THE BLOOD

*Take to them every man a lamb... They shall take of the **blood**, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door posts of the houses, wherein they shall eat it... And the **blood** shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the **blood**, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. Exodus 12:3, 7, 13*

*Ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the **blood** that is in the bason, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the **blood** that is in the bason; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when he seeth the **blood** upon the lintel, and on the two side posts, the LORD will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite you. Exodus 12:22-23*

*Thou shalt not offer the **blood** of my sacrifice with leavened bread; neither shall the fat of my sacrifice remain until the morning. Exodus 23:18*

*Moses took half of the **blood**, and put it in basons; and half of the **blood** he sprinkled on the altar. And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient. And Moses took the **blood**, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the **blood** of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words. Exodus 24:6, 8*

*Thou shalt take of the **blood** of the bullock, and put it upon the horns of the altar with thy finger, and pour all the **blood** beside the bottom of the altar... and thou shalt slay the ram, and thou shalt take his **blood**, and sprinkle it round about upon the altar... Then shalt thou kill the ram, and take of his **blood**, and put it upon the tip of the right ear of Aaron, and upon the tip of the right ear of his sons, and upon the thumb of their right hand, and upon the great toe of their right foot, and sprinkle the **blood** that is upon the altar, and of the anointing oil, and sprinkle it upon Aaron, and upon his garments, and upon his sons, and upon the garments of his sons with him: and he shall be hallowed, and his garments, and his sons, and his sons' garments with him. Exodus 29:12, 16, 20-21*

*Aaron shall make an atonement upon the horns of it once in a year with the **blood** of the sin offering of atonements; once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD. Exodus 30:10*

*Thou shalt not offer the **blood** of my sacrifice with leaven; neither shall the sacrifice of the feast of the passover be left unto the morning. Exodus 34:25*

*The priest that is anointed shall bring of the bullock's **blood** to the tabernacle of the congregation: and the priest shall dip his finger in some of the **blood**, and sprinkle it seven times before the LORD, even before the veil. And he shall put some of the **blood** upon the horns of the altar which is before the LORD, that is in the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall pour out all the **blood** at the bottom of the altar of the burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. Leviticus 4:16-18*

*He shall sprinkle of the **blood** of the sin offering upon the side of the altar; and the rest of the **blood** shall be wrung out at the bottom of the altar; it is a sin offering. Leviticus 5:9*

*Whatsoever shall touch the flesh thereof shall be holy: and when there is sprinkled of the **blood** thereof upon any garment, thou shalt wash that whereon it was sprinkled in the holy place...And no sin offering, whereof any of the **blood** is brought into the tabernacle of the congregation to reconcile withal in the holy place, shall be eaten: it shall be burnt in the fire. Leviticus 6:27, 30*

*In the place where they kill the burnt offering shall they kill the trespass offering: and the **blood** thereof shall he sprinkle round about upon the altar...And of it he shall offer one out of the whole oblation for an heave offering unto the LORD, and it shall be the priest's that sprinkle the **blood** of the peace offerings. Leviticus 7:2, 14*

*Moreover ye shall eat no manner of **blood**, whether it be of fowl or of beast, in any of your dwellings...Whatsoever soul it be that eateth any manner of **blood**, even that soul shall be cut off from his people.. Leviticus 7:26-27*

Moses took of the anointing oil, and of the **blood** which was upon the altar, and sprinkled it upon Aaron, and upon his garments, and upon his sons, and upon his sons' garments with him; and sanctified Aaron, and his garments, and his sons, and his sons' garments with him. Leviticus 8:30

When the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest: Who shall offer it before the LORD, and make an atonement for her; and she shall be cleansed from the issue of her **blood**. This is the law for her that hath born a male or a female. Leviticus 12:6-7

The priest shall take one he lamb, and offer him for a trespass offering, and the log of oil, and wave them for a wave offering before the LORD: and he shall **slay the lamb** in the place where he shall kill the sin offering and the burnt offering, in the holy place: for as the sin offering is the priest's, so is the trespass offering: it is most holy. Leviticus 14:12-13

He shall take of the **blood** of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the **blood** with his finger seven times. Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his **blood** within the vail, and do with that **blood** as he did with the **blood** of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat...and he shall go out unto the altar that is before the LORD, and make an atonement for it; and shall take of the **blood** of the bullock, and of the blood of the goat, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about. And he shall sprinkle of the **blood** upon it with his finger seven times, and cleanse it, and hallow it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel. Leviticus 16:14-15, 18-19

The priest shall sprinkle the **blood** upon the altar of the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a sweet savour unto the LORD... Whatsoever man there be of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of **blood**; I will even set my face against that soul that eateth **blood**, and will cut him off from among his people. For the life of the flesh is in the **blood**: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the **blood** that maketh an atonement for the soul. Leviticus 17:6, 10-11

*I said unto the children of Israel, No soul of you shall eat **blood**, neither shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat **blood**...For it is the life of all flesh; the **blood** of it is for the life thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall eat the **blood** of no manner of flesh: for the life of all flesh is in the **blood** thereof: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off. Leviticus 17:12, 14*

*If the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled; and the revenger of **blood** find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of **blood** kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of **blood**...So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye are: for **blood** it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the **blood** that is shed therein, but by the **blood** of him that shed it. Numbers 35:26-27, 33*

*If the place which the LORD thy God hath chosen to put his name there be too far from thee, then thou shalt kill of thy herd and of thy flock, which the LORD hath given thee, as I have commanded thee, and thou shalt eat in thy gates whatsoever thy soul lusteth after... Only be sure that thou eat not the **blood**: for the **blood** is the life; and thou mayest not eat the life with the flesh...And thou shalt offer thy burnt offerings, the flesh and the **blood**, upon the altar of the LORD thy God: and the **blood** of thy sacrifices shall be poured out upon the altar of the LORD thy God, and thou shalt eat the flesh. Deuteronomy 12:21, 23, 27*

