of John, whence was it? From heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then **believe** him? Matthew 21:25

For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye **believed** him not; but the publicans and the harlots **believed** him: and ye, when ye had seen it, repented not afterward, that ye might **believe** him. Matthew 21:32

Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ, or there; **believe** it not... Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; **believe** it not. Matthew 24:23, 26

The chief priests mocking him, with the scribes and elders, said, He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the cross, and we will **believe** him. Matthew 27:42

And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. Mark 1:15

As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only **believe**. Mark 5:36

Jesus said unto him, If thou canst **believe**, all things are possible to him that **believeth**. And straitway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I **believe**; help thou mine unbelief. Mark 9:23-24

Whosoever shall offend one of these little ones that **believe** in me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea. Mark 9:42

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. Mark 11:23-24

They reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then did ye not **believe** him? But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he was a prophet indeed. Mark 11:31-32

Then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here is Christ; or, lo, he is there; believe him not: Mark 13:21

Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the cross, that we may see and **believe**. And they that were crucified with him reviled him. Mark 15:32

And they, when they had heard that he was alive, and had been seen of her, **believed** not...And they went and told it unto the residue; neither **believed** they them. Mark 16:13

Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they **believed** not them which had seen him after he was risen. And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that **believeth** and is baptized shall be saved; but he that **believeth** not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that **believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues... Mark 16:14-17

Forasmuch as man have taken in hand to set forth in order a declaration of those things which are most surely **believed** among us. Even as they delivered them unto us, which from the beginning were eyewitnesses, and ministers of the word; It seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write unto thee... Luke 1:1-3

And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because thou **believest** not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season. Luke 1:20

Blessed is she that **believed**: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord. Luke 1:45

Those by the way side are they that hear; then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts, lest they should **believe** and be saved. They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for while **believe**, and in time of temptation fall away. Luke 8:12-13

But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: **believe** only, and she shall be made whole. Luke 8:50

They reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then **believed** ye him not? Luke 20:5

Art thou the Christ? Tell us. And he said unto them, If I tell you, ye will not **believe**: Luke 22:67

They remembered his words, and returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest...And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they **believed** them not... Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to **believe** all that the prophets have spoken: Luke 24:8-11, 25

While they yet **believed** not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, Have ye here any meat? Luke 24:41

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John, The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through him might **believe**. John 1:6-7

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that **believe** on his name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12-13

Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, **believest** thou? Thou shalt see greater things than these. John 1:50

This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples **believed** on him. John 2:11

When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they **believed** the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said. John 2:22

Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast day, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did. John 2:23

If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you of heavenly things? And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven... As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:13-18

He that **believeth** on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that **believeth** not on the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him. John 3:36

Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. ... Many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did... And many more believed because of his own word. And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard him ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world. John 4:21, 39, 41-42

So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum. When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death. Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe. The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die. Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way... So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house. John 4:46-50-53

Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and **believeth** on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. John 5:24

And ye have not his word abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not. John 5:38

How can ye **believe**, which receive honour one of another, and seek not the honour that cometh from God only? Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuseth you, even Moses, in whom ye trust. For had ye **believed** Moses, ye would have **believed** me: for he wrote of me. But if ye **believe** not his writings, how shall ye **believe** my words? John 5:44-47

Jesus answered... This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent. They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? What dost thou work? ... And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not. John 6:29-30, 35-36

And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and **believeth** on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day... Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that **believeth** on me hath everlasting life. John 6:40, 47

But there are some of you that **believe** not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that **believed** not, and who should betray him. John 6:64

Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? Thou hast the words of eternal life. And we **believe** and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God. John 6:68-69

His brethren therefore said unto him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that thy disciples also may see the works that thou doest...For neither did his brethren **believe** in him. John 7:3, 5

Many of the people **believed** on him, and said, When Christ cometh, will he do more miracles than these which this man hath done? John 7:31

He that **believeth** on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that **believe** on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:38-39

Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived? Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees **believed** on him? John 7:47-48

And he said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above; ye are of this world; I am not of this world. I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye **believe** not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins. John 8:23-24

Then said Jesus unto them, When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that I am he, and that I do nothing of myself; but as my Father hath taught me, I speak these things. And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him. As he spake these words, many believed on him. Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:28-32

Because I tell you the truth, ye **believe** me not. Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do ye not **believe** me? He that is of God heareth God's words: ye therefore hear them not, because ye are not of God. John 8:45-47

But the Jews did not **believe** concerning him, that he had been blind, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight. He answered and said, Who is he, Lord, that I might **believe** on him? ...And he said, Lord, I **believe**. And he worshipped him. John 9:35-36, 38

Jesus answered them, I told you, and ye **believed** not: the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me. But ye **believe** not, because ye are not of my sheep, as I said unto you...If I do not the works of my Father, **believe** me not. But if I do, though ye **believe** not me, **believe** the works: that ye may know, and **believe**, that the Father is in me, and I in him. John 10:25-26, 37-38

Therefore they sought again to take him: but he escaped out of their hand, and went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode. And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle; but all things that John spake of this man were true. And many **believed** on him there. John 10:42

I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may **believe**; nevertheless let us go unto him. John 11:15

Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that **believeth** in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: Whosoever liveth and **believeth** in me shall never die. **Believest** thou this? She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I **believe** that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world. John 11:25-27

Some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died?...Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest **believe**, thou shouldest see the glory of God? Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may **believe** that thou hast sent me... John 11:37, 40-42

He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go. Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus did, **believed** on him. John 11:43-45

If we let him thus alone, all men will **believe** on him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation. John 11:48

Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and **believed** on Jesus. John 12:11

While ye have light, **believe** in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them. But though he had done so many miracles before them, yet they **believed** not on him. That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spake, Lord, who hath **believed** our report? And to whom hath the arm of the Lord been revealed? Therefore they could not **believe**, because that Esaias said again... John 12:36-39

Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many **believed** on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue...Jesus cried and said, He that **believeth** on me, **believeth** not on me, but on him that sent me...I am come a light into the world, that whosoever **believeth** on me should not abide in darkness. And if any man hear my words, and **believe** not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. John 12:42, 44, 46-47

Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, ye may **believe** that I am he. John 13:19

Let not your heart be troubled: ye **believe** in God, **believe** also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. John 14:1-2

**Believest** thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. **Believe** me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else **believe** me for the very works' sake. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that **believeth** on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. John 14:10-12

Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I. And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, that ye might **believe**. John 14:28-29

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they **believe** not on me; John 16:7-9

For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have **believed** that I came out from God. John 16:27

Now are we sure that thou knowest all things, and needest not that any man should ask thee: by this we **believe** that thou camest forth from God. Jesus answered them, Do ye now **believe**? John 16:30-31

For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have **believed** that thou didst send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. John 17:8-10

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall **believe** on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us; that the world may **believe** that thou hast sent me. John 17:20-21

He that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knoweth that he saith true, that ye might **believe**. John 19:35

Then went in also that other disciple, which came first to the sepulchre, and he saw, and **believed**. John 20:8

The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not **believe**. John 20:25

Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but **believing**. And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God. Jesus saith unto him, Thomas, because thou hast seen me, thou hast **believed**: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have **believed**. John 20:27-29

Many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that ye might **believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that **believing** ye might have life through his name. John 20:30-31

All that believed were together, and had all things common... Acts 2:44

Howbeit many of them which heard the word **believed**; and the number of the men was about five thousand. Acts 4:4

And the multitude of them that **believed** were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things in common. Acts 4:32

And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. And **believers** were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) Acts 5:14

