HOPE

*Turn again, my daughters, go your way; for I am too old to have an husband. If I should say, I have **hope**, if I should have an husband also to night, and should also bear sons; Would ye tarry for them till they were grown? would ye stay for them from having husbands? nay, my daughters; for it grieveth me much for your sakes that the hand of the LORD is gone out against me. And they lifted up their voice, and wept again: and Orpah kissed her mother-in-law; but Ruth clave unto her. Ruth 1:11-14*

*We have trespassed against our God, and have taken strange wives of the people of the land: yet now there is **hope** in Israel concerning this thing...Now therefore make confession unto the LORD God of your fathers, and do his pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives. Then all the congregation answered and said with a loud voice, As thou hast said, so must we do. Ezra 10:2, 11-12*

*Now in the twelfth month, that is, the month Adar, on the thirteenth day of the same, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews **hoped** to have power over them, (though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that hated them;) Esther 9:1*

*So the poor hath **hope**, and iniquity stoppeth her mouth. Behold, happy is the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty. Job 5:16-17*

*What is my strength, that I should **hope**? and what is mine end, that I should prolong my life? Is my strength the strength of stones? or is my flesh of brass? Is not my help in me? and is wisdom driven quite from me? Job 6:11*

*The paths of their way are turned aside; they go to nothing, and perish. The troops of Tema looked, the companies of Sheba waited for them. They were confounded because they had **hoped**; they came thither, and were ashamed. Job 6:18-20*

*My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle, and are spent without **hope**. O remember that my life is wind: mine eye shall no more see good. The eye of him that hath seen me shall see me no more: thine eyes are upon me, and I am not. Job 7:6-8*

*Can the rush grow up without mire? can the flag grow without water? Whilst it is yet in his greenness, and not cut down, it withereth before any other herb. So are the paths of all that forget God; and the hypocrite's **hope** shall perish: whose **hope** shall be cut off, and whose trust shall be a spider's web. Job 8:11-14*

*Thou shalt be secure, because there is **hope**; yea, thou shalt dig about thee, and thou shalt take thy rest in safety. Also thou shalt lie down, and none shall make thee afraid; yea, many shall make suit unto thee. But the eyes of the wicked shall fail, and they shall not escape, and their **hope** shall be as the giving up of the ghost. Job 11:18-20*

*For there is **hope** of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender branch thereof will not cease... Yet through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant. But man dieth, and wasteth away: yea, man giveth up the ghost, and where is he? Job 14:7, 9-10*

*The waters wear the stones: thou wastest away the things which grow out of the dust of the earth; and thou destroyest the **hope** of man. Thou prevailest for ever against him, and he passeth: thou changest his countenance, and sendest him away. Job 14:19-20*

*I have said to corruption, Thou art my father: to the worm, Thou art my mother, and my sister. And where is now my **hope**? as for my **hope**, who shall see it? Job 17:14-15*

*He hath fenced up my way that I cannot pass, and he hath set darkness in my paths. He hath stripped me of my glory, and taken the crown from my head. He hath destroyed me on every side, and I am gone: and mine **hope** hath he removed like a tree. Job 19:8-10*

*For what is the **hope** of the hypocrite, though he hath gained, when God taketh away his soul? Will God hear his cry when trouble cometh upon him? Will he delight himself in the Almighty? will he always call upon God? Job 27:8-10*

*If I have made gold my **hope**, or have said to the fine gold, Thou art my confidence; If I rejoiced because my wealth was great, and because mine hand had gotten much... This also were an iniquity to be punished by the judge; for I should have denied the God that is above. Job 31:24-25, 28*

*Behold, the **hope** of him is in vain: shall not one be cast down even at the sight of him? Job 41:9*

*I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved. Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoiceth: my flesh also shall rest in **hope**. For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Psalm 16:8-10*

*Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver them. They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded. But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him: let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him. But thou art he that took me out of the womb: thou didst make me **hope** when I was upon my mother's breasts. I was cast upon thee from the womb: thou art my God from my mother's belly. Be not far from me; for trouble is near; for there is none to help... Psalm 22:3-11*

Ye that fear the LORD, praise him; all ye the seed of Jacob, glorify him; and fear him, all ye the seed of Israel. For he hath not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither hath he hid his face from him; but when he cried unto him, he heard. Psalm 22:23-24

*Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that **hope** in the LORD. Psalm 31:24*

*Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that **hope** in his mercy: To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield. For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy name. Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we **hope** in thee. Psalm 33:18-22*

*For in thee, O LORD, do I **hope**: thou wilt hear, O Lord my God. Psalm 38:15*

*And now, Lord, what wait I for? my **hope** is in thee. Psalm 39:7*

*Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted in me? **hope** thou in God: for I shall yet praise him for the help of his countenance. Psalm 42:5*

*O send out thy light and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles. Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy... Why art thou cast down, O my soul? And why art thou disquieted within me? **Hope** in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God. Psalm 43:3-5*

