HUMILITY

*And Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, How long wilt thou refuse to **humble** thyself before me? Let my people go, that they may serve me. Exodus 10:3*

*And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be **humbled**, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob... Leviticus 26:41-42*

*And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to **humble** thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no. And he **humbled** thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live. Deuteronomy 8:2-3*

*Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might **humble** thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end; Deuteronomy 8:16*

*Seest thou how Ahab **humbleth** himself before me? Because he **humbleth** himself before me, I will not bring the evil in his days: but in his son's days will I bring the evil upon his house. 1 Kings 21:29*

*Because thine heart was tender, and thou hast **humbled** thyself before the LORD, when thou heardest what I spake against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and hast rent thy clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard thee, saith the LORD. 2 Kings 22:19*

*If my people, which are called by my name, shall **humble** themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14*

*Whereupon the princes of Israel and the king **humbled** themselves; and they said, The LORD is righteous. 2 Chronicles 12:6*

*And when the LORD saw that they **humbled** themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, They have **humbled** themselves; therefore I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some deliverance; and my wrath shall not be poured out upon Jerusalem by the hand of Shishak...And when he **humbled** himself, the wrath of the LORD turned from him, that he would not destroy him altogether: and also in Judah things went well. 2 Chronicles 12:7, 12*

*Nevertheless divers of Asher and Manasseh and of Zebulun **humbled** themselves, and came to Jerusalem. 2 Chronicles 30:11*

*Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit done unto him; for his heart was lifted up: therefore there was wrath upon him, and upon Judah and Jerusalem. Notwithstanding Hezekiah **humbled** himself for the pride of his heart, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah. 2 Chronicles 32:25-26*

*And when he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and **humbled** himself greatly before the God of his fathers... 2 Chronicles 32:26*

*Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his prayer unto his God, and the words of the seers that spake to him in the name of the LORD God of Israel, behold, they are written in the book of the kings of Israel. His prayer also, and how God was intreated of him, and all his sin, and his trespass, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was **humbled**: behold, they are written among the sayings of the seers. 2 Chronicles 33:18-19*

*Amon...did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, as did Manasseh his father: for Amon sacrificed unto all the carved images which Manasseh his father had made, and served them; and **humbled** not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had **humbled** himself; but Amon trespassed more and more. And his servants conspired against him, and slew him in his own house. 2 Chronicles 33:21-24*

*Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst **humble** thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and **humbledst** thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard thee also, saith the LORD. 2 Chronicles 34:27*

*Zedekiah...did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD his God, and **humbled** not himself before Jeremiah the prophet speaking from the mouth of the LORD. 2 Chronicles 36:11-12*

*When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save the **humble** person. Job 22:29*

*Sing praises to the LORD, which dwelleth in Zion: declare among the people his doings. When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the **humble**. Psalm 9:11-12*

*He croucheth, and [falsely]**humbleth** himself, that the poor may fall by his strong ones. He hath said in his heart, God hath forgotten: he hideth his face; he will never see it. Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hands: forget not the **humble**...LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the **humble**: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear: to judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress. Psalm 10:10-12, 17-18*

*My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the **humble** shall hear thereof, and be glad. Psalms 34:2*

*But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth: I **humbled** my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom. Psalms 35:13*

*I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving...The **humble** shall hear this, and be glad: and your heart shall live that seek God. Psalms 69:30, 32*

*The LORD is high above all nations, and his glory above the heavens. Who is like unto the LORD our God, who dwelleth on high, Who **humbleth** himself to behold the things that are in heaven, and in earth! Psalm 113:4-6*

*Thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth. Do this now, my son, and deliver thyself, when thou art come into the hand of thy friend; go, **humble** thyself, and make sure thy friend. Give not sleep to thine eyes, nor slumber to thine eyelids. Proverbs 6:2-4*

*The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom; and before honour is **humility**. Proverbs 15:33*

*Better it is to be of an **humble** spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud. Proverbs 16:19*

*Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, and before honour is **humility**. Proverbs 18:12*