But when they **believed** Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. Then Simon himself **believed** also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done. Acts 8:12-13

As they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, If thou **believest** with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I **believe** that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Acts 8:36-37

When Saul was come to Jerusalem he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and **believed** not that he was a disciple. Acts 9:26

It was known throughout all Joppa; and many **believed** in the Lord. Acts 9:42

Him God raised up the third day, and shewed him openly... To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever **believeth** in him shall receive remission of sins. While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. And they of the circumcision which **believed** were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. Acts 10:40, 43-45

Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God? When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life...And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord. Acts 11:17-18, 21

Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, **believed**, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord. Acts 13:12

By him all that **believe** are justified from all things, from which ye could not be justified by the law of Moses. Acts 13:39

Beware therefore, lest that come upon you, which is spoken of in the prophets; Behold, ye despisers, and wonder, and perish: for I work a work in your days, a work which ye shall in no wise **believe**, though a man declare it unto you. Acts 13:40-41

When the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy, and spake against those things which were spoken by Paul, contradicting and blaspheming. Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles. For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life **believed**. Acts 13:45-48

It came to pass in Iconium, that they went both together into the synagogue of the Jews, and so spake, that a great multitude both of the Jews and also of the Greeks **believed**...And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they **believed**. Acts 14:1, 23

But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which believed, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses. And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter. When there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and believe. And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as he did unto us; and put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they. Acts 15:11

Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and **believed**; but his father was a Greek: Acts 16:1

Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, **Believe** on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. And they spake unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway. And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, **believing** in God with all his house. Acts 16:31-34

And some of them **believed**, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few. But the Jews which **believed** not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. Acts 17:4-5

These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. Therefore many of them **believed**; also of honourable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few. ... Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and **believed**: among the which was Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them. Acts 17:11-12, 34

He departed thence, and entered into a certain man's house, named Justus, one that worshipped God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue. And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, **believed** on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing **believed**, and were baptized. Acts 18:7-8

And when he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had **believed** through grace: Acts 18:27

He said unto them, Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. And he said unto them, Unto what then were ye baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. Acts 19:2-4

But when divers were hardened, and **believed** not, but spake evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the school of one Tyrannus. Acts 19:9

Many that **believed** came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. Acts 19:18

And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which **believe**; and they are all zealous of the law: Acts 21:20

As touching the Gentiles which **believe**, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication. Acts 21:25

And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that **believed** on thee... Acts 22:19

But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, **believing** all things which are written in the law and in the prophets: Acts 24:14

King Agrippa, **believest** thou the prophets? I know that thou **believest**. Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost thou persuadest me to be a Christian. Acts 26:27-28

I perceive that this voyage will be with hurt and much damage... Nevertheless the centurion **believed** the master and the owner of the ship, more than those things which were spoken by Paul. ... Wherefore, sirs, be of good cheer: for I **believe** God, that it shall be even as it was told me. Acts 27:11, 25

And some **believed** the things which were spoken, and some **believed** not. Acts 28:24

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that **believeth**; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. Romans 1:16

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. Romans 3:23-26

For what saith the scripture? Abraham **believed** God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness. Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. But to him that worketh not, but **believeth** on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Romans 4:3-5

And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that **believe**, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also... Romans 4:11

(As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he **believed**, even God, who quickeneth the dead, and calleth those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope **believed** in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. Romans 4:17-18

Now if we be dead with Christ, we **believe** that we shall also live with him; Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once; but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Romans 6:8-10

Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone. As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. Romans 9:31-33

For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that **believeth**... Romans 10:3-4

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt **believe** in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man **believeth** unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever **believeth** on him shall not be ashamed. Romans 10:9-11

How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? Romans 10:14-16

For as ye in times past have not **believed** God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief: Even so have these also now not **believed**, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy. Romans 11:30-31

And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we **believed**. Romans 13:11

For one **believeth** that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eateth herbs. Let not him that eateth despise him that eateth not; and let not him which eateth not judge him that eateth: for God hath received him. Romans 14:2-3

The God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in **believing**, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost... That I may be delivered from them that do not **believe** in Judaea; and that my service which I have for Jerusalem may be accepted of the saints; Romans 15:13, 31

For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that **believe**. 1 Corinthians 1:21

Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye **believed**, even as the Lord gave to every man? 1 Corinthians 3:5

To the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that **believeth** not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away. And the woman which hath an husband that **believeth** not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him. 1 Corinthians 7:12-13

If any of them that **believe** not bid you to a feast, and ye be disposed to go; whatsoever is set before you, eat, asking no question for conscience sake. 1 Corinthians 10:27

For first of all, when ye come together in the church, I hear that there be divisions among you; and I partly **believe** it. 1 Corinthians 11:18

Charity...Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. 1 Corinthians 13:4, 7

Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that **believe**, but to them that **believe** not: but prophesying serveth not for them that **believe** not, but for them which **believe**. If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those that are unlearned, or unbelievers, will they not say that ye are mad? But if all prophesy, and there come in one that **believeth** not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he is judged of all: 1 Corinthians 14:22-24

Brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have **believed** in vain. Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so ye **believed**. 1 Corinthians 15:1-2, 11

In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which **believe** not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. 2 Corinthians 4:4

We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you. 2 Corinthians 4:13-14

Be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion hath light with darkness? And what concord hath Christ with Belial? Or what part hath he that **believeth** with an infidel? 2 Corinthians 6:14-15

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have **believed** in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. Galatians 2:16

Even as Abraham **believed** God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness...But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that **believe**. Galatians 3:6, 22

In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye **believed**, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise. Ephesians 1:13

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints. And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to usward who **believe**, according to the working of his mighty power... Ephesians 1:18-19

For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to **believe** on him, but also to suffer for his sake; Philippians 1:29

So that ye were ensamples to all that **believe** in Macedonia and Achaia. 1 Thessalonians 1:7

Ye are witnesses, and God also, how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that **believe**... 1 Thessalonians 2:10

For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that **believe**. 1 Thessalonians 2:13

For if we **believe** that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring him. 1 Thessalonians 4:14

To you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengenance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord... When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that **believe** (because our testimony among you was **believed**) in that day. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10

And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should **believe** a lie: That they all might be damned who **believed** not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and **belief** of the truth: 2 Thessalonians 2:11-13

Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter **believe** on him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:16

Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, **believed** on in the world, received up into glory. 1 Timothy 3:16

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils. Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth. 1 Timothy 4:1-3

For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that **believe**. ...Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the **believers**, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:10, 12

If any man or woman that **believeth** have widows, let them relieve them, and let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed. 1 Timothy 5:16

Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and his doctrine be not blasphemed. And they that have **believing** masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort. 1 Timothy 6:1-2

For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have **believed**, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. If we **believe** not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself. 2 Timothy 2:12-13

This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have **believed** in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. Titus 3:8

To whom sware he that they should not enter into his rest, but to them that **helieved** not? Hebrews 3:18

For we which have **believed** do enter into rest, as he said, As I have sworn in my wrath, if they shall enter into my rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world. Hebrews 4:3

But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul. Hebrews 10:39

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must **believe** that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Hebrews 11:6

By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that **believed** not, when she had received the spies with peace. Hebrews 11:31

Thou **believest** that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also **believe**, and tremble. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? James 2:19-20

The scripture was fulfilled which saith, Abraham **believed** God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. James 2:23

That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory... 1 Peter 1:7-8

Who by him do **believe** in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:21

Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that **believeth** on him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which **believe** he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner... 1 Peter 2:6-7