*For thou art my **hope**, O Lord GOD: thou art my trust from my youth... I will **hope** continually, and will yet praise thee more and more. Psalm 71:5, 14*

*He established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children: that the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children: That they might set their **hope** in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments: and might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation that set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not stedfast with God. Psalm 78:5-8*

*Take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have **hoped** in thy judgments. Psalm 119:43*

*Remember the word unto thy servant, upon which thou hast caused me to **hope**. Psalm 119:49*

*Thy hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn thy commandments. They that fear thee will be glad when they see me; because I have **hoped** in thy word. Psalm 119:73-74*

*My soul fainteth for thy salvation: but I **hope** in thy word... Psalm 119:81*

*Thou art my hiding place and my shield: I **hope** in thy word... Psalm 119:114*

*Uphold me according unto thy word, that I may live: and let me not be ashamed of my **hope**... Psalm 119:116*

*I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I **hoped** in thy word. Psalm 119:147*

*LORD, I have **hoped** for thy salvation, and done thy commandments Psalm 119:166*

*I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word **do I hope**... **Let Israel hope** in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption. And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. Psalm 130:5, 7-8*

*Let Israel **hope** in the LORD from henceforth and for ever. Psalm 131:3*

*Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose **hope** is in the LORD his God: which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keepeth truth for ever: Which executeth judgment for the oppressed: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners: The LORD openeth the eyes of the blind: the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down: the LORD loveth the righteous: The LORD preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down. The LORD shall reign forever, even thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD. Psalm 146:5-10*

*The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that **hope** in his mercy. Psalm 147:11*

*The **hope** of the righteous shall be gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish. Proverbs 10:28*

*When a wicked man dieth, his expectation shall perish: and the **hope** of unjust men perisheth. Proverbs 11:7*

***Hope** deferred maketh the heart sick: but when the desire cometh, it is a tree of life. Proverbs 13:12*

*The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous hath **hope** in his death. Proverbs 14:32*

*Chasten thy son while there is **hope**, and let not thy soul spare for his crying. Proverbs 19:18*

*Seest thou a man wise in his own conceit? there is more **hope** of a fool than of him. Proverbs 26:12*

*Seest thou a man that is hasty in his words? there is more **hope** of a fool than of him. Proverbs 29:20*

*For to him that is joined to all the living there is **hope**: for a living dog is better than a dead lion. Ecclesiastes 9:4*

*For the grave cannot praise thee, death can not celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot **hope** for thy truth. Isaiah 38:18*

*Thou art wearied in the greatness of thy way; yet saidst thou not, There is no **hope**: thou hast found the life of thine hand; therefore thou wast not grieved...For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart. I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners. Isaiah 57:10, 17-18*

*A wild ass used to the wilderness, that snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not weary themselves; in her month they shall find her. Withhold thy foot from being unshod, and thy throat from thirst: but thou saidst, There is no **hope**: no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go. As the thief is ashamed when he is found, so is the house of Israel ashamed; they, their kings, their princes, and their priests, and their prophets, Saying to a stock, Thou art my father; and to a stone, Thou hast brought me forth: for they have turned their back unto me, and not their face: but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise and save us. But where are thy gods that thou hast me thee? let them arise, if they can save thee in the time of thy trouble: for according to the number of thy cities are thy gods, O Judah. Jeremiah 2:24-28*

*Truly in vain is salvation **hoped** for from the hills, [high places for idol sacrifices] and from the multitude of mountains: truly in the LORD our God is the salvation of Israel. Jeremiah 3:23*

*O LORD, though our iniquities testify against us, do thou it for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against thee. **O hope of Israel**, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man that turneth aside to tarry for a night? ...Thou art in the midst of us, and we are called by thy name; leave us not. Jeremiah 14:7-9*

*Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose **hope** the LORD is. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh... Jeremiah 17:7*

*O LORD, **the hope of Israel**, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters. Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise. Jeremiah 17:13-14*

*Be not a terror unto me; thou art my **hope** in the day of evil. Let them be confounded that persecute me, but let not me be confounded: let them be dismayed, but let not me be dismayed: bring upon them the day of evil, and destroy them with double destruction. Jeremiah 17:17-18*

*Behold, I frame evil against you and devise a device against you: return ye now every one from his evil way, and make your ways and your doings good. And they said, There is no **hope**: but we will walk after our own devices, and we will every one do the imagination of his evil heart. Therefore thus saith the LORD; Ask ye now among the heathen, who hath heard such things: the virgin of Israel hath done a very horrible things. Jeremiah 18:11-13*

*Refrain thy voice from weeping, and thine eyes from tears: for thy work shall be rewarded, saith the LORD; and they shall come again from the land of the enemy. And there is **hope** in thine end, saith the LORD, that thy children shall come again to their own border. Jeremiah 31:16-17*

*In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek the LORD their God. They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant that shall not be forgotten. My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their resting place. All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, **the hope** of their fathers. Jeremiah 50:4-7*