*By **humility** and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honour, and life. Proverbs 22:4*

*A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the **humble** in spirit. Proverbs 29:23*

*Their land also is full of idols; they worship the work of their own hands, that which their own fingers have made. And the mean man boweth down, and the great man **humbleth** himself [to an idol]: therefore forgive them not... The lofty looks of man shall be **humbled**, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. Isaiah 2:8-9, 11*

*And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty men shall be **humbled**, and the eyes of the lofty shall be **humbled**: Isaiah 5:15*

*Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the haughty shall be **humbled**. Isaiah 10:33*

*For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and **humble** spirit, to revive the spirit of the **humble**, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls which I have made. For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart. I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners. Isaiah 57:15-18*

*Say unto the king and to the queen, **Humble** yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, even the crown of your glory. Jeremiah 13:18*

*They are not **humbled** even unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in my law, nor in my statutes, that I set before you and before your fathers. Jeremiah 44:10*

*And I said, My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD: Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is **humbled** in me. This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness. Lamentations 3:18-23*

*O thou king, the most high God gave Nebuchadnezzar thy father a kingdom, and majesty, and glory, and honour: And for the majesty that he gave him, all people, nations, and languages, trembled and feared before him...But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him: And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling was with the wild asses...And thou his son, O Belshazzar, hast not **humbled** thine heart, though thou knewest all this; Daniel 5:18-22*

HUMILITY IN NEW COVENANT

*Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them, And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall **humble** himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 18:2-4*

*But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, even Christ; and all ye are brethren. And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven. Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, even Christ. But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant. And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall **humble** himself shall be exalted. Matthew 23:8-12*

*When thou art bidden of any man to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honourable man than thou be bidden of him; And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room. But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee. For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that **humbleth** himself shall be exalted. Luke 14:8-11*

*Two men went up to the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank thee, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that **humbleth** himself shall be exalted. Luke 18:10-14*

*He said unto them, Ye know, from the first day that I came into Asia, after what manner I have been with you at all seasons, Serving the Lord with all **humility** of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews: And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house. Acts 20:18-20*

*For I fear, lest, when I come, I shall not find...there be debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults: And lest, when I come again, my God will **humble** me among you, and that I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed. 2 Corinthians 12:20-21*

*Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he **humbled** himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name... Philipians 2:5-9*

*And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words... Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary **humility** and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, and not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God. Colossians 2:4, 18-19*

*Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, (Touch not; taste not; handle not; Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men? Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and **humility**, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh. Colossians 2:20-23*

*Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the **humble**...Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. **Humble** yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. James 4:5-6, 8-10*

*Ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with **humility**: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the **humble**. **Humble** yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time. 1 Peter 5:5-6*

ENDURANCE

*Let my lord, I pray thee, pass over before his servant: and I will lead on softly, according as the cattle that goeth before me and the children be able to **endure**, until I come unto my lord unto Seir. Genesis 33:14*

*If thou shalt do this thing, and God command thee so, then thou shalt be able to **endure**, and all this people shall also go to their place in peace. Exodus 18:23*

*O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy **endureth** for ever... And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because his mercy **endureth** for ever... 1 Chronicles 16:34, 41*

*It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy **endureth** for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the cloud of the house of the LORD; 2 Chronicles 5:13*

*And when all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy **endureth** for ever. ... And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of musick of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because his mercy **endureth** for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded the trumpets before them, and all Israel stood. 2 Chronicles 7:3, 6*

*When he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy **endureth** for ever. 2 Chronicles 20:21*

*They sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy **endureth** for ever toward Israel. And the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. Ezra 3:11*

*For how can I **endure** to see the evil that shall come unto my people?
Or how can I **endure** to see the destruction of my kindred? Esther 8:6*

*He shall lean upon his house, but it shall not stand: he shall hold it fast,
but it shall not **endure**. Job 8:15*

