DECEIT

My father peradventure will feel me, and I shall seem to him as a **deceiver**; and I shall bring a curse upon me, and not a blessing. Genesis 27:12

And your father hath **deceived** me, and changed my wages ten times; but God suffered him not to hurt me. Genesis 31:7

The sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father **deceitfully**, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister: And they said unto them, We cannot do this thing... Genesis 34:13-14

And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will intreat the LORD that the swarms of flies may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, tomorrow: but let not Pharaoh deal **deceitfully** any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD. Exodus 8:29

If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt **deceitfully** with her. Exodus 21:8

If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbor in that which delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath **deceived** his neighbour; Or have found that which was lost, and lieth concerning it, and sweareth falsely; in any of all these that a man doeth, sinning therein: Then it shall be, because he hath sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he hath **deceitfully** gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found, Leviticus 6:2-4

Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not **deceived**, and ye turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them; Deuteronomy 11:16

And Saul said unto Michal, Why hast thou **deceived** me so, and sent away mine enemy, that he is escaped? And Michal answered Saul, He said unto me, Let me go; why should I kill thee? 1 Samue 119:17

Saul sware to her by the LORD, saying, As the LORD liveth, there shall no punishment happen to thee for this thing. Then said the woman, whom shall I bring up unto thee?... When the woman saw Samuel, she cried with a loud voice: and the woman spake to Saul, saying, why hast thou deceived me? For thou art Saul. 1 Samuel 28:10-12

Thou knowest Abner the son of Ner, that he came to **deceive** thee, and to know thy going out and thy coming in, and to know all that thou doest. 2 Samuel 3:25

And he answered, My lord, O king, my servant deceived me: for thy servant said, I will saddle me an ass, that I may ride thereon, and go to the king; because thy servant is lame. 2 Samuel 19:26

Then she said, Did I desire a son of my lord? Did I not say, Do not deceive me? 2 Kings 4:28

Thus saith the king, Let not Hezekiah **deceive** you: for he shall not be able to deliver you out of his hand: 2 Kings 18:29

Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God in whom thou trustest **deceive** thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be delivered into the hand of the king of Assyria. 2 Kings 19:10

Now therefore let not Hezekiah **deceive** you, nor persuade you on this manner, neither yet believe him: for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver his people out of mine hand, and out of the hand of my fathers: how much less shall your God deliver you out of mine hand? 2 Chronicles 32:15

My brethren have dealt **deceitfully** as a brook, and as the stream of brooks they pass away; Job 6:15

With him is strength and wisdom: the **deceived** and the **deceiver** are his. Job 12:16

Will ye speak wickedly for God? And talk deceitfully for him? Job 13:7

Let not him that is **deceived** trust in vanity: for vanity shall be his recompence. Job 15:31

They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit. Job 15:35

My lips shall not speak wickedness, nor my tongue utter deceit. Job 27:4

If I have walked with vanity, or if my foot hath hasted to **deceit**; Let me be weighed in an even balance, that God may know mine integrity. Job 31:5-6

If mine heart have been **deceived** by a woman, or if I have laid wait at my neighbour's door; Then let my wife grind unto another... Job 31:9-10

Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing: the LORD will abhor the bloody and deceitful man. Psalms 5:6

His mouth is full of cursing and **deceit** and fraud: under his tongue is mischief and vanity. Psalms 10:7

He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn **deceitfully**. Psalms 24:4

For they speak not peace: but they devise **deceitful** matters against them that are quiet in the land. Psalms 35:20

The words of his mouth are iniquity and **deceit**; he hath left off to be wise, and to do good. Psalms 36:3

They also that seek after my life lay snares for me: and they that seek my hurt speak mischievous things, and imagine **deceits** all the day long Psalms 38:12

Judge me, O God, and plead my cause gainst an ungodly nation: O deliver me from the **deceitful** and unjust man. Psalms 43:1

Thou givest thy mouth to evil, and thy tongue frameth **deceit**. Psalms 50:19

Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? The goodness of God endureth continually. Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully. Thou lovest evil more than good; and lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah. Thou lovest all devouring words, O thou deceitful tongue. God shall likewise destroy thee for ever, he shall take thee away, and pluck thee out of thy dwelling place, and root thee out of the land of the living. Selah. Psalms 52:1-5

Wickedness is in the midst thereof: **deceit** and guile depart not from her streets. Psalms 55:11

But thou, O God, shalt bring them down into the pit of destruction: bloody and **deceitful** men shall not live out half their days; but I will trust in thee. Psalms 55:23

He shall redeem their soul from **deceit** and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight. Psalms 72:14

Yet they tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not his testimonies: But turned back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a **deceitful** bow. Psalms 78:56-57

He that worketh **deceit** shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight. Psalms 101:7

For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the **deceitful** are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue. Psalms 109:2

Thou hast trodden down all them that err from thy statutes: for their deceit is falsehood. Psalms 119:118

Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips, and from a **deceitful** tongue. Psalms 120:2

Thou lovest all devouring words, Othou deceitful tongue. Psalms 52:4

The wicked worketh a **deceitful** work: but to him that soweth righteousness shall be a sure reward. Proverbs 11:18

The thoughts of the righteous are right: but the counsels of the wicked are deceit. Proverbs 12:5

He that speaketh truth sheweth forth righteousness: but a false witness deceit. Proverbs 12:17

Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellors of peace is joy. Proverbs 12:20

The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way: but the folly of fools is **deceit**. Proverbs 14:8

A true witness delivereth souls: but a **deceitful** witness speaketh lies. Proverbs 14:25

Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise. Proverbs 20:1

Bread of **deceit** is sweet to a man; but afterwards his mouth shall be filled with gravel. Proverbs 20:17