*If thou shalt keep all these commandments to do them, which I command thee this day, to love the LORD thy God, and to walk ever in his ways... That innocent **blood** be not shed in thy land, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance, and so **blood** be upon thee... Then the elders of his city shall send and fetch him thence, and deliver him into the hand of the avenger of **blood**, that he may die. Thine eye shall not pity him, but thou shalt put away the guilt of innocent **blood** from Israel, that it may go well with thee. Deuteronomy 19:10, 12-13*

*They shall answer and say, Our hands have not shed this **blood**, neither have our eyes seen it. Be merciful, O LORD, unto thy people Israel, whom thou hast redeemed, and lay not innocent **blood** unto thy people of Israel's charge. And the **blood** shall be forgiven them. So shalt thou put away the guilt of innocent **blood** from among you, when thou shalt do that which is right in the sight of the LORD. Deuteronomy 21:7-9*

*Blessed be thy advice, and blessed be thou, which hast kept me this day from coming to shed **blood**, and from avenging myself with mine own hand. 1 Samuel 25:33*

*When David heard it, he said, I and my kingdom are guiltless before the LORD for ever from the **blood** of Abner the son of Ner: 2 Samuel 3:28*

*The king said unto him, Do as he hath said, and fall upon him, and bury him; that thou mayest take away the innocent **blood**, which Joab shed, from me, and from the house of my father. And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing thereof, to wit, Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah. 1 Kings 2:31-32*

*They cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the **blood** gushed out upon them. 1 Kings 18:28*

*Moreover Manasseh shed innocent **blood** very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his sin wherewith he made Judah to sin, in doing that which was evil in the sight of the LORD...also for the innocent **blood** that he shed: for he filled Jerusalem with innocent **blood**; which the LORD would not pardon. 2 Kings 21:16, 24:4*

*The word of the LORD came to me, saying, Thou hast shed **blood** abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto my name, because thou hast shed much **blood** upon the earth in my sight. 1 Chronicles 22:8*

*They killed the passover, and the priests sprinkled the **blood** from their hands, and the Levites flayed them. 2 Chronicles 35:11*

*Their sorrows shall be multiplied that hasten after another god: their drink offerings of **blood** will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips. Psalm 16:4*

*The righteous shall rejoice when he seeth the vengeance: he shall wash his feet in the **blood** of the wicked. Psalm 58:10*

*He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their **blood** be in his sight. Psalm 72:14*

*Their **blood** have they shed like water round about Jerusalem; and there was none to bury them. We are become a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us. Psalm 79:3-4*

*These six things doth the LORD hath: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent **blood**, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, a false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19*

*A man that doeth violence to the **blood** of any person shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him. Proverbs 28:17*

*And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of **blood**. Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil; Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. Isaiah 1:15-17*

*He that walketh righteously, and speaketh uprightly; he that despiseth the gain of oppressions, that shaketh his hands from holding of bribes, that stoppeth his ears from hearing of **blood**, and shutteth his eyes from seeing evil; He shall dwell on high: his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks: bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure. Isaiah 33:15-16*

*When I say to the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his **blood** will I require at thine hand. Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul. When a righteous man doth turn from the righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die; because thou hast not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he hath done shall not be remembered; but his **blood** will I require at thine hand. Ezekiel 3:18-20*

THE BLOOD IN THE NEW COVENANT

*And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the **blood** of the prophets... That upon you may come all the **blood** of righteous Abel unto the **blood** of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom ye slew between the temple and the altar. Matthew 23:30, 35*

*For this is **my blood** of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. Matthew 26:28*

*Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent **blood**. And they said, What is that to us? See thou to that. Matthew 27:4*

*And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of **blood**. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. Wherefore that field was called, The field of **blood**, unto this day. Matthew 27:6-8*

*When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the **blood** of this just person: see ye to it. Then answered all the people, and said, His **blood** be on us, and on our children. Matthew 27:24-25*

*And he said unto them, This is **my blood** of the new testament, which is shed for many. Mark 14:24*

*That the **blood** of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation; From the **blood** of Abel unto the **blood** of Zacharias, which perished between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, It shall be required of this generation. Luke 11:50-51*

*He took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in **my blood**, which is shed for you...Being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were **great drops of blood** falling down to the ground. Luke 22:19-20, 44*

*As many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: Which were born, not of **blood**, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John 1:12-14*

*Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink **his blood**, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh **my blood**, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For my flesh is meat indeed, and **my blood**, is drink indeed. He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh **my blood**, dwelleth in me, and I in him. John 6:53-56*

*When they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out **blood** and water. John 19:33-34*

*For he was numbered with us, and had obtained part of this ministry. Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, **Acedama**, that is to say, **The field of blood**. Acts 1:17-19*

*And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: and on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: and I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; **blood**, and fire, and vapour of smoke: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into **blood**, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: Acts 2:19-20*

*The high priest asked them, Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this name? And, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring **this man's blood** upon us. Acts 5:27-28*

*My sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from **blood**. For Moses of old time hath in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day. ... For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from **blood**, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Acts 15:19-21, 28-29*

*God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands; Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things; And hath made of one **blood** all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation; That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring. Acts 17:24-28*

*Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I am pure from the **blood** of all men. Acts 20:26*

*Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with **his own blood**. Acts 20:28*

*As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from **blood**, and from strangled, and from fornication. Acts 21:25*

*And when the **blood** of the martyr Stephen was shed, I also was standing by, and consenting unto his death, and kept the raiment of them that slew him. Acts 22:20*

*Their feet are swift to shed **blood**: Destruction and misery are in their ways: and the way of peace they have not known. Romans 3:15-17*

*For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in **his blood**, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; Romans 3:25*

*But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by **his blood**, we shall be saved from wrath through him. Romans 5:8-9*

*The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of **the blood** of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we being many are one bread, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread. 1 Corinthians 10:16-17*

*After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in **my blood**: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come. Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and **blood of the Lord**. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. 1 Corinthians 11:25-30*

*Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and **blood** cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. 1 Corinthians 15:50*

*Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will, To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through **his blood**, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; Ephesians 1:5-7*

*But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by **the blood of Christ**. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; and that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby: Ephesians 2:13-16*

*Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and **blood**, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Ephesians 6:10-12*

*Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through **his blood**, even the forgiveness of sins: Colossians 1:12-14*

*And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; And having made peace through **the blood** of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled in the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreprouceable in his sight: if ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached... Colossians 1:17-23*

*Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and **blood**, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham. Hebrews 2:14-16*

*Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God. But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without **blood**, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people... Hebrews 9:6-7*

*But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; Neither by the **blood** of goats and calves, but by **his own blood** he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. For if the **blood** of bulls and goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Hebrews 9:11-14*

*Whereupon neither the first testament was dedicated without **blood**. For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the **blood** of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, Saying, This is the **blood** of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you. Moreover he sprinkled with **blood** both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry. And almost all things are by the law purged with **blood**; and without shedding of **blood** is no remission... Nor yet that ye should offer himself often, as the high priest entered into the holy place every year with **blood** of others; Hebrews 9:18-23, 25*

*For it is not possible that the **blood** of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Hebrews 10:4*

*This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the LORD, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by **the blood of Jesus**, Hebrews 10:16-19*

*Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted **the blood of the covenant**, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? Hebrews 10:29*

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice [blood] than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh. Hebrews 11:4

*Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of **blood**, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them. Hebrews 11:28*

*Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. Ye have not yet resisted unto **blood**, striving against sin. Hebrews 12:2-4*

*To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect. And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the **blood** of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel. See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven. Hebrews 12:23-25*

*For the bodies of those beasts, whose **blood** is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp. Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with **his own blood**, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach. Hebrews 13:11-13*

*Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through **the blood** of the everlasting covenant, Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:20-21*

*Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of **the blood** of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace be multiplied. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you...
1 Peter 1:2-4*

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with **the precious blood of Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:18-21

This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and **the blood of Jesus Christ** his Son cleanseth us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:5-9

This is he that came by water and **blood**, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and **blood**. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and **the blood**: and these three agree in one. 1 John 5:6-8

And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in **his own blood**. Revelation 1:5

They sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by **thy blood** out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; Revelation 5:9

When he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: They cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our **blood** on them that dwell on the earth? And white robes were given every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled. Revelation 6:9-11

*I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in **the blood of the Lamb**. Revelation 7:14*

*They overcame him by **the blood of the Lamb**, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11*

*The winepress was trodden without the city, and **blood** came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs. Revelation 14:20*

*The second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the **blood** of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea. And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and the fountains of waters; and they became **blood**. ...For they have shed the **blood** of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them **blood** to drink; for they are worthy. Revelation 16:3-4, 6*

*I saw the woman drunken with the **blood** of the saints, and with the **blood** of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. Revelation 17:6*

*In her was found the **blood** of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth. Revelation 18:24*

*He was clothed with a vesture dipped in **blood**: and his name is called The Word of God. Revelation 19:13*

LAMBS AND SHEEP

*She again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of **sheep**, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. Genesis 4:2*

*Abraham set seven ewe **lambs** of the flock by themselves. And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What mean these seven ewe **lambs** which thou hast set by themselves: And he said, For these seven ewe **lambs** shalt thou take of my hand, that they may be a witness unto me, that I have digged this well. Genesis 21:28-30*

*Isaac spake unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the **lamb** for a burnt offering? Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a **lamb** for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. Genesis 22:7-8*

*Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a **lamb**, according to the house of their fathers, a **lamb** for an house: And if the household be too little for the **lamb**, let him and his neighbour next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the **lamb**. Your **lamb** shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the **sheep**, or from the goats: Exodus 12:3-5*

*Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take out a **lamb** according to your families, and kill the passover. Exodus 12:21*

*Now this is that which thou shalt offer upon the altar; two **lambs** of the first year day by day continually. The one **lamb** thou shalt offer in the morning; and the other **lamb** thou shalt offer at even. Exodus 29:38-39*

*The firstling of an ass thou shalt redeem with a **lamb**: and if thou redeem him not, then shalt thou break his neck. All the firstborn of thy sons thou shalt redeem. And none shall appear before me empty. Exodus 34:20*

*If he offer a **lamb** for his offering, then shall he offer it before the LORD. Leviticus 3:7*

*Then ye shall sacrifice one kid of the goats for a sin offering, and two **lambs** of the first year for a sacrifice of peace offerings. And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the LORD, with the two **lambs**: they shall be holy unto the LORD for the priest. Leviticus 23:19-20*

*Thou shalt not sacrifice unto the LORD thy God any bullock, or **sheep**, wherein is blemish, or any evilfavouredness: for that is an abomination unto the LORD thy God. Deuteronomy 17:1*

*Samuel took a sucking **lamb**, and offered it for a burnt offering wholly unto the LORD: and Samuel cried unto the LORD for Israel; and the LORD heard him. 1 Samuel 7:9*

*Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which is with the **sheep**. 1 Samuel 16:19*

*David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's **sheep** at Bethlehem...David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's **sheep**, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a **lamb** out of the flock: 1 Samuel 17:15, 34*

*They offered unto the LORD the same time, of the spoil which they had brought, seven hundred oxen and seven thousand **sheep**. 2 Chronicles 15:11*

*Thou hast given us like **sheep** appointed for meat; and hast scattered us among the heathen... Yea, for thy sake are we killed all the day long; we are counted as sheep for the slaughter. Psalms 44:11, 22*

*But made his own people to go forth like **sheep**, and guided them in the wilderness like a flock...For he is our God; and we are the people of his pasture, and the **sheep** of his hand. Psalm 78:52, 95:7*

*I have gone astray like a lost **sheep**; seek thy servant; for I do not forget thy commandments. Psalm 119:176*

*When Israel went out of Egypt...the sea saw it and fled: Jordan was driven back. The mountains skipped like **rams**, and the little hills like **lambs**. What ailed thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? Thou Jordan, that thou wast driving back? Ye mountains, that ye skipped like **rams**; and ye little hills, like **lambs**? Psalms 144:1, 3-6*

*Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, and look well to thy herds.... The **lambs** are for thy clothing, and the goats are the price of the field. Proverbs 27:23, 26*