*If I have lifted up my hand against the fatherless, when I saw my help in
the gate: Then let mine arm fall from my shoulder blade, and mine arm be
broken from the bone. For destruction from God was a terror to me, and by
reason of his highness I could not **endure**. Job 31:23*

*O thou enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and thou hast
destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them. But the LORD
shall **endure** for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment. And he
shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the
people in uprightness. The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a
refuge in times of trouble. And they that know thy name will put their
trust in thee: for thou, LORD, hast not forsaken them that seek thee.
Psalm 9:6-10*

*The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul...The fear of the
LORD is clean, **enduring** for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true
and righteous altogether. Psalm 19:7, 9*

*Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the
remembrance of his holiness. For his anger **endureth** but a moment; in
his favour is life: weeping may **endure** for a night, but joy cometh in the
morning. Psalm 30:4-5*

*Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? The goodness of
God **endureth** continually. Psalm 52:1*

*He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the
needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. They shall fear thee as long
as the sun and moon **endure**, throughout all generations...In his days
shall the righteous flourish; and the abundance of peace so long as the
moon **endureth**. Psalm 72:4-5, 7*

*His name shall **endure** for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the
sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed.
Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous
things. Psalm 72:17*

*The haters of the LORD should have submitted themselves unto him; but their time should have **endured** for ever. Psalm 81:15*

*My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to **endure** for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven...His seed shall **endure** for ever, and his throne as the sun before me. Psalm 89:28-29, 36*

*For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth **endureth** to all generations. Psalm 100:5*

*My days are like a shadow that declineth; and I am withered like grass. But thou, O LORD, shalt **endure** for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations...They shall perish, but thou shalt **endure**: yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed: Psalm 102:11-12, 26*

*Praise ye the LORD. O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy **endureth** for ever...O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. Psalm 106:1, 107:1*

*His work is honourable and glorious: and his righteousness **endureth** for ever...The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise **endureth** for ever. Psalm 111:3, 10*

*Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness **endureth** for ever...He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness **endureth** for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour. Psalm 112:3, 9*

*O Praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people. For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD **endureth** for ever. Praise ye the LORD. Psalm 117:1-2*

*O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: because his mercy **endureth** for ever. Let Israel now say, that his mercy **endureth** for ever. Let the house of Aaron now say, that his mercy **endureth** for ever. Let them now that fear the LORD say, that his mercy **endureth** for ever. Psalm 118:1-4*

*O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. Psalm 118:29*

*Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments **endureth** for ever. Psalm 119:160*

*Thy name, O LORD, **endureth** for ever; and thy memorial, O LORD, throughout all generations. Psalm 135:13*

*O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. O give thanks unto the God of gods: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. O give thanks to the Lord of lords: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him who alone doeth great wonders: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him that by wisdom made the heavens: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him that stretched out the earth above the waters: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him that made great lights: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: The sun to rule by day: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: The moon and stars to rule by night: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him that smote Egypt in their firstborn: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: And brought out Israel from among them: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: With a strong hand, and with a stretched out arm: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him which divided the Red sea into parts: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. And made Israel to pass through the midst of it: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea; for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him which led his people through the wilderness: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. To him which smote great kings: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: And slew famous kings: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: Sihon king of the Amorites: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: And Og the king of Bashan: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: And gave their land for an heritage: for his mercy **endureth** for ever: Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. Who remembered us in our low estate: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. And hath redeemed us from our enemies: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. Who giveth food to all flesh: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. O give thanks unto the God of heaven: for his mercy **endureth** for ever. Psalm 136:1-26*

*Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies... The LORD will perfect that which concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, **endureth** for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands. Psalm 138:7-8*

*Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion **endureth** throughout all generations. Psalm 145:13*

*Be thou diligent to know the state of thy flocks, and look well to thy herds. For riches are not for ever: and doth the crown **endure** to every generation? Proverbs 27:23-24*

*Again there shall be heard in this place... The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: for the LORD is good; for his mercy **endureth** for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 33:10-11*

*Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee. Can thine heart **endure**, or can thine hands be strong, in the days that I shall deal with thee? I the LORD have spoken it, and will do it. Ezekiel 22:13-14*

*Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves. But beware of men... And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that **endureth** to the end shall be saved. Matthew 10:16, 22*

*And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall **endure** unto the end, the same shall be saved. And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. Matthew 24:11-14*

*These are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; And have no root in themselves, and so **endure** but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake, immediately they are offended. Mark 4:16-17*

*Now the brother shall betray the brother to death, and the father the son; and children shall rise up against their parents, and shall cause them to be put to death. And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall **endure** unto the end, the same shall be saved. Mark 13:12-13*

*Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which **endureth** unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed. John 6:27*

*What if God, willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, **endured** with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: Romans 9:22*

*Though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profiteth me nothing. Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth. Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, **endureth** all things. 1 Corinthians 13:3-7*

*And whether we be afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effectual in the **enduring** of the same sufferings which we also suffer; or whether we be comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. 2 Corinthians 1:6*

*So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye **endure**: Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also suffer: Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; 2 Thessalonians 1:4-9*

*Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. Thou therefore **endure** hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully. 2 Timothy 2:3*

*Therefore I **endure** all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: 2 Timothy 2:10-12*

*Thou hast fully known my...patience, persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I **endured**: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. 2 Timothy 3:11*

*Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not **endure** sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But watch thou in all things, **endure** afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of thy ministry. 2 Timothy 4:2-5*

*Be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises...So, after he had patiently **endured**, he obtained the promise. Hebrews 6:12, 15*

*For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after ye were illuminated, ye **endured** a great fight of afflictions; Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used. For ye had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that ye have in heaven a better and an **enduring** substance. Hebrews 10:30-32*

*By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he **endured**, as seeing him who is invisible. Hebrews 11:27*

*Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him **endured** the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider him that **endured** such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds. Hebrews 12:3*

*My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him: For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. If ye **endure** chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. Hebrews 12:5-8*

*For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest, and the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which voice they that heard intreated that the word should not be spoken to them anymore: (For they could not **endure** that which was commanded, And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned, or thrust through with a dart: and so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, I exceedingly fear and quake:) Hebrews 12:18-21*

*Blessed is the man that **endureth** temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. James 1:12*

*Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door. Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience. Behold, we count them happy which **endure**. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy. James 5:9-11*

*Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: But the word of the Lord **endureth** for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you. 1 Peter 1:23-25*

*Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God **endure** grief, suffering wrongfully. For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God. 1 Peter 2:18-19*

LONGSUFFERING

*And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, **longsuffering**, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:6*

*And now, I beseech thee, let the power of my Lord be great, according as thou hast spoken, saying, The LORD is **longsuffering**, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. And the LORD said, I have pardoned according to thy word: But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the LORD. Because all those men which have seen my glory, and my miracles, which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have tempted me now these ten times, and have not hearkened to my voice; Surely they shall not see the land which I swear unto their fathers, neither shall any of them that provoked me see it... Numbers 14:17-23*

*O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them. But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, **longsuffering**, and plenteous in mercy and truth. O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give thy strength unto thy servant, and save the son of thine handmaid. Shew me a token for good; that they which hate me may see it, and be ashamed: because thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me. Psalm 86:14-17*

*O LORD, thou knowest: remember me, and visit me, and revenge me of my persecutors; take me not away in thy **longsuffering**: know that for thy sake I have suffered rebuke. Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart. For I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts. I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou hast filled me with indignation. Why is my pain perpetual, and my wound incurable, which refuseth to be healed?... Jeremiah 15:15-18*

*And thinkest thou this, O man, that judgest them which do such things, and doest the same, that thou shalt escape the judgment of God? Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and **longsuffering**; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God; Who will render to every man according to his deeds: To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish... Romans 2:3-9*

*Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour? What if God willing to shew his wrath, and to make his power known, endured with much **longsuffering** the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: And that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory. Even us, whom he hath called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles? Romans 9:21-24*

