HOLY SPIRIT AND HOLINESS

The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the **Spirit** of God moved upon the face of the waters. Genesis 1:2

The LORD said, My **spirit** shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. Genesis 6:3

It came to pass in the morning that his **spirit** was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but there was none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh. Genesis 41:8

They told him all the words of Joseph, which he had said unto them: and when he saw the wagons which Joseph had sent to carry him, the **spirit** of Jacob their father revived. Genesis 45:27

He said, Draw not nigh hither: put off thy shoes from off thy feet, for the place whereon thou standest is **holy** ground. Exodus 3:5

Moses spake so unto the children of Israel: but they hearkened not unto Moses for anguish of **spirit**, and for cruel bondage. Exodus 6:9

In the first day there shall be a **holy** convocation, and in the seventh day there shall be an **holy** convocation to you; no manner of work shall be done in them, save that which every man must eat, that only may be done of you. Exodus 12:16

Thou in thy mercy hast led forth the people which thou hast redeemed: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy **holy** habitation. Exodus 15:13

He said unto them, This is that which the LORD hath said, To morrow is the rest of the **holy** sabbath unto the LORD: bake that which ye will bake to day, and seeth that ye will seethe; and that which remaineth over lay up for you to be kept until the morning. Exodus 16:23

Ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an **holy** nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel. Exodus 19:6

Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. Exodus 20:8

Ye shall be **holy** men unto me: neither shall ye eat any flesh that is torn of beasts in the field; ye shall cast it to the dogs. Exodus 22:31

Thou shalt hang up the vail under the taches, that thou mayest bring in thither within the vail the ark of the testimony: and the vail shall divide unto you between the **holy** place and the most **holy**. And thou shalt put the mercy seat upon the ark of the testimony in the most **holy** place. Exodus 26:33-34

Thou shalt make **holy** garments for Aaron thy brother for glory and for beauty. Thou shalt speak unto all that are wise hearted, whom I have filled with the **spirit** of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office. And these are the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make **holy** garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office. Exodus 28:2-4

Aaron shall bear the names of the children of Israel in the breastplate of judgment upon his heart, when he goeth in unto the **holy** place, for a memorial before the LORD continually. Exodus 28:29

I have filled him with the **spirit** of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship. Exodus 31:3

A golden bell and a pomegranate, a golden bell and a pomegranate, upon the hem of the robe round about. And it shall be upon Aaron to minister: and his sound shall be heard when he goeth in unto the **holy** place before the LORD, and when he cometh out, that he die not. And thou shalt make a plate of pure gold, and grave upon it, like the engravings of a signet, **HOLINESS** TO THE LORD. Exodus 28:34-36

It shall be upon Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the iniquity of the **holy** things, which the children of Israel shall hallow in all their **holy** gifts; and it shall be always upon his forehead, that they may be accepted before the LORD... They shall be upon Aaron, and upon his sons, when they come in unto the tabernacle of the congregation, or when they come near unto the altar to minister in the **holy** place, that they bear not the iniquity, and die: it shall be a statute for ever unto him and his seed. Exodus 28:38, 43

Thou shalt put the mitre upon his head, and put the **holy** crown upon the mitre. Exodus 29:6

The **holy** garments of Aaron shall be his sons' after him, to be anointed therein, and to be consecrated in them. And thou shalt take the ram of the consecration, and seethe his flesh in the **holy** place...and they shall eat those things wherewith the atonement was made, to consecrate and to sanctify them: but a stranger shall not eat thereof, because they are **holy**. And if aught of the flesh of the consecrations, or of the bread, remain unto the morning, then thou shalt burn the remainder with fire: it shall not be eaten, because it is **holy**...seven days thou shalt make an atonement for the altar, and sanctify it; and it shall be an altar most **holy**: whatsoever toucheth the altar shall be **holy**. Exodus 29:29-30, 33-34, 37

Aaron shall make an atonement upon the horns of it once in a year with the blood of the sin offering of atonements: once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most **holy** unto the LORD...Exodus 30:10

Thou shalt make it an oil of **holy** ointment, an ointment compound after the art of the apothecary: it shall be an holy anointing oil...and thou shalt sanctify them, that they may be most holy: whatsoever toucheth them shall be **holv**. And thou shalt anoint the tabernacle of the congregation therewith, and the ark of the testimony, and the table and all his vessels, and the altar of incense, and the altar of burnt offering with all his vessels, and the laver and his foot. And thou shalt sanctify them, that they may be most holy: whatsoever toucheth them shall be holy. And thou shalt anoint Aaron and his sons, and consecrate them, that they may minister unto me in the priest's office, and thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel, saying, This shall be an holy anointing oil unto me throughout your generations. Upon man's flesh shall it not be poured, neither shall ye make any other like it, after the composition of it: it is holy, and it shall be holy unto you... Thou shalt make it a perfume, a confection after the art of the apothecary, tempered together, pure and holy: and thou shalt beat some of it very small, and put of it before the testimony in the tabernacle of the congregation, where I will meet with thee: it shall be unto you most holy. And as for the perfume which thou shalt make, ye shall not make to yourselves according to the composition thereof: it shall be unto thee holy for the LORD. Exodus 30:25-31, 35-37

See, I have filled him with the **spirit** of God, in wisdom, and understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship to devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, and in cutting of stones, to set them, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship...the cloths of service, and the **holy** garments for Aaron the priest, and the garments of his sons, to minister in the priest's office, and the anointing oil, and sweet incense for the **holy** place: according to all that I have commanded thee shall they do... Exodus 31:2-5, 10-11

Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it is **holy** unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth any work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people. Six days may work be done; but in the seventh is the sabbath of rest, **holy** to the LORD: whosoever doeth any work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death. Exodus 31:14-15

Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day there shall be to you an **holy** day, a sabbath of rest to the LORD: whosoever doeth work there in shall be put to death. Exodus 35:2

And every wise-hearted among you shall come, and make all that the LORD hath commanded... The cloths of service, to do service in the holy place, the holy garments for Aaron the priest, and the garments of his sons, to minister in the priest's office. And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses. They came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments. Exodus 35:10, 19-21

Moses said unto the children of Israel, See, the LORD hath called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah; and he hath filled him with the **spirit** of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship. Exodus 35:31

He made the **holy** anointing oil, and the pure incense of sweet spices, according to the work of the apothecary. Exodus 37:29

All the gold that was occupied for the work in all the work of the **holy** place, even the gold of the offering, was twenty and nine talents, and seven hundred and thirty shekels, after the shekel of the sanctuary. Exodus 38:24

Of the blue, and purple, and scarlet, they made cloths of service, to do service in the **holy** place, and made the **holy** garments for Aaron; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 39:1

And they made the plate of the **holy** crown of pure gold, and wrote upon it a writing, like to the engravings of a signet, **HOLINESS** TO THE LORD. Exodus 39:30

The cloths of service to do service in the **holy** place, and the **holy** garments for Aaron the priest, and his sons' garments, to minister in the priest's office. Exodus 39:41

Thou shalt take the anointing oil, and anoint the tabernacle, and all that is therein, and shalt hallow it, and all the vessels thereof: and it shall be **holy**. And thou shalt anoint the altar of the burnt offering, and all his vessels, and sanctify the altar: and it shall be an altar most **holy**. Exodus 40:9-10

Thou shalt put upon Aaron the **holy** garments, and anoint him, and sanctify him; that he may minister unto me in the priest's office. Exodus 30:13

The remnant of the meat offering shall be Aaron's and his sons': it is a thing most **holy** of the offerings of the LORD made by fire. Leviticus 2:3

That which is left of the meat offering shall be Aaron's and his sons': it is a thing most **holy** of the offerings of the LORD made by fire. Leviticus 2:10

If a soul commit a trespass, and sin through ignorance, in the **holy** things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a trespass offering: and he shall make amends for the harm that he hath done in the **holy** thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and it shall be forgiven him. Leviticus 5:15-16

The remainder thereof shall Aaron and his sons eat: with unleavened bread shall it be eaten in the **holv** place; in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation they shall eat it. It shall not be baken with leaven. I have given it unto them for their portion of my offerings made by fire; it is most holy, as is the sin offering, and as the trespass offering. All the males among the children of Aaron shall eat of it. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations concerning the offerings of the LORD made by fire: every one that toucheth them shall be holy...Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying, This is the law of the sin offering: In the place where the burnt offering is killed shall the sin offering be killed before the LORD: it is most holy. The priest that offereth it for sin shall eat it: in the holy place shall it be eaten, in the court of the tabernacle of the congregation. Whatsoever shall touch the flesh thereof shall be holy: and when there is sprinkled of the blood thereof upon any garment, thou shalt wash that whereon it was sprinkled in the **holy** place. But the earthen vessel wherein it is sodden shall be broken: and if it be sodden in a brasen pot, it shall be both scoured, and rinsed in water. All the males among the priests shall eat thereof: it is most holy. And no sin offering, whereof any of the blood is brought into the tabernacle of the congregation to reconcile withal in the holy place, shall be eaten: it shall be burnt in the fire. Leviticus 6:16-18, 25-30

Likewise this is the law of the trespass offering: it is most **holy**... Every male among the priests shall eat thereof: it shall be eaten in the **holy** place: it is most **holy**. Leviticus 7:1, 6

He put the mitre upon his head; also upon the mitre, even upon his forefront, did he put the golden plate, the **holy** crown; as the LORD commanded Moses. Leviticus 8:9

The LORD spake unto Aaron, saying, Do not drink wine nor strong drink, thou, nor thy sons with thee, when ye go into the tabernacle of the congregation, lest ye die: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations: and that ye may put difference between unclean and clean; and that ye may teach the children of Israel all the statutes which the LORD hath spoken...Moses spake unto Aaron, and unto Eleazar and unto Ithamar, his sons that were left, Take the meat offering that remaineth of the offerings of the LORD made by fire, and eat it without leaven beside the altar: for it is most holy: and ye shall eat it in the holy place, because it is thy due, and thy sons' due...Leviticus 10:10-13

For I am the LORD your God; ye shall therefore sanctify yourselves, and ye shall be **holy**; for I am **holy**: neither shall ye defile yourselves with any manner of creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be **holy**, for I am **holy**. Leviticus 11:44-45

He shall slay the lamb in the place where he shall kill the sin offering and the burn offering, in the **holy** place: for as the sin offering is the priest's, so is the trespass offering: it is most **holy**. Leviticus 14:13

The LORD said unto Moses, Speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the **holv** place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat. Thus shall Aaron come into the holy place with a young bullock for a sin offering, and a ram for a burnt offering. He shall put on the holy linen coat, and he shall have the linen breeches upon his flesh, and shall be girded with a linen girdle, and with the linen mitre shall he be attired: these are **holy** garments; therefore shall he wash his flesh in water, and so put them on...He shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their transgressions in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their And there shall be no man in the tabernacle of the congregation when he goeth in to make an atonement in the holy place. until he come out, and have made an atonement for himself, and for his household, and for all the congregation of Israel... When he hath made an end of reconciling the **holy** place, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and the altar, he shall bring the live goat: and Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: and the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness. And Aaron shall come into the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall put off the linen garments, which he put on when he went into the holy place, and shall leave them there: and he shall wash his flesh with water in the holy place, and put on his garments, and come forth, and offer his burnt offering, and the burnt offering of the people, and make an atonement for himself, and for the people. Leviticus 16:2-4, 16-17, 20-24

The bullock for the sin offering, and the goat for the sin offering, whose blood was brought in to make atonement in the **holy** place, shall one carry forth without the camp; and they shall burn in the fire their skins, and their flesh, and their dung... Leviticus 16:27

The priest, whom he shall anoint, and whom he shall consecrate to minister in the priest's office in his father's stead, shall make the atonement, and shall put on the linen clothes, even the holy garments. And he shall make an atonement for the holy sanctuary, and he shall make an atonement for the tabernacle of the congregation, and for the altar, and he shall make an atonement for the priests, and for all the people of the congregation. And this shall be an everlasting statute unto you, to make an atonement for the children of Israel for all their sins once a year. And he did as the Lord commanded Moses. Leviticus 16:32-34

Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, and say unto them, Ye shall be **holy**: for I the LORD your God am **holy**. Leviticus 19:2

In the fourth year all the fruit thereof shall be **holy** to praise the LORD withal. Leviticus 19:24

I will set my face against that man, and will cut him off from among his people; because he hath given of his seed unto Molech, to defile my sanctuary, and to profane my **holy** name... Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye **holy**: for I am the LORD your God. Leviticus 20:3, 7

Ye shall be **holy** unto me: for I the LORD am **holy**, and have severed you from other people, that ye should be mine. A man also or woman that hath a familiar **spirit**, or that is a wizard, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones: their blood shall be upon them. Leviticus 20:26-27