*They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made others to **hope** that they would confirm the word. Ezekiel 13:6*

*My strength and my **hope** is perished from the LORD: Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me. This I recall to my mind, therefore have I **hope**. It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness. The LORD is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I **hope** in him. It is good that a man should both **hope** and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD. Lamentations 3:18-26*

*He putteth his mouth in the dust; if so be there may be **hope**. He giveth his cheek to him that smiteth him: he is filled full of reproach. For the Lord will not cast off for ever: But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies. For he doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men. To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth, To turn aside the right of a man before the face of the most High, To subvert a man in his cause, the Lord approveth not. Lamentations 3:29*

*Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our **hope** is lost: we are cut off for our parts. Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, O my people, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. And ye shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves, and shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the LORD have spoken it... Ezekiel 37:11-14*

*I will give her her vineyards from thence, and the valley of Achor for a door of **hope**: and she shall sing there, as in the days of her youth, and as in the day when she came up out of the land of Egypt. Hosea 2:15*

*The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD will be the **hope** of his people, and the strength of the children of Israel. Joel 3:16*

*By the blood of thy covenant I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit wherein is no water. Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of **hope**: even to day do I declare that I will render double unto thee; Zechariah 9:11-12*

*If ye lend to them of whom ye **hope** to receive, what thank have ye? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again. Luke 6:34*

*When Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding glad: for he was desirous to see him of a long season, because he had heard many things of him; and he **hoped** to have seen some miracle done by him. Luke 23:8*

*For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved. Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in **hope**; Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance. Acts 2:25-28*

*When Paul perceived that the one part were Sadducees, and the other Pharisees, he cried out in the council, Men and brethren, I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the **hope** and resurrection of the dead I am called in question. Acts 23:6*

*This I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets: and have **hope** toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust. And herein do I exercise myself to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men... Acts 24:14-16*

*He **hoped** also that money should have been given him of Paul, that he might loose him: wherefore he sent for him the oftener, and communed with him. Acts 24:26*

*My manner of life from my youth, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, know all the Jews; Which knew me from the beginning...And now I stand and am judged for the **hope** of the promise made of God unto our fathers: Unto which promise our twelve tribes, instantly serving God day and night, **hope** to come, For which **hope's** sake, king Agrippa, I am accused of the Jews. Why should it be thought a thing incredible with you, that God should raise the dead? Acts 26:6-8*

*When neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on us, all **hope** that we should be saved was then taken away. Acts 27:20*

*For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see you, and to speak with you: because that for the **hope** of Israel I am bound with this chain.*
Acts 28:20

*As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations...who against **hope** believed in **hope**, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be. And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sarah's womb.*
Romans 4:17-19

*Being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: by whom we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in **hope** of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulation also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; and patience, experience; and experience, **hope**: and **hope** maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would dare to die. But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.* *Romans 5:1-10*

*For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in **hope**, Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groaneth and travaileth in pain together until now. And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. For we are saved by **hope**: but **hope** that is seen is not **hope**: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet **hope** for? But if we **hope** for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it.* *Romans 8:20-25*

*Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love...Rejoicing in **hope**; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.* *Romans 12:10, 12-13*

*For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have **hope**. Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:4-6*

*Now the God of **hope** fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in **hope**, through the power of the Holy Ghost. Romans 15:13*

*He that ploweth should plow in **hope**; and that he that thresheth in **hope** should be partaker of his **hope**. 1 Corinthians 9:10*

*Charity...rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; beareth all things, believeth all things, **hopeth** all things, endureth all things...Now abideth faith, **hope**, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:6-7, 13*

*If Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins. Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished. If in this life only we have **hope** in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. 1 Corinthians 15:19*

*Seeing then that we have such **hope**, we use great plainness of speech: 2 Corinthians 3:12*

*For to their power, I bear record, yea, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves; Praying us with much entreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. And this they did, not as we **hoped**, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God. 2 Corinthians 8:3-5*

*For we stretch not ourselves beyond our measure, as though we reached not unto you: for we are come as far as to you also in preaching the gospel of Christ: Not boasting of things without our measure, that is, of other men's labours; but having **hope**, when your faith is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to our rule abundantly, To preach the gospel in the regions beyond you, and not to boast in another man's line of things made ready to our hand. But he that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord. 2 Corinthians 10:15*

*Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace. For we through the Spirit wait for the **hope** of righteousness by faith. Galatians 5:4-5*

*That the...Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the **hope** of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints... Ephesians 1:16-18*

*...In time past Gentiles in the flesh...that at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no **hope**, and without God in the world... Ephesians 2:11-12*

*...Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one **hope** of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:3-6*

*For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, According to my earnest expectation and my **hope**, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death. Philippians 1:19-20*

*We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you...For the **hope** which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel... Colossians 1:3, 5*

*Yet now hath he reconciled in the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight: If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the **hope** of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister; Colossians 1:21-23*

*Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the **hope** of glory: Colossians 1:26-27*

*Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of **hope** in our Lord Jseus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father; Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God. 1 Thessalonians 1:3*

*For what is our **hope**, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming? 1 Thessalonians 2:19*

*I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no **hope**. 1 Thessalonians 4:13*

*But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the **hope** of salvation. 1 Thessalonians 5:8*

*Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good **hope** through grace, Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17*

*Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our **hope**; Unto Timothy... 1 Timothy 1:1*

*Paul...According to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness...In **hope** of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began... Titus 1:1-2*

*We should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed **hope**, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ... Titus 2:12-13*

*According to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; that being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the **hope** of eternal life. Titus 3:5-7*

*Christ as a son over his own house; whose house we are, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the **hope** firm unto the end. Hebrews 3:6*

*We desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of **hope** unto the end: That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises. Hebrews 6:11-12*

God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the **hope** set before us: which **hope** we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil; whither the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. Hebrews 6:17-20

It is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth another priest, Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. For he testifieth, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec...For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better **hope** did; by the which we draw nigh unto God. Hebrews 7:15-19

Now faith is the substance of things **hoped** for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively **hope** by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you... 1 Peter 1:3-4

Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and **hope** to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; as obedient children... 1 Peter 1:13

For you...who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and **hope** might be in God. 1 Peter 1:20-21

Sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the **hope** that is in you with meekness and fear: 1 Peter 3:15

Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God...Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is. And every man that hath this **hope** purifieth himself, even as he is pure. 1 John 3:1-3

TRUST

*For the LORD shall judge his people, and repent himself for his servants, when he seeth that their power is gone, and there is none shut up, or left. And he shall say, Where are their gods, their rock in whom they **trusted**... Deuteronomy 32:36-37*

*Sihon **trusted** not Israel to pass through his coast; but Sihon gathered all his people together, and pitched in Jahaz, and fought against Israel. Judges 11:20*

*The LORD recompense thy work, and a full reward be given thee of the LORD God of Israel, under whose wings thou art come to **trust**. Ruth 2:12*

*The God of my rock; in him will I **trust**: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence. 2 Samuel 22:3*

*As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that **trust** in him. For who is God, save the LORD? And who is a rock, save our God? God is my strength and power: and he maketh my way perfect. 2 Samuel 22:31-33*

*He **trusted** in the LORD God of Israel; so that after him was none like him among all the kings of Judah, nor any that were before him. 2 Kings 18:5*

*Neither let Hezekiah make you **trust** in the LORD, saying, The LORD will surely deliver us, and this city shall not be delivered into the hand of the king of Assyria. 2 Kings 18:30 (Spoken by an enemy)*

For thou art my hope, O Lord GOD: thou art my **trust** from my youth. Psalms 71:1-5

*But it is good for me to draw near to God: I have put my **trust** in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all thy works. Psalms 73:28*

*I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I **trust**...He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou **trust**: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Psalm 91:2, 4*

*He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, **trusting** in the LORD. Psalm 112:7*

*They that make them are like unto them: so is every one that **trusteth** in them. O Israel, **trust** thou in the LORD: he is their hope and their shield. Behold, ye **trust** in lying words, that cannot profit. Will ye steal, murder, and commit adultery, and swear falsely, and burn incense unto Baal, and walk after other gods whom ye know not; And come and stand before me in this house, which is called by my name, and say, We are delivered to do all these abominations? ... Therefore will I do unto this house, which is called by my name, wherein ye **trust**, and unto the place which I gave to you and to your fathers, as I have done to Shiloh. Jeremiah 7:4-10, 14*

*If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses? And if in the land of peace, wherein thou **trustedst**, they wearied thee, then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan? Jeremiah 12:5*

*This is thy lot, the portion of thy measure from me, saith the LORD; because thou hast forgotten me, and **trusted** in falsehood. Jeremiah 13:25*

*Thus saith the LORD; Cursed be the man that **trusteth** in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD. *She obeyed not the voice; she received not correction; she **trusted** not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God. Zephaniah 3:2*

*I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall **trust** in the name of the LORD. Zephaniah 3:12*

*Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles...And in his name shall the Gentiles **trust**. Matthew 12:18, 21*

*He **trusted** in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the Son of God. Matthew 27:43*

*Whensoever I take my journey into Spain, I will come to you: for I **trust** to see you in my journey, and to be brought on my way thitherward by you, if first I be somewhat filled with your company. Romans 15:24*

*For I will not see you now by the way; but I **trust** to tarry a while with you, if the Lord permit. 1 Corinthians 16:7*

And such **trust** have we through Christ to God-ward: Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God... 2 Corinthians 3:2-5*

*Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I **trust** also are made manifest in your consciences. 2 Corinthians 5:11*

*Do ye look on things after the outward appearance? If any man **trust** to himself that he is Christ's, let him of himself think this again, that, as he is Christ's, even so are we Christ's. 2 Corinthians 10:7*