*In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings; by pureness, by knowledge, by **longsuffering**, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned, by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, by honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet true; as unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed; as sorrowful, yet alway rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. 2 Corinthians 6:4-10*

*Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, revellings, and such like...they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, **longsuffering**, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh*

*Walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with **longsuffering**, forbearing one another in love; endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:1-3*

*We also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might according to his glorious power, unto all patience and **longsuffering** with joyfulness... Colossians 1:9-11*

*Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, **longsuffering**; Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. Colossians 3:12-14*

*For this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all **longsuffering**, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:16*

*For their folly shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was. But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, **longsuffering**, charity, patience, persecutions, afflictions... 2 Timothy 3:10*

*Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all **longsuffering** and doctrine. 2 Timothy 4:2*

*By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison...which sometime were disobedient, when once the **longsuffering** of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is eight souls were saved by water. 1 Peter 3:19-20*

*The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is **longsuffering** to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance...and account that the **longsuffering** of our Lord is salvation; even as our brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you... 2 Peter 3:9, 15*

LOWLINESS

*The stranger that is within thee shall get up above thee very high; and thou shalt come down very **low**. Deuteronomy 28:43*

*And it came to pass, when he saw her, that he rent his clothes, and said, Alas, my daughter! Thou hast brought me very **low**, and thou art one of them that trouble me: for I have opened my mouth unto the LORD, and I cannot go back. Judges 11:35*

*The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth **low**, and lifteth up. 1 Samuel 2:7*

*For the LORD brought Judah **low** because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD. 2 Chronicles 28:19*

*Who giveth rain upon the earth, and sendeth waters upon the fields. To set up on high those that be **low**; that those which mourn may be exalted to safety. Job 5:10-11*

*His sons come to honour, and he knoweth it not; and they are brought **low**, but he perceiveth it not of them. Job 14:21*

*They are exalted for a little while, but are gone and brought **low**; they are taken out of the way as all other, and cut off as the tops of the ears of corn. Job 24:24*

*Look on every one that is proud, and bring him **low**; and tread down the wicked in their place. Job 40:12*

*Hear this, all ye people; give ear, all ye inhabitants of the world. Both **low** and high, rich and poor, together... Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, when the iniquity of my heels shall compass me about? They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; None of them can be any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceaseth for ever:) Psalm 49:1-2, 5-8*

*Trust in him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before him: God is a refuge for us. Selah. Surely men of **low** degree are vanity, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than vanity. Psalm 62:9*

*O remember not against us former iniquities: let thy tender mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very **low**. Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of thy name: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for thy name's sake. Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is their God? Let him be known among the heathen in our sight by the revenging of the blood of thy servants which is shed. Psalm 79:8-10*

*Many times did he deliver them; but they provoked him with their counsel, and were brought **low** for their iniquity. Nevertheless he regarded their affliction, when he heard their cry: And he remembered for them his covenant, and repented according to the multitude of his mercies. He made them also to be pitied of all those that carried them captive. Psalm 106:43-46*

*He blesseth them also, so that they are multiplied greatly...Again, they are minished and brought **low** through oppression, affliction, and sorrow. He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way. Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD. Psalm 107:38-43*

*The LORD preserveth the simple: I was brought **low**, and he helped me. Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee. Psalm 116:6-7*

*O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good...And gave their land for an heritage: for his mercy endureth for ever: Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his mercy endureth for ever. Who remembered us in our **low** estate: for his mercy endureth for ever: and hath redeemed us from our enemies: for his mercy endureth for ever. Psalm 136:21-24*

*Though the LORD be high, yet hath he respect unto the **lowly**: but the proud he knoweth afar off. Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me. Psalm 138:6-7*

*I said, Thou art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living. Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very **low**: deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I. Psalm 142:5-6*

*The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just. Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth grace unto the **lowly**. The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools. Proverbs 3:33-35*

*When pride cometh, then cometh shame: but with the **lowly** is wisdom. The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them. Proverbs 11:2-3*