They shall be **holy** unto their God, and not profane the name of their God; for the offerings of the LORD made by fire, and the bread of their God, they do offer: therefore they shall be **holy**. They shall not take a wife that is a whore, or profane; neither shall they take a woman put away from her husband: for he is **holy** unto his God. Thou shalt sanctify him therefore; for he offereth the bread of thy God: he shall be **holy** unto thee: for I the LORD, which sanctify you, am **holy**. Leviticus 21:6-8

He shall eat the bread of his God, both of the most **holy**, and of the **holy**. Leviticus 21:22

Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, that they separate themselves from the **holy** things of the children of Israel, and that they profane not my **holy** name in those things which they hallow unto me: I am the LORD. Say unto them, Whosoever he be of all your seed among your generations, that goeth unto the **holy** things, which the children of Israel hallow unto the LORD, having his uncleanness upon him, that soul shall be cut off from my presence: I am the LORD. Leviticus 22:2-3

What man soever of the seed of Aaron is a leper, or hath a running issue; he shall not eat of the **holy** things, until he be clean. And whoso toucheth any thing that is unclean by the dead, or a man whose seed goeth from him; or whosoever toucheth any creeping thing, whereby he may be made unclean, or a man of whom he may take uncleanness, whatsoever uncleanness he hath; the soul which hath touched any such shall be unclean until even, and shall not eat of the holy things, unless he wash his flesh with water. And when the sun is down, he shall be clean, and shall afterward eat of the holy things; because it is his food... There shall no stranger eat of the **holy** thing: a sojourner of the priest, or an hired servant, shall not eat of the holy thing. But if the priest buy any soul with his money, he shall eat of it, and he that is born in his house: they shall eat of his meat. If the priest's daughter also be married unto a stranger, she may not eat of an offering of the holy things. But if the priest's daughter be a widow, or divorced, and have no child, and is returned unto her father's house, as in her youth, she shall eat of her father's meat: but there shall no stranger eat thereof. And if a man eat of the holy thing unwittingly, then he shall put the fifth part thereof unto it, and shall give it unto the priest with the holy thing. And they shall not profane the holy things of the children of Israel, which they offer unto the LORD; or suffer them to bear the iniquity of trespass, when they eat their **holy** things: for I the LORD do sanctify them... Therefore shall ye keep my commandments, and do them: I am the LORD. Neither shall ye profane my holy name; but I will be hallowed among the children of Israel: I am the LORD which hallow you... Leviticus 22:4-7, 10-16, 31-32

Concerning the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be **holy** convocations, even these are my feasts. Six days shall work be done: but the seventh day is the sabbath of rest, an **holy** convocation; ye shall do no work therein: it is the sabbath of the LORD in all your dwellings. These are the feasts of the LORD, even **holy** convocations, which ye shall proclaim in their seasons. Leviticus 23:2-4

In the first day ye shall have an **holy** convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein. But ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD seven days: in the seventh day is an **holy** convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein. Leviticus 23:7-8

And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the LORD, with the two lambs: they shall be **holy** to the LORD for the priest. And ye shall proclaim on the selfsame day, that it may be an **holy** convocation unto you: ye shall do no servile work therein: it shall be a statute for ever in all your dwellings throughout your generations. Leviticus 23:20-21

Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an **holy** convocation...Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement; it shall be an **holy** convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD. Leviticus 23:24, 27

On the first day shall be an **holy** convocation: ye shall do no servile work therein. Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: on the eighth day shall be an **holy** convocation unto you; and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD: it is a solemn assembly; and ye shall do no servile work therein. These are the feasts of the LORD, which ye shall proclaim to be **holy** convocations, to offer an offering made by fire unto the LORD, a burnt offering, and a meat offering, a sacrifice, and drink offerings, every thing upon his day... Leviticus 23:35-37

And it shall be Aaron's and his sons; and they shall eat it in the **holy** place: for it is most **holy** unto him of the offerings of the LORD made by fire by a perpetual statute. Leviticus 24:9

For it is the jubile; it shall be **holy** unto you: ye shall eat the increase thereof out of the field. Leviticus 25:12

If it be a beast, whereof men bring an offering unto the LORD, all that any man giveth of such unto the LORD shall be **holy**. Leviticus 27:9

He shall not alter it, nor change it, a good for a bad, or a bad for a good: and if he shall at all change beast for beast, then it and the exchange thereof shall be **holy**. Leviticus 27:10

And when a man shall sanctify his house to be **holy** unto the LORD, then the priest shall estimate it, whether it be good or bad: as the priest shall estimate it, so shall it stand. Leviticus 27:14

The field, when it goeth out in the jubile, shall be **holy** unto the LORD, as a field devoted; the possession thereof shall be the priest's. And if a man sanctify unto the LORD a field which he hath bought, which is not of the fields of his possession; then the priest shall reckon unto him the worth of thy estimation, even unto the year of the jubile: and he shall give thine estimation in that day, as a **holy** thing unto the LORD. Leviticus 27:21-23

No devoted thing, that a man shall devote unto the LORD of all that he hath, both of man and beast, and of the field of his possession, shall be sold or redeemed: every devoted thing is most holy unto the LORD. None devoted, which shall be devoted of men, shall be redeemed; but shall surely be put to death. And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is the LORD'S: it is holy unto the LORD. And if a man will at all redeem aught of his tithes, he shall add thereto the fifth part thereof. And concerning the tithe of the herd, or of the flock, even of whatsoever passeth under the rod, the tenth shall be holy unto the LORD. He shall not search whether it be good or bad, neither shall he change it: and if he change it at all, then both it and the change thereof shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed. Leviticus 27:28-33

This shall be the service of the sons of Kohath in the tabernacle of the congregation, about the most **holy** things: Numbers 4:4

When Aaron and his sons have made an end of covering the sanctuary, and all the vessels of the sanctuary, as the camp is to set forward; after that, the sons of Kohath shall come to bear it: but they shall not touch any holy thing, lest they die. These things are the burden of the sons of Kohath in the tabernacle of the congregation...But thus do unto them, that they may live, and not die, when they approach unto the most holy things: Aaron and his sons shall go in, and appoint them every one to his service and to his burden: but they shall not go in to see when the holy things are covered, lest they die. Numbers 4:15, 19-20

Every offering of all the **holy** things of the children of Israel, which they bring unto the priest, shall be his. Numbers 5:9

...And the **spirit** of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be defiled: or if the **spirit** of jealousy come upon him, and he be jealous of his wife, and she be not defiled... The priest shall take **holy** water in an earthen vessel; and of the dust that is in the floor of the tabernacle the priest shall take, and put it into the water: Numbers 5:14, 17

When the **spirit** of jealousy cometh upon him, and he be jealous over his wife, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law. Then shall the man be guiltless from iniquity, and this woman shall bear her iniquity. Numbers 5:30-31

All the days of his separation there shall no razor come upon his head: until the days be fulfilled, in the which he separateth himself unto the LORD, he shall be **holy**, and shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow...all the days of his separation he is **holy** unto the LORD...and the priest shall wave them for a wave offering before the LORD: this is **holy** for the priest, with the wave breast and heave shoulder: and after that the Nazarite may drink wine. Numbers 6:5, 8, 20

I will come down and talk with thee there: and I will take of the **spirit** which is upon thee, and will put it upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with thee, that thou bear it not thyself alone. Numbers 11:17

The LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the **spirit** that was upon him, and gave it unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, that, when the **spirit** rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease. Numbers 11:25

But there remained two of the men in the camp, the name of the one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the **spirit** rested upon them; and they were of them that were written, but went not out unto the tabernacle: and they prophesied in the camp...And Moses said unto him, Enviest thou for my sake? Would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, and that the LORD would put his **spirit** upon them. Numbers 11:26, 29

But my servant Caleb, because he had another **spirit** with him, and hath followed me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it. Numbers 14:24

That ye may remember, and do all my commandments, and be **holy** unto your God. Numbers 15:40

They gathered themselves together against Moses and against Aaron, and said unto them, Ye take too much upon you, seeing all the congregation are holy, every one of them, and the LORD is among them: wherefore then lift ye up yourselves above the congregation of the LORD? ... And he spake unto Korah and unto all his company, saying, Even tomorrow the LORD will shew who are his, and who is holy; and will cause him to come near unto him: even him whom he hath chosen will he cause to come near unto him. This do; Take you censers, Korah, and all his company; and put fire therein, and put incense in them before the LORD tomorrow: and it shall be that the man whom the LORD doth choose, he shall be holy: ye take too much upon you, ye sons of Levi. Numbers 16:3, 5-7

This shall be thine of the most **holy** things, reserved from the fire: every oblation of theirs, every meat offering of theirs, and every sin offering of theirs, and every trespass offering of theirs, which they shall render unto me, shall be most **holy** for thee and for thy sons. In the most **holy** place shalt thou eat it; every male shall eat it: it shall be holy unto thee. Numbers 18:9-10

But the firstling of a cow, or the firstling of a sheep, or the firstling of a goat, thou shalt not redeem; they are **holy**: thou shalt sprinkle their blood upon the altar, and shalt burn their fat for an offering made by fire, for a sweet savour unto the LORD. Numbers 18:17

All the heave offerings of the **holy** things, which the children of Israel offer unto the LORD, have I given thee, and thy sons and thy daughters with thee, by a statute for ever: it is a covenant of salt for ever before the LORD unto thee and to thy seed with thee. Numbers 18:19

Ye shall bear no sin by reason of it, when ye have heaved from it the best of it: neither shall ye pollute the **holy** things of the chidren of Israel, lest ye die. Numbers 18:32

Balaam lifted up his eyes, and he saw Israel abiding in his tents according to their tribes; and the **spirit** of God came upon him. Numbers 24:2

The LORD said unto Moses, Take thee Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the **spirit**, and lay thine hand upon him; Numbers 27:18

The drink offering thereof shall be the fourth part of an hin for the one lamb: in the **holy** place shalt thou cause the strong wine to be poured unto the LORD for a drink offering. Numbers 28:7

In the first day shall be an **holy** convocation; ye shall do no manner of servile work therein...On the seventh day ye shall have an **holy** convocation; ye shall do no servile work. Also in the day of the firstfruits, when ye bring a new meat offering unto the LORD, after your weeks be out, ye shall have an **holy** convocation; ye shall do no servile work: Numbers 28:18, 25-26

In the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have an **holy** convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you...ye shall have on the tenth day of this seventh month an **holy** convocation; and ye shall afflict your souls: ye shall not do any work therein...and on the fifteenth day of the seventh month ye shall have an **holy** convocation; ye shall do no servile work, and ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: Numbers 29:1, 7, 12

Moses sent them to the war, a thousand of every tribe, them and Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest, to the war, with the **holy** instruments, and the trumpets to blow in his hand. Numbers 31:6

The congregation shall deliver the slayer out of the hand of the revenger of blood, and the congregation shall restore him to the city of his refuge, whither he was fled: and he shall abide in it unto the death of the high priest, which was anointed with **holy** oil. Numbers 35:25

Sihon king of Heshbon would not let us pass by him: for the LORD thy God hardened his **spirit**, and made his heart obstinate, that he might deliver him into thy hand, as appeareth this day. Deuteronomy 2:30

For thou art an **holy** people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. Deuteronomy 7:6

Only thy **holy** things which thou hast, and thy vows, thou shalt take, and go unto the place which the LORD shall choose. Deuteronomy 12:26

For thou art an **holy** people unto the LORD thy God, and the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth. Deuteronomy 14:2

Ye shall not eat of any thing that dieth of itself: thou shalt give it unto the stranger that is in thy gates, that he may eat it; or thou mayest sell it unto an alien: for thou art an **holy** people unto the LORD thy God. Deuteronomy 14:21

For the LORD thy God walketh in the midst of thy camp, to deliver thee, and to give up thine enemies before thee; therefore shall thy camp be **holy**: that he see no unclean thing in thee, and turn away from thee. Deuteronomy 23:14

Look down from thy **holy** habitation, from heaven, and bless thy people Israel, and the land which thou hast given us, as thou swarest unto our fathers, a land that floweth with milk and honey... Deuteronomy 26:15

To make thee high above all nations which he hath made, in praise, and in name, and in honour; and that thou mayest be an **holy** people unto the LORD thy God, as he hath spoken. Deuteronomy 26:19

The LORD shall establish thee an **holy** people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways. Deuteronomy 28:9

Of Levi he said, Let thy Thummim and thy Urim be with thy **holy** one, whom thou didst prove at Massah, and with whom thou didst strive at the waters of Meribah; Deuteronomy 33:8

Joshua the son of Nun was full of the **spirit** of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses. Deuteronomy 34:9