Be not desirous of his dainties; for they are deceitful meat. Proverbs 23:3

Be not a witness against thy neighbor without cause; and **deceive** not with thy lips. Proverbs 24:28

He that hateth dissembleth with his lips, and layeth up **deceit** within him; Proverbs 26:24

Whose hatred is covered by **deceit**, his wickedness shall be shewed before the whole congregation. Proverbs 26:26

Faithful are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful. Proverbs 27:6

The poor and the **deceitful** man meet together: the LORD lighteneth both their eyes. Proverbs 29:13

Favour is **deceitful**, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

The princes of Zoan are become fools, the princes of Noph are **deceived**; they have also seduced Egypt, even they that are the stay of the tribes thereof. Isaiah 19:13

This is a rebellious people, lying children...which say to the seers, See not, and to the prophets, Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy **deceits**: Isaiah 30:9-10

Thus saith the king, Let not Hezekiah **deceiv**e you; for he shall not be able to deliver you. Isaiah 36:14

Thus shall ye speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not thy God, in whom thou trustest, **deceive** thee, saying, Jerusalem shall not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria. Isaiah 37:10

He feedeth on ashes: a **deceived** heart hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, Is there not a lie in my right hand? Isaiah 44:20

He made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any **deceit** in his mouth. Isaiah 53:9

Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! Surely thou hast greatly **deceived** this people and Jerusalem, saying, Ye shall have peace; whereas the sword reacheth unto the soul. Jeremiah 4:10

As a cage is full of birds, so are their houses full of **deceit**: therefore they are become great, and waxen rich. Jeremiah 5:27

Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? They hold fast **deceit**, they refuse to return. Jeremiah 8:5

And they will **deceive** every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity. Thine habitation is in the midst of **deceit**; through **deceit** they refuse to know me, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 9:5-6

Their tongue is as an arrow shot out; it speaketh **deceit**: one speaketh peaceably to his neighbour with his mouth, but in heart he layeth his wait. Jeremiah 9:8

Then the LORD said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the **deceit** of their heart. Jeremiah 14:14

The heart is **deceitful** above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it? Jeremiah 17:9

O LORD, thou **deceived** me, and I was **deceived**: thou art stronger than I, and hast prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocketh me. Jeremiah 20:7

How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? Yea, they are prophets of the **deceit** of their own heart; Jeremiah 23:26

For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Let not your prophets and your diviners, that be in the midst of you, **deceive** you, neither hearken to your dreams which ye cause to be dreamed. Jeremiah 29:8

Thus saith the LORD; **Deceive** not yourselves, saying, The Chaldeans shall surely depart from us: for they shall not depart. Jeremiah 37:9

Cursed be he that doeth the work of the LORD deceitfully, and cursed be he that keepth back his sword from blood. Jeremiah 48:10

Thy terribleness hath **deceived** thee, and the pride of thine heart, O thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, that holdest the height of the hill: though thou shouldest make thy nest as high as the eagle, I will bring thee down from thence, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 49:16

I called for my lovers, but they **deceived** me: my priests and mine elders gave up the ghost in the city, while they sought their meat to relieve their souls. Lamentations 1:19

And if the prophet be **deceived** when he hath spoken a thing, I the LORD have **deceived** that prophet, and I will stretch out my hand upon him, and will destroy him from the midst of my people Israel. Ezekiel 14:9

And after the league made with him he shall work **deceitfully**: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people. Daniel 11:23

They return, but not to the most High: they are like a **deceitful** bow: their princes shall fall by the sword for the rage of their tongue: this shall be their derision in the land of Egypt. Hosea 7:16

Ephraim compasseth me about with lies, and the house of Israel with deceit: but Judah yet ruleth with God, and is faithful with the saints. Hosea 11:12

He is a merchant, the balances of **deceit** are in his hand: he loveth to oppress. Hosea 12:7

Hear this O ye that swallow up the needy, even to make the poor of the land to fail, Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? And the sabbath, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by **deceit**? Amos 8:4-5

The pride of thine heart hath **deceived** thee, thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that saith in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground? Obadiah 1:3

All the men of thy confederacy have brought thee even to the border: the men that were at peace with thee have **deceived** thee, and prevailed against thee; they that eat thy bread have laid a wound under thee: there is none understanding in him. Obadiah 1:7

Shall I count them pure with the wicked balances, and with the bag of deceitful weights? For the rich men thereof are full of violence, and the inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue is **deceitful** in their mouth. Micah 6:11-12

In the same day also will I punish all those that leap on the threshold, which fill their masters' houses with violence and **deceit**. Zephaniah 1:9

The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a **deceitful** tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Zephaniah 3:13

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to **deceive**. Zechariah 13:4

But cursed be the **deceiver**, which hath in his flock a male, and voweth, and sacrificeth unto the Lord a corrupt thing: for I am a great King, saith the LORD of hosts, and my name is dreadful among the heathen. Malachi 1:14

DECEIT IN NEW COVENANT

He also that received seed among the thorns is he that heareth the word; and the care of this world, and the **deceitfulness** of riches, choke the word, and he becometh unfruitful. Matthew 13:22

And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man **deceive** you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall **deceive** many. Matthew 24:4-5

Many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. Matthew 24:11

For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall **deceive** the very elect. Matthew 24:24

Saying, Sir, we remember that that **deceiver** said, while he was yet alive, After three days I will rise again. Matthew 27:63

The cares of the world, and the **deceitfulness** of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becometh unfruitful. Mark 4:19

From within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, **deceit**, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishess: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man. Mark 7:22