*The highway of the upright is to depart from evil: he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul. Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the **lowly**, than to divide the spoil with the proud. He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso trusteth in the LORD, happy is he. Proverbs 16:17-20*

*There is an evil which I have seen under the sun, as an error which proceedeth from the ruler: Folly is set in great dignity, and the rich sit in **low** place. Ecclesiastes 10:6-7*

*In the day when the keepers of the house shall tremble, and the strong men shall bow themselves, and the grinders cease because they are few, and those that look out of the windows be darkened, and the doors be shut in the streets, when the sound of the grinding is **low**, and he shall rise up at the voice of the bird, and all the daughters of musick shall be brought **low**; also when they shall be afraid of that which is high, and fears shall be in the way... Ecclesiastes 12:3-5*

*Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty. The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought **low**... Isaiah 2:10-12*

*And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made **low**: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. And the idols he shall utterly abolish. And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2:17-19*

*Behold, the day of the LORD cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine. And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and will lay **low** the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:9-11*

*For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall. Thou shalt bring down the noise of strangers, as the heat in a dry place; even the heat with the shadow of a cloud: the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought **low**...and he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth his hands to swim: and he shall bring down their pride together with the spoils of their hands. And the fortress of the high fort of thy walls shall he bring down, lay **low**, and bring to the ground, even to the dust. Isaiah 25:4-5, 11-12*

*For he bringeth down them that dwell on high; the lofty city, he layeth it **low**; he layeth it **low**, even to the ground; he bringeth it even to the dust. The foot shall tread it down, even the feet of the poor, and the steps of the needy. The way of the just is uprightness: thou, most upright, dost weigh the path of the just. Yea, in the way of thy judgments, O LORD, have we waited for thee; the desire of our soul is to thy name, and to the remembrance of thee. Isaiah 26:5-8*

*And thou shalt be brought down, and shalt speak out of the ground, and thy speech shall be **low** out of the dust, and thy voice shall be, as of one that hath a familiar spirit, out of the ground, and thy speech shall whisper out of the dust. Moreover the multitude of thy strangers shall be like small dust, and the multitude of the terrible ones shall be as chaff that passeth away: yea, it shall be at an instant suddenly. Isaiah 29:4-5*

*Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field. And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever. And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places; When it shall hail, coming down on the forest; and the city shall be **low** in a **low** place. Isaiah 32:16-19*

*The voice of him that crieth in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made **low**: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain: and the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it. Isaiah 40:3-5*

*Mine eye runneth down with rivers of water for the destruction of the daughter of my people. Mine eye trickleth down, and ceaseth not, without any intermission, till the LORD look down, and behold from heaven. Mine eye affecteth mine heart because of all the daughters of my city. Mine enemies chased me sore, like a bird, without cause. They have cut off my life in the dungeon, and cast a stone upon me. Waters flowed over mine head; then I said, I am cut off. I called upon thy name, O LORD, out of the **low** dungeon. Thou hast heard my voice: hide not thine ear at my breathing, at my cry. Thou drewest near in the day that I called upon thee: thou saidst, Fear not. Lamentations 3:55-57*

*And it grew, and became a spreading vine of **low** stature, whose branches turned toward him, and the roots thereof were under him: so it became a vine, and brought forth branches, and shot forth sprigs...And all the trees of the field shall know that I the LORD have brought down the high tree, have exalted the **low** tree, have dried up the green tree, and have made the dry tree to flourish: I the LORD have spoken and have done it. Ezekiel 17:16, 24*

*And thou, profane wicked prince of Israel, whose day is come, when iniquity shall have no end. Thus saith the Lord GOD; Remove the diadem, and take off the crown: this shall not be the same: exalt him that is **low**, and abase him that is high. I will overturn, overturn, overturn, it: and it shall be no more, until he come whose right it is; and I will give it him. Ezekiel 21:25-27*

*Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; **lowly**, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and he shall speak peace unto the heathen: and his dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth. Zechariah 9:9-10*

*Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and **lowly** in heart; and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light. Matthew 12:28-31*