And it came to pass, when all the kings of the Amorites, which were on the side of Jordan westward, and all the kings of the Canaanites, which were by the sea, heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of Jordan from before the children of Israel, until we were passed over, that their heart melted, neither was there **spirit** in them any more, because of the children of Israel. Joshua 5:1

The captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is **holy**. And Joshua did so. Joshua 5:15

Joshua said unto the people, Ye cannot serve the LORD: for he is an **holy** God; he is a jealous God; he will not forgive your transgressions nor your sins. If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good. Joshua 24:19-20

The **Spirit** of the LORD came upon him, and he judged Israel, and went out to war: and the LORD delivered Chushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand prevailed against Chushan-rishathaim. Judges 6:34

Then God sent an evil **spirit** between Abimelech and the men of Shechem; and the men of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelec: Judges 9:23

Then the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon Jephthah, and he passed over Gilead, and Manasseh, and passed over Mizpeh of Gilead, and from Mizpeh of Gilead he passed over unto the children of Ammon. Judges 11:29

The **Spirit** of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol. Judges 13:25

The **Spirit** of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and he had nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done. Judges 14:6

The **Spirit** of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house. Judges 14:19

When he came unto Lehi, the Philistines shouted against him: and the **Spirit** of the LORD came mightily upon him, and the cords that were upon his arms became as flax that was burnt with fire, and his bands loosed from off his hands. Judges 15:14

But God clave an hollow place that was in the jaw, and there came water thereout; and when he had drunk, his **spirit** came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof En-hakkore, which is in Lehi unto this day. Judges 15:19

Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I am a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD. 1 Samuel 1:15

Hannah prayed, and said, My heart rejoiceth in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in thy salvation. There is none **holy** as the LORD: for there is none beside thee: neither is there any rock like our God. Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let not arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed. 1 Samuel 2:1-3

The **Spirit** of the LORD will come upon thee, and thou shalt prophesy with them, and shalt be turned into another man...and when they came thither to the hill, behold, a company of prophets met him; and the **Spirit** of God came upon him, and he prophesied among them. 1 Samuel 10:6, 10

The **Spirit** of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled greatly. 1 Samuel 11:6

Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah. But the **Spirit** of the LORD departed from Saul, and an evil **spirit** from the LORD troubled him. 1 Samuel 16:13-14

Saul's servants said unto him, Behold now, an evil **spirit** from God troubleth thee. Let our lord now command thy servants, which are before thee, to seek out a man, who is a cunning player on an harp: and it shall come to pass, when the evil **spirit** from God is upon thee, that he shall play with his hand, and thou shalt be well... 1 Samuel 16:15-16

The men of Beth-shemesh said, Who is able to stand before this **holy** LORD God? And to whom shall he go up from us? 1 Samuel 6:20

And it came to pass, when the evil **spirit** from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil **spirit** departed from him...It came on the morrow, that the evil **spirit** from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played... 1 Samuel 16:23, 18:10

The evil **spirit** from the LORD was upon Saul, as he sat in his house with his javelin in his hand: and David played with his hand. And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing as appointed over them, the **Spirit** of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied. 1 Samuel 19:9, 20

He went thither to Naioth in Ramah: and the **Spirit** of God was upon him also, and he went on, and prophesied, until he came to Naioth in Ramah. 1 Samuel 19:23

David answered the priest, and said unto him, Of a truth women have been kept from us about these three days, since I came out, and the vessels of the young men are **holy**, and the bread is in a manner common, yea, though it were sanctified this day in the vessel. 1 Samuel 21:5

Then said Saul unto his servants, Seek me a woman that hath a familiar **spirit**, that I may go to her, and enquire of her. And his servants said to him, Behold, there is a woman that hath a familiar **spirit** at Endor. And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar **spirit**, and bring me him up, whom I shall name unto thee. 1 Samuel 28:7-8

They gave him a piece of a cake of figs, and two clusters of raisins: and when he had eaten, his **spirit** came again to him: for he had eaten no bread, nor drunk any water, three days and three nights. 1 Samuel 30:12

The **Spirit** of the LORD spake by me, and his word was in my tongue. 2 Samuel 23:2

He built twenty cubits on the sides of the house, both the floor and the walls with boards of cedar: he even built them for it within, even for the oracle, even for the most **holy** place. 1 Kings 6:16

The bowls, and the snuffers, and the basons, and the spoons, and the censers of pure gold; and the hinges of gold, both for the doors of the inner house, the most **holy** place, and for the doors of the house, to wit, of the temple. 1 Kings 7:50

They brought up the ark of the LORD, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the **holy** vessels that were in the tabernacle...the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the Lord unto his place, into the oracle of the house, to the most **holy** place, even under the wings of the cherubims. 1 Kings 8:4, 6

They drew out the staves, that the ends of the staves were seen out in the **holy** place before the oracle, and they were not seen without: and there they are unto this day...and it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the **holy** place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD. 1 Kings 8:10

And the meat of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and their apparel, and his cupbearers, and his ascent by which he went up unto the house of the LORD; there was no more **spirit** in her. 1 Kings 10:5

And it shall come to pass, as soon as I am gone from thee, that the **Spirit** of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and so when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth. 1 Kings 18:12

Jezebel his wife came to him, and said unto him, Why is thy **spirit** so sad, that thou eatest no bread? 1 Kings 21:5

She said unto her husband, Behold now, I perceive that this is an **holy** man of God, which passeth by us continually. Let us make a little chamber, I pray thee, on the wall... 2 Kings 4:9-10

And there came for a **spirit**, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will persuade him. And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, Thou shalt persuade him, and prevail also: go forth, and do so. Now therefore, behold, the LORD hath put a lying **spirit** in the mouth of all these thy prophets, and the LORD hath spoken evil concerning thee. But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near, and smote Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way went the **Spirit** of the LORD from me to speak unto thee? And Micaiah said, Behold, thou shalt see in that day, when thou shalt go into an inner chamber to hide thyself. 1 Kings 22:21-25 (also 2 Chronicles 18:20-23)

Elijah said unto Elisha, Ask what I shall do for thee, before I be taken away from thee. And Elisha said, I pray the, let a double portion of thy spirit be upon me. 2 Kings 2:9

When the sons of the prophets which were to view at Jericho saw him, they said, The **spirit** of Elijah doth rest on Elisha. And they came to meet him, and bowed themselves to the ground before him. And they said unto him, Behold now, there be with thy servants fifty strong men; let them go, we pray thee, and seek thy master: lest peradventure the **Spirit** of the LORD hath taken him up, and cast him upon some mountain, or into some valley, and he said, Ye shall not send. 2 Kings 2:15-16

Whom hast thou reproached and blasphemed? And against whom hast thou exalted thy voice, and lifted up thine eyes on high? Even against the **Holy** One of Israel. 2 Kings 19:22

The God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the **spirit** of Tilgath-pilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh... 1 Chronicles 5:26

Aaron and his sons offered upon the altar of the burnt offering, and on the altar of incense, and were appointed for all the work of the place most **holy**, and to make an atonement for Israel, according to all that Moses the servant of God had commanded. 1 Chronicles 6:49

So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, even against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking counsel of one that had a familiar **spirit**, to enquire of it. 1 Chronicles 10:13

Then the **spirit** came upon Amasai, who was chief of the captains, and he said, Thine are we, David, and on thy side, thou son of Jesse: peace, peace be unto thee, and peace be to thine helpers; for thy God helpeth thee. Then David received them, and made them captains of the band. 1 Chronicles 12:18

Glory ye in his **holy** name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD...Say, ye, Save us, O God of our salvation, and gather us together, and deliver us from the heathen, that we may give thanks to thy **holy** name, and glory in thy praise. 1 Chronicles 16:10, 35

Now set your heart and your soul to seek the LORD your God; arise therefore, and build ye the sanctuary of the LORD God, to bring the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and the **holy** vessels of God, into the house that is to be built to the name of the LORD. 1 Chronicles 22:19

And the pattern of all that he had by the **spirit**, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things. 1 Chronicles 28:12

The sons of Amram; Aaron and Moses: and Aaron was separated, that he should sanctify the most **holy** things, he and his sons for ever, to burn incense before the LORD, to minister unto him, and to bless in his name for ever. 1 Chronicles 23:13

Because their office was to wait on the sons of Aaron for the service of the house of the LORD, in the courts, and in the chambers, and in the purifying of all **holy** things, and the work of the service of the house of the LORD...that they should keep the charge of the tabernacle of the congregation, and the charge of the **holy** place, and the charge of the sons of Aaron their brethren, in the service of the house of the LORD. 1 Chronicles 23:28, 32

I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, which I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the **holy** house...O LORD our God, all this store that we have prepared to build thee an house for thine **holy** name cometh of thine hand, and is all thine own. 1 Chronicles 29:3, 16

He made the most **holy** house, the length whereof was according to the breadth of the house, twenty cubits, and the breadth thereof twenty cubits: and he overlaid it with fine gold, amounting to six hundred talents...and in the most **holy** house he made two cherubims of image work, and overlaid them with gold. 2 Chronicles 3:8, 10

The snuffers, and the basons, and the spoons, and the censers, of pure gold: and the entry of the house, the inner doors thereof for the most **holy** place, and the doors of the house of the temple were of gold. 2 Chronicles 4:22

They brought up the ark, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the **holy** vessels that were in the tabernacle, these did the priests and the Levites bring up...and the priests brought in the ark of the covenant of the LORD unto his place, to the oracle of the house, into the most **holy** place, even under the wings of the chrubims...and it came to pass, when the priests were come out of the **holy** place (for all the priests that were present were sanctified, and did not then wait by course... 2 Chronicles 5:10-11

Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell in the house of David king of Israel, because the places are holy, whereunto the ark of the LORD hath come. 2 Chronicles 8:11

And the meat of his table, and the sitting of his servants, and the attendance of his ministers, and their apparel; his cupbearers also, and their apparel; and his ascent by which he went up into the house of the LORD; there was no more **spirit** in her. 2 Chronicles 9:4

And the **Spirit** of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded: and he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin; The LORD is with you, while ye be with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you: but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you. 2 Chronicles 15:1-2

Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the **Spirit** of the LORD in the midst of the congregation. 2 Chronicles 20:14

Moreover the LORD stirred up against Jehoram the **spirit** of the Philistines, and of the Arabians, that were near the Ethiopians: 2 Chronicles 21:16

Let none come into the house of the LORD, save the priests, and they that minister of the Levities; they shall go in, for they are **holy**: but all the people shall keep the watch of the LORD. 2 Chronicles 23:6

And the **Spirit** of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? Because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you. 2 Chronicles 24:20

Hear me, ye Levites, sanctify now yourselves, and sanctify the house of the LORD God of your fathers, and carry forth the filthiness out of the **holy** place. For our fathers have trespassed, and done that which was evil in the eyes of the LORD... they have shut up the doors of the porch, and put out the lamps, and have not burned incense nor offered burnt offerings in the **holy** place unto the God of Israel. 2 Chronicles 29:5-7

Then the priests the Levites arose and blessed the people: and their voice was heard, and their prayer came up to his **holy** dwelling place, even unto heaven. 2 Chronicles 30:27

Concerning the children of Israel and Judah, that dwelt in the cities of Judah, they also brought in the tithe of oxen and sheep, and the tithe of holy things which were consecrated unto the LORD their God, and laid them by heaps...and Kore the son of Imnah the Levite, the porter toward the east, was over the freewill offerings of God, to distribute the oblations of the LORD, and the most holy things. 2 Chronicles 31:6, 14

And he caused the children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar **spirit**, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the **sight** of the LORD, to provoke him to anger. 2 Chronicles 33:6

Josiah...said unto the Levites that taught all Israel, which were **holy** unto the LORD, Put the **holy** ark in the house which Solomon the son of David king of Israel did built; it shall not be a burden upon your shoulders; serve now the LORD your God, and his people Israel...and stand in the **holy** place according to the divisions of the families... 2 Chronicles 35:3, 5

They roasted the passover with fire according to the ordinance: but the other **holy** offerings sod they in pots, and in caldrons, and in pans, and divided them speedily among all the people. 2 Chronicles 35:13

Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD spoken by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD stirred up the **spirit** of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying, thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth hath the LORD God of heaven given me; and he hath charged me to build him an house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Who is there among you of all his people? The LORD his God be with him, and let him go up. 2 Chronicles 36:22-23; Ezra 1:1-3

I said unto them, Ye are **holy** unto the LORD; the vessels are **holy** also; and the silver and the gold are a freewill offering unto the LORD God of your fathers. Ezra 8:28

For they have taken of their daughters for themselves, and for their sons: so that the **holy** seed have mingled themselves with the people of those lands: yea, the hand of the princes and rulers hath been chief in this trespass. Ezra 9:2