And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any man **deceive** you: For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall **deceive** many. Mark 13:5-6

And he said, Take heed that ye be not **deceived**: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ, and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them. Luke 21:8

Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived? John 7:47

Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Romans 1:29

Their throat is an open sepulchre; with their tongues they have used **deceit**; the poison of asps is under their lips: Romans 3:13

For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, **deceived** me, and by it slew me. Romans 7:11

Mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple. Romans 16:17-18

Let no man **deceive** himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise. 1 Corinthians 3:18

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not **deceived**: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind... 1 Corinthians 6:9

Be not **deceived**: evil communications corrupt good manners. 1 Corinthians 15:33

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. 2 Corinthians 4:1-2

In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities...By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as **deceivers**, and yet true; 2 Corinthians 6:8

For such are false apostles, **deceitful** workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 2 Corinthians 11:13

Be not **deceived**; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. Galatians 6:7

That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to **deceive**; Ephesians 4:14

That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the **deceitful** lusts; Ephesians 4:22

Let no man **deceive** you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. Ephesians 5:6

Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain **deceit**, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

For our exhortation was not of **deceit**, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile: 1 Thessalonians 2:3

Let no man **deceive** you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition... 2 Thessalonians 2:3

Then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy by the brightness of his coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all **deceivableness** of unrighteousness in them that perish, because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 2 Thessalonians 2:8-10

And Adam was not **deceived**, but the woman being **deceived** was in the transgression. 1 Timothy 2:14

But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, **deceiving**, and being **deceived**. 2 Timothy 3:13

For there are many unruly and vain talkers and **deceivers**, specially they of the circumcision: Titus 1:10

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, **deceived**, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another. Titus 3:3

But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the **deceitfulness** of sin. Hebrews 3:13

But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. James 1:22

And shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. Spots they are and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own **deceivings** while they feast with you; 2 Peter 2:13

If we say that we have no sin, we **deceive** ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 1 John 1:8

Little children, let no man **deceive** you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous. 1 John 3:7

For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist. 2.John 1:7

And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations **deceived**. Revelation 18:23

The beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone...And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season...And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea...And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. Revelations 19:20, 20:3, 8, 10

HAUGHTINESS

The afflicted people thou wilt save: but thine eyes are upon the **haughty**, that thou mayest bring them down. 2 Samuel 22:28

LORD, my heart is not **haughty**, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me. Psalm 131:1

Pride goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18

Before destruction the heart of man is **haughty**, and before honour is humility. Proverbs 18:12

Proud and haughty scorner is his name, who dealeth in proud wrath. Proverbs 21:24

The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the **haughtiness** of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day... The loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the **haughtiness** of men shall be made low: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. Isaiah 2:11, 17

Moreover the LORD saith, Because the daughters of Zion are **haughty**, and walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes, walking and mincing as they go, and making a tinkling with their feet: Therefore the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts. Isaiah 3:16-17

Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the **haughty** shall be humbled. Isaiah 10:33

The day of the LORD cometh...For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine. I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and will lay low the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:9-11

We have heard of the pride of Moab; he is very proud: even of his haughtiness, and his pride, and his wrath: but his lies shall not be so. Isaiah 16:6

The earth mourneth and fadeth away, the world languisheth and fadeth away, the **haughty** people of the earth do languish. Isaiah 24:4

We have heard the pride of Moab, (he is exceeding proud) his loftiness, and his arrogancy, and his pride, and the **haughtiness** of his heart. Jeremiah 48:29

They were **haughty**, and committed abomination before me: therefore I took them away as I saw good. Ezekiel 16:50

Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, against this family do I devise an evil, from which ye shall not remove your necks; neither shall ye go haughtily: for this time is evil. Micah 2:3

In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be **haughty** because of my holy mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

INIQUITY

But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the **iniquity** of the Amorites is not yet full. Genesis 15:16

And when morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take thy wife, and thy two daughters, which are here; lest thou be consumed in the **iniquity** of the city. Genesis 19:15

And Judah said, What shall we say unto my lord? What shall we speak? Or how shall we clear ourselves? God hath found out the **iniquity** of thy servants: behold, we are my lord's servants, both we, and he also with whom the cup is found. Genesis 44:16

Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me; Exodus 20:5

And it shall be upon Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the **iniquity** of the holy things, which the children of Israel shall hallow in all their holy gifts; and it shall be always upon his forehead, that they may be accepted before the LORD. Exodus 28:38

And they shall be upon Aaron, and upon his sons, when they come in unto the tabernacle of the congregation, or when they come near unto the altar to minister in the holy place; that they bear not **iniquity**, and die: it shall be a statute for ever unto him and his seed after him. Exodus 28:43

Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving **iniquity** and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:7

And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance. Exodus 34:9

And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and is a witness, whether he hath seen or known of it, if he do not utter it, then he shall bear his iniquity. Leviticus 5:1

And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he wist it not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his **iniquity**. Leviticus 5:17

And if any of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offereth it: it shall be an abomination, and the soul that eateth of it shall bear his **iniquity**. Leviticus 7:18

Wherefore have ye not eaten the sin offering in the holy place, seeing it is most holy, and God hath given it you to bear the **iniquity** of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD? Leviticus 10:17

And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the **iniquities** of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: And the goat shall bear upon him all their **iniquities** unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness. Leviticus 16:21-22

But if he wash them not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his iniquity. Leviticus 17:16

And the land is defiled: therefore I do visit the **iniquity** thereof upon it, and the land itself vomiteth out her inhabitants. Leviticus 18:25

Therefore every one that eateth it shall bear his **iniquity**, because he hath profaned the hallowed thing of the LORD: and that soul shall be cut off from among his people. Leviticus 19:8