*And Mary said, My soul doth magnify the Lord, And my spirit hath rejoiced in God my Saviour. For he hath regarded the **low** estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. For he that is mighty hath done to me great things; and holy is his name. Luke 1:46-49*

*As it is written in the book of the words of Esaias the prophet, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be brought **low**; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways shall be made smooth; And all flesh shall see the salvation of God. Luke 3:4-6*

*Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of **low** estate. Be not wise in your own conceits. Romans 12:16*

*I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all **lowliness** and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:1-6*

*If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in **lowliness** of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Philippians 2:3-4*

*Let the brother of **low** degree rejoice in that he is exalted: but the rich, in that he is made **low**: because as the flower of the grass he shall pass away. James 1:9-10*

MEEKNESS

*(Now the man Moses was very **meek**, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.) Numbers 12:3*

*The **meek** shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek him: your heart shall live for ever. Psalm 22:26*

*The **meek** will he guide in judgment: and the **meek** will he teach his way. Psalm 25:9*

*But the **meek** shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. Psalm 37:11*

*Gird thy sword upon thy thigh, O most mighty, with thy glory and thy majesty. And in thy majesty ride prosperously because of truth and **meekness** and righteousness; and thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things. Psalm 45:4*

*Thou, even thou, art to be feared: and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry? Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still, when God arose to judgment, to save all the **meek** of the earth. Selah. Psalm 76:7-9*

*The LORD lifteth up the **meek**: he casteth the wicked down to the ground. Psalm 147:6*

*For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the **meek** with salvation. Psalm 149:4*

*But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the **meek** of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. Isaiah 11:4*

*The **meek** also shall increase their joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 29:19*

*The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the **meek**; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God... Isaiah 61:1-2*

*For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes; That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the **meek**: and a man and his father will go in unto the same maid, to profane my holy name: And they lay themselves down upon clothes laid to pledge by every altar, and they drink the wine of the condemned in the house of their god. Amos 2:6-9*

*Seek ye the LORD, all ye **meek** of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek **meekness**: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger. Zephaniah 2:3*

*Blessed are the **meek**: for they shall inherit the earth. Matthew 5:5*

*Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am **meek** and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. Matthew 11:29*

*Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, **meek**, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. Matthew 21:5*

*What will ye? Shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and in the spirit of **meekness**? 1 Corinthians 4:21*

*Now I Paul myself beseech you by the **meekness** and gentleness of Christ, who in presence am base among you, but being absent am bold toward you... 2 Corinthians 10:1*

*The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, **meekness**, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:23*

*Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, ye which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of **meekness**; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Galatians 6:1*

*I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called, with all lowliness and **meekness**, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:1-3*

*Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, **meekness**, longsuffering; forbearing one another, and forgiving one another... Colossians 3:12-13*

*They that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, **meekness**. 1 Timothy 6:10-11*

*In **meekness** instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; and that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:25-26*

*Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work. To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, shewing all **meekness** unto all men. For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. Titus 3:1-3*

*My beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath: For the wrath of man worketh not the righteousness of God. Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with **meekness** the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. James 1:19-21*

*Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him shew out of a good conversation his works with **meekness** of wisdom. James 3:13*

*Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; while they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear. Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a **meek** and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price. 1 Peter 3:1-4*

*But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with **meekness** and fear: Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ. 1 Peter 3:15-16*

PATIENCE

*Rest in the LORD, and wait **patiently** for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass. Psalm 37:7*

*I waited **patiently** for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. Psalm 40:1*

*Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the **patient** in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. Ecclesiastes 7:8-9*

*The servant therefore fell down, and worshipped him, saying, Lord, have **patience** with me, and I will pay thee all. Matthew 18:26*

*And his fellowservant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have **patience** with me, and I will pay thee all. Matthew 18:29*

*They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. That which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with **patience**. Luke 8:13-15*

*And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake. But there shall not an hair of your head perish. In your **patience** possess ye your souls. Luke 21:19*