*I **trust** that ye shall know that we are not reprobates. 2 Corinthians 13:6*

*That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first **trusted** in Christ. In whom ye also **trusted**, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Ephesians 1:12-13*

*But I **trust** in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state...But I **trust** in the LORD that I also myself shall come shortly. Philippians 2:19, 24*

*Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might **trust** in the flesh, I more: Philippians 3:4*

*But as we were allowed of God to be put in **trust** with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which trieth the hearts. 1 Thessalonians 2:4*

*We know that the law is good, if a man use it lawfully...According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my **trust**. And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry... 1 Timothy 1:11-12*

*For therefore we both labour and suffer reproach, because we **trust** in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe. 1 Timothy 4:10*

*Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, **trusteth** in God, and continueth in supplications and prayers night and day. 1 Timothy 5:5*

*Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor **trust** in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy. That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life. O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy **trust**, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee. Amen. 1 Timothy 6:17-21*

*Prepare me also a lodging: for I **trust** that through your prayers I shall be given to you. Philemon 1:22*

*...I will declare thy name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto thee. And again, I will put my **trust** in him. And again, Behold, I and the children which God hath given me. Hebrews 2:12-13*

*Pray for us: for we **trust** we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. Hebrews 13:18*

*For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who **trusted** in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: 1 Peter 3:5*

*Having many things to write unto you, I would not write with paper and ink: but I **trust** to come unto you, and speak face to face, that our joy may be full. 2 John 1:12*

*I **trust** I shall shortly see thee, and we shall speak face to face. Peace be to thee. Our friends salute thee. Greet the friends by name. 3 John 1:14*

OBEY

*Now therefore, my son, **obey** my voice according to that which I command thee. Genesis 27:8*

*And his mother said unto him, Upon me be thy curse, my son: only **obey** my voice, and go fetch me them. Genesis 27:13*

*Now therefore, my son, **obey** my voice; and arise, flee thou to Laban my brother to Haran; Genesis 27:43*

*In thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast **obeyed** my voice. Genesis 22:18*

*Because that Abraham **obeyed** my voice, and kept my charge, my commandments, my statutes, and my laws. Genesis 26:5*

*Jacob **obeyed** his father and his mother, and was gone to Padan-aram. Genesis 28:7*

*And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should **obey** his voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go. Exodus 5:2*

*Now therefore, if ye will **obey** my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine. Exodus 19:5*

*Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and **obey** his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him. But if thou shalt indeed **obey** his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. Exodus 23:20-22*

*And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be **obedient**. And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the Covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words. Exodus 24:7-8*

*Thou shalt put some of thine honour upon him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be **obedient**. Numbers 27:20*

*If from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul. When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days, if thou turn to the LORD thy God, and shalt be **obedient** unto his voice; (For the LORD thy God is a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he sware unto them. Deuteronomy 4:29-31*

*As the nations which the LORD destroyeth before your face, so shall ye perish; because ye would not be **obedient** unto the voice of the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 8:20*

*Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; A blessing, if ye **obey** the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day: And a curse, if ye will not **obey** the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known. Deuteronomy 11:26-28*

*Ye shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear him, and keep his commandments, and **obey** his voice, and ye shall serve him, and cleave unto him. Deuteronomy 13:4*

*If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not **obey** the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and that, when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them: Then shall his father and his mother lay hold on him, and bring him out unto the elders of his city, and unto the gate of his place; and they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son is stubborn and rebellious, he will not **obey** our voice; he is a glutton, and a drunkard. And all the men of his city shall stone him with stones, that he die: so shalt thou put evil away from among you; and all Israel shall hear, and fear. Deuteronomy 21:18-21*

*Thou shalt therefore **obey** the voice of the LORD thy God, and do his commandments and his statutes, which I command thee this day. Deuteronomy 27:10*

*Ye shall be left few in number, whereas ye were as the stars of heaven for multitude; because thou wouldest not **obey** the voice of the LORD thy God. Deuteronomy 28:62*

*And shalt return unto the LORD thy God, and shalt **obey** his voice according to all that I command thee this day, thou and thy children, with all thine heart, and with all thy soul; Deuteronomy 30:2*

*The LORD thy God will put all these curses upon thine enemies, and on them that hate thee, which persecuted thee. And thou shalt return and **obey** the voice of the LORD, and do all his commandments which I command thee this day. Deuteronomy 30:7-8*

*That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, and that thou mayest **obey** his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy life, and the length of thy days: that thou mayest dwell in the land which the LORD swore unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them. Deuteronomy 30:20*

*For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people that were men of war, which came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD: unto whom the LORD swore that he would not shew them the land, which the LORD swore unto their fathers that he would give us, a land that floweth with milk and honey. Joshua 5:6*

*And said unto them, Ye have kept all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, and have **obeyed** my voice in all that I commanded you: Joshua 22:2*