And if a man shall take his sister, his father's daughter, or his mother's daughter, and see her nakedness, and she see his nakedness; it is a wicked thing; and they shall be cut off in the sight of their people: he hath uncovered his sister's nakedness; he shall bear his iniquity...And thou shalt not uncover the nakedness of thy mother's sister, nor of thy father's sister: for he uncovereth his near kin: they shall bear their iniquity. Leviticus 20:17, 19

...Or suffer them to bear the **iniquity** of trespass, when they eat their holy things: for I the LORD do sanctify them. Leviticus 22:16

They that are left of you shall pine away in their **iniquity** in your enemies' lands; and also in the **iniquities** of their fathers shall they pine away with them. Leviticus 26:39

If they shall confess their **iniquity**, and the **iniquity** of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me; And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their **iniquity**: Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember: and I will remember the land. Leviticus 26:40-42

The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their *iniquity*: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes. Leviticus 26:43

Then shall the man bring his wife unto the priest, and he shall bring her offering for her, the tenth part of an ephah of barley meal; he shall pour no oil upon it, nor put frankincense thereon; for it is an offering of jealousy, an offering of memorial, bringing **iniquity** to remembrance. Numbers 5:15

This is the law of jealousies, when a wife goeth aside to another...when the spirit of jealousy cometh upon him, and he be jealous over his wife, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law. Then shall the man be guiltless from **iniquity**, and this woman shall bear her **iniquity**. Numbers 5:29-31

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving **iniquity** and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the **iniquity** of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. Numbers 14:18-19

After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year, shall ye bear your **iniquities**, even forty years, and ye shall know my breach of promise. Numbers 14:34

Because he hath despised the word of the LORD, and hath broken his commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; his **iniquity** shall be upon him. Numbers 15:31

The LORD said unto Aaron, Thou and thy sons and thy father's house with thee shall bear the **iniquity** of the sanctuary: and thou and thy sons with thee shall bear the **iniquity** of your priesthood. Numbers 18:1

But the Levities shall do the service of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they shall bear their **iniquity**: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they have no inheritance. Numbers 18:23

He hath not beheld **iniquity** in Jacob, neither hath he seen perverseness in Israel: the LORD his God is with him, and the shout of a king is among them. Numbers 23:21

But if he shall any ways make them void after that he hath heard them; then he shall bear her **iniquity**. Numbers 30:15

Thou shalt not make thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the waters beneath the earth: Thou shalt not bow down thyself unto them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me... Deuteronomy 5:9

One witness shall not rise up against a man for any **iniquity**, or for any sin, in any sin that he sinneth: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established. Deuteronomy 19:15

He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without **iniquity**, just and right is he. Deuteronomy 32:4

Is the **iniquity** of Peor too little for us, from which we are not cleansed until this day, although there was a plague in the congregation of the LORD, Joshua 22:17

Did not Achan the son of Zerah commit a trespass in the accursed thing, and wrath fell on all the congregation of Israel? And that man perished not alone in his **iniquity**. Joshua 22:20

For I told him that I will judge his house for ever for the **iniquity** which he knoweth; because his sons made themselves vile, and he restrained them not. And therefore I have sworn unto the house of Eli, that the **iniquity** of Eli's house shall not be purged with sacrifice nor offering for ever. 1 Samuel 3:13-14

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as **iniquity** and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king. 1 Samuel 15:23

And David fled from Naioth in Ramah, and came and said before Jonathan, What have I done? What is mine **iniquity**? And what is my sin before thy father, that he seeketh my life? 1 Samuel 20:1

Therefore thou shalt deal kindly with thy servant; for thou hast brought thy servant into a covenant of the LORD with thee: notwithstanding, if there be in me **iniquity**, slay me thyself; for why shouldest thou bring me to thy father? 1 Samuel 20:8

And fell at his feet, and said, Upon me, my lord, upon me let this **iniquity** be: and let thine handmaid, I pray thee, speak in thine audience, and hear the words of thine handmaid. 1 Samuel 25:24

I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit **iniquity**, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men: 2 Samuel 7:14

And the woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the iniquity be on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his throne be guiltless. 2 Samuel 14:9

And Absalom answered Joab, Behold, I sent unto thee, saying, Come hither, that I may send thee to the king, to say, Wherefore am I come from Geshur? It had been good for me to have been there still: now therefore let me see the king's face; and if there be any **iniquity** in me, let him kill me. 2 Samuel 14:32

And said unto the king, Let not my lord impute **iniquity** unto me, neither do thou remember that which thy servant did perversely the day that my lord the king went out of Jerusalem, that the king should take it to his heart. 2 Samuel 19:19

I was also upright before him, and have kept myself from mine **iniquity**. 2 Samuel 22:24

And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And David said unto the LORD, I have sinned greatly in that I have done: and now, I beseech thee, O LORD, take away the **iniquity** of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly. 2 Samuel 24:10

And David said unto God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech thee, do away the **iniquity** of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly. 1 Chronicles 21:8

Wherefore now let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no **iniquity** with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts. 2 Chronicles 19:7

Even as I have seen, they that plow **iniquity**, and sow wickedness, reap the same. Joh 4:8

So the poor hath hope, and iniquity stoppeth her mouth. Job 5:16

Return, I pray you, let it not be **iniquity**; yea, return again, my righteousness is in it. Is there **iniquity** in my tongue? Cannot my taste discern perverse things? Job 6:29-30

And why dost thou not pardon my transgression, and take away mine iniquity? For now shall I sleep in the dust; and thou shalt seek me in the morning, but I shall not be. Job 7:21