*I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before thee touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews: Especially because I know thee to be expert in all customs and questions which are among the Jews: wherefore I beseech thee to hear me **patiently**. Acts 26:2-3*

*To them who by **patient** continuance in well doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil...but glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good... Romans 2:7-10*

*But we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh **patience**; and **patience**, experience; and experience, hope: and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:3-5*

*For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with **patience** wait for it. Romans 8:24-25*

*Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope; **patient** in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. Romans 12:10-13*

*For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through **patience** and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. Now the God of **patience** and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:4-6*

*Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed: But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much **patience**, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses... 2 Corinthians 6:3-4*

*Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all **patience**, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds. 2 Corinthians 12:12*

*For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; Stenghtened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all **patience** and longsuffering with joyfulness; Giving thanks unto the Father... Colossians 1:9-12*

*We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers; Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and **patience** of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father... 1 Thessalonians 1:3*

Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be **patient** toward all men. See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men. 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth; So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your **patience** and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure... 2 Thessalonians 1:3-4

But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you. And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the **patient** waiting for Christ. 2 Thessalonians 3:3-5

A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behaviour, given to hospitality, apt to teach; not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but **patient**, not a brawler, not covetous; one that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. 1 Timothy 3:2-6

For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, **patience**, meekness. Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses. 1 Timothy 6:10-12

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, **patient**, in meekness instructing those who oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance... 2 Timothy 2:24-25

But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, **patience**, persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. 2 Timothy 3:10-12

*But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine: That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in **patience**. Titus 2:2*

*And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: that ye be not slothful but followers of them who through faith and **patience** inherit the promises. For when God made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself, Saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. And so, after he had **patiently** endured, he obtained the promise. Hebrews 6:11-15*

*Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of **patience**, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and he that shall come will come, and will not tarry. Hebrews 10:35-37*

*Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with **patience** the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2*

*My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh **patience**. But let **patience** have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing. James 1:2-4*

*Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long **patience** for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be ye also **patient**; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draweth nigh. Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door. James 5:7-9*

*Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of **patience**. Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the **patience** of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy. James 5:10-11*

*For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? But if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it **patiently**, this is acceptable with God. For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: 1 Peter 2:20-23*

*Giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance **patience**; and to **patience** godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth. 2 Peter 1:5-12*

*I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and **patience** of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. Revelations 1:9*

*I know thy works, and thy labour, and thy **patience**, and how thou canst not bear them which are evil: and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them liars: and hast borne, and hast **patience**, and for my name's sake hast laboured, and hast not fainted. Revelation 2:2-3*

*I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy **patience**, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first. Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee... Revelation 2:19-20*

*Because thou hast kept the word of my **patience**, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. Revelation 3:10*

*If any man have an ear, let him hear. He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the **patience** and the faith of the saints. Revelation 13:9-10*

*Here is the **patience** of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. Revelation 14:12-13*

REVERENCE

*Ye shall keep my sabbaths, and **reverence** my sanctuary: I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:30 and Leviticus 26:2*

*When Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did **reverence**. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold thy servant! 2 Samuel 9:6*

*Then Bath-sheba bowed with her face to the earth, and did **reverence** to the king, and said, Let my lord king David live for ever. 1 Kings 1:31*

*All the king's servants, that were in the king's gate, bowed, and **reverenced** Haman: for the king had so commanded concerning him. But Mordecai bowed not, nor did him **reverence**...And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him **reverence**, then was Haman full of wrath. Esther 3:2, 5*

*God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in **reverence** of all them that are about him. Psalm 89:7*

*He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and **reverend** is his name. Psalm 111:9*

*Last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will **reverence** my son. Matthew 21:37*

*Having yet therefore one son, his wellbeloved, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will **reverence** my son. Mark 12:6*

*Then said the lord of the vineyard, What shall I do? I will send my beloved son: it may be they will **reverence** him when they see him. Luke 20:13*

*Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she **reverence** her husband. Ephesians 5:33*

*Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them **reverence**: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? Hebrews 12:9*

*Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with **reverence** and godly fear... Hebrews 12:28*