This is his commandment, That we should **believe** on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. 1 John 3:23

Beloved, **believe** not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. ... And we have known and **believed** the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. 1 John 4:1, 16

Whosoever **believeth** that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him. ... Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that **believeth** that Jesus is the Son of God? 1 John 5:1, 5

He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life. These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. 1 John 5:10-13

I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that **believed** not. Jude 1:5

#### **FAITH**

My servant Moses is not so, who is **faithful** in all mine house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were ye not afraid to speak against my servant Moses? Numbers 12:7-8

Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the **faithful** God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; Deuteronomy 7:9

And he said, I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no **faith**. Deuteronomy 32:20

I will raise me up a **faithful** priest, that shall do according to that which is in mine heart and in my mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed for ever. 1 Samuel 2:35

Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who is so **faithful** among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house? 1 Samuel 22:14

The LORD render to every man his righteousness and his **faithfulness**: for the LORD delivered thee into my hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed. 1 Samuel 26:23

I am one of them that are peaceable and **faithful** in Israel: thou seekest to destroy a city and a mother in Israel: why wilt thou swallow up the inheritance of the LORD? 2 Samuel 20:19

Moreover they reckoned not with the men, into whose hand they delivered the money to be bestowed on workmen: for they dealt **faithfully**. 2 Kings 12:15

Howbeit there was no reckoning made with them of the money that was delivered into their hand, because they dealt **faithfully**. 2 Kings 22:7

And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in the fear of the LORD, faithfully, and with a perfect heart. 2 Chronicles 19:9

And brought in the offerings and the tithes and the dedicated things faithfully: over which Cononiah the Levite was ruler, and Shimei his brother was the next. 2 Chronicles 31:12

The men did the work **faithfully**: and the overseers of them were Jahath and Obadiah, the Levites, of the sons of Merari; and Zechariah and Meshullam, of the sons of Kohathites, to set it forward; and other of the Levites, all that could skill of instruments of musick. 2 Chronicles 34:12

I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he was a **faithful** man, and feared God above many. Nehemiah 7:2

And foundest his heart **faithful** before thee, and madest a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Girgashites, to give it, I say, to his seed, and hast performed thy words; for thou art righteous. Nehemiah 9:8

I made treasurers over the treasuries, Shelemiah the priest, and Zadok the scribe, and of the Levites, Pedaiah: and next to them was Hanan the son of Zaccur, the son of Mattaniah: for they were counted **faithful**, and their office was to distribute unto their brethren. Nehemiah 13:13

For there is no **faithfulness** in their mouth; their inward part is very wickedness; their throat is an open sepulchre; they flatter with their tongue. Psalm 5:9

Help, LORD; for the godly man ceaseth; for the **faithful** fail from among the children of men. Psalm 12:1

O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the **faithful**, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer. Psalm 31:23

Thy mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; and thy faithfulness reacheth unto the clouds. Psalm 36:5

I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation. Psalm 40:10

Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? Or thy faithfulness in destruction? Psalm 88:11

I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy **faithfulness** to all generations. For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever: thy **faithfulness** shalt thou establish in the very heavens... Psalm 89:1-2

The heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD: thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints...But my faithfulness and my mercy shall be with him: and in my name shall his horn be exalted...My lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail...It shall be established for ever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah. Psalm 89:5, 8, 24, 33, 37

Mine eyes shall be upon the **faithful** of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me. Psalm 101:6

I know, O LORD, that thy judgments are right, and that thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me...All thy commandments are faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help thou me...Thy faithfulness is unto all generations: thou hast established the earth, and it abideth...Thy testimonies that thou hast commanded are righteous and very faithful. Psalms 119:75, 86, 90, 138

Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, and in thy righteousness. Psalm 143:1

A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a **faithful** spirit concealeth the matter. Proverbs 11:13

A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador is health. Proverbs 13:17

A faithful witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies. Proverbs 14:5

Most men will proclaim every one his own goodness: but a **faithful** man who can find? Proverbs 20:6

As the cold of snow in the time of harvest, so is a **faithful** messenger to them that send him: for he refresheth the soul of his master. Proverbs 25:13

**Faithful** are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful. Proverbs 27:6

A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent. Proverbs 28:20

The king that **faithfully** judgeth the poor, his throne shall be established for ever. Proverbs 29:14

How is the **faithful** city become an harlot? It was full of judgment; righteousness lodged in it; but now murderers...And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the **faithful** city. Isaiah 1:21, 26

I took unto me **faithful** witnesses to record, Uriah the priest, and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah. Isaiah 8:2

Righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and **faithfulnes**s the girdle of his reins. Isaiah 11:5

O LORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are **faithfulness** and truth. For thou hast made of a city an heap; of a defenced city a ruin: a palace of strangers to be no city; it shall never be built. Therefore shall the strong people glorify thee, the city of the terrible nations shall fear thee. For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress... Isaiah 25:1-3

Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is **faithful**, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee. Isaiah 49:7

The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word **faithfully**. What is the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD. Jeremiah 23:28

Then they said to Jeremiah, The LORD be a true and **faithful** witness between us, if we do not even according to all things for the which the LORD thy God shall send thee to us. Jeremiah 42:5

It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is thy faithfulness. Lamentations 3:22-23

Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he was **faithful**, neither was there any error or fault found in him. Daniel 6:4

Ephraim compasseth me about with lies, and the house of Israel with deceit: but Judah yet ruleth with God, and is **faithful** with the saints. Hosea 11:12

I will even betroth thee unto me in **faithfulness**: and thou shalt know the LORD. Hosea 2:20

Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 2:4

Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall he not much more clothe you, O ye of little faith? Matthew 6:30

When Jesus heard it, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great **faith**, no, not in Israel. Matthew 8:10

And he said unto them, Why are ye fearful, O ye of little **faith**? Then he arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. Matthew 8:26

And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their **faith** said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee. Matthew 9:2

But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, Daughter, be of good comfort; thy **faith** hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. Matthew 9:22

Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your **faith** be it unto you. Matthew 9:29

And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little **faith**, wherefore didst thou doubt? Matthew 14:31

Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is thy **faith**: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour. Matthew 15:28

When Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little **faith**, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread? Matthew 16:8

Then Jesus answered and said, O **faithless** and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I suffer you? Bring him hither to me. Matthew 17:17

Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have **faith** as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Matthew 17:20

Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt now, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. Matthew 21:21

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and **faith**: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Matthew 23:23

Who then is a **faithful** and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season? Matthew 24:45

His lord said unto him, Well done, thou good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord...His lord said unto him, Well done, good and faithful servant; thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord. Matthew 25:21, 23

When Jesus saw their **faith**, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee. Mark 2:5

And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no faith? Mark 4:40

And he said unto her, Daughter, thy **faith** hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague. Mark 5:34

He answereth him, and saith, O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I suffer you? Bring him hither to me. Mark 9:19

Jesus said unto him, Go thy way; thy **faith** hath made thee whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way. Mark 10:52

Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. Mark 11:22

And when he saw their **faith**, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee. Luke 5:20

When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. Luke 7:9

He said to the woman, thy **faith** hath saved thee; go in peace. Luke 7:50

And he said unto them, Where is your **faith**? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! For he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him. Luke 8:25

He said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: thy **faith** hath made thee whole; go in peace. Luke 8:48

Jesus answering said, O **faithless** and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you, and suffer you? Bring thy son hither. Luke9:41

If then God so clothe the grass, which is today in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more will he clothe you, O ye of little faith? Luke 12:28