Are thy days as the days of man? Are thy years as man's days, that thou enquirest after mine **iniquity**, and searchest after my sin? Thou knowest that I am not wicked; and there is none that can deliver out of thine hand. Thine hands have made me and fashioned me together round about; yet thou dost destroy me. Remember, I beseech thee, that thou hast made me as the clay; and wilt thou bring me into dust again? Job 10:5-9

If I sin, then thou markest me, and thou wilt not acquit me from mine iniquity. Job 10:14

And that he would shew thee the secrets of wisdom, that they are double to that which is! Know therefore that God exacteth of thee less than thine iniquity deserveth. Job 11:6

If **iniquity** be in thine hand, put it far away, and let not wickedness dwell in thy tabernacles. Job 11:14

How many are mine **iniquities** and sins? Make me to know my transgression and my sin. Job 13:23

For thou writest bitter things against me, and makest me to possess the iniquities of my youth. Job 13:26

My transgression is sealed up in a bag, and thou sewest up mine **iniquity**. Job 14:17

For thy mouth uttereth thine **iniquity**, and thou choosest the tongue of the crafty. Job 15:5

How much more abominable and filthy is man, which drinketh **iniquity** like water? Job 15:16

The heaven shall reveal his **iniquity**; and the earth shall rise up against him. Job 20:27

How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and how oft cometh their destruction upon them! ... God layeth up his **iniquity** for his children: he rewardeth him, and he shall know it. Job 21:17, 19

Is not thy wickedness great? And thine iniquities infinite? Job 22:5

If thou return to the Almighty, thou shalt be built up, thou shalt put away iniquity far from thy tabernacles. Job 22:23

I made a covenant with mine eyes; why then should I think upon a maid? For what portion of God is there from above? And what inheritance of the Almighty from on high? Is not destruction to the wicked? And a strange punishment to the workers of **iniquity**? Job 31:1-3

If mine heart have been deceived by a woman...then let my wife grind for another, and let others bow down to her. For this is an heinous crime; yea, it is an **iniquity** to be punished by the judges. Job 31:9-11

This also were an **iniquity** to be punished by the judge: for I should have denied the God that is above. Job 31:28

If I covered my transgressions as Adam, by hiding mine **iniquity** in my bosom: Did I fear a great multitude, or did the contempt of families terrify me, that I went not out of the door? Job 31:33-34

I am clean without transgression, I am innocent; neither is there **iniquity** in me. Job 33:9

Which goeth in company with the workers of **iniquity**, and walketh with wicked men. Job 34:8

Therefore hearken unto me, ye men of understanding: far be it from God, that he should do wickedness; and from the Almighty, that he should commit *iniquity*. Job 34:10

There is no darkness, nor shadow of death, where the workers of *iniquity* may hide themselves. Job 34:22

That which I see not teach thou me: if I have done **iniquity**, I will do no more. Job 34:32

Who hath enjoined him his way? Or who can say, Thou hast wrought iniquity? Job 36:23

He openeth also their ear to discipline, and commandeth that they return from **iniquity**. Job 36:10

Take heed, regard not iniquity: for this hast thou chosen rather than affliction. Job 36:21

And said, O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to thee, my God: for our **iniquities** are increased over our head, and our trespass is grown up unto the heavens. Ezra 9:6

Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our **iniquities** have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day. Ezra 9:7

And after all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that thou our God hast punished us less than our iniquities deserve, and hast given us such delivereance as this; Ezra 9:13

And cover not their **iniquity**, and let not their sin be blotted out from before thee: for they have provoked thee to anger before the builders. Nehemiah 4:5

And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the **iniquities** of their fathers. Nehemiah 9:2

The foolish shall not stand in thy sight: thou hatest all workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 5:5

Depart from me, all ye workers of **iniquity**; for the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping. Psalm 6:8

O LORD my God, if I have done this; if there be **iniquity** in my hands ...Behold, he travaileth with **iniquity**, and hath conceived mischief, and brought forth falsehood. Psalm 7:3, 14

Have all the workers of **iniquity** no knowledge? Who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD. Psalm 14:4

I was also upright before him, and I kept myself from mine **iniquity**. Psalm 18:23

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies. For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine *iniquity*; for it is great. Psalm 25:10-11

Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of **iniquity**, which speak peace to their neighbours, but mischief is in their hearts. Psalm 28:3

For my life is spent with grief, and my years with sighing: my strength faileth because of mine **iniquity**, and my bones are consumed. Psalm 31:10

Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not **iniquity**, and in whose spirit there is no guile...I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine **iniquity** have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the **iniquity** of my sin. Selah. Psalm 32:2, 5

For he flattereth himself in his own eyes, until his **iniquity** be found to be hateful. The words of his mouth are **iniquity** and deceit: he hath left off to be wise, and to do good. Psalm 36:2-3

There are the workers of **iniquity** fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise. Psalm 36:12

Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 37:1

For mine **iniquities** are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me. Psalm 38:4

For I will declare mine iniquity; I will be sorry for my sin. Psalm 38:18

When thou with rebukes dost correct man for **iniquity**, thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man is vanity. Selah. Psalm 39:11

For innumerable evils have compassed me about: mine **iniquities** have taken hold upon me, so that I am not able to look up; they are more than the hairs of mine head: therefore my heart faileth me. Psalm 40:12

And if he come to see me, he speaketh vanity: his heart gathereth **iniquity** to itself; when he goeth abroad, he telleth it. Psalm 41:6

Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, when the **iniquity** of my heels shall compass me about? Psalm 49:5

Wash me throughly from mine **iniquity**, and cleanse me from my sin...Behold, I was shapen in **iniquity**; and in sin did my mother conceive me...Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine **iniquities**. Psalm 51:2, 5, 9