*To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? Saith the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of **lambs**, or of he goats...Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting...and when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear; your hands are full of blood. Isaiah 1:11, 13, 15*

*The LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God that is holy shall be sanctified in righteousness. Then shall the **lambs** feed after their manner, and the waste places of the fat ones shall strangers eat. Isaiah 5:16-17*

*The wolf also shall dwell with the **lamb**, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox... They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. Isaiah 11:6-7, 9*

*The sword of the LORD is filled with blood, it is made fat with fatness, and with the blood of **lambs** and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams: for the LORD hath a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Idumea...For it is the day of the LORD'S vengeance, and the year of recompences for the controversy of Zion. Isaiah 34:6, 8*

*He shall feed his flock like a shepherd: he shall gather the **lambs** with his arm, and carry them in his bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young. Isaiah 40:11*

*He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a **lamb** to the slaughter, and as a **sheep** before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. Isaiah 53:7*

*The wolf and the **lamb** shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith the LORD. Isaiah 65:25*

*Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the **sheep** of my pasture! saith the LORD. Jeremiah 23:1*

*I will bring them down like **lambs** to the slaughter, like rams with he goats. How is Sheshach taken! And how is the praise of the whole earth surprised! How is Babylon become an astonishment among the nations! Jeremiah 51:40-41*

*Dedan was thy merchant in precious clothes for chariots. Arabia, and all the princes of Kedar, they occupied with thee in **lambs, and rams, and goats**: in these were they thy merchants. Ezekiel 27:20-21*

*For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, will both search my **sheep**, and seek them out. As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his **sheep** that are scattered; so will I seek out my **sheep**, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day. Ezekiel 34:11-12*

*Ye shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of **lambs**, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan. And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you. Ezekiel 39:18-19*

*The people of the land shall worship at the door of this gate before the LORD in the sabbaths and in the new moons. And the burnt offering that the prince shall offer unto the LORD in the sabbath day shall be six **lambs** without blemish, and a **ram** without blemish. And the meat offering shall be an ephah for a **ram**, and the meat offering for the **lambs** as he shall be able to give, and an hin of oil to an ephah. And in the day of the new moon it shall be a young bullock without blemish, and six **lambs**, and a **ram**: they shall be without blemish. And he shall prepare a meat offering, an ephah for a bullock, and an ephah for a **ram**, and for the **lambs** according as his hand shall attain unto, and an hin of oil to an ephah. Ezekiel 46:3-7*

*Now when the prince shall prepare a voluntary burnt offering or peace offerings voluntarily unto the LORD, one shall then open him the gate that looketh toward the east, and he shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, as he did on the sabbath day: then he shall go forth; and after his going forth one shall shut the gate. Thou shalt daily prepare a burnt offering unto the LORD of a **lamb** of the first year without blemish: thou shalt prepare it every morning... Thus shall they prepare the **lamb**, and the meat offering, and the oil, every morning for a continual burnt offering. Ezekiel 46:12-13, 15*

*Though thou, Israel, play the harlot, yet let not Judah offend; and come not ye unto Gilgal, neither go ye up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD liveth. For Israel slideth back as a backsliding heifer: now the LORD will feed them as a **lamb** in a large place. Hosea 4:15-16*

*Woe to them that are at ease in Zion, and trust in the mountain of Samaria, which are named chief of the nations, to whom the house of Israel came!...that stretch upon beds of ivory, and stretch themselves upon their couches, and eat the **lambs** out of the flock, and the calves out of the midst of the stall; that chant to the sound of the viol, and invent to themselves instruments of musick, like David; That drink wine in bowls, and anoint themselves with the chief ointments: but they are not grieved for the affliction of Jacob. Amos 6:1, 4-6*

LAMBS AND SHEEP IN THE NEW COVENANT

*After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come. Therefore said he unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest. Go your ways; behold, I send you forth as **lambs** among wolves...and heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh you. Luke 10:1-3, 9*

*The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the **Lamb** of God, which taketh away the sin of the world. This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me...Again the next day after John stood, and two of his disciples; and looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the **Lamb** of God! John 1:29-30, 35-36*

*So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my **lambs**. He saith to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my **sheep**. He saith unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, lovest thou me? Peter was grieved because he said unto him the third time, Lovest thou me? And he said unto him, Lord, thou knowest all things; thou knowest that I love thee. Jesus saith unto him, Feed my **sheep**. John 21:15-17*

*Understandest thou what thou readest? And he said, How can I except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him. The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a **sheep** to the slaughter; and like a **lamb** dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth: In his humiliation his judgment was taken away: and who shall declare his generation? For his life is taken from the earth. And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray thee, of whom speaketh the prophet this? Of himself, or of some other man? Then Philip opened his mouth and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus. Acts 8:30-35*

*Ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a **lamb** without blemish and without spot: 1 Peter 1:18-19*

*And I beheld, and lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a **Lamb** as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the throne. And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the **Lamb**, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of the saints. Revelation 5:6-8*

*And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign upon the earth. And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the **Lamb** that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessings, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the **Lamb** for ever and ever. And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever. Revelation 5:9-14*

*And I say when the **Lamb** opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see. And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow... Revelation 6:1-2a*

*The kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the **Lamb**: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? Revelation 6:15-17*

*After this I beheld, and lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the **Lamb**, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the **Lamb**. And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. Revelation 7:9-12*

*And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? And whence came they? And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in **the blood of the Lamb**. Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. For the **Lamb** which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. Revelation 7:13-17*

*I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by **the blood of the Lamb**, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:10-11*

*They worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? Who is able to make war with him? ...And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the **Lamb** slain from the foundation of the world. Revelation 13:4, 7-8*

And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon. Revelation 13:11 [false]

*I looked, and, lo, a **Lamb** stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: And they sung as it were a new song before the throne... These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the **Lamb** whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the **Lamb**. Revelation 14:1-2, 4*

*The third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the **Lamb**: And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. Revelation 14:9-11*

*They sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the **Lamb**, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints. Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? For thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest. Revelation 15:3-4*