Now for a little space grace hath been shewed from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail in his **holy** place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage. Ezra 9:8

The Tirshatha said unto them, that they should not eat of the most **holy** things, till there stood up a priest with Urim and Thummin. ... Nehemiah, which is the Tirshatha, and Ezra the priest the scribe, and the Levities that taught the people, said unto all the people, This day is **holy** unto the LORD your God; mourn not, nor weep. For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the law. Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength. So the Leviites stilled all the people, saying, Hold your peace, for the day is **holy**; neither be ye grieved. Nehemiah 7:65, 8:9-11

Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments: and madest known unto them thy holy sabbath, and commandedst them precepts, statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses thy servant: and gavest them bread from heaven... Thou gavest also thy good spirit to instruct them, and withheldest not thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their thirst... Yet many years didst thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the people of the lands. Nehemiah 9:13-15, 20, 30

If the people of the land bring ware or any victuals on the sabbath day to sell, that we would not buy it of them on the sabbath, or on the **holy** day: and that we would leave the seventh year, and the exaction of every debt...for the shewbread, and for the continual meat offering, and for the continual burnt offering, of the sabbaths, of the new moons, for the set feasts, and for the **holy** things, and for the sin offerings to make an atonement for Israel, and for all the work of the house of our God. Nehemiah 10:31, 33

The rulers of the people dwelt at Jerusalem: the rest of the people also cast lots, to bring one of ten to dwell in Jerusalem the **holy** city, and nine parts to dwell in other cities. Nehemiah 11:1

All the Levites in the **holy** city were two hundred fourscore and four. Nehemiah 11:18

All Israel in the days of Zerubbabel, and in the days of Nehemiah, gave the portions of the singers and the porters, every day his portion: and they sanctified **holy** things unto the Levites, and the Levites sanctified them unto the children of Aaron. Nehemiah 12:47

Then a **spirit** passed before my face; the hair of my flesh stood up: Job 4:15

For the arrows of the Almighty are within me, the poison whereof drinketh up my **spirit**: the terrors of God do set themselves in array against me. Job 6:4

Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the **Holy** One. Job 6:10

Therefore I will not refrain my mouth; I will speak in the anguish of my spirit; I will complain in the bitterness of my soul. Job 7:11

Thou hast granted me life and favour, and thy visitation hath preserved my **spirit**. Job 10:12

I have heard the check of my reproach, and the **spirit** of my understanding causeth me to answer. Job 20:3

As for me, is my complaint to man? And if it were so, why should not my spirit be troubled? Job 21:4

To whom hast thou uttered words? And whose **spirit** came from thee? ...By his **spirit** he hath garnished the heavens; his hand hath formed the crooked serpent. Job 26:4, 13

All the while my breath is in me, and the **spirit** of God is in my nostrils; Job 27:3

But there is a **spirit** in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them understanding...Job 32:8

For I am full of matter, the **spirit** within me constraineth me. Job 32:18

The **Spirit** of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life. Job 33:4

If he set his heart upon man, if he gather unto himself his **spirit** and his breath; all flesh shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust. Job 34:14

Yet have I set my king upon my **holy** hill of Zion. I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee. Psalm 2:6-7

I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his **holy** hill. Selah. Psalm 3:4

But as for me, I will come into thy house in the multitude of thy mercy: and in thy fear will I worship toward thy **holy** temple. Psalm 5:7

The LORD is in his **holy** temple, the LORD'S throne is in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men. Psalm 11:4

LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell in thy **holy** hill? Psalm 15:1

For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine **Holy** One to see corruption. Psalm 16:10

Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed; he will hear him from his **holy** heaven with the saving strength of his right hand. Psalm 20:6

Thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel. Psalm 22:3

Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who shall stand in his holy place? Psalm 24:3

Hear the voice of my supplications, when I cry unto thee, when I lift up my hands toward thy **holy** oracle. Psalm 28:2

Into thine hand I commit my **spirit**: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth. Psalm 31:5

Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose **spirit** there is no guile. Psalm 32:2

The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite **spirit**. Psalm 34:18

O send out thy light and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles. Psalm 43:3

There is a river, the streams whereof shall make glad the city of God, the **holy** place of the tabernacles of the most High. Psalm 46:4

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right **spirit** within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy **holy spirit** from me. Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free **spirit**...the sacrifices of God are a broken **spirit**: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. Psalm 51:10-12, 17

Blessed is the man whom thou choosest, and causest to approach unto thee, that he may dwell in thy courts: we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house, even of thy **holy** temple. Psalm 65:4

A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in his **holy** habitation. Psalm 68:5

The chariots of God are twenty thousand, even thousands of angels: the Lord is among them, as in Sinai, in the **holy** place. Psalm 68:17

O God, thou art terrible out of thy **holy** places: the God of Israel is he that giveth strength and power unto his people. Blessed be God. Psalm 68:35

I will also praise thee with the psaltery, even thy truth, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou **Holy** One of Israel. Psalm 71:22

He shall cut off the **spirit** of princes: he is terrible to the kings of the earth. Psalm 76:12

I remembered God, and was troubled: I complained, and my **spirit** was overwhelmed. Selah...I call to remembrance my song in the night: I commune with mine own heart: and my **spirit** made diligent search. Psalm 77:3, 6

That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments: And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation that set not their heart aright, and whose **spirit** was not stedfast with God. Psalm 78:7-8

Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the **Holy** One of Israel. Psalm 78:41

O God, the heathen are come into thine inheritance; thy **holy** temple have they defiled; they have laid Jerusalem on heaps. Psalm 79:1

Preserve my soul; for I am **holy**: O thou my God, save thy servant that trusteth in thee. Psalm 86:2

His foundation is in the holy mountain. Psalm 87:1

For the LORD is our defence; and the **Holy** One of Israel is our king. Then thou spakest in vision to thy **holy** one, and saidst, I have laid help upon one that is mighty; I have exalted one chosen out of the people. I have found David my servant; with my **holy** oil have I anointed him. Psalm 89:18-20

O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his **holy** arm, hath gotten him the victory. Psalm 98:1

Let them praise thy great and terrible name; for it is **holy**...Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; for he is **holy**...Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his **holy** hill; for the LORD our God is **holy**. Psalm 99:3, 5, 9

Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his **holy** name. Psalm 103:1

Thou sendest forth thy **spirit**, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth. Psalm 104:30

Glory ye in his **holy** name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. Psalm 105:3

For he remembered his **holy** promise, and Abraham his servant. Psalm 105:42

Because they provoked his **spirit**, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips. Psalm 106:33

Save us, OLORD our God, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto thy **holy** name, and to triumph in thy praise. Psalm 106:47

He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: **holy** and reverend is his name. Psalm 111:9

I will worship toward thy **holy** temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name. Psalm 138:2

Whither shall I go from thy **spirit**? Or whither shall I flee from thy presence? Psalm 139:7

When my **spirit** was overwhelmed within me; my heart within me is desolate...Hear me speedily, O LORD: my **spirit** faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit. Psalm 143:4, 7

Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy **spirit** is good; lead me into the land of uprightness. Psalm 143:10

The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and **holy** in all his works...My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless his **holy** name for ever and ever. Psalm 145:17, 21

Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my **spirit** unto you, I will make known my words unto you. Proverbs 1:23

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the **holy** is understanding. Proverbs 9:10

A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful **spirit** concealeth the matter. Proverbs 11:13

He that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but he that is hasty of spirit exalteth folly. Proverbs 14:29

A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the **spirit**. Proverbs 15:4

A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the **spirit** is broken. Proverbs 15:13

Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty **spirit** before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble **spirit** with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud. Proverbs 16:18-19

He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city. Proverbs 16:32

A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken **spirit** drieth the bones. Proverbs 17:22

He that hath knowledge spareth his words: and a man of understanding is of an excellent **spirit**. Proverbs 17:27

The **spirit** of man will sustain his infirmity; but a wounded **spirit** who can bear? Proverbs 18:14

It is a snare to the man who devoureth that which is **holy**, and after vows to make enquiry. Proverbs 20:25

The **spirit** of man is the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly. Proverbs 20:27

He that hath no rule over his own **spirit** is like a city that is broken down, and without walls. Proverbs 25:28

A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit. Proverbs 29:23

I neither learned wisdom, nor have the knowledge of the **holy**. Proverbs 30:3

I have seen all the works that are done under the sun; and, behold, all is vanity and vexation of **spirit**...And I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know madness and folly: I perceived that this also is vexation of **spirit**. Ecclesiastes 1:14, 17

Then I looked on all the works that my hands had wrought, and on the labour that I had laboured to do: and, behold, all was vanity and vexation of **spirit**, and there was no profit under the sun... Therefore I hated life; because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: for all is vanity and vexation of **spirit**. Ecclesiastes 2:11, 17

For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is vanity and vexation of **spirit**. Ecclesiastes 2:26

Who knoweth the **spirit** of man that goeth upward, and the **spirit** of the beast that goeth downward to the earth? Ecclesiastes 3:21

Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this a man is envied of his neighbour. This is also vanity and vexation of **spirit**...better is an handful with quietness, than both the hands full with travail and vexation of **spirit**. Ecclesiastes 4:4, 6

There is no end of all the people, even of all that have been before them: they also that come after shall not rejoice in him. Surely this also is vanity and vexation of **spirit**. Ecclesiastes 4:16

Better is the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the desire: this is also vanity and vexation of **spirit**. Ecclesiastes 6:9

Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the patient in **spirit** is better than the proud in **spirit**...Be not hasty in thy **spirit** to be angry: for anger resteth in the bosom of fools. Ecclesiastes 7:8-9

There is no man that hath power over the **spirit** to retain the **spirit**; neither hath he power in the day of death: and there is no discharge in that war; neither shall wickedness deliver those that are given to it. Ecclesiastes 8:8

So I saw the wicked buried, who had come and gone from the place of the **holy**, and they were forgotten in the city where they had so done: this is also vanity. Ecclesiastes 8:10

If the **spirit** of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for yielding pacifieth great offences. Ecclesiastes 10:4

As thou knowest not what is the way of the **spirit**, nor how the bones do grow in the womb of her that is with child: even so thou knowest not the works of God who maketh all. Ecclesiastes 11:5

Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the **spirit** shall return unto God who gave it. Ecclesiastes 12:7

Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the **Holy** One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward. Isaiah 1:4

It shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called **holy**, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem: When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the **spirit** of judgment, and by the **spirit** of burning. And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the glory shall be a defence. And there shall be a tabernacle for a shadow in the daytime from the heat, and for a place of refuge, and for a covert from storm and from rain. Isaiah 4:3-6

The LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God that is **holy** shall be sanctified in righteousness. Isaiah 5:16

Woe unto them that draw iniquity with cords of vanity, and sin as it were with a cart rope: that say, let him make speed, and hasten his work, that we may see it: and let the counsel of the **Holy** One of Israel draw nigh and come, that we may know it? ... As the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, so their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the **Holy** One of Israel. Isaiah 5:18-19, 24

One cried unto another, and said, **Holy, holy, holy**, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. Isaiah 6:3

Yet in it shall be a tenth, and it shall return, and shall be eaten: as a teil tree, and as an oak, whose substance is in them, when they cast their leaves: so the **holy** seed shall be the substance thereof. Isaiah 6:13

The light of Israel shall be for a fire, and his **Holy** One for a flame: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day... Isaiah 10:17

It shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the **Holy** One of Israel, in truth. Isaiah 10:20

And the **spirit** of the LORD shall rest upon him, the **spirit** of wisdom and understanding, the **spirit** of counsel and might, the **spirit** of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD... Isaiah 11:2

They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my **holy** mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. Isaiah 11:9

Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great is the **Holy** One of Israel in the midst of thee. Isaiah 12:6

The **spirit** of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof; and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and they shall seek to the idols, and to the charmers, and to them that have familiar **spirits**, and to the wizards... The LORD hath mingled a perverse **spirit** in the midst thereof: and they have caused Egypt to err in every work thereof, as a drunken man staggereth in his vomit. Isaiah 19:3, 14

At that day shall a man look to his Maker, and his eyes shall have respect to the **Holy** One of Israel. Isaiah 17:7

With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my **spirit** within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness. Isaiah 26:9

It shall come to pass in that day, that the great trumpet shall be blown, and they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria, and the outcasts in the land of Egypt, and shall worship the LORD in the holy mount at Jerusalem. Isaiah 27:13

In that day shall the LORD of hosts be for a crown of glory, and for a diadem of beauty, unto the residue of his people, and for a **spirit** of judgment to him that sitteth in judgment, and for strength to them that turn the battle to the gate. Isaiah 28:5-6

Thou shalt be brought down, and shalt speak out of the ground, and thy speech shall be low out of the dust, and thy voice shall be, as of one that hath a familiar **spirit**, out of the ground, and thy speech shall whisper out of the dust. Isaiah 29:4