The fool hath said in his heart, There is no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable **iniquity**: there is none that doeth good...Have the workers of **iniquity** no knowledge? Who eat up my people as they eat bread: they have not called upon God. Psalm 53:1, 4

Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast **iniquity** upon me, and in wrath they hate me. Psalm 55:3

Shall they escape by **iniquity**? In thine anger cast down the people, O God. Psalm 56:7

Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God; defend me from them that rise up against me. Deliver me from the workers of **iniquity**, and save me from bloody men. Psalm 59:1-2

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of **iniquity**: who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words. Psalm 64:1-3

Iniquities prevail against me: as for our transgressions, thou shalt purge them away. Psalm 65:3

If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me. Psalm 66:18

Add iniquity unto their iniquity: and let them not come into thy righteousness. Let them be blotted out... Psalm 69:27-28

They search out *iniquities*; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the heart, is deep. Psalm 74:6

Be he, being full of compassion, forgave their **iniquity**, and destroyed them not: yea, many a time turned he his anger away, and did not stir up all his wrath. Psalm 78:38

O remember not against us former **iniquities**: let thy tender mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very low. Psalm 79:8

Thou hast forgiven the **iniquity** of thy people, thou hast covered all their sin. Selah. Psalm 85:2

Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their **iniquity** with stripes. Psalm 89:32

Thou hast set our **iniquities** before thee, our secret sins in the light of thy countenance. Psalm 90:8

When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of **iniquity** do flourish; it is that they shall be destroyed for ever... Psalm 92:7

For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. Psalm 92:9

Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? Or who will stand up for me against the workers of **iniquity**? Psalm 94:16

Shall the throne of **iniquity** have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law? Psalm 94:20

And he shall bring upon them their own **iniquity**, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off. Psalm 94:23

Who forgiveth all thine **iniquities**; who healeth all thy diseases; Psalm 103:3

He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. Psalm 103:10

We have sinned with our fathers, we have committed **iniquity**, we have done wickedly. Psalm 106:6

Many times did he deliver them; but they provoked him with their counsel, and were brought low for their **iniquity.** Psalm 106:43

Fools because of their transgression, and because of their **iniquities**, are afflicted. Psalms 107:17

He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way. Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all **iniquity** shall stop her mouth. Psalm 107:40-42

Let the **iniquity** of his fathers be remembered with the LORD; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out. Psalm 109:14

Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart. They also do no **iniquity**: they walk in his ways. Psalm 119:3

Order my steps in thy word: and let not any **iniquity** have dominion over me. Psalm 119:133

For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous; lest the righteous put forth their hands unto **iniquity**. Psalm 125:3

As for such as turn aside unto their crooked ways, the LORD shall lead them forth with the workers of **iniquity**: but peace shall be upon Israel. Psalm 125:5

If thou, LORD, shouldest mark **iniquities**, O Lord, who shall stand? Psalm 130:3

And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. Psalm 130:8

Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work **iniquity**: and let me not eat of their dainties...Keep me from the snares which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 141:4, 9

His own *iniquities* shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins. Proverbs 5:22

The way of the LORD is strength to the upright: but destruction shall be to the workers of **iniquity**. Proverbs 10:29

By mercy and truth *iniquity* is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil. Proverbs 16:6

An ungodly witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity. Proverbs 19:28

It is joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. Proverbs 21:15

He that soweth **iniquity** shall reap vanity: and the rod of his anger shall fail. Proverbs 22:8

And moreover I saw under the sun the place of judgment, that wickedness was there; and the place of righteousness, that **iniquity** was there. Ecclesiastes 3:16

Ah sinful nation, a people laden with **iniquity**, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward. Isaiah 1:4

Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is **iniquity**, even the solemn meeting. Isaiah 1:13

Woe unto them that draw **iniquity** with cords of vanity, and sin as it were with a cart rope: Isaiah 5:18

And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine **iniquity** is taken away, and thy sin is purged. Isaiah 6:7

And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and lay low the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:11

Prepare slaughter for his children for the **iniquity** of their fathers; that they do not rise, nor possess the land, nor fill the face of the world with cities. Isaiah 14:21

And it was revealed in mine ears by the LORD of hosts, Surely this **iniquity** shall not be purged from you till ye die, saith the Lord GOD of hosts. Isaiah 22:14

For, behold, the LORD cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their **iniquity**: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain. Isaiah 26:21

By this therefore shall the **iniquity** of Jacob be purged; and this is all the fruit to take away his sin; when he maketh all the stones of the altar as chalkstones that are beaten in sunder, the groves and images shall not stand up. Isaiah 27:9

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for **iniquity** are cut off: Isaiah 29:20

Therefore this **iniquity** shall be to you as a breach ready to fall, swelling out in a high wall, whose breaking cometh suddenly at an instant. Isaiah 30:13

Yet he also is wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back his words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that work **iniquity**. Isaiah 31:2

For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work **iniquity**, to practise hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD, to make empty the soul of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail. Isaiah 32:6

And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their **iniquity**. Isaiah 33:24

Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her **iniquity** is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD'S hand double for all her sins. Isaiah 40:2

Thou hast bought me no sweet cane with money, neither hast thou filled me with the fat of thy sacrifices: but thou hast made me to serve with thy sins, thou hast wearied me with thine **iniquities**. Isaiah 43:24

Thus saith the LORD, Where is the bill of your mother's divorcement, whom I have put away? Or which of my creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold, for your **iniquities** have ye sold yourselves, and for your transgressions is your mother put away. Isaiah 50:1

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all...He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. Isaiah 53:5-6, 11

For the **iniquity** of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart. Isaiah 57:17