The Lord said, Who then is that **faithful** and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season? Luke 12:42

He that is **faithful** in that which is least is **faithful** also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore ye have not been **faithful** in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? And if ye have not been **faithful** in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own? Luke 16:10-12

And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our **faith**. And the Lord said, If ye had **faith** as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you. Luke 17:5-6

He said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole. Luke 17:19

I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find **faith** on the earth? Luke 18:8

Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee. Luke 18:42 He said unto him, Well, thou good servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities. Luke 19:17

But I have prayed for thee, that thy **faith** fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. Luke 22:32

Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not **faithless**, but believing. John 20:27

His name through **faith** in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see and know: yea, the **faith** which is by him hath given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all. Acts 3:16

The saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of **faith** and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch: ... The word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the **faith**. And Stephen, full of **faith** and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people. Acts 6:5, 7-8

For he was a good man, and full of the Holy Ghost and of **faith**: and much people was added unto the Lord. Acts 11:24

But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the faith. Acts 13:8

The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had **faith** to be healed... When they were come, and had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of **faith** unto the Gentiles. Acts 14:9, 27

And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. Acts 15:9

So were the churches established in the **faith**, and increased in number daily. Acts 16:5

When she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be **faithful** to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us. Acts 16:15

Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 20:21

After certain days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, which was a Jewess, he sent for Paul, and heard him concerning the **faith** in Christ. Acts 24:24

... To make thee a minister and a witness... To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by **faith** that is in me. Acts 26:17-18

By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the **faith** among all nations, for his name: Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ: Romans 1:5-6

I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your **faith** is spoken of throughout the whole world... That is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual **faith** both of you and me. Romans 1:8, 12

For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from **faith to faith**: as it is written, The just shall live by **faith**. Romans 1:17

For what if some did not believe? Shall their unbelief make the **faith** of God without effect? Romans 3:3

Even the righteousness of God which is by **faith** of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through **faith** in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; Romans 3:22-25

Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? Nay: but by the law of **faith**. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by **faith** without the deeds of the law. Romans 3:27-28

Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by **faith**, and uncircumcision through **faith**. Do we then make void the law through **faith**? God forbid: yea, we establish the law. Romans 3:30-31

But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his **faith** is counted for righteousness. Romans 4:5

Cometh this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? For we say that **faith** was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness. Romans 4:9

He received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the **faith** which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also: Romans 4:11

The father of circumcision to them who are not of the circmcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that **faith** of our father Abraham, which he had being yet uncircumcised. For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of **faith**. For if they which are of the law be heirs, **faith** is made void, and the promise made of none effect: Because the law worketh wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression. Therefore it is of **faith**, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the **faith** of Abraham; who is the father of us all... Romans 4:12-16

Being not weak in **faith**, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in **faith**, giving glory to God... Romans 4:19-20

Therefore being justified by **faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by **faith** into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2

What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of **faith**. But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by **faith**, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone... Romans 9:30-32

But the righteousness which is of **faith** speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (That is, to bring Christ down from above:) Or, who shall descend into the deep? (That is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) But what saith it? The word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of **faith**, which we preach... Romans 10:6-8

So then **faith** cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. Romans 10:17

Thou wilt say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be graffed in. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear... Romans 11:19-20

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith. Romans 12:3

Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of **faith**; Romans 12:6

Him that is weak in **faith** receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations. Romans 14:1

Hast thou **faith**? Have it to thyself before God. Happy is he that condemneth not himself in that thing which he alloweth. And he that doubteth is damned if he eat, because he eateth not of **faith**: for whatsoever is not of faith is sin. Romans 14:22-23

But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of **faith:** Romans 16:26

God is **faithful**, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. 1 Corinthians 1:9

My speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and power. That your **faith** should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful. 1 Corinthians 4:2

For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church. 1 Corinthians 4:17

Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that hath obtained mercy of the Lord to be **faithful**. 1 Corinthians 7:25

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is **faithful**, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it. 1 Corinthians 10:13

To another **faith** by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12:9

Though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all **faith**, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. 1 Corinthians 13:2

And now abideth **faith**, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:13

If Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your **faith** is also vain...And if Christ be not raised, your **faith** is vain; ye are yet in your sins. 1 Corinthians 15:14, 17

Watch ye, stand fast in the **faith**, quit you like men, be strong. 1 Corinthians 16:13

Not for that we have dominion over your **faith**, but are helpers of your joy: for by **faith** ye stand. 2 Corinthians 1:24

We having the same spirit of **faith**, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak... 2 Corinthians 4:13

Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: (For we walk by **faith**, not by sight:) 2 Corinthians 5:6-7

Therefore, as ye abound in every thing, in **faith**, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that ye abound in this grace also. 2 Corinthians 8:7

Not boasting of things without our measure, that is, of other men's labours; but having hope, when your **faith** is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to our rule abundantly, 2 Corinthians 10:15

Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the **faith**; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobate? 2 Corinthians 13:5

But they had heard only, That he which persecuted us in times past now preacheth the **faith** which once he destroyed. Galatians 1:23

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the **faith** of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. Galatians 2:16

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the **faith** of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20

O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? Are ye so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh? Have ye suffered so many things in vain? If it be yet in vain. He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham. And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed. So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham. Galatians 3:1-9

But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by faith. And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. Galatians 3:11-15

But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by **faith** of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. But before **faith** came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the **faith** which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by **faith**. But after that **faith** is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For ye are all the children of God by **faith** in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:22-26

For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by **faith**. For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but **faith** which worketh by love. Galatians 5:5

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: Galatians 5:22-23

As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of **faith**. Galatians 6:10

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the **faithful** in Christ Jesus... Wherefore I also, after I heard of your **faith** in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers. Ephesians 1:1, 15-16

For by grace are ye saved through **faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God...In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the **faith** of him. Ephesians 2:8, 3:12

That Christ may dwell in your hearts by **faith**; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the love of Christ, which passesth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. Ephesians 3:17-19

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one **faith**, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:5-6

Till we all come in the unity of the **faith**, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: Ephesians 4:13

Above all, taking the shield of **faith**, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. Ephesians 6:16

But that he also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things: Ephesians 6:21

Peace be to the brethren, and love with **faith**, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Ephesians 6:23

Having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of **faith**; Philippians 1:25

Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the **faith** of the gospel; Philippians 1:27

Yea, and if I be offered upon the sacrifice and service of your **faith**, I joy, and rejoice with you all. Philippians 2:17

And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the **faith** of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: Philippians 3:9

To the saints and **faithful** brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, since we heard of your **faith** in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints... Colossians 1:2-4

As ye also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a faithful minister of Christ; Colossians 1:7

If ye continue in the **faith** grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister... Colossians 1:23

For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your **faith** in Christ. Colossians 2:5

Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the **faith**, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. Colossians 2:7

Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the **faith** of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. Colossians 2:12

All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, who is a beloved brother, and a **faithful** minister and fellowservant in the Lord: Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts; with Onesimus, a **faithful** and beloved brother, who is one of you. They shall make known unto you all things which are done here. Colossians 4:7-9

Remembering without ceasing your work of **faith**, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father...For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your **faith** to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing. 1 Thessalonians 1:3, 8

Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone; And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith: That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto. For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; even as it came to pass, and ye know. For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain. 1 Thessalonians 3:1-5

But now when Timotheus came from you unto us, and brought us good tidings of your **faith** and charity, and that ye have good remembrance of us always, desiring greatly to see us, as we also to see you: Therefore, brethren, we were comforted over you in all our affliction and distress by your **faith**: 1 Thessalonians 3:6-7