The meek also shall increase their joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the **Holy** One of Israel... When he seeth his children, the work of mine hands, in the midst of him, they shall sanctify my name, and sanctify the **Holy** One of Jacob, and shall fear the God of Israel. They also that erred in **spirit** shall come to understanding, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine. Isaiah 29:19, 23-24

Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my **spirit**, that they may add sin to sin: Isaiah 30:1

This is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of the LORD: which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits: Get you out of the way, turn aside out of the path, cause the Holy One of Israel to cease from before us. Wherefore thus saith the Holy One of Israel, Because ye despise this word, and trust in oppression and perverseness, and stay thereon: therefore this iniquity shall be to you as a breach ready to fall...For thus saith the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not. Isaiah 30:9-13, 15

Ye shall have a song, as in the night when a **holy** solemnity is kept; and gladness of heart, as when one goeth with a pipe to come into the mountain of the LORD, to the mighty One of Israel. Isaiah 30:29

Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and trust in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the **Holy** One of Israel, neither seek the LORD! ... Now the Egyptians are men, and not God; and their horses flesh, and not **spirit**... Isaiah 31:1, 3

Until the **spirit** be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest. Isaiah 32:15

Seek ye out of the book of the LORD, and read: no one of these shall fail, none shall want her mate: for my mouth it hath commanded, and his **spirit** it hath gathered them. Isaiah 34:16

Whom hast thou reproached and blasphemed? And against whom hast thou exalted thy voice, and lifted up thine eyes on high? Even against the **Holy** One of Israel. Isaiah 37:23

O LORD, by these things men live, and in all these things is the life of my spirit: so wilt thou recover me, and make me to live. Isaiah 38:16

The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the **spirit** of the LORD bloweth upon it: surely the people is grass... Who hath directed the **Spirit** of the LORD, or being his counsellor hath taught him? Isaiah 40:7, 13

To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? Saith the **Holy** One. Isaiah 40:25

Fear not, thou worm Jacob, and ye men of Israel; I will help thee, saith the LORD, and thy redeemer, the **Holy** One of Israel. Behold, I will make thee a new sharp threshing instrument having teeth: thou shalt thresh the mountains, and beat them small, and shalt make the hills as chaff. Thou shalt fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and thou shalt rejoice in the LORD, and shalt glory in the **Holy** One of Israel. Isaiah 41:14-16

I will set in the desert the fir tree...that they may see, and know, and consider, and understand together, that the hand of the LORD hath done this, and the **Holy** One of Israel hath created it. Isaiah 41:19-20

Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my **spirit** upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles... Thus saith God the LORD, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that which cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and **spirit** to them that walk therein: Isaiah 42:1, 5

For I am the LORD thy God, the **Holy** One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee... Thus saith the LORD, your redeemer, the **Holy** One of Israel; For your sake I have sent to Babylon, and have brought down all their nobles, and the Chaldeans, whose cry is in the ships. Isaiah 43:3, 14-15

For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my **spirit** upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: Isaiah 44:3

Thus saith the LORD, the **Holy** One of Israel, and his Maker, Ask me of things to come concerning my sons, and concerning the work of my hands command ye me. Isaiah 45:11

As for our redeemer, the LORD of hosts is his name, the **Holy** One of Israel. Isaiah 47:4

For they call themselves of the **holy** city, and stay themselves upon the God of Israel; The LORD of hosts is his name. Isaiah 48:2

Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there am I: and now the Lord GOD, and his **Spirit** hath sent me. Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the **Holy** One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go. Isaiah 48:16-17

Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his **Holy** One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the **Holy** One of Israel, and he shall choose thee. Isaiah 49:7

Awake, awake; put on thy strength, O Zion; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the **holy** city: for henceforth there shall be no more come into thee the uncircumcised and the unclean. Isaiah 52:1

The LORD hath made bare his **holy** arm in the eyes of all the nations; and all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God. Isaiah 52:10

For thy Maker is thine husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the **Holy** One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called. For the LORD hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in **spiri**t, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God. Isaiah 54:5-6

Behold, thou shalt call a nation that thou knowest not, and nations that knew not thee shall run unto thee because of the LORD thy God, and for the **Holy** One of Israel; for he hath glorified thee. Isaiah 55:5

For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is **Holy**; I dwell in the high and **holy** place, with him also that is of a contrite and humble **spirit**, to revive the **spirit** of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the **spirit** should fail before me, and the souls which I have made. Isaiah 57:15-16

If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my **holy** day; and call the sabbath a delight, the **holy** of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words: then shalt thou delight thyself in the LORD... Isaiah 58:13-14a

So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the **Spirit** of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him. And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD. As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My **spirit** that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever. Isaiah 59:19-21

Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the **Holy** One of Israel, because he hath glorified thee. The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come bending unto thee; and all they that despised thee shall bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet; and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the **Holy** One of Israel. Isaiah 60:9, 14

The **spirit** of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the **spirit** of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified. Isaiah 61:1-3

They shall call them, The **holy** people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken. Isaiah 62:12

In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in his love and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old. But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, and he fought against them. Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, and his people, saying, Where is he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? Where is he that put his holy Spirit within him? That led them by the right hand of Moses with his glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make himself an everlasting name? Isaiah 63:9-12

That led them through the deep, as an horse in the wilderness, that they should not stumble? As a beast goeth down into the valley, the **Spirit** of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name. Isaiah 63:13-14

Thy **holy** cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation. Our **holy** and our beautiful house, where our fathers praised thee, is burned up with fire; and all our pleasant things are laid waste. ... Behold, my servants shall sing for joy of heart, but ye shall cry for sorrow of heart, and shall howl for vexation of **spirit**. Isaiah 64:11-14

Ye are they that forsake the LORD, that forget my **holy** mountain, that prepare a table for that troop, and that furnish the drink offering unto that number. Isaiah 65:11

The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my **holy** mountain, saith the LORD. Isaiah 65:25

Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? And where is the place of my rest? For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite **spirit**, and trembleth at my word. Isaiah 66:1-2

They shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my **holy** mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD. Isaiah 66:20

What hath my beloved to do in mine house, seeing she hath wrought lewdness with many, and the **holy** flesh is passed from thee? When thou doest evil, then thou rejoicest. Jeremiah 11:15

Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his **holy** habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread the grapes, against all the inhabitants of the earth. Jeremiah 25:30

The whole valley of the dead bodies, and of the ashes, and all the fields unto the brook of Kidron, unto the corner of the horse gate toward the east, shall be **holy** unto the LORD; it shall not be plucked up, nor thrown down any more for ever. Jeremiah 31:40

Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her: for she hath been proud against the LORD, against the **Holy** One of Israel. Jeremiah 50:29

For Israel hath not been forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; though their land was filled with sin against the **Holy** One of Israel. Jeremiah 51:5

Make bright the arrows; gather the shields: the LORD hath raised up the **spirit** of the kings of the Medes: for his device is against Babylon, to destroy it; because it is the vengeance of the LORD, the vengeance of his temple. Jeremiah 51:11

They went every one straight forward: whither the **spirit** was to go, they went; and they turned not when they went. Ezekiel 1:12

Whithersoever the **spirit** was to go, they went, thither was their **spirit** to go; and the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the **spirit** of the living creature was in the wheels. When those went, these went; and when those stood, these stood; and when those were lifted up from the earth, the wheels were lifted up over against them: for the **spirit** of the living creature was in the wheels. Ezekiel 1:20-21

And the **spirit** entered into me when he spake unto me, and set me upon my feet, that I heard him that spake unto me. Ezekiel 2:2

Then the **spirit** took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, saying, Blessed be the glory of the LORD from his place...so the **spirit** lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my **spirit**; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me. Ezekiel 3:12, 14

Then the **spirit** entered into me, and set me upon my feet, and spake with me, and said unto me, Go, shut thyself within thine house. Ezekiel 3:24

Wherefore I will bring the worst of the heathen, and they shall possess their houses: I will also make the pomp of the strong to cease; and their holy places shall be defiled. Ezekiel 7:24

And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the **spirit** lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where was the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy. Ezekiel 8:3

When they stood, these stood; and when they were lifted up, these lifted up themselves also: for the **spirit** of the living creature was in them. Ezekiel 10:17

Moreover the **spirit** lifted me up, and brought me unto the east gate of the LORD'S house, which looketh eastward: and behold the door of the gate five and twenty men; among whom I saw Jaazaniah the son of Azur, and Pelatiah the son of Benaiah, princes of the people. Ezekiel 11:1

And the **Spirit** of the **LORD** fell upon me, and said unto me, Speak; Thus saith the LORD; Thus have ye said, O house of Israel: for I know the things that come into your mind, every one of them. Ezekiel 11:5

And I will give them one heart, and I will put a new **spirit** within you; and I will take the stony heart out of their flesh, and will give them an heart of flesh: that they may walk in my statutes, and keep mine ordinances, and do them: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God. Ezekiel 11:19-20

Afterwards the **spirit** took me up, and brought me in a vision by the Spirit of God into Chaldea, to them of the captivity. So the vision that I had seen went up from me. Ezekiel 11:24

Thus saith the Lord GOD; woe unto the foolish prophets, that follow their own **spirit**, and have seen nothing! Ezekiel 13:3

Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new **spirit**: for why will ye die, O house of Israel? For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith the Lord GOD: wherefore turn yourselves, and live ye. Ezekiel 18:31-32

As for you, O house of Israel, thus saith the Lord GOD; Go ye, serve ye every one his idols, and hereafter also, if ye will not hearken unto me: but pollute ye my holy name no more with your gifts, and with your idols. For in mine holy mountain, in the mountain of the height of Israel, saith the Lord GOD, there shall all the house of Israel, all of them in the land, serve me: there will I accept them, and there will I require your offerings, and the firstfruits of your oblations, with all your holy things. Ezekiel 20:39-40

Son of man, set thy face toward Jerusalem, and drop thy word toward the **holy** places, and prophesy against the land of Israel...And it shall be, when they say unto thee, Wherefore sighest thou? That thou shalt answer, For the tidings; because it cometh: and every heart shall melt, and all hands shall be feeble, and every **spirit** shall faint, and all knees shall be weak as water: behold, it cometh, and shall be brought to pass, saith the LORD GOD. Ezekiel 21:2, 7

Thou hast despised mine **holy** things, and hast profaned my sabbaths...Her priests have violated my law, and have profaned mine **holy** things: they have put no difference between the **holy** and profane, neither have they shewed difference between the unclean and the clean, and have hid their eyes from my sabbaths, and I am profaned among them. Ezekiel 22:8, 26

Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the **holy** mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. Ezekiel 28:14

When they entered unto the heathen, whither they went, they profaned my holy name, when they said to them, These are the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of his land. But I had pity for mine holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the heathen, whither they went. Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; I do not this for your sakes, O house of Israel, but for mine holy name's sake, which ye have profaned among the heathen, whither ye went. Ezekiel 36:20-22

A new heart also will I give you, and a new **spirit** will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my **spirit** within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them. Ezekiel 36:26-27

As the **holy** flock, as the flock of Jerusalem in her solemn feasts; so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men: and they shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 36:38

The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in **the spirit of the LORD**, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones. Ezekiel 37:1

Ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves, and shall put my **spirit** in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken it, and performed it, saith the LORD. Ezekiel 37:13-14

So will I make my **holy** name known in the midst of my people Israel; and I will not let them pollute my **holy** name any more: and the heathen shall know that I am the LORD, the **Holy** One in Israel... Thus saith the Lord GOD; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have mercy upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my **holy** name. Ezekiel 39:7, 25

Neither will I hide my face any more from them: for I have poured out my spirit upon the house of Israel, saith the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 39:29

So he measured the length thereof, twenty cubits; and the breadth, twenty cubits, before the temple: and he said unto me, This is the most **holy** place. Fzekiel 41:4

Then said he unto me, The north chambers and the south chambers, which are before the separate place, they be holy chambers, where the priests that approach unto the LORD shall eat the most holy things: there shall they lay the most holy things, and the meat offering, and the sin offering, and the trespass offering; for the place is holy. When the priests enter therein, then shall they not go out of the holy place into the utter court, but there they shall lay their garments wherein they minister; for they are holy; and shall put on other garments, and shall approach to those things which are for the people. Ezekiel 42:13-14

So the **spirit** took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the house. And I heard him speaking unto me out of the house; and the man stood by me. Ezekiel 43:5-6

And he said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcases of their kings in their high places. In their setting of their threshold by my thresholds, and their post by my posts, and the wall between me and them, they have even defiled my holy name by their abominations that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in mine anger... This is the law of the house; Upon the top of the mountain the whole limit thereof round about shall be most holy. Behold, this is the law of the house. Ezekiel 43:7-8, 12