But your *iniquities* have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with *iniquity*; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness. None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth *iniquity*. They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper. Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: Isaiah 59:2-6a

Their works are works of **iniquity**, and the acts of violence is in their hands. Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood; their thoughts are thoughts of **iniquity**; wasting and destruction are in their paths. Isaiah 59:6-7

For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our **iniquities**, we know them; Isaiah 59:12

But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our **iniquities**, like the wind, have taken us away. And there is none that calleth upon thy name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of thee: for thou hast hid thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our **iniquities**...Be not wroth very sore, O LORD, neither remember **iniquity** for ever: behold, see, we beseech thee, we are all thy people. Isaiah 64:6-7, 9

Thus saith the LORD, What **iniquity** have your fathers found in me, that they are gone far from me, and have walked after vanity, and are become vain? ... For though thou wash thee with nitre, and take thee such soap, yet thine **iniquity** is marked before me, saith the Lord GOD. Jeremiah 2:5, 22

Only acknowledge thine **iniquity**, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 3:13

Your **iniquities** have turned away these things, and your sins have withholden good things from you. Jeremiah 5:25

And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit **iniquity**. Jeremiah 9:5

They are turned back to the **iniquities** of their forefathers, which refused to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken my covenant which I made with their fathers. Jeremiah 11:10

And if thou say in thine heart, Wherefore come these things upon me? For the greatness of thine **iniquity** are thy skirts discovered, and thy heels made bare. Jeremiah 13:22

O LORD, though our **iniquities** testify against us, do thou it for thy name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against thee. Jeremiah 14:7

Thus saith the LORD unto this people, Thus have they loved to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD doth not accept them; he will now remember their **iniquity**, and visit their sins. Jeremiah 14:10

We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, and the **iniquity** of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee. Jeremiah 14:20

And it shall come to pass, when thou shalt shew this people all these words, and they shall say unto thee, Wherefore hath the LORD pronounced all this great evil against us? Or what is our **iniquity**? Or what is our sin that we have committed against the LORD our God? Jeremiah 16:10

For mine eyes are upon all their ways: they are not hid from my face, neither is their **iniquity** hid from mine eyes. And first I will recompense their **iniquity** and their sin double; because they have defiled my land, they have filled mine inheritance with the carcases of their detestable and abominable things. Jeremiah 16:17-18

Yet, LORD, thou knowest all their counsel against me to slay me: forgive not their **iniquity**, neither blot out their sin from thy sight, but let them be overthrown before thee; deal thus with them in the time of thine anger. *Jeremiah* 18:23

And it shall come to pass, when seventy years are accomplished, that I will punish the king of Babylon, and that nation, saith the LORD, for their **iniquity**, and the land of the Chaldeans, and will make it perpetual desolations. Jeremiah 25:12

All thy lovers have forgotten thee; they seek thee not; for I have wounded thee with the wound of an enemy, with the chastisement of a cruel one, for the multitude of thine **iniquity**; because thy sins were increased. Why criest thou for thine affliction? Thy sorrow is incurable for the multitude of thine **iniquity**: because thy sins were increased, I have done these things unto thee. Jeremiah 30:14-15

But every one shall die for his own **iniquity**: every man that eateth the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge. Jeremiah 31:30

And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their **iniquity**, and I will remember their sins no more. Jeremiah 31:34

Thou shewest lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompensest the *iniquity* of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty God, the LORD of hosts, is his name. Jeremiah 32:18

And I will cleanse them from all their **iniquity**, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their **iniquities**, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me. Jeremiah 33:8

It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the evil which I purpose to do unto them; that they may return every man from his evil way; that I may forgive their **iniquity** and their sin. Jeremiah 36:3

And I will punish him and his seed and his servants for their **iniquity**; and I will bring upon them, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and upon the men of Judah, all the evil that I have pronounced against them; but they hearkened not. Jeremiah 36:31

In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the **iniquity** of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I reserve. Jeremiah 50:20

Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her **iniquity**; for this is the time of the LORD'S vengenance; he will render unto her a recompence. Jeremiah 51:6

Thy prophets have seen vain and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine **iniquity**, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of banishment. Lamentations 2:14

For the punishment of the **iniquity** of the daughter of my people is greater than the punishment of the sin of Sodom, that was overthrown as in a moment, and no hands stayed on her. Lamentations 4:6

For the sins of her prophets, and the **iniquities** of her priests, that have shed the blood of the just in the midst of her, They have wandered as blind men in the streets, they have polluted themselves with blood, so that men could not touch their garments. Lamentations 4:13-14

The punishment of thine **iniquity** is accomplished, O daughter of Zion; he will no more carry thee away into captivity: he will visit thine **iniquity**, O daughter of Edom; he will discover thy sins. Lamentations 4:22

Our fathers have sinned, and are not; and we have borne their **iniquities**. Lamentations 5:7

When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his **iniquity**; but his blood will I require at thine hand. Yet if thou warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his **iniquity**; but thou hast delivered thy soul. Again, When a righteous man doth turn from his righteousness, and commit **iniquity**, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die; because thou hast not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he hath done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at thine hand. Ezekiel 3:18-20

Lie thou also upon thy left side, and lay the **iniquity** of the house of Israel upon it: according to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon it thou shalt bear their **iniquity**. For I have laid upon thee the years of their **iniquity**, according to the number of the days, three hundred and ninety days: so shalt thou bear the **iniquity** of the house of Israel. And when thou hast accomplished them, lie again on thy right side, and thou shalt bear the **iniquity** of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed thee each day for a year. Ezekiel 4:4-6

That they may want bread and water, and be astonied one with another, and consume away for their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 4:17