For what thanks can we render to God again for you, for all the joy wherewith we joy for your sakes before our God; Night and day praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith? 1 Thessalonians 3:9-10

Let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of **faith** and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. 1 Thessalonians 5:8

Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. 1 Thessalonians 5:24

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your **faith** groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth; So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and **faith** in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure. 2 Thessalonians 1:3-4

Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of **faith** with power: That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12

Pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you; And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not **faith**. But the Lord is **faithful**, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. 2 Thessalonians 3:1-3

Unto Timothy, my own son in the **faith**: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord. As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest charge some that they teach no other doctrine, neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in **faith**: so do. Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of **faith** unfeigned... 1 Timothy 1:2-5

I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. 1 Timothy 1:12-15

Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck: 1 Timothy 1:19

Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in **faith** and verity. 1 Timothy 2:7

Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in **faith** and charity and holiness with sobriety. 1 Timothy 2:15

Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre; holding the mystery of the **faith** in a pure conscience...Even so must their wives be grave, not slanderers, sober, **faithful** in all things...For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the **faith** which is in Christ Jesus. 1 Timothy 3:8-9, 11, 13

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the **faith**, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils... 1 Timothy 4:1

If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the words of **faith** and of good doctrine, whereunto thou hast attained. 1 Timothy 4:6

For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come. This is a **faithful** saying and worthy of all acceptation. 1 Timothy 4:8-9

Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in **faith**, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

If any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the **faith**, and is worse than an infidel. 1 Timothy 5:8

But the younger widows refuse: for when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry. Having damnation, because they have cast off their first **faith**. 1 Timothy 5:11-12

They that have believing masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are **faithful** and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort. 1 Timothy 6:2

For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the **faith**, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, **faith**, love, patience, meekness. Fight the good fight of **faith**, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses. 1 Timothy 6:10-12

O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: Which some professing have erred concerning the **faith**. Grace be with thee. Amen. 1 Timothy 6:21

When I call to remembrance the unfeigned **faith** that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also...Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in **faith** and love which is in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 1:5, 13

The things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to **faithful** men, who shall be able to teach others also. 2 Timothy 2:2

It is a **faithful** saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: If we believe not, yet he abideth **faithful**: he cannot deny himself. 2 Timothy 2:11-13

Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the **faith** of some. 2 Timothy 2:18

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, **faith**, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. 2 Timothy 2:22

As Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the **faith**...But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, **faith**, longsuffering, charity, patience... 2 Timothy 3:8, 10

From a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through **faith** which is in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 3:15

I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the **faith**: 2 Timothy 4:7

Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness... To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour. Titus 1:1, 4

If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having **faithful** children not accused of riot or unruly...Holding fast the **faithful** word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers. Titus 1:6, 9

This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the **faith**... Titus 1:13

That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in **faith**, in charity, in patience. Titus 2:2

This is a **faithful** saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. Titus 3:8

All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the **faith**. Grace be with you all. Amen. Titus 3:15

I thank my God, making mention of thee always in my prayers, Hearing of thy love and **faith**, which thou hast toward the Lord Jesus, and toward all saints; That the communication of thy **faith** may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus. Philemon 1:4-6

Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and **faithful** high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. Hebrews 2:17

Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. Hebrews 3:1-2

Moses verily was **faithful** in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after... Hebrews 3:5

For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with **faith** in them that heard it. Hebrews 4:2

Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God. Hebrews 6:1

That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through **faith** and patience inherit the promises. Hebrews 6:12

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of **faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the profession of our **faith** without wavering; (for he is **faithful** that promised;) Hebrews 10:22-23

Now the just shall live by **faith**: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Hebrews 10:38

Now **faith** is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through **faith** we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which did appear. Hebrews 11:1-3

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh. Hebrews 11:4

By **faith** Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. But without **faith** it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. Hebrews 11:5-6

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: Hebrews 11:7-9

Through **faith** also Sarah herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him **faithful** who had promised... These all died in **faith**, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. Hebrews 11:11, 13

By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son... Hebrews 11:17

By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come. By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, leaning upon the top of the staff. By faith Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones. Hebrews 11:20-22

By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment. By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter...By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible. Hebrews 11:23-27

Through **faith** he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them. By **faith** they passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned. Hebrews 11:28-27

By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days. By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace... Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions... And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise: Hebrews 11:23-39

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our **faith**; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2

Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose **faith** follow, considering the end of their conversation. Hebrews 13:7

Knowing this, that the trying of your **faith** worketh patience...But let him ask in **faith**, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. James 1:3, 6

My brethren, have not the **faith** of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons...Hearken, my beloved brethren, hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in **faith**, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath promised to them that love him? James 2:1, 5

What doth it profit, my brethren, though a man say he hath **faith**, and have not works? Can **faith** save him? James 2:14

Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and I will shew thee my faith by my works. Thou believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble. But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? James 2:17-22

And the scripture was fullfilled which saith, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also. James 2:23-26

The prayer of **faith** shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. James 5:15

Who are kept by the power of God through **faith** unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 1 Peter 1:5

That the trial of your **faith**, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory. Receiving the end of your **faith**, even the salvation of your souls. 1 Peter 1:7-9

Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your **faith** and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:21

Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a **faithful** Creator. 1 Peter 4:19

Whom resist stedfast in the **faith**, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world. 1 Peter 5:9

By Silvanus, a **faithful** brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true grace of God wherein ye stand. 1 Peter 5:12

Beside this, giving all diligence, add to your **faith** virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. 2 Peter 1:5-8

If we confess our sins, he is **faithful** and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our **faith**. 1 John 5:4

Beloved, thou doest **faithfully** whatsoever thou doest to the brethren, and to strangers; 3 John 1:5

Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the **faith** which was once delivered unto the saints. Jude 1:3

But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy **faith**, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. Jude 1:20-21

And from Jesus Christ, who is the **faithful** witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood. Revelation 1:5

Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou **faithful** unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life. Revelation 2:10

I know thy works, and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is: and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my **faithful** martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwelleth... Revelation 2:13

I know thy works, and charity, and service, and **faith**, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. Revelation 2:19

Unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the **faithful** and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God; Revelation 3:14

It was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. If any man have an ear, let him hear. He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the **faith** of the saints.

The smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the **faith** of Jesus. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. Revelation 14:11-13

These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and **faithful**. Revelation 17:14

I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called **Faithful** and True, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. Revelation 19:11

He that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. Revelation 21:5

He said unto me, These sayings are **faithful** and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done. Revelation 22:6

The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my **salvation**, my high tower, and my refuge, my **saviour**; thou **savest** me from violence. 2 Samuel 22:3

Thou hast also given me the shield of thy **salvation**: and thy gentleness hath made me great. 2 Samuel 22:36

The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and exalted be the God of the rock of my **salvation**. 2 Samuel 22:47

He is the tower of **salvation** for his king: and sheweth mercy to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore. 2 Samuel 22:51

Although my house be not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire, although he make it not to grow. 2 Samuel 23:5

Sing unto the LORD, all the earth; shew forth from day to day his salvation...And say ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy holy name, and glory in thy praise. 1 Chronicles 16:23, 35

Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with **salvation**, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness. 2 Chronicles 6:41

Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye still, and see the **salvation** of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; tomorrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you. 2 Chronicles 20:17

He also shall be my **salvation**: for an hypocrite shall not come before him. Job 13:16