Ye have not kept the charge of mine **holy** things: but ye have set keepers of my charge in my sanctuary for yourselves...and the Levites that are gone away far from me...they shall not come near unto me, to do the office of a priest unto me, nor to come near to any of my **holy** things, in the most **holy** place: but they shall bear their shame, and their abominations which they have committed. Ezekiel 44:8, 13

When they go forth into the utter court, even into the utter court to the people, they shall put off their garments wherein they ministered, and lay them in the **holy** chambers, and they shall put on other garments; and they shall not sanctify the people with their garments... They shall teach my people the difference between the **holy** and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; and they shall judge it according to my judgments; and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and they shall hallow my sabbaths. Ezekiel 44:19,23-24

Moreover, when ye shall divide by lot the land for inheritance, ye shall offer an oblation unto the LORD, an **holy** portion of the land: the length shall be the length of five and twenty thousand reeds, and the breadth shall be ten thousand. This shall be **holy** in all the borders thereof round about...And of this measure shalt thou measure the length of five and twenty thousand, and the breadth of ten thousand: and in it shall be the sanctuary and the most **holy** place. The **holy** portion of the land shall be for the priests the ministers of the sanctuary, which shall come near to minister unto the LORD: and it shall be a place for their houses, and an **holy** place for the sanctuary... Ezekiel 45:1, 3-4

And ye shall appoint the possession of the city five thousand broad, and five and twenty thousand long, over against the oblation of the **holy** portion: it shall be for the whole house of Israel. And a portion shall be for the prince on the one side and on the other side of the oblation of the **holy** portion, and of the possession of the city, before the oblation of the **holy** portion; and before the possession of the city, from the west side westward, and from the east side eastward: and the length shall be over against one of the portions, from the west border unto the east border. Ezekiel 45:6-7

After he brought me through the entry, which was at the side of the gate, into the **holy** chambers of the priests, which looked toward the north: and, behold, there was a place on the two sides westward. Ezekiel 46:19

For them, even the priests, shall be this **holy** oblation; toward the north five and twenty thousand in length, and toward the west ten thousand in breadth, and toward the east ten thousand in breadth, and toward the south five and twenty thousand in length: and the sanctuary of the LORD shall be in the midst thereof...and this oblation of the land that is offered shall be unto them a thing most **holy** by the border of the Levites...and they shall not sell of it, neither exchange, nor alienate the firstfruits of the land: for it is **holy** unto the LORD. Ezekiel 48:10, 12, 14

The residue in length over against the oblation of the **holy** portion shall be ten thousand eastward, and ten thousand westward: and it shall be over against the oblation of the **holy** portion; and the increase thereof shall be for food unto them that serve the city...all the oblation shall be five and twenty thousand by five and twenty thousand: ye shall offer the **holy** oblation foursquare, with the possession of the city. And the residue shall be for the prince, on the one side and on the other of the **holy** oblation, and of the possession of the city, over against the five and twenty thousand of the oblation toward the east border, and westward over against the five and twenty thousand toward the west border, over against the portions for the prince: and it shall be the **holy** oblation; and the sanctuary of the house shall be in the midst there. Ezekiel 48:21

In the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his **spirit** was troubled, and his sleep brake from him...and the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my **spirit** was troubled to know the dream. Daniel 2:1, 3

[Nebuchadnezzar] I thought it good to shew the signs and wonders that the high God hath wrought toward me. How great are his signs! And how mighty are his wonders! His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom...Daniel came in before me, whose name was Belteshazzar, according to the name of my god, and in whom is the **spirit** of the **holy** gods: and before him I told the dream, saying, O Belteshazzar, master of the magicians, because I know that the **spirit** of the **holy** gods is in thee, and no secret troubleth thee, tell me the visions of my dream that I have seen, and the interpretation thereof. Daniel 4:1-3, 8-9

I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven... This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men. This dream I king Nebuchadnezzar have seen. Now thou, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the wise men of my kingdom are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but thou art able; for the spirit of the holy gods is in thee...whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and let his portion be with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him... Daniel 4:13, 17-18, 23

There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom is the **spirit** of the **holy** gods; and in the days of thy father light and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar thy father, the king, I say, thy father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers; Forasmuch as an excellent **spirit**, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and shewing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel... He will shew the interpretation... I have even heard of thee, that the **spirit** of the gods is in thee, and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom is found in thee. Daniel 5:11-12, 14

Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent **spirit** was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm. Daniel 6:3

I Daniel was grieved in my **spirit** in the midst of my body, and the visions of my head troubled me. Daniel 7:15

His power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the **holy** people. Daniel 8:24

O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people are become a reproach to all that are about us...and while I was speaking, and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God for the holy mountain of my God...even the man Gabriel...informed me...seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:16, 20, 24

Then shall he return into his land with great riches; and his heart shall be against the **holy** covenant; and he shall do exploits, and return to his own land...for the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the **holy** covenant: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the **holy** covenant... And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious **holy** mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him. Daniel 11:28, 30, 45

I heard the man clothed in linen, which was upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and sware by him that liveth for ever that it shall be for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the **holy** people, all these things shall be finished. Daniel 12:7

My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declareth unto them: for the **spirit** of whoredoms hath caused them to err, and they have gone a whoring from under their God... They will not frame their doings to turn unto their God: for the **spirit** of whoredoms is in the midst of them, and they have not known the LORD. Hosea 4:12, 5:4

I will not execute the fierceness of mine anger, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am God, and not man; the **Holy** One in the midst of thee: and I will not enter into the city. Hosea 11:9

Blow ye the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my **holy** mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of the LORD cometh, for it is nigh at hand... Joel 2:1

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my **spirit** upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: and also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my **spirit**. Joel 2:28-29

So shall ye know that I am the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my **holy** mountain: then shall Jerusalem be **holy**, and there shall no strangers pass through her any more. Joel 3:17

For three transgressions of Israel, and four four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof...that pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the meek: and a man and his father will go in unto the same maid, to profane my **holy** name. Amos 2:6-7

For as ye have drunk upon my **holy** mountain, so shall all the heathen drink continually, yea, they shall drink, and they shall swallow down, and they shall be as though they had not been. Obadiah 1:16

Then I said, I am cast out of thy sight; yet I will look again toward thy **holy** temple...when my soul fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my prayer came in unto thee, into thine **holy** temple. Jonah 2:4, 7

Hear, all ye people; hearken, O earth, and all that therein is; and let the Lord GOD be witness against you, the Lord from his **holy** temple. Micah 1:2

O thou that art named of the house of Jacob, is the **spirit** of the LORD straitened? Are these his doings? Do not my words do good to him that walketh uprightly? If a man walking in the **spirit** and falsehood do lie, saying, I will prophesy unto thee of wine and of strong drink; he shall even be the prophet of this people...But truly I am full of power by the **spirit** of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin. Micah 2:7, 11; 3:8

Art thou not from everlasting, O LORD my God, mine **Holy** One? We shall not die. O LORD, thou hast ordained them for judgment; and, O mighty God, thou hast established them for correction. Habakkuk 1:12

The LORD is in his **holy** temple: let all the earth keep silence before him. Habakkuk 2:20

God came from Teman, and the **Holy** One from mount Paran. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of his praise. Habakkuk 3:3

In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my **holy** mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

The LORD stirred up the **spirit** of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the **spirit** of the remnant of the people, and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God... Haggai 1:14

According to the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my **spirit** remaineth among you: fear ye not. Haggai 2:5

If one bear **holy** flesh in the skirt of his garment, and with his skirt do touch bread, or pottage, or wine, or oil, or any meat, shall it be **holy**? And the priests answered and said, No. Haggai 2:12

The LORD shall inherit Judah his portion in the **holy** land, and shall choose Jerusalem again. Be silent, O all flesh, before the LORD: for he is raised up out of his **holy** habitation. Zechariah 2:13

Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, Knowest thou not what these be? And I said, No, my lord. Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my **spirit**, saith the LORD of hosts. Zechariah 4:5-6

Then cried he upon me, and spake unto me, saying, Behold, these that go toward the north country have quieted my **spirit** in the north country. Zechariah 6:8

Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his **spirit** by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts. Zechariah 7:12

Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the **holy** mountain. Zechariah 8:3

The burden of the word of the LORD for Israel, saith the LORD, which stretcheth forth the heavens, and layeth the foundation of the earth, and formeth the **spirit** of man within him...and I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the **spirit** of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. Zechariah 12:1, 10

And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, that I will cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they shall no more be remembered: and also I will cause the prophets and the unclean **spirit** to pass out of the land. Zechariah 13:2

And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the **spirit**. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your **spirit**, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth. For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for one covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your **spirit**, that ye deal not treacherously. Malachi 2:15-16

HOLY SPIRIT AND SPIRIT IN THE NEW COVENANT

Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: when as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the **Holy Ghost**. Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a public example, was minded to put her away privily. But while he thought on these things, behold the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the **Holy Ghost**. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. Matthew 1:18-21

I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the **Holy Ghost**, and with fire: whose fan is in his hand, and he will throughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire. Matthew 3:11-12

And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the **Spirit** of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him... Matthew 3:16

Then was Jesus led up of the **Spirit** into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil...then the devil taketh him up into the **holy** city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple... Matthew 4:1, 5

Blessed are the poor in **spirit**: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:3

Give not that which is **holy** unto the dogs, neither cast ye your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you. Matthew 7:6

For it is not ye that speak, but the **Spirit** of your Father which speaketh in you. Matthew 10:20

...Esaias the prophet, saying, Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my **spirit** upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles. Matthew 12:17-18

But if I cast out devils by the **Spirit** of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. Matthew 12:28

All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the **Holy Ghost** shall not be forgiven unto men. And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the **Holy Ghost**, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come. Matthew 12:32

When the unclean **spirit** is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none. Matthew 12:43

When the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a **spirit**; and thy cried out for fear. Matthew 14:26

He saith unto the, How then doth David in **spirit** call him Lord, saying, The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? Matthew 22:43-44

When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the **holy** place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) Then let them...flee into the mountains...Matthew 24:15-16

When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the **holy** angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: Matthew 25:31

Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the **spirit** indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak. Matthew 26:41

Jesus, when he had cried again with a loud voice, yielded up **the ghost**... The graves were opened; and many bodies of the saints which slept arose, and came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the **holy** city, and appeared unto many. Matthew 27:52-54

Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the **Holy Ghost**: Matthew 28:19

I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize you with the **Holy Ghost**. Mark 1:8

Straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the **Spirit** like a dove descending upon him: and there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. And immediately the **Spirit** driveth him into the wilderness. Mark 1:10-11

There was in their synagogue a man with an unclean **spirit**; and he cried out, saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? Art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art, the **Holy** One of God. And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the unclean **spirit** had torn him, and cried with a loud voice, he came out of him. Mark 1:23-26

Immediately when Jesus perceived in his **spirit** that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts? Mark 2:8

He that shall blaspheme against the **Holy Ghost** hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation: because they said, He hath an unclean **spirit**. Mark 3:29-30

When he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man with an unclean **spirit**... When he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him, and cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of the most high God? I adjure thee by God, that thou torment me not. For he said unto him, Come out of the man, thou unclean **spirit**. Mark 5:2, 6-8

For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an **holy**, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly. Mark 6:20

When they saw him walking upon the sea, they supposed it had been a spirit, and cried out: Mark 6:49

For a certain woman, whose young daughter had unclean **spirit**, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet: Mark 7:25

He sighed deeply in his **spirit**, and saith, Why doth this generation seek after a sign? Verily I say unto you, There shall no sign be given unto this generation. Mark 8:12

Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels. Mark 8:38

One of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb **spirit**...and they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the **spirit** tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming...when Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul **spirit**, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf **spirit**, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him. And the **spirit** cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead. Mark 9:17, 20, 25-26

For David himself said by the **Holy Ghost**, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool. Mark 12:36

But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the **Holy Ghost**. Mark 13:11

Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. The **spirit** truly is ready, but the flesh is weak. Mark 14:38

For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and he shall be filled with the **Holy Ghost**, even from his mother's womb...He shall go before him in the **spirit** and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:15, 17

The angel answered and said unto her, **The Holy Ghost** shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that **holy** thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. Luke 1:35

It came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutaion of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the **Holy Ghost**: Luke 1:41

My **spirit** hath rejoiced in God my Saviour... For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and **holy** is his name. Luke 1:47, 49

His father Zacharias was filled with the **Holy Ghost**, and prophesied saying, Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, and hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; as he spake by the mouth of his **holy** prophets, which have been since the world began: that we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; to perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his **holy** covenant. The oath which he sware to our father Abraham, that he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, in **holiness** and righteousness before him, all the days of our life. And thou, child, shalt be called the prophet of the Highest; for thou shalt go before the face of the Lord to prepare his ways... Luke 1:67-76