*The beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition. And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. These shall make war with the **Lamb**, and the **Lamb** shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him are called, and chosen, and faithful. Revelation 17:11-14*

*The four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia. And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great. And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the **Lamb** is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of the saints. And saith unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the **Lamb**. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God. Revelation 19:4-9*

*There came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the **Lamb's** wife. And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, Having the glory of God... Revelation 21:9-11a*

*The wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the **Lamb**. And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. Revelation 21:14-15*

*I say no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the **Lamb** are the temple of it. And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the **Lamb** is the light thereof. Revelation 21:22-23*

*And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there...And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the **Lamb's** book of life. Revelation 21:25, 27*

*He shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the **Lamb**. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the **Lamb** shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: and they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. Revelation 22:1-5*

HIS CROSS AND CRUCIFIXION

*He that taketh not his **cross**, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. Matthew 10:38*

*Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his **cross**, and follow me. Matthew 16:24*

*Ye know that after two days is the feast of the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be **crucified**. Matthew 26:2*

*Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? They all say unto him, Let him be **crucified**. And the governor said, Why, what evil hath he done? But they cried out the more, saying, Let him be **crucified**. When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see ye to it. Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children. Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered him to be **crucified**. Matthew 27:22-26*

*And they **crucified** him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots. And sitting down they watched him there; And set up over his head his accusation written, THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS. Matthew 27:35-37*

*Then were there two thieves **crucified** with him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. And they that passed by reviled him, wagging their heads, And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, save thyself. If thou be the Son of God, come down from the **cross**. Likewise also the chief priests mocking him, with the scribes and elders, said, He saved others; himself he cannot save. If he be the King of Israel, let him now come down from the **cross**, and we will believe him. He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God. The thieves also, which were **crucified** with him, cast the same in his teeth. Matthew 27:38-44*

*The angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was **crucified**. He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. Matthew 28:5-6*

*When he had called the people unto him with his disciples also, he said unto them, Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his **cross**, and follow me. Mark 8:34*

*Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the **cross**, and follow me. Mark 10:21*

*The chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them. And Pilate answered and said again unto them, What will ye then that I shall do unto him whom ye call the King of the Jews? And they cried out again, **Crucify him**. Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil hath he done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, **Crucify him**. And so Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged him, to be **crucified**. Mark 15:11-15*

*And when they had **crucified** him, they parted his garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take. And it was the third hour, and they **crucified** him. And the superscription of his accusation was written over, THE KING OF THE JEWS. Mark 15:24-26*

*And with him they **crucify** two thieves; the one on his right hand, and the other on his left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors. And they that passed by railed on him, wagging their heads, and saying, Ah, thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days, Save thyself, and come down from the **cross**. Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others, himself he cannot save. Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the **cross**, that we may see and believe. And they that were **crucified** with him reviled him. Mark 15:27-32*

*Entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were affrighted. And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was **crucified**: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him. But go your way, tell his disciples and Peter that he goeth before you into Galilee: there shall ye see him, as he said unto you. And they went out quickly, and fled from the sepulchre; for they trembled and were amazed: Mark 16:6-8*

*He said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his **cross** daily, and follow me. Luke 9:23*

*Whosoever doth not bear his **cross**, and come after me, cannot be my disciple. Luke 14:27*

*They were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be **crucified**. And the voices of them and of the chief priests' prevailed. And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required. And he released unto them him that for sedition and murder was cast into prison, whom they had desired; but he delivered Jesus to their will. And as they led him away, they laid hold upon one Simon, a Cyrenian, coming out of the country, and on him they laid the **cross**, that he might bear it after Jesus. Luke 23:23-26*

*When they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they **crucified** him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided him, saying, He saved others; let him save himself, if he be Christ, the chosen of God. Luke 23:33-35*

*As they were afraid, and bowed down their faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee, Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be **crucified**, and the third day rise again. And they remembered his words, And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest. Luke 24:5-9*

*And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people: And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have **crucified** him. Luke 24:19-20*

*Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be **crucified**. And they took Jesus, and led him away. He bearing his **cross** went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha: where they **crucified** him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst. And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the **cross**. Jn 19:16-19*

*Then the soldiers, when they had **crucified** Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did. John 19:23-24*

*Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was **crucified** with him. But when they came to Jesus, and saw that he was dead already, they brake not his legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water... These things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of him shall not be broken. And again another scripture saith, They shall look on him whom they pierced. John 19:32-37*

*Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury. Now in the place where he was **crucified** there was a garden; and in the garden a new sepulchre, wherein was never man yet laid. There laid they Jesus therefore because the Jews' preparation day; for the sepulchre was nigh at hand. John 19:40-42*

*Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have **crucified** and slain: Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it... Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have **crucified**, both Lord and Christ. Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? Acts 2:22-24, 36-37*

*If we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye **crucified**, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. Acts 4:9-11*

*What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is **crucified** with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more, death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.*
Romans 6:1-13

*For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the **cross** of Christ should be made of none effect. For the preaching of the **cross** is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.*
1 Corinthians 1:17-18

*But we preach Christ **crucified**, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.*
1 Corinthians 1:23-25

*I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and him **crucified**. And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.*
1 Corinthians 2:1-2

*But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have **crucified** the Lord of glory. 1 Corinthians 2:7-8*

*For though he was **crucified** through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you. 2 Corinthians 13:4*

*Since ye seek a proof of Christ speaking in me, which to youward is not weak, but is mighty in you. For though he was **crucified** through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you. 2 Corinthians 13:3-4*

*I am **crucified** with Christ; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20*

*O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, **crucified** among you? Galatians 3:1*

*And I brethren, if I yet preach circumcision, why do I yet suffer persecution? Then is the offence of the **cross** ceased. Galatians 5:11*

*They that are Christ's have **crucified** the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 5:24-26*

*As many as desire to make a fair shew in the flesh, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the **cross** of Christ. ...But God forbid that I should glory, save in the **cross** of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is **crucified** unto me, and I unto the world. Galatians 6:12, 14*

*But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition between us...to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace; And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the **cross**, having slain the enmity thereby: Ephesians 2:16*

*Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus; Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the **cross**. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:5-11*

*Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the **cross** of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.) Philippians 3:17-19*

*For it pleased the Father that in him should all fulness dwell; And, having made peace through the blood of his **cross**, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. Colossians 1:19-20*

*You, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his **cross**; Colossians 2:14*

*It is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they **crucify** to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame. Hebrews 6:4-6*

*Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the **cross**, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2*

*Their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was **crucified**. Rev 11:8*

COVENANT

*Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech; and both of them made a **covenant**. Genesis 21:27*

*God heard their groaning, and God remembered his **covenant** with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. Exodus 2:24*

*I have also established my **covenant** with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, wherein they were strangers. And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel, whom the Egyptians keep in bondage; and I have remembered my **covenant**. Exodus 6:4-5*

*Now there, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my **covenant**, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: and ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel. Exodus 19:5-6*

*Thou shalt make no **covenant** with them, nor with their gods. Exodus 23:32*

*He took the book of the **covenant**, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient. And Moses took the **blood**, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold **the blood of the covenant**, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words. Exodus 24:7-8*

*He said, Behold, I make a **covenant**: before all thy people I will do marvels, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation: and all the people among which thou art shall see the work of the LORD: for it is a terrible thing that I will do with thee. Observe thou that which I command thee this day... Take heed to thyself, lest thou make a **covenant** with the inhabitants of the land whither thou goest, lest it be for a snare in the midst of thee. But ye shall destroy their altars, break their images, and cut down their groves: For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God: Lest thou make a **covenant** with the inhabitants of the land, and they go a whoring after their gods, and do sacrifice unto their gods, and one call thee, and thou eat of his sacrifice. Exodus 34:10-15*

*And the LORD said unto Moses, Write thou these words: for after the tenor of these words I have made a **covenant** with thee and with Israel. And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the **covenant**, the ten commandments. Exodus 34:27-28*

*Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth **covenant** and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; Deuteronomy 7:9*

*When ye have transgressed the **covenant** of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and ye shall perish quickly from off the good land which he hath given you. Joshua 23:16*

*Lo Zadok also, and all the Levites were with him, bearing the ark of the **covenant** of God: and they set down the ark of God; and Abiathar went up, until all the people had done passing out of the city. 2 Samuel 15:24*

*David the son of Jesse said, and the man who was raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said, Although my house be not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting **covenant**, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire, although he make it not to grow. 2 Samuel 23:5*

*The king went up into the house of the LORD, and all the men of Judah and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem with him, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the people, both small and great: and he read in their ears all the words of the book of the **covenant** which was found in the house of the LORD. And the king stood by a pillar, and made a **covenant** before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and with all their soul, to perform the words of this **covenant** that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the **covenant**...and the king commanded all the people, saying, Keep the passover unto the LORD your God, as it is written in the book of this **covenant**. 2 Kings 23:2-3, 21*

*So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD out of the house of Obed-edom with joy. And it came to pass, when God helped the Levites that bare the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD, that they offered seven bullocks and seven rams. And David was clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also had upon him an ephod of linen. Thus all Israel brought up the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD with shouting, and with sound of the cornet, and with trumpets, and with cymbals, making a noise with psalteries and harps. 1 Chronicles 15:25-28*

*Be ye mindful always of his **covenant**; the word which he commanded to a thousand generations; even of the **covenant** which he made with Abraham, and of his oath unto Isaac; and hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting **covenant**. 1 Chronicles 16:15-17*

*So he left there before the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the ark continually, as every day's work required: 1 Chronicles 16:37*

*There was nothing in the ark save the two tables which Moses put therein at Horeb, when the LORD made a **covenant** with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt. 2 Chronicles 5:10*

*As for thee, if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded thee, and shalt observe my statutes and my judgments; then will I stablish the throne of thy kingdom, according as I have **covenanted** with David thy father, saying, there shall not fail thee a man to be rule in Israel. But if ye turn away, and forsake my statutes and my commandments, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and worship them; then will I pluck them up by the roots out of my land which I have given them; and this house, which I have sanctified for my name, will I cast out of my sight, and will make it to be a proverb and a byword among all nations. 2 Chronicles 7:18-20*

*Howbeit the LORD would not destroy the house of David, because of the **covenant** that he had made with David, and as he promised to give a light to him and to his sons for ever. 2 Chronicles 21:7*

*I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth **covenant** and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments: Let thine ear now be attentive, and thine eyes open, that thou mayest hear the prayer of thy servant, which I pray before thee now, day and night, for the children of Israel thy servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against thee: both I and my father's house have sinned. We have dealt very corruptly against thee, and have not kept the commandments....Nehemiah 1:5-7*

*All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his **covenant** and his testimonies...The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his **covenant**. Psalm 25:10, 14*

*Gather my saints together unto me; those that have made a **covenant** with me by sacrifice. Psalm 50:5*

*But unto the wicked God saith, What hast thou to do to declare my statutes, or that thou shouldest take my **covenant** in thy mouth? Psalm 50:16*

*He hath put for this hands against such as be at peace with him: he hath broken his **covenant**. Psalm 55:20*

*Have respect unto the **covenant**: for the dark places of the earth are full of the habitations of cruelty. Psalm 74:20*

*They kept not the **covenant** of God, and refused to walk in his law; Psalm 78:10*

*For their heart was not right with him, neither were they stedfast in his **covenant**. Psalm 78:37*

*I have made a **covenant** with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant...My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my **covenant** shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven. Psalm 89:3, 28-29*

*My **covenant** will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure for ever, and his throne as the sun before me. It shall be established for ever as the moon, as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah. Psalm 89:34-37*

*Thou hast made void the **covenant** of thy servant: thou hast profaned his crown by casting it to the ground. Thou hast broken down all his hedges; thou hast brought his strongholds to ruin. All that pass by the way spoil him: he is a reproach to his neighbours. Psalm 89:39-41*

*The mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children to such as keep his **covenant**, and to those that remember his commandments to do them. Psalm 103:17-18*