**Salvation** belongeth unto the LORD: thy blessing is upon thy people. Selah. Psalm 3:8

That I may shew forth all thy praise in the gates of the daughter of **Zion**: I will rejoice in thy **salvation**. Psalm 9:14

But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy **salvation**. Psalm 13:5

Oh that the **salvation** of Israel were come out of **Zion**! When the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad. Psalm 14:7

The LORD is my light and my **salvation**; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? Psalm 27:1

Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my **salvation**. Psalm 27:9

Draw out the spear, and stop the way against them that persecute me: say unto my soul, I am thy **salvation**. Psalm 35:3

My soul shall be joyful in the LORD: it shall rejoice in his salvation. Psalm 35:9

But the **salvation** of the righteous is of the LORD: he is their strength in the time of trouble. Psalm 37:39

Make haste to help me, O Lord my salvation. Psalm 38:22

I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy **salvation**: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation. Psalm 40:15

Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: let such as love thy salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified. Psalm 40:16

Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the **salvation** of God. Psalm 50:23

Restore unto me the joy of thy **salvation**; and uphold me with thy free spirit. Psalm 51:12

Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my **salvation**: and my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness. Psalm 51:14

Oh that the **salvation** of Israel were come out of **Zion**! When God bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad. Psalm 53:6

Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him cometh my salvation. Psalm 62:1

He only is my rock and my **salvation**; he is my defence; I shall not be greatly moved. Psalm 62:2

He only is my rock and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved...In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God. Psalm 62:6-7

By terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; who art the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off upon the sea... Psalm 65:5

Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah. Psalm 68:19

He that is our God is the God of **salvation**; and unto GOD the Lord belong the issues from death. Psalm 68:20

But as for me, my prayer is unto thee, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation. Psalm 69:13

But I am poor and sorrowful: let thy **salvation**, O God, set me up on high. Psalm 69:29

For God will **save** Zion, and will build the cities of Judah: that they that dwell there, and have it in possession. The seed also of his servants shall inherit it: and they that love his name shall dwell there. Psalm 69:34-35

Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee: and let such as love thy **salvation** say continually, Let God be magnified. Psalm 70:4

My mouth shall shew forth thy righteousness and thy **salvation** all the day; for I know not the numbers thereof. Psalm 71:15

For God is my King of old, working **salvation** in the midst of the earth. Psalm 74:12

Therefore the LORD heard this, and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel; Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his **salvation**... Psalm 78:21-22

Help us, O God of our **salvation**, for the glory of thy name: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for thy name's sake. Psalm 79:9

Turn us, O God of our **salvation**, and cause thine anger toward us to cease. Psalm 85:4

Shew us thy mercy, OLORD, and grant us thy salvation. Psalm 85:7

Surely his **salvation** is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land. Psalm 85:9

O LORD God of my **salvation**, I have cried day and night before thee: Psalm 88:1

He shall cry unto me, Thou art my father, my God, and the rock of my salvation. Psalm 89:26

With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation. Psalm 91:16

O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our **salvation**. Psalm 95:1

Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his **salvation** from day to day. Psalm 96:2

The LORD hath made known his **salvation**: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen. He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the **salvation** of our God. Psalm 98:2-3

Remember me, O LORD, with the favour that thou bearest unto thy people: O visit me with thy salvation; Psalm 106:4

I will take the cup of **salvation**, and call upon the name of the LORD. Psalm 116:13

The LORD is my strength and my song, and is become my salvation... The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. Psalm 118:14-15

I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation. Psalm 118:21

Let thy mercies come also unto me, O LORD, even thy salvation, according to thy word...My soul fainteth for thy salvation: but I hope in thy word. Psalm 119:41, 81

**Salvation** is far from the wicked: for they seek not thy statutes. Psalm 119:155

LORD, I have hoped for thy **salvation**, and done thy commandments. Psalm 119:166

I have longed for thy **salvation**, O LORD; and thy law is my delight. Psalm 119:174

I will also clothe her priests with **salvation**: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy. Psalm 132:16

O GOD the Lord, the strength of my **salvation**, thou hast covered my head in the day of battle. Psalm 140:7

It is he that giveth **salvation** unto kings: who delivereth David his servant from the hurtful sword. Psalm 144:10

For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation. Psalm 149:4

Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation. Isaiah 12:2-3

As it is written in the book of the words of Esaias the prophet... All flesh shall see the **salvation** of God. Luke 3:4, 6

Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house. Luke 10:9

Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for **salvation** is of the Jews. John 4:22

By the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth...Neither is there **salvation** in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be **saved**. Acts 4:12

Men and brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whosoever among you feareth God, to you is the word of this **salvation** sent. Acts 13:26

For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for **salvation** unto the ends of the earth. Acts 13:47

Be it known therefore unto you, that the **salvation** of God is sent unto the Gentiles, and that they will hear it. Acts 28:28

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ; for it is the power of God unto **salvation** to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. Romans 1:16

Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own **salvation** with fear and trembling. Philippians 2:12

But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of **salvation**. 1 Thessalonians 5:8

For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain **salvation** by our Lord Jesus Christ... 1 Thessalonians 5:8-9

But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to **salvation** through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: 2 Thessalonians 2:13

Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the **salvation** which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. 2 Timothy 2:10

And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto **salvation** through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 3:15

For the grace of God that bringeth **salvation** hath appeared unto all men. Titus 2:11

Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation? Hebrews 1:14

How shall we escape, if we neglect so great **salvation**; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him... Hebrews 2:3

For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their **salvation** perfect through sufferings. Hebrews 2:10

And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal **salvation** unto all them that obey him... Hebrews 5:9

But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and things that accompany **salvation**, though we thus speak. Hebrews 6:9

So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto **salvation**. Hebrews 9:28

Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto **salvation** ready to be revealed in the last time. 1 Peter 1:5

Receiving the end of your faith, even the **salvation** of your souls. Of which **salvation** the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you. 1 Peter 1:9-10

Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless. Account that the longsuffering of our Lord is **salvation**... 2 Peter 3:14-15

Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common **salvation**, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. Jude 1:3

Lo a great multitude...cried with a loud voice, saying, **Salvation** to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. Revelation 7:10

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come **salvation**, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. Revelation 12:10

After these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; **Salvation**, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. ## **TESTIMONY**

As the LORD commanded Moses, so Aaron laid it up before the **Testimony**, to be kept. Exodus 16:34

If the ox were wont to push with his horn in time past, and it hath been **testified** to his owner, and he hath not kept him in, but that he hath killed a man or a woman; the ox shall be stoned, and his owner also shall be put to death. Exodus 21:29

Thou shalt put into the ark the **testimony** which I shall give thee... Thou shalt put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the **testimony** that I shall give thee. And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy sea, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the **testimony**, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel. Exodus 25:16, 21-22

Thou shalt hang up the vail under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the vail the ark of the **testimony**: and the vail shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy. Thou shalt put the mercy seat upon the ark of the **testimony** in the most holy place. Exodus 26:34

In the tabernacle of the congregation without the vail, which is before the **testimony**, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel. Exodus 27:21

Thou shalt put it before the vail that is by the ark of the **testimony**, before the mercy seat that is over the **testimony**, where I will meet with thee... Thou shalt anoint the tabernacle of the congregation therewith, and the ark of the **testimony**... Exodus 30:6, 26

Thou shalt beat some of it very small, and put of it before the **testimony** in the tabernacle of the congregation, where I will meet with thee: it shall be unto you most holy. Exodus 30:36