The child grew, and waxed strong in **spirit**, and was in the deserts till the day of his shewing unto Israel. Luke 1:80

(As it is written in the law of the Lord, Every male that openeth the womb shall be called **holy** to the Lord;) Luke 2:23

Behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the **Holy Ghost** was upon him. It was revealed unto him by the **Holy Ghost**, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ. He came by the **Spirit** into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God... Luke 2:25-28

The child grew, and waxed strong in **spirit**, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him. Luke 2:40

John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the **Holy Ghost** and with fire: whose fan is in his hand, and he will throughly purge his floor, and will gather the wheat into his garner; but the chaff he will burn with fire unquenchable. Luke 3:16-17

The **Holy Ghost** descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased. Luke 3:22

Jesus being full of the **Holy Ghost** returned from Jordan, and was led by the **Spirit** into the wilderness...Luke 4:1

Jesus returned in the power of the **Spirit** into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. Luke 4:14

The **Spirit** of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor, he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, to preach the acceptable day of the Lord. Luke 4:18-19

In the synagogue there was a man, which had a **spirit** of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice, saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? Art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the **Holy** One of God. And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not. Luke 4:33-35

(For he had commanded the unclean **spirit** to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.) Luke 8:29

Her **spirit** came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat. Luke 8:55

Lo, a **spirit** taketh him, and he suddenly crieth out; and it teareth him that he foameth again, and bruising him hardly departeth from him...And as he was yet a coming, the devil threw him down, and tare him. And Jesus rebuked the unclean **spirit**, and healed the child, and delivered him again to his father. Luke 9:39, 42

But he turned, and rebuked them, and said, Ye know not what manner of spirit ye are of. Luke 9:55

In that hour Jesus rejoiced in **spirit**, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight. Luke 10:21

If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the **Holy Spirit** to them that ask him? Luke 11:13

When the unclean **spirit** is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. Luke 11:24

Whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the **Holy Ghost** it shall not be forgiven. And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and unto magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say: For the **Holy Ghost** shall teach you in that same hour what ye ought to say. Luke 12:10-12

Behold, there was a woman which had a **spirit** of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself. Luke 13:11

When Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my **spirit**: and having said thus, he gave up the **ghost**. Luke 23:46

They were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit. Luke 24:37

Behold my hands and my feet, that it is I myself: handle me, and see, for a spirit hath not flesh and bones, as ye see me have. Luke 24:39

John bare record, saying, I saw the **Spirit** descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. I knew him not: be he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the **Spirit** descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the **Holy Ghost**. John 1:32-33

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the **Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the **Spirit** is **spirit**... The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the **Spirit**. John 3:5-6, 8

For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God for God giveth not the **Spirit** by measure unto him. John 3:34

But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in **spirit** and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him God is a **Spirit**: and they that worship him must worship him in **spirit** and in truth. John 4:23-24

It is the **spirit** that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are **spirit**, and they are life. John 6:63

In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the **Spirit**, which they that believe on him should receive: for the **Holy Ghost** was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:37-39

When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the **spirit**, and was troubled. John 11:33

When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in **spirit**, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray me. John 13:21

If ye love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever, Even the **Spirit** of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you... These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you. But the Comforter, which is the **Holy Ghost**, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. John 14:15-17, 25-26

But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the **Spirit** of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me... John 15:26

Howbeit when he, the **Spirit** of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. John 16:13

Now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. **Holy** Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are. John 17:11

He shewed unto them his hands and his side. Then were the disciples glad, when they saw the Lord. Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you. And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the **Holy Ghost**: John 20:20-22

The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which he was taken up, after that the **Holy Ghost** had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chose: to whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs... Acts 1:1-3

For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the **Holy Ghost** not many days hence...but ye shall receive power, after that the **Holy Ghost** is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:5, 8

Men and brethren, this scripture must needs have been fulfilled, which the **Holy Ghost** by the mouth of David spake before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus. Acts 1:16

And they were all filled with the **Holy Ghost**, and began to speak with other tongues, as the **Spirit** gave them utterance. Acts 2:4

And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my **Spirit** upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: and on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my **Spirit**; and they shall prophesy: Acts 2:17-18

Thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine **Holy** One to see corruption. Acts 2:27

This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the **Holy Ghost**, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. Acts 2:32-33

Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do? Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the **Holy Ghost**. Acts 2:37-38

Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? Or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or **holines**s we had made this man to walk? The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate...but ye denied the **Holy** One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you; Acts 3:12-14

When they had set them in the midst, they asked, By what power, or by what name, have ye done this? Then Peter, filled with the **Holy Ghost**, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel, if we this day be examined of the good deed done to the impotent man, by what means he is made whole; be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. Acts 4:7-10

The kings of the earth stood up...Against thy **holy** child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together. Acts 4:26-27

Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, by stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy **holy** child Jesus. When they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the **Holy Ghost**, and they spake the word of God with boldness. Acts 4:29-31

Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the **Holy Ghost**, and to keep back part of the price of the land? ... Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the **Spirit** of the Lord? Behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out. Acts 5:3, 9

We are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the **Holy Ghost**, whom God hath given to them that obey him. Acts 5:32

Brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business. But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word. And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip...whom they set before the apostles: and when they had prayed, they laid their hands on them. And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith. And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people. Acts 6:3-8

They were not able to resist the wisdom and the **spirit** by which he spake...and set up false witnesses, which said, This man ceaseth not to speak blasphemous words against this **holy** place, and the law: Acts 6:10, 13

Then said the Lord to him, Put off thy shoes from thy feet: for the place where thou standest is **holy** ground. Acts 7:33

Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the **Holy Ghost**: as your fathers did, so do ye... When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth. But he, being full of the **Holy Ghost**, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God... Acts 7:51, 54-55

They stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my **spirit**. Acts 7:59

Who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the **Holy Ghost**: (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the **Holy Ghost**. Acts 8:15-17

When Simon saw that through laying on of the apostle's hands the **Holy Ghost** was given, he offered them money, saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay hands, he may receive the **Holy Ghost**. Acts 8:18-19

Then the **Spirit** said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot. Acts 8:29

When they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Phillip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. Acts 8:39

Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the **Holy Ghost**. Acts 9:17

Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the **Holy Ghost**, were multiplied. Acts 9:31

While Peter thought on the vision, the **Spirit** said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee...and they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an **holy** angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee. Acts 10:19

...How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the **Holy Ghost** and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him. Acts 10:38

While Peter yet spake these words, the **Holy Ghost** fell on all them which heard the word. And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the **Holy Ghost**. For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the **Holy Ghost** as well as we? And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Acts 10:44-48

The **Spirit** bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house... As I began to speak, the **Holy Ghost** fell on them, as on us at the beginning. Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the **Holy Ghost**. Acts 11:12, 15-16

For he was a good man, and full of the **Holy Ghos**t and of faith: and much people was added unto the Lord. Acts 11:24

And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the **Spirit** that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar. Acts 11:28

As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the **Holy Ghost** said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them. When they had fasted and prayed, and laid their hands on them, they sent them away. So they, being sent forth by the **Holy Ghost**, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus. Acts 13:2-4

Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with the **Holy Ghost**, set his eyes on him, and said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? Acts 13:9-10

He saith also in another psalm, Thou shalt not suffer thine **Holy** One to see corruption. Acts 13:35

The disciples were filled with joy, and with the **Holy Ghost**. Acts 13:52

And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the **Holy Ghost**, even as he did unto us; and put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. Acts 15:8-9

For it seemed good to the **Holy Ghost**, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; that ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Acts 15:28-29

When they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the **Holy Ghost** to preach the word in Asia, after they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the **Spirit** suffered them not. Acts 16:6-7

And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a **spirit** of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying...and this she did many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the **spirit**, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour. Acts 16:16, 18

Now while Paul waited for them at Athens, his **spirit** was stirred in him, when he saw the city wholly given to idolatry. Acts 17:18

When Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the **spirit**, and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ. Acts 18:5

This man was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in the **spirit**, and spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John. Acts 18:25

Have ye received the **Holy Ghost** since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any **Holy Ghost**... When Paul had laid his hands upon them, the **Holy Ghost** came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied. Acts 19:2, 6

The evil **spirit** answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? And the man in whom the evil **spirit** was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. Acts 19:15-16

After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the **spirit**, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome. Acts 19:21

Now, behold, I go bound in the **spirit** unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there: Acts 20:22

And finding disciples, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the **Spirit**, that he should not go up to Jerusalem. Acts 21:4

The Jews...when they saw him in the temple, stirred up all the people, and laid hands on him, crying out, Men of Israel, help: This is the man, that teacheth all men every where against the people, and the law, and this place: and further brought Greeks also into the temple, and hath polluted this holy place. Acts 21:27-28

For the Sadducees say that there is no resurrection, neither angel, nor spirit: but the Pharisees confess both. And there arose a great cry: and the scribes that were of the Pharisees' part arose, and strove, saying, We find no evil in this man: but if a **spirit** or an angel hath spoken to him, let us not fight against God. Acts 23:8-9

Now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there: save that the **Holy Ghost** witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me. Acts 20:22-23

Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the **Holy Ghost** hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood. Acts 20:28

When he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the **Holy Ghost**, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles. Acts 21:11

Some believed the things which were spoken, and some believed not. And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, Well spake the **Holy Ghost** by Esaias the prophet unto our fathers, saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing ye shall hear, and shall not understand; and seeing ye shall see, and not perceive: Acts 28:24-25

In the **holy** scriptures...Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; and declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the **spirit of holiness**, by the resurrection from the dead: by whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name: among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ...For God is my witness, whom I serve with my **spirit** in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers... Romans 1:3-4, 9

He is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the **spirit**, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God. Roman 2:29

We glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope: and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the **Holy Ghost** which is given unto us. Romans 5:3-5

For as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto **holiness**. For when ye were servants of sin, ye were free from rightouesness. What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto **holiness**, and the end everlasting life. Romans 6:19-22

Now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should serve in newness of **spirit**, and not in the oldness of the letter. Romans 7:6

Wherefore the law is **holy**, and the commandment **holy**, and just, and good. Romans 7:12

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the **Spirit**. For the law of the **Spirit** of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: that the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the **Spirit**. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the **Spirit** the things of the **Spirit**. Romans 8:1-5

But ye are not in the flesh, but in the **Spirit**, if so be that the **Spirit** of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the **Spirit** of Christ, he is none of his. And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the **Spirit** is life because of righteousness. But if the **Spirit** of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his **Spirit** that dwelleth in you. Romans 8:9-11

For if ye live after flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the **Spirit** do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall life. For as many as are led by the **Spirit** of God, they are the sons of God. For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the **Spirit** of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. The **Spirit** beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God. Romans 8:13-16

Not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the **Spirit**, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. Romans 8:23

Likewise the **Spirit** helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the **Spirit** maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the **Spirit**, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. Romans 8:26-27

I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the **Holy Ghost**, that I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart. Romans 9:1-2

(According as it is written, God hath given them the **spirit** of slumber, eyes that they should not see, and ears that they should not hear;) unto this day. Romans 11:8

For if the firstfruit be **holy**, the lump is also **holy**: and if the root be **holy**, so are the branches. Romans 11:16

Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in **spirit**; serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer... Romans 12:10-12

For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the **Holy Ghost**. Romans 14:17

Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the **Holy Ghost**. Romans 15:13

I have written the more boldly unto you in some sort, as putting you in mind, because of the grace that is given me of God, that I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the **Holy Ghost**. Romans 15:15-16

For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ hath not wrought by me, to make the Gentiles obedient, by word and deed. Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the **Spirit** of God; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ. Romans 15:18-19

Now I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the love of the **Spirit**, that ye strive together with me in your prayers to God for me; Romans 15:30

Salute one another with an **holy** kiss. The churches of Christ salute you. Romans 16:16

I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the **Spirit** and of power: 1 Corinthians 2:3-4

As it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 1 Corinthians 2:9-14

Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the **Spirit** of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is **holy**, which temple ye are. 1 Corinthians 3:16-17

What will ye? Shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and in the spirit of meekness? 1 Corinthians 4:21

For I verily, as absent in body, but present in **spirit**, have judged already, as though I were present, concerning him that hath so done this deed, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my **spirit**, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ, to deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the **spirit** may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. 1 Corinthians 5:3-5

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? ... And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. 1 Corinthians 6:9, 11

What? Know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? For two, saith he, shall be one flesh. But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. 1 Corinthians 6:16-17

What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the **Holy Ghost** which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