*The people said unto Joshua, The LORD our God will we serve, and his voice will we **obey**. Joshua 24:24*

*Ye shall make no league with the inhabitants of this land; ye shall throw down their altars: but ye have not **obeyed** my voice: why have ye done this? Judges 2:2*

*Yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, **obeying** the commandments of the LORD; but they did not so. Judges 2:17*

*I said unto you, I am the LORD your God; fear not the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but ye have not **obeyed** my voice. Judges 6:10*

*If ye will fear the LORD, and serve him, and **obey** his voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both ye and also the king that reigneth over you continue following the LORD your God: But if ye will not **obey** the voice of the LORD, but rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall the hand of the LORD be against you, as it was against your fathers. 1 Samuel 12:14-15*

*Nevertheless the people refused to **obey** the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us; 1 Samuel 8:19*

*Wherefore then didst thou not **obey** the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD? And Saul said unto Samuel, Yea, I have **obeyed** the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amelekites. 1 Samuel 15:19-20*

*Samuel said, Hath the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in **obeying** the voice of the LORD? Behold, to **obey** is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. 1 Samuel 15:22*

*Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and **obeyed** their voice. 1 Samuel 15:24*

*Because thou **obeyedst** not the voice of the LORD, nor executedst his fierce wrath upon Amalek, therefore hath the LORD done this thing unto thee this day... The woman came unto Saul, and saw that he was sore troubled, and said unto him, Behold, thine handmaid hath **obeyed** thy voice, and I have put my life in my hand, and have hearkened unto thy words which thou spakest unto me. 1 Samuel 28:18, 21 (obeyed Saul to do evil)*

*Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be **obedient** unto me. 2 Samuel 22:45*

*Because they **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD their God, but transgressed his covenant, and all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded, and would not hear them, nor do them. 2 Kings 18:12*

*Thus saith the LORD, Ye shall not go up, nor fight against your brethren: return every man to his house: for this thing is done of me. And they **obeyed** the words of the LORD, and returned from going against Jeroboam. 2 Chronicles 11:4*

*Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel **obeyed** him. 1 Chronicles 29:23*

*Then said he unto him, Because thou hast not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD, behold, as soon as thou art departed from me, a lion shall slay thee. And as soon as he was departed from him, a lion found him, and slew him. 1 Kings 20:36*

*But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments, And refused to **obey**, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou art a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not. Nehemiah 9:17*

*If they **obey** and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures. But if they **obey** not, they shall perish by the sword, and they shall die without knowledge. Job 36:11-12*

*As soon as they hear of me, they shall **obey** me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me. Psalm 18:44*

*How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof; And have not **obeyed** the voice of my teachers, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me! I was almost in all evil in the midst of the congregation and assembly. Proverbs 5:12-14*

*As an earring of gold, and an ornament of fine gold, so is a wise reprovener upon an **obedient** ear. Proverbs 25:12*

*The eye that mocketh at his father, and despiseth to **obey** his mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it. Proverbs 30:17*

*If ye be willing and **obedient**, ye shall eat the good of the land: but if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it. Isaiah 1:19-20*

*They shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall **obey** them. Isaiah 11:14*

*Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? Did not the LORD, he against whom we have sinned? For they would not walk in his ways, neither were they **obedient** unto his law. Isaiah 42:24*

*Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that **obeyeth** the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? Let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. Isaiah 50:10*

*Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not **obeyed** my voice, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 3:13*

*We lie down in our shame, and our confusion covereth us: for we have sinned against the LORD our God, we and our fathers, from our youth even unto this day, and have not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD our God. Jeremiah 3:25*

*But this thing commanded I them, saying, **Obey** my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: and walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you. Jeremiah 7:23*

*Therefore thou shalt speak all these words unto them; but they will not hearken to thee: thou shalt also call unto them; but they will not answer thee. But thou shalt say unto them, this is a nation that **obeyeth** not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receiveth correction: truth is perished, and is cut off from their mouth. Jeremiah 7:27-128*

*The LORD saith, Because they have forsaken my law which I set before them, and have not **obeyed** my voice, neither walked therein; But have walked after the imagination of their own heart, and after Baalim, which their fathers taught them: Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will feed them, even this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink. Jeremiah 9:13-15*

*Say thou unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel; Cursed be the man that **obeyeth** not the words of this covenant. Which I commanded your fathers in the day that I brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, from the iron furnace, saying, **Obey** my voice, and do them, according to all which I command you: so shall ye be my people, and I will be your God: Jeremiah 11:3-4*

*For I earnestly protested unto your fathers in the day that I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, even unto this day, rising early and protesting, saying, **obey** my voice Yet they **obeyed** not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not. Jeremiah 11:7-8*

*But if they will not **obey**, I will utterly pluck up and destroy that nation, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 12:17*

*But they **obeyed** not, neither inclined their ear, but made their neck stiff, that they might not hear, nor receive instruction. Jeremiah 17:23*