The tabernacle of the congregation, and the ark of the **testimony**, and the mercy seat that is thereupon, and all the furniture of the tabernacle... *Exodus* 31:7

He gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of **testimony**, tables of stone, written with the finger of God. Exodus 31:18

Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the **testimony** were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written. Exodus 32:15

It came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of **testimony** in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses wist not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him. Exodus 34:29

This is the sum of the tabernacle, even of the tabernacle of the **testimony**, as it was counted, according to the commandment of Moses, for the service of the Levites, by the hand of Ithamar, son to Aaron the priest. Exodus 38:21

They brought the tabernacle unto Moses, the tent of the congregation finished: and the children of Israel did according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so did they. And they brought the tabernacle unto Moses, the tent, and all his furniture, his taches, his boards, his bars, and his pillars, and his sockets, and the covering of rams' skins dyed red, and the covering of badgers' skins, and the veil of the covering, the ark of the testimony, and the staves thereof, and the mercy seat... Exodus 39:33-35

Thou shalt put therein the ark of the **testimony**, and cover the ark with the vail... Thou shalt set the altar of gold for the incense before the ark of the **testimony**, and put the hanging of the door to the tabernacle...He took and put the **testimony** into the ark, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark: and he brought the ark into the tabernacle, and set up the vail of the covering, and covered the ark of the **testimony**; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 40:3, 5, 20-21

He shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the **testimony**, that he die not... Leviticus 16:13

Without the vail of the **testimony**, in the tabernacle of the congregation, shall Aaron order it from the evening unto the morning before the LORD continually: it shall be a statute for ever... Leviticus 24:3

Thou shalt appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of **testimony**, and over all the vessels thereof, and over all things that belong to it: they shall bear the tabernacle, and all the vessels thereof; and they shall minister unto it, and shall encamp round about the tabernacle. Numbers 1:50

The Levites shall pitch round about the tabernacle of **testimony**, that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel: and the Levites shall keep the charge of the tabernacle of **testimony**. Numbers 1:53

When the camp setteth forward, Aaron shall come, and his sons, and they shall take down the covering vail, and cover the ark of **testimony** with it... Numbers 4:5

When Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the ark of **testimony**, from between the two cherubims; and he spake unto him. Numbers 7:89

On the day that the tabernacle was reared up the cloud covered the tabernacle, namely, the tent of the **testimony**: and at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning. Numbers 9:15

It came to pass on the twentieth day of the second month, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the **testimony**. Numbers 10:11

Thou shalt lay them up in the tabernacle of the congregation before the **testimony**, where I will meet with you. Numbers 17:4

The LORD said unto Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token against the rebels; and thou shalt quite take away their murmurings from me, that they die not. Numbers 17:10

Whoso killeth any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not **testify** against any person to cause him to die. Numbers 35:30

These are the **testimonies**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt. Deuteronomy 4:45

Ye shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and his testimonies, and his statutes, which he hath commanded thee...And when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What mean the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD our God hath commanded you? Deuteronomy 6:17, 20

It shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish. Deuteronomy 8:19

If a false witness rise up against any man to **testify** against him that which is wrong... The judges shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and hath **testified** falsely against his brother; Then shall ye do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt thou put the evil away from among you. Deuteronomy 19:16, 18

It shall come to pass, when many evils and troubles are befallen them, that this song shall **testify** against them as a witness; for it shall not be forgotten otu of the mouths of their seed: for I know their imagination which they go about, even now, before I have brought them into the land which Isware. Deuteronomy 31:21

He said unto them, Set your hearts unto all the words which I **testify** among you this day, which ye shall command your children to observe to do, all the words of this law. Deuteronomy 32:46

Command the priests that bear the ark of the **testimony**, that they come up out of Jordan. Joshua 4:16

I went out full, and the LORD hath brought me home again empty: why then call ye me Naomi, seeing the LORD hath **testified** against me, and the Almighty hath afflicted me? Ruth 1:21

Now this was the manner in former time in Israel concerning redeeming and concerning changing, for to confirm all things; a man plucked off his shoe, and gave it to his neighbour: and this was a **testimony** in Israel. Ruth 4:7

David said unto him, Thy blood be upon thy head; for thy mouth hath testified against thee, saying, I have slain the LORD'S anointed. 2 Samuel 1:16

Keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, to keep his statutes, and his commandments, and his judgments, and his testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that thou mayest prosper in all that thou doest, and whithersoever thou turnest thyself. 1 Kings 2:3

He brought forth the king's son, and put the crown upon him, and gave him the **testimony**; and they made him king, and anointed him; and they clapped their hands, and said, God save the king. 2 Kings 11:12

They rejected his statutes, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his **testimonies** which he **testified** against them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the heathen that were round about them, concerning whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them. 2 Kings 17:15

Yet the LORD **testified** against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn ye from your evil ways, and keep my commandments and my statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by my servants the prophets. 2 Kings 17:13

The king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his **testimonies** and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant. 2 Kings 23:3

Give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep thy commandments, thy **testimonies**, and thy statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the palace, for the which I have made provision. 1 Chronicles 29:19

He sent prophets to them, to bring them again unto the LORD; and they testified against them: but they would not give ear. 2 Chronicles 24:19

The king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep s commandments, and his **testimonies**, and his statutes, with all his heart, and with all his soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book. 2 Chronicles 34:31

Nevertheless they were disobedient, and rebelled against thee, and cast thy law behind their backs, and slew thy prophets which testified against them to turn them to thee, and they wrought great provocations... After they had rest, they did evil again before thee: therefore leftest thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto thee, thou heardest them from heaven; and many times didst thou deliver them according to thy mercies; and testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and hardened their neck, and would not hear... Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept thy law, nor hearkened unto thy commandments and thy testimonies, wherewith thou didst testify against them. Nehemiah 9:26, 28-29, 34

Many years didst thou forbear them, and **testifiedst** against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the people of the lands. Nehemiah 9:30

In those days saw I in Judah some treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bring in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all manner of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I **testified** against them in the day wherein they sold victuals. Nehemaih 13:15

Then I **testified** against them, and said unto them, Why lodge ye about the wall? If ye do so again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no more on the sabbath. Nehemiah 13:21

Thine own mouth condemneth thee, and not I: yea, thine own lips **testify** against thee. Job 15:6

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the **testimony** of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. Psalm 19:7

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his **testimonies**. Psalm 25:10

Hear, O my people, and I will speak; O Israel, and I will **testify** against thee: I am God, even thy God. Psalm 50:7

For he established a **testimony** in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children... Psalm 78:5

They tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not his testimonies... Psalm 78:56

This he ordained in Joseph for a **testimony**, when he went out through the land of Egypt: where I heard a language that I understood not... Hear, O my people, and I will **testify** unto thee: O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me; There shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any strange god. Psalm 81:5, 8-9

Thy testimonies are very sure: holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever. Psalm 93:5

He spake unto them in the cloudy pillar: they kept his **testimonies**, and the ordinance that he gave them. Psalm 99:7

Blessed are they that keep his **testimonies**, and that seek him with the whole heart...I have rejoiced in the way of thy **testimonies**, as much as in all riches...Remove from me reproach and contempt; for I have kept thy **testimonies**. Psalm 119:2, 14, 22

Thy testimonies also are my delight and my counsellors...I have stuck unto thy testimonies: O LORD, put me not to shame...Incline my heart unto thy testimonies, and not to covetousness. Psalm 119:24, 31, 36