*He hath remembered his **covenant** for ever, the word which he commanded to a thousand generations. Which **covenant** he hath made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac; and confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting **covenant**. Psalm 105:8-10*

*Any time did he deliver them; but they provoked him with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity. Nevertheless he regarded their affliction, when he heard their cry: and he remembered for them his **covenant**, and repented according to the multitude of his mercies. Psalm 106:43-45*

*He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD is gracious and full of compassion. He hath given meat unto them that fear him: he will ever be mindful of his **covenant**... The works of his hands are verity and judgment; all his commandments are sure. They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness. He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his **covenant** for ever: holy and reverend is his name. Psalm 111:4-5, 7-9*

*The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne., If thy children will keep my **covenant** and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore. Psalm 132:11-12*

*He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his saints...to deliver thee from the strange woman, even from the stranger which flattereth with her words; which forsaketh the guide of her youth, and forgetteth the **covenant** of her God. For her house inclineth unto death, and her paths unto the dead. Proverbs 2:8, 16-18*

*The earth is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting **covenant**...Hear the word of the LORD, ye scornful men, that rule this people which is in Jerusalem. Because ye have said, We have made a **covenant** with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves. Isaiah 28:5, 14-15*

*Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. And your **covenant** with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye shall be trodden down by it. Isaiah 28:17-18*

*The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the **covenant**, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man. Isaiah 33:8*

*Thus saith God the LORD, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein: I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a **covenant** of the people, for a light to the Gentiles; To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. Isaiah 42:5-7*

*Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee. Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a **covenant** of the people... Isaiah 49:7-8*

*For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the **covenant** of my peace be removed, saith the LORD that hath mercy on thee. O thou afflicted, tossed with tempest, and not comforted, behold, I will lay thy stones with fair colours, and lay thy foundations with sapphires. Isaiah 54:10-11*

*Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will made an everlasting **covenant** with you, even the sure mercies of David. Behold, I have given him for a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people. Isaiah 55:3-4*

*For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, and chose the things that please me, and take hold of my **covenant**; Even unto them will I give in mine house and within my walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off. Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be his servants, every one that keepeth the sabbath from polluting it, and taketh hold of my **covenant**. Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: Isaiah 56:4-7*

*Behind the doors also and the posts hast thou set up thy remembrance: for thou hast discovered thyself to another than me, and art gone up; thou hast enlarged thy bed, and made thee a **covenant** with them; thou lovedst their bed where thou sawest it. And thou wentest to the king with ointment, and didst increase thy perfumes, and didst send thy messengers far off, and didst debase thyself even unto hell. Isaiah 57:8-9*

*The Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD. As for me, this is my **covenant** with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever. Isaiah 59:20-21*

*For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting **covenant** with them. And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the LORD hath blessed. Isaiah 61:8-9*

*It shall come to pass, when ye be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, saith the LORD, they shall say no more, The ark of the **covenant** of the LORD: neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it; neither shall that be done any more. Jeremiah 3:16*

*Hear ye the words of this **covenant**, and speak unto the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and say thou unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel; Cursed be the man that obeyeth not the words of his **covenant**... Jeremiah 11:2-3*

*The LORD said unto me, Proclaim all these words in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying, Hear ye the words of this **covenant**, and do them... Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this **covenant**, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not... They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my **covenant** which I made with their fathers. Jeremiah 11:6, 8, 10*

*We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, and the iniquity of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee. Do not abhor us, for thy name's sake, do not disgrace the throne of thy glory: remember, break not thy **covenant** with us. Jeremiah 14:20-21*

*Many nations shall pass by this city, and they shall say every man to his neighbour, wherefore hath the LORD done thus unto this great city? Then they shall answer, Because they have forsaken the **covenant** of the LORD their God, and worshipped other gods, and served them. Jeremiah 22:8-9*

*Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new **covenant** with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the **covenant** that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which **covenant** they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith the LORD: but this shall be the **covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel; after those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people. Jeremiah 31:31-33*

*I will make an everlasting **covenant** with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me. Yea, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with my whole heart and with my whole soul. Jeremiah 32:40-41*

Thus saith the LORD; If ye can break my **covenant** of the day, and my **covenant** of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; then may also my **covenant** be broken with David, my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me. Jeremiah 33:21-22

If my **covenant** be not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them. Jeremiah 33:25-26

In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek the LORD their God. They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual **covenant** that shall not be forgotten. Jeremiah 50:4-5

When I passed by thee, and looked upon thee, behold, thy time was the time of love; and I spread my skirt over thee, and covered thy nakedness: yea, I swore unto thee, and entered into a **covenant** with thee, saith the Lord GOD, and thou becamest mine. Then washed I thee with water; yea, I thoroughly washed away thy blood from thee, and I anointed thee with oil... For thus saith the Lord GOD; I will even deal with thee as thou hast done, which hast despised the oath in breaking the **covenant**. Nevertheless I will remember my **covenant** with thee in the days of thy youth, and I will establish unto thee an **everlasting covenant**. Then thou shalt remember thy ways, and be ashamed, when thou shalt receive thy sisters, thine elder and thy younger: and I will give them unto thee for daughters, but not by thy **covenant**. And I will establish my **covenant** with thee; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: Ezekiel 16:8-9, 59-62

I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the **covenant**: and I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 20:37-38

*I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it. I will make with them a **covenant** of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. Ezekiel 34: 24-25*

*David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them. And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David shall be their prince for ever. Moreover I will make a **covenant** of peace with them; It shall be an **everlasting covenant** with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for ever. My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their God, and they shall be my people. Ezekiel 37:24-27*

*Thou shalt say to the rebellious, even to the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; O ye house of Israel, let it suffice you of all your abominations, In that ye have brought into my sanctuary strangers, uncircumcised in flesh, to be in my sanctuary, to pollute it, even my house, when ye offer my bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken my **covenant** because of all your abominations. Ezekiel 44:6-7*

*I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes: and I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the **covenant** and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments; we have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments... Daniel 9:3-5*

*After threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined. And he shall confirm the **covenant** with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate. Daniel 9:26-27*