*Concerning a nation...If it do evil in my sight, that it **obey** not my voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them. Jeremiah 18:10*

*I spake unto thee in thy prosperity; but thou saidst, I will not hear. This hath been thy manner from thy youth, that thou **obeyedst** not my voice. Jeremiah 22:21*

*Therefore now amend your ways and your doings, and **obey** the voice of the LORD your God; and the LORD will repent him of the evil that he hath pronounced against you. Jeremiah 26:13*

*And they came in, and possessed it; but they **obeyed** not thy voice, neither walked in thy law; they have done nothing of all that thou commandedst them to do: therefore thou hast caused all this evil to come upon them: Jeremiah 32:23*

*Now when all the princes, and all the people, which had entered into the covenant, heard that every one should let his manservant, and every one his maidservant, go free, that none should serve themselves of them any more, then they **obeyed**, and let them go. Jeremiah 34:10*

*Thus have we **obeyed** the voice of Jonadab the son of Rechab our father in all that he hath charged us, to drink no wine all our days, we, our wives, our sons, nor our daughters; Jeremiah 35:8*

*But we have dwelt in tents, and have **obeyed**, and done according to all that Jonadab our father commanded us. But it came to pass, when Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon came up into the land, that we said, Come, and let us go to Jerusalem for fear of the army... Jeremiah 35:10-11*

*And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have **obeyed** the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you: Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Jonadab the son of Rechab shall not want a man to stand before me for ever. Jeremiah 35:10, 18-19*

*Will ye not receive instruction to hearken to my words? saith the LORD. The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons not to drink wine, are performed; for unto this day they drink none, but **obey** their father's commandment: notwithstanding I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye hearkened not unto me. Jeremiah 35:13-14*

*But Jeremiah said, They shall not deliver thee. **Obey**, I beseech thee, the voice of the LORD, which I speak unto thee: so it shall be well unto thee, and thy soul shall live. Jeremiah 38:20*

*Now the LORD hath brought it, and done according as he hath said: because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not **obeyed** his voice, therefore this thing is come upon you. Jeremiah 40:3*

*Whether it be good, or whether it be evil, we will **obey** the voice of the LORD our God, to whom we send thee; that it may be well with us, when we **obey** the voice of the LORD our God. Jeremiah 42:6*

*But if ye say, We will not dwell in this land, neither **obey** the voice of the LORD your God, Saying, No; but we will go into the land of Egypt, where we shall see no war...it shall come to pass, that the sword, which ye feared shall overtake you... Jeremiah 42:13-15*

*And now I have this day declared it to you; but ye have not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD your God, nor any thing for the which he hath sent me unto you. Jeremiah 42:21*

*So Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, and all the people, **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD, to dwell in the land of Judah... So they came into the land of Egypt: for they **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD: thus came they even to Tahpanhes. Jeremiah 43:4, 7*

*Because ye have burned incense, and because ye have sinned against the LORD, and have not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD, nor walked in his law, nor in his statutes, nor in his testimonies, therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day. Jeremiah 44:23*

*And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and **obey** him. Daniel 7:27*

*Neither have we **obeyed** the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets. Yea, all Israel have transgressed thy law, even by departing, that they might not **obey** thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against him. Daniel 9:10-11*

*Therefore hath the LORD watched upon the evil, and brought it upon us: for the LORD our God is righteous in all his works which he doeth: for we **obeyed** not his voice. Daniel 9:14*

*She **obeyed** not the voice; she received not correction; she trusted not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God. Zephaniah 3:2*

*And they that are far off shall come and build in the temple of the LORD, and ye shall know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you. And this shall come to pass, if ye will diligently **obey** the voice of the LORD your God. Zechariah 6:15*

*Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, **obeyed** the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him, and the people did fear before the LORD. Haggai 1:12*

NEW COVENANT OBEDIENCE

*But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea **obey** him? Matthew 8:27*

*They were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? What new doctrine is this? For with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits, and they do **obey** him. ... They feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea **obey** him? Mark 1:27, 4:41*

*He said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this? For he commandeth even the winds and the water, and they **obey** him. Luke 8:25*

*The Lord said, if ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should **obey** you. Luke 17:6*

*Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to **obey** God rather than men. The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. Him hath God exalted with his righthand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. And we are his witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that **obey** him. Acts 5:29-32*

*For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many as **obeyed** him, were scattered, and brought to nought. After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, even as many as **obeyed** him, were dispersed. Acts 5:36-37*

*And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of priests were **obedient** to the faith. Acts 6:7*

*This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us: To whom our fathers would not **obey**, but thrust him from them, and in their hearts turned back again into Egypt, Saying unto Aaron, Make us gods... Acts 7:38-40*

Concerning his Son Jesus Christ...By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for **obedience** to the faith among all nations, for his name: Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ: Romans 1:3, 5-6

Unto them that are contentious, and do not **obey** the truth, but **obey** unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; Romans 2:8-9