For the unbelieving husband is sanctified by the wife, and the unbelieving wife is sanctified by the husband: else were your children unclean; but now are they **holy**... There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be **holy** both in body and in **spirit**: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband...the wife is bound by the law as long as her husband liveth; but if her husband be dead, she is at liberty to be married to whom she will; only in the Lord. But she is happier if she so abide, after my judgment: and I think also that I have **the Spirit of God**. 1 Corinthians 7:14, 34, 39-40

Do ye not know that they which minister about **holy** things live of the things of the temple? And they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar? 1 Corinthians 9:13

Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh in all in all...But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues: but all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will. 1 Corinthians 12:3-11

For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. For by one **Spirit** are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one **Spirit**. For the body is not one member, but many...Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. 1 Corinthians 12:12-13, 27

For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the **spirit** he speaketh mysteries. 1 Corinthians 14:2

Let him that speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret. For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my **spirit** prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. What is it then? I will pray with the **spirit**, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the **spirit**, and I will sing with the understanding also. Else when thou shalt bless with the **spirit**, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest? 1 Corinthians 14:13-16

And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening **spirit**. 1 Corinthians 15:45

For that which was lacking on your part they have supplied. For they have refreshed my **spirit** and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such...All the brethren greet you. Greet ye one another with an **holy** kiss. 1 Corinthians 16:17b-18, 20

Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and hath anointed us, is God; Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the **Spirit** in our hearts. 2 Corinthians 1:21-22

When I came to Troas to preach Christ's gospel, and a door was opened unto me of the Lord, I had no rest in my **spirit**, because I found not Titus my brother: but taking my leave of them, I went from thence into Macedonia. 2 Corinthians 2:12-13

For as much as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the **Spirit** of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshly tables of the heart. And such trust have we through Christ to God-ward: not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God; who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the **spirit**: for the letter killeth, but the **spirit** giveth life. If the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away: How shall not the ministration of the **spirit** be rather glorious? 2 Corinthians 3:3-8

Now the Lord is that **Spirit**: and where the **Spirit** of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the **Spirit** of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:17-18

We having the same **spirit** of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak... 2 Corinthians 4:13

For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life. Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the **Spirit**. 2 Corinthians 5:4-5

In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings; By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy **Ghost**, by love unfeigned, by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, by honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and, behold we live; as chastened, and not killed; as sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. ... Come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord God Almighty. Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. 2 Corinthians 6: 4-10, 17-18, 7:1

Therefore we were comforted in your comfort: yea, and exceedingly the more joyed we for the joy of Titus, because his **spirit** was refreshed by you all...and his inward affection is more abundant toward you, whilst he remembereth the obedience of you all, how with fear and trembling ye received him. 2 Corinthians 7:13

For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another **spirit**, which we have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him. 2 Corinthians 11:4

I desired Titus, and with him I sent a brother. Did Titus make a gain of you? Walked we not in the same **spirit**? Walked we not in the same steps? 2 Corinthians 12:18

Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you. Greet one another with an **holy** kiss. All the saints salute you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the **Holy Ghost**, be with you all. Amen. 2 Corinthians 13:11-14

This only would I learn of you, Received ye the **Spirit** by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? Are ye so foolish? Having begun in the **Spirit**, are ye now made perfect by the flesh? Have ye suffered so many things in vain? If it be yet in vain. He therefore that ministereth to you the **Spirit**, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? Galatians 3:2-5

Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the **Spirit** through faith. Galatians 3:13-14

When the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth **the Spirit of his Son** into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. Galatians 4:4-6

Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace. For we through the **Spirit** wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. Galatians 5:4-5

Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise. But as then he that was born after the flesh persecuted him that was born after the **Spirit**, even so it is now. Galatians 5:28-29

This I say then, walk in the **Spirit**, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the **Spirit**, and the **Spirit** against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led by the **Spirit**, ye are not under the law. Galatians 5:16-18

The fruit of the **Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the **Spirit**, let us also walk in the **Spirit**. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 5:22-26

Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are **spiritual**, restore such an one in the **spirit** of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Galatians 6:1

Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the **Spirit** shall of the **Spirit** reap life everlasting. Galatians 6:7-8

Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your **spirit**. Amen. Galatians 6:18

According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be **holy** and without blame before him in love. Ephesians 1:4

In whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that **holy Spirit** of promise, which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the **spirit** of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: Ephesians 1:13b-17

You hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins; wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the **spirit** that now worketh in the children of disobedience: Ephesians 2:1-2

For through him we both have access by one **Spirit** unto the Father. Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow-citizens with the saints, and of the household of God; and are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone... Ephesians 2:18-20

In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an **holy** temple in the Lord: In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the **Spirit**. Ephesians 2:21-22

... When ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ) which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of **holy** apostles and prophets by the **Spirit**; that the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel... Ephesians 3:4-5

For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his **Spirit** in the inner man... Ephesians 3:14-16

I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavouring to keep the unity of the **Spirit** in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:1-3

There is one body, and one **Spirit**, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:4-6

If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus: that ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; and be renewed in the spirit of your mind: and that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. Ephesians 4:21-24

Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. And grieve not the **holy Spirit** of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. Ephesians 4:29-30

That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be **holy** and without blemish. Ephesians 5:27

(For the fruit of the **Spirit** is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) Ephesians 5:9

Be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the **Spirit**; speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord... Ephesians 5:18-19

Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the **Spirit**, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the **Spirit**, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints... Ephesians 6:17-18

For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the **Spirit** of Jesus Christ... Philippians 1:19

Let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one **spirit**, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the **Spirit**, if any bowels and mercies, fulfil ye my joy, that ye be like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Philippians 1:27, 2:1-2

For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the **spirit**, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh. Philippians 3:3

Ye also learned of Epaphras our dear fellow-servant, who is for you a faithful minister of Christ; who also declared unto us your love in the **Spirit**. Colossians 1:7-8

And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled in the body of his flesh through death, to present you **holy** and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight... Colossians 1:21-22

For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the **spirit**, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ. Colossians 2:5

Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an **holyday**, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ. Colossians 2:16-17

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, **holy** and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. Colossians 3:12-13

For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the **Holy Ghost**, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake. And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the **Holy Ghost**... 1 Thessalonians 1:5-6

To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in **holiness** before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints. 1 Thessalonians 3:13

For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto **holiness**. He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his **holy Spirit**. 1 Thessalonians 4:7-8

Quench not the **Spirit**. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole **spirit** and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Thessalonians 5:19-23

Greet all the brethren with an **holy** kiss. I charge you by the Lord that this epistle be read unto all the **holy** brethren. 1 Thessalonians 5:26-27

Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him, that ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by **spirit**, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. 2 Thessalonians 2:1-2

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the **spirit** of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 2 Thessalonians 2:7-8

We are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the **Spirit** and belief of the truth... 2 Thessalonians 2:13

Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith, and charity and **holiness** with sobriety. 1 Timothy 2:15

I will therefore that men pray every where, lifting up **holy** hands, without wrath and doubting. 1 Timothy 2:8

Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the **Spirit**, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. 1 Timothy 3:16

Now the **Spirit** speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing **spirits**, and doctrines of devils... 1 Timothy 4:1

Be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in **spirit**, in faith, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

God hath not given us the **spirit** of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind. Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; who hath saved us, and called us with an **holy** calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began... 2 Timothy 1:7-9

Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the **Holy Ghost** which dwelleth in us...From a child thou hast known the **holy** scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 1:13-14, 3:15

The Lord Jesus Christ be with thy **spirit**. Grace be with you. Amen. 2 Timothy 4:22

A bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; but a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, just, **holy**, temperate... The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh **holiness**, not false accusers, not given to wine, teachers of good things; That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good... Titus 1:7-8, 2:3-5

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the **Holy Ghost**; Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus... Titus 3:5-6

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your **spirit**. Amen. Philemon 1:25

How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him; God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the **Holy Ghost**, according to his own will? Hebrews 2:3-4

Holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. Hebrews 3:1-2

Wherefore (as the **Holy Ghost** saith, To day if ye will hear his voice, Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness: Hebrews 3:7-8

For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and **spirit**, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Hebrews 4:12

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the **Holy Ghost**, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, if they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame. Hebrews 6:4-6

For such an high priest became us, who is **holy**, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; Hebrews 7:26

Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God. But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people: the **Holy Ghost** signifying, that the way into the **holiest** of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing: Hebrews 9:6-8

Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the **holy** place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. For if the blood of bulls and of goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal **Spirit** offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Hebrews 9:12-14

For Christ is not entered into the **holy** places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the **holy** place every year with blood of others... Hebrews 9:24-25

For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. Whereof the **Holy Ghost** also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before, This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. ... Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the **holiest** by the blood of Jesus. Hebrews 10:14-17, 19

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an **unholy** thing, and hath done despite unto the **Spirit** of grace? Hebrews 10:28-29

For they...chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his **holiness**...Make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but rather let it be healed. Follow peace with all men, and **holiness**, without which no man shall see the Lord: Hebrews 12:10-14

For as the body without the **spirit** is dead, so faith without works is dead also. James 2:26

Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? Whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The **spirit** that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? James 4:4-5

Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia, elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the **Spirit**, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. 1 Peter 1:1-2

... The prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you: searching what, or what manner of time the **Spirit** of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the **Holy Ghost** sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into. 1 Peter 1:10-12

But as he which hath called you is **holy**, so be ye **holy** in all manner of conversation; because it is written, Be ye **holy**; for I am **holy**. 1 Peter 1:15-16

Seeing ye have purifed your souls in obeying the truth through the **Spirit** unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: 1 Peter 1:22

Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an **holy** priesthood, to offer up **spiritual** sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ...ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an **holy** nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light. 1 Peter 2:5, 9

Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparrel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet **spirit**, which is in the sight of God of great price. For after this manner in the old time the **holy** women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands... 1 Peter 3:3-5

For it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye suffer for well-doing, than for evil-doing. For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the **Spirit**: by which also he went and preached unto the **spirits** in prison; 1 Peter 3:17-19

For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the **spirit**. But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. 1 Peter 4:6-7

If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the **spirit** of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified. 1 Peter 4:14

There came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. This voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the **holy** mount...For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but **holy** men of God spake as they were moved by the **Holy Ghost**. 2 Peter 1:17-18, 21

For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the **holy** commandment delivered unto them. 2 Peter 2:21

This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the **holy** prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour: Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, and saying, where is the promise of his coming? 2 Peter 3:1-3

Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all **holy** conversation and godliness.. 2 Peter 3:11

Ye have an unction from the **Holy One**, and ye know all things...but the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. 1 John 2:20, 27

This is his commandment, that we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as he gave us commandment. And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the **Spirit** which he hath given us. 1 John 3:23-24

Beloved, believe not every **spirit**, but try the **spirits** whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world. Hereby know ye the **Spirit** of God: Every **spirit** that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: and every **spirit** that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that **spirit** of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world. 1 John 4:1-3

We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the **spirit** of truth, and the **spirit** of error. 1 John 4:6

Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his **Spirit**. 1 John 4:13

This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the **Spirit** that beareth witness, because the **Spirit** is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the **Holy Ghost**: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the **Spirit**, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one. 1 John 5:6-8

Beloved, remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ; how that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. These be they who separate themselves, sensual, having not the **Spirit**. But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most **holy** faith, praying in the **Holy Ghost**, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. Jude 1:19-20

I was in the **Spirit** on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea. Revelation 1:10-11

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God. Revelation 2:7

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death. Revelation 2:11

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** saith unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receive thit. Revelation 2:17

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** saith unto the churches. Revelation 2:29, 3:6, 3:13, 3:22

To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is **holy**, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth... Revelation 3:7

Immediately I was in the **spirit**: and behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne...and the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, **Holy, holy, holy**, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. Revelation 4:2, 8

And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, **holy** and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? Revelation 6:10

But the court which is without the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the Gentiles: and the **holy** city shall they tread under foot forty and two months. Revelation 11:2

After three days and an half the **Spirit** of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them. Revelation 11:11

The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the **holy** angels, and in the presence of the Lamb... Revelation 14:10

I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforeth: Yea, saith the **Spirit**, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. Revelation 14:13

Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? For thou only art **holy**: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest. Revelation 15:4

So he carried me away in the **spirit** into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. Revelation 17:3

He cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul **spirit**, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird...Rejoice over her, thou heaven, and ye **holy** apostles and prophets; for God hath avenged you on her. Revelation 18:2, 20

I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See that thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the **spirit** of prophecy. Revelation 19:10

Blessed and **holy** is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. Revelation 20:6

I John saw the **holy** city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband...He carried me away in the **spirit** to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the **holy** Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God. Revelation 21:2, 10

He said to me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done...He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still. Revelation 22:6, 11

The **Spirit** and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely. Revelation 22:17

If any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the **holy** city, and from the things which are written in this book. Revelation 22:19