*Then shall he return into his land with great riches; and his heart shall be against the holy **covenant**; and he shall do exploits, and return to his own land...for the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy **covenant**: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy **covenant**. Arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate. And such as do wickedly against the **covenant** shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong and do exploits. Daniel 11:28-32*

*In that day will I make a **covenant** for them with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and with the creeping things of the ground: and I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely. And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies. I will even betroth thee unto me in faithfulness: and thou shalt know the LORD. Hosea 2:18-20*

*They like men have transgressed the **covenant**: there have they dealt treacherously against me. Hosea 6:7*

*Set the trumpet to thy mouth. He shall come as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed my **covenant**, and trespassed against my law. Israel shall cry unto me, My God, we know thee. Israel hath cast off the thing that is good: the enemy shall pursue him. Hosea 8:1-3*

*Their heart is divided; now shall they be found faulty: he shall break down their altars, he shall spoil their images. For now they shall say, We have no king, because we feared not the LORD; what then should a king do to us? They have spoken words, swearing falsely in making a **covenant**: thus judgment springeth up as hemlock in the furrows of the field. Hosea 10:2-4*

*Ephraim feedeth on wind, and followeth after the east wind: he daily increaseth lies and desolation; and they do make a **covenant** with the Assyrians, and oil is carried into Egypt. The LORD hath also a controversy with Judah, and will punish Jacob according to his ways; according to his doing will he recompense him. Hosea 12:1-2*

*Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and he shall speak peace unto the heathen: and his dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth. As for thee also, by the blood of thy **covenant** I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit where in is no water. Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even to day do I declare that I will render double unto thee; Zechariah 9:9-12*

*I took my staff, even Beauty, and cut it asunder, that I might break my **covenant** which I had made with all the people. And it was broken in that day: and so the poor of the flock that waited upon me knew that it was the word of the LORD. Zechariah 11:10-11*

*Ye shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that my **covenant** might be with Levi, saith the LORD of hosts. My **covenant** was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name. Malachi 2:4-5*

*For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts. But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the **covenant** of Levi, saith the LORD of hosts. Malachi 2:7-8*

*Have we not all one father? Hath not one God created us? Why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the **covenant** of our fathers? Judah hath dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah hath profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and hath married the daughter of a strange god. The LORD will cut off the man that doeth this, the master and the scholar, out of the tabernacles of Jacob, and him that offereth an offering unto the LORD of hosts. This have ye done again, covering the altar of the LORD with tears, with weeping, and with crying out, insomuch that he regardeth not the offering any more, or receiveth it with good will at your hand. Malachi 2:10-13*

*Yet ye say, wherefore? Because the LORD hath been witness between thee and the wife of thy youth, against whom thou hast dealt treacherously: yet is she thy companion, and the wife of thy **covenant**. And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth. For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for one covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously. Malachi 2:13-16*

*Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the **covenant**, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts. But who may abide the day of his coming? And who shall stand when he appeareth? For he is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap: and he shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and he shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness. Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant unto the LORD, as in the days of old, and as in former years. And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against the false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger from his right, and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts. Malachi 3:1-5*

COVENANT IN NEW COVENANT

*To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy **covenant**. The oath which he swore to our father Abraham. Luke 1:72-73*

*Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the **covenant** which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, and in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed. Acts 3:25*

*The nation to whom they shall be in bondage will I judge, said God: and after that shall they come forth, and serve me in this place. And he gave him the **covenant** of circumcision: and so Abraham begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac begat the twelve patriarchs. Acts 7:7-8*

*Even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, **covenant**-breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28-32*

*...The Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the **covenants**, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises; whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen. Romans 9:4-5*

*There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is my **covenant** unto them, when I shall take away their sins. Romans 11:26-27*

*Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though it be but a man's **covenant**, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannulleth, or addeth thereto. Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ. And this I say, that the **covenant**, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should made the promise of none effect. Galatians 3:15-17*

*For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. Which things are an allegory: for these are the two **covenants**; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar. For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children. But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all. Galatians 4:22-26*

*That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the **covenants** of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. Ephesians 2:12-13*

Now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better **covenant**, which was established upon better promises. For if that first **covenant** had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new **covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Not according to the **covenant** that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my **covenant**, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. For this is the **covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord I will put my laws into their mind, and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people...In that he saith, A new **covenant**, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away. Hebrews 8:6-10, 13

Then verily the first **covenant** had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary. For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary. And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all. Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the **covenant** overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the **covenant**; and over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercy-seat... Hebrews 9:1-5

*But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; from henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before, This is the **covenant** that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; and having a high priest over the house of God; Hebrews 10:12-21*

*For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the **covenant**, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. Hebrews 10:26-31*

*Ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, and to Jesus the mediator of the new **covenant**, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel. See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven. Hebrews 12:22-25*

*Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting **covenant**, make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:20-21*

TESTAMENT

*For this is my blood of the new **testament**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. Matthew 26:28*

*He said unto them, This is my blood of the new **testament**, which is shed for many. Mark 14:24*

*Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new **testament** in my blood, which is shed for you. Luke 22:20*

*After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new **testament** in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. 1 Corinthians 11:25*

*Who also hath made us able ministers of the new **testament**; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life. 2 Corinthians 3:6*

*But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old **testament**; which vail is done away in Christ. 2 Corinthians 3:14*

*There is verily a disannulling of the commandment going before for the weakness and unprofitableness thereof. For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope did; by the which we draw nigh unto God. And inasmuch as not without an oath he was made priest: (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said unto him, The Lord sware and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:) By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better **testament**. And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered to continue by reason of death: but this man because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them. For such an high priest became us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; Hebrews 7:18-26*

*And for this cause he is the mediator of the new **testament**, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first **testament**, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. For where a **testament** is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. For a **testament** is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator liveth. Whereupon neither the first **testament** was dedicated without blood. For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, saying, This is the blood of the **testament** which God hath enjoined unto you. Hebrews 9:15-20*

*The temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his **testament**: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19*