I will speak of thy **testimonies** also before kings, and will not be ashamed...I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto thy **testimonies**...Let those that fear thee turn unto me, and those that have known thy **testimonies**...Quicken me after thy lovingkindness; so shall I keep the **testimony** of thy mouth...The wicked have waited for me to destroy me: but I will consider thy **testimonies**...I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy **testimonies** are my meditation. Psalm 119:46, 59, 79, 88, 95, 99

Thy testimonies have I taken as an heritage for ever: for they are the rejoicing of my heart... Thou puttest away all the wicked of the earth like dross: therefore I love thy testimonies... I am thy servant; give me understanding, that I may know thy testimonies... Psalm 119:111, 119, 125

Thy testimonies are wonderful: therefore doth my soul keep them... Thy testimonies that thou hast commanded are righteous and very faithful. Psalm 119:129, 135

The righteousness of thy **testimonies** is everlasting: give me understanding, and I shall live...I cried unto thee; save me, and I shall keep thy **testimonies**...Concerning thy **testimonies**, I have known of old that thou hast founded them for ever...Many are my persecutors and mine enemies; yet do I not decline from thy **testimonies**...My soul hath kept thy **testimonies**; and I love them exceedingly. I have kept thy precepts and thy **testimonies**: for all my ways are before thee. Psalm 119:144, 146, 152, 157, 167-168

Jerusalem is builded as a city that is compact together: Whither the tribes go up, the tribes of the LORD, unto the **testimony** of Israel, to give thanks unto the name of the LORD. Psalm 122:3-4

If thy children will keep my covenant and my **testimony** that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore. Psalm 132:12

Bind up the **testimony**, seal the law among my disciples... Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion. And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? For the living to the dead? To the law and to the **testimony**: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. Isaiah 8:16, 18-20

For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins **testify** against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them... Isaiah 59:12

O LORD, though our iniquities **testify** against us, do thou it for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against thee. Jeremiah 14:7

Because ye have burned incense, and because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day. Jeremiah 44:23

The pride of Israel doth **testify** to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them. Hosea 5:5

Hear ye, and testify in the house of Jacob, saith the Lord GOD, the God of hosts. Amos 3:13

O my people, what have I done unto thee? And wherein have I wearied thee? **Testify** against me. Micah 6:3

## TESTIMONY AND TESTIFY IN THE NEW COVENANT

Jesus saith unto him, See thou tell no man; but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a **testimony** unto them. Matthew 8:4

Ye shall be brought before governors and kings for my sake, for a **testimony** against them and the Gentiles. Matthew 10:18

See thou say nothing to any man: but go thy way, shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing those things which Moses commanded, for a **testimony** unto them. Mark 1:44

Whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for a **testimony** against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city. Mark 6:11

Take heed to yourselves: for they shall deliver you up to councils; and in the synagogues ye shall be beaten: and ye shall be brought before rulers and kings for my sake, for a **testimony** against them. Mark 13:9

He charged him to tell no man: but go, and shew thyself to the priest, and offer for thy cleansing, according as Moses commanded, for a **testimony** unto them. Luke 5:14

Whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a **testimony** against them. Luke 9:5

He said, I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldst send him to my father's house: For I have five brethren; that he may **testify** unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. Abraham saith unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them...If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead. Luke 16:26-31

They shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. And it shall turn to you for a **testimony**. Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. Luke 21:12-15

Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all men, and needed not that any should **testify** of man: for he knew what was in man. John 2:24-25

Verily, verily, I say unto thee, We speak that we do know, and **testify** that we have seen; and ye receive not our witness. John 3:11

What he hath seen and heard, that he **testifieth**; and no man receiveth his **testimony**. He that hath received his **testimony** hath set to his seal that God is true. John 3:32-33

Many of the Samaritans of that city believed on him for the saying of the woman, which **testified**, He told me all that ever I did. John 4:39

For Jesus himself **testified**, that a prophet hath no honour in his own country. John 4:44

I receive not **testimony** from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved. John 5:34

Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which **testify** of me. John 5:39

The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I **testify** of it, that the works thereof are evil. John 7:7

It is also written in your law, that the **testimony** of two men is true. John 8:17

When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and **testified**, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me. John 13:21

When the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall **testify** of me... John 15:26

This is the disciple which **testifieth** of these things, and wrote these things: and we know that his **testimony** is true. John 21:24

With many other words did he **testify** and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. Acts 2:40

They, when they had **testified** and preached the word of the Lord, returned to Jerusalem, and preached the gospel in many villages of the Samaritans. Acts 8:25

He commanded us to preach unto the people, and to **testify** that it is he which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. Acts 10:42

When he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave **testimony**, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will. Acts 13:22

Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave **testimony** unto the word of his grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands. Acts 14:3

When Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and **testified** to the Jews that Jesus was Christ. Acts 18:5

I have kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have showed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house, **testifying** both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ...None of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to **testify** the gospel of the grace of God. Acts 20:20-21, 24

Make haste, and get thee quickly out of Jerusalem: for they will not receive thy **testimony** concerning me. And I said, Lord... Acts 22:18-19

The night following the Lord stood by him, and said, Be of good cheer, Paul: for as thou hast **testified** of me in Jerusalem, so must thou bear witness also at Rome. Acts 23:11

My manner of life from my youth, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, know all the Jews; which knew me from the beginning, if they would **testify**, that after the most straitest sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee. Acts 26:4-5

When they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into his lodging; to whom he expounded and **testified** the kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and out of the prophets, from morning till evening. Acts 28:23

I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ; That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge; Even as the **testimony** of Christ was confirmed in you: so that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ... 1 Corinthians 1:4-8

I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the **testimony** of God. 1 Corinthians 2:1

If Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain. Yea, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have **testified** of God that he raised up Christ: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not. 1 Corinthians 15:14-15

For our rejoicing is this, the **testimony** of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward. 2 Corinthians 1:12

For I **testify** again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law. Galatians 5:3

This I say therefore, and **testify** in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But ye have not so learned Christ; If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts... Ephesians 4:17-22

... That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and **testified**. 1 Thessalonians 4:6

When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our **testimony** among you was believed) in that day. 2 Thessalonians 1:10

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be **testified** in due time. 1 Timothy 2:5-6

Be not thou therefore ashamed of the **testimony** of our Lord, nor or me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God... 2 Timothy 1:8

One in a certain place **testified**, saying, What is man, that thou art mindful of him? Or the son of man, that thou visitest him? Hebrews 2:6

Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a **testimony** of those things which were to be spoken after... Hebrews 3:5

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by he being dead yet speaketh. By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. Hebrews 11:4-5

Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it **testified** beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. 1 Peter 1:11

By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and **testifying** that this is the true grace of God, wherein ye stand. 1 Peter 5:12

We have seen and do **testify** that the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world. 1 John 4:14

If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath **testified** of his Son. 1 John 5:9

For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and **testified** of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth. 3 John 1:3

The revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to show unto his servants things which must shortly come to pass; and he sent and signified it by his angel unto his servant John: who bare record of the word of God, and of the **testimony** of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw. Revelation 1:1-2

I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the **testimony** of Jesus Christ. Revelation 1:9

When he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the **testimony** which they held... Revelation 6:9

When they shall have finished their **testimony**, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against the, and shall overcome them, and kill them. Revelation 11:7

They overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11

The dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the **testimony** of Jesus Christ. Revelation 12:17

After that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the **testimony** in heaven was opened... Revelation 15:5

I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, see thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the **testimony** of Jesus; worship God: for the **testimony** of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. Revelation 19:10