For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ hath not wrought by me, to make the Gentiles **obedient**, by word and deed, For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the **obedience** of one shall many be made righteous. Romans 5:18-19

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should **obey** it in the lusts thereof. Romans 6:12

Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to **obey**, his servants ye are to whom ye **obey**; whether of sin unto death, or of **obedience** unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have **obeyed** from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Romans 6:16-17

How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! But they have not all **obeyed** the gospel. For Esaias saith, Lord, who hath believed our report? Romans 10:15-16

For your **obedience** is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil. Romans 16:19

Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began, But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the **obedience** of faith: To God only wise, be glory through Jesus Christ for ever. Amen. Romans 16:25-27

Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under **obedience**, as also saith the law. 1 Corinthians 14:34

*For to this end also did I write, that I might know the proof of you, whether ye be **obedient** in all things. 2 Corinthians 2:9*

*And his inward affection is more abundant toward you, whilst he remembereth the **obedience** of you all, how with fear and trembling ye received him. 2 Corinthians 7:15*

*Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the **obedience** of Christ; And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your **obedience** is fulfilled. 2 Corinthians 10:5-6*

*O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not **obey** the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? Galatians 3:1*

*Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not **obey** the truth? Galatians 5:7*

*Children, **obey** your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Ephesians 6:1*

*Servants, be **obedient** to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; Ephesians 6:5*

*And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became **obedient** unto death, even the death of the cross. Philippians 2:8*

*Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always **obeyed**, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. Philippians 2:12*

*Children, **obey** your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord. Colossians 3:20*

*Servants, **obey** in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God: Colossians 3:22*

*You who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that **obey** not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power... 2 Thes 1:7-9*

*If any man **obey** not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed. 2 Thessalonians 3:14*

*Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to **obey** magistrates, to be ready to every good work, to speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. Titus 3:1-2*

*The aged women...may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, **obedient** to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. Titus 2:3-5*

*Exhort servants to be **obedient** unto their own masters, and to please them well in all things, not answering again; Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God... Titus 2:9-10*

*Having confidence in thy **obedience** I wrote unto thee, knowing that thou wilt also do more than I say. Philemon 1:21*

*Though he were a Son, yet learned he **obedience** by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that **obey** him; Called of God an high priest after the order of Melchisedec. Hebrews 5:8-10*

*By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, **obeyed**; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. Hebrews 11:8*

***Obey** them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves; for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you. Hebrews 13:17*

*Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may **obey** us; and we turn about their whole body. James 3:3*

*Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto **obedience** and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. 1 Peter 1:2*

*As **obedient** children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation; Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy. 1 Peter 1:14-16*

*Seeing ye have purified your souls in **obeying** the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever. 1 Peter 1:22-23*

*Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any **obey** not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; 1 Peter 3:1*

*For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God; and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that **obey** not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator. 1 Peter 4:17-19*

DISOBEDIENCE

*He cried unto the man of God that came from Judah, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Forasmuch as thou hast **disobeyed** the mouth of the LORD, and hast not kept the commandment which the LORD thy God commanded thee, But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place of the which the LORD did say to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers. 1 Kings 13:20-21*

*When the prophet that brought him back from the way heard thereof, he said, It is the man of God, who was **disobedient** unto the word of the LORD: therefore the LORD hath delivered him unto the lion, which hath torn him, and slain him, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake unto him. 1 Kings 13:26*

*Nevertheless they were **disobedient**, and rebelled against thee, and cast thy law behind their backs, and slew thy prophets which testified against them to turn them to thee, and they wrought great provocations. Nehemiah 9:26*

*He shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the **disobedient** to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:17*

Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not **disobedient** unto the heavenly vision: Acts 26:19

Even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, **disobedient** to parents, without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28-32

For as by one man's **disobedience** many were made sinners, so by the **obedience** of one shall many be made righteous. Romans 5:19

Esaias is very bold, and saith, I was found of them that sought me not; I was made manifest unto them that asked not after me. But to Israel he saith, All day long I have stretched forth my hands unto a **disobedient** and gainsaying people. Romans 10:20-21

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the **obedience** of Christ; and having in a readiness to revenge all **disobedience**, when your **obedience** is fulfilled. 2 Corinthians 10:3-6

Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of **disobedience**: Ephesians 2:2

Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of **disobedience**. Ephesians 5:6

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth: fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of **disobedience**... Colossians 3:5-6

*Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and **disobedient**, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine: According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust. 1 Timothy 1:9-11*

*This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, **disobedient** to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 2 Timothy 3:1-5*

*Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being abominable, and **disobedient**, and unto every good work reprobate. Titus 1:15-16*

*For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, **disobedient**, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. Titus 3:3*

*For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and **disobedience** received a just recompence of reward; How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him; God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to his own will? Hebrews 2:2-4*

*Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be **disobedient**, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, and a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being **disobedient**: whereunto also they were appointed. 1 Peter 2:7-8*

*For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: by which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Which sometime were **disobedient**, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. 1 Peter 3:18-20*