For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they were yet alive: for the vision is touching the whole multitude thereof, which shall not return; neither shall any strengthen himself in the **iniquity** of his life. They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goeth to the battle: for my wrath is upon all the multitude thereof. Ezekiel 7:13

They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumblingblock of their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 7:19

Then said he unto me, The **iniquity** of the house is Israel and Judah is exceeding great, and the land is full of blood, and the city full of perverseness: for they say, the LORD hath forsaken the earth, and the LORD seeth not. Ezekiel 9:9

But they that escape of them shall escape, and shall be on the mountains like doves of the valleys, all of them mourning, every one for his **iniquity**. Ezekiel 14:10

Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their **iniquity** before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them? Therefore speak unto them, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Every man of the house of Israel that setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his **iniquity** before his face, and cometh to the prophet; I the LORD will answer him that cometh according to the multitude of his idols. Ezekiel 14:3-4

For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourneth in Israel, which separateth himself from me, and setteth up his idols in his heart, and putteth the stumblingblock of his **iniquity** before his face, and cometh to a prophet to enquire of him concerning me; I the LORD will answer him by myself: Ezekiel 14:7

Behold, this was the **iniquity** of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. Ezekiel 16:49

He that hath not given forth upon usury, neither hath taken any increase, that hath withdrawn his hand from **iniquity**, hath executed true judgment between man and man. Ezekiel 18:8

That hath taken his hand from the poor, that hath not received usury nor increase, hath executed my judgments, hath walked in my statutes; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live. As for his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did that which is not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his iniquity. Yet say ye, Why? Doth not the son bear the iniquity of the father? When the son hath done that which is lawful and right, and hath kept all my statutes, and hath done them, he shall surely live. Ezekiel 18:17-19

The soul that sinneth, it shall die. The son shall not bear the **iniquity** of the father, neither shall be father bear the **iniquity** of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him. Ezekiel 18:20

But when the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth **iniquity**, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he hath trespassed, and in his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die. Ezekiel 18:24

When a righteous man turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth **iniquity**, and dieth in them; for his **iniquity** that he hath done shall he die. Ezekiel 18:26

Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the Lord God. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so **iniquity** shall not be your ruin. Ezekiel 18:30

And it shall be unto them as a false divination in their sight, to them that have sworn oaths: but he will call to remembrance the **iniquity**, that they may be taken. Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have made your **iniquity** to be remembered, in that your transgressions are discovered, so that in all your doings your sins do appear; because, I say, that ye are come to remembrance, ye shall be taken with the land. And thou, profane wicked prince of Israel, whose day is come, when **iniquity** shall have an end... Whiles they see vanity unto thee, whiles they divine a lie unto thee, to bring thee upon the necks of them that are slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their **iniquity** shall have an end. Ezekiel 21:23-25, 29

And your tires shall be upon your heads, and your shoes upon your feet: ye shall not mourn nor weep; but ye shall pine away for your **iniquities**, and mourn one toward another. Ezekiel 24:23

Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till **iniquity** was found in thee... Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine **iniquities**, by the **iniquity** of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee. Ezekiel 28:15, 18

And it shall be no more the confidence of the house of Israel, which bringeth their **iniquity** to remembance, when they shall look after them: but they shall know that I am the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 29:16

And they shall not lie with the mighty that are fallen of the uncircumcised, which are gone down to hell with their weapons of war: and they have laid their swords under their heads, but their **iniquities** shall be upon their bones, though they were the terror of the mighty in the land of the living. Ezekiel 32:27

But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his **iniquity**; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand. Ezekiel 33:6

When I say unto the wicked, O wicked man, thou shalt surely die; if thou dost not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his **iniquity**; but his blood will I require at thine hand. Nevertheless, if thou warn the wicked of his way to turn from it; if he do not turn from his way, he shall die in his **iniquity**; but thou hast delivered thy soul. Ezekiel 33:8-9

When I shall say to the righteous, that he shall surely live; if he trust to his own righteousness, and commit **iniquity**, all his righteousnesses shall not be remembered; but for his **iniquity** that he hath committed, he shall die for it. Ezekiel 33:13

If the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statues of life, without committing **iniquity**; he shall surely live, he shall not die... When the righteous turneth from his righteousness, and committeth **iniquity**, he shall even die thereby. Ezekiel 33:15, 18

Because thou hast had a perpetual hatred, and hast shed the blood of the children of Israel by the force of the sword in the time of their calamity, in the time that their **iniquity** had an end: Ezekiel 35:5

Then shall ye remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for your **iniquities** and for your abominations... Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day that I shall have cleansed you from all your iniquities I will also cause you to dwell in the cities, and the wastes shall be builded. Ezekiel 36:31, 33

And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their **iniquity**: because they trespassed against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword. Ezekiel 39:23

Thou son of man, shew the house to the house of Israel, that they may be ashamed of their **iniquities**: and let them measure the pattern. Ezekiel 43:10

And the Levites that are gone away far from me, when Israel went astray, which went away from me after their idols; they shall even bear their iniquity. Ezekiel 44:10

Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Israel to fall into **iniquity**; therefore have I lifted up mine hand against them, saith the Lord GOD, and they shall bear their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 44:12

Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine **iniquities** by shewing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity. Daniel 4:27

We have sinned, and have committed **iniquity**, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments: Daniel 9:5

As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our **iniquities**, and understand thy truth. Daniel 9:13

O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, the holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the **iniquities** of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people are become a reproach to all that are about us. Daniel 9:16

Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for **iniquity**, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:24

They eat up the sin of my people, and they set their heart on their **iniquity**. Hosea 4:8

And the pride of Israel doth testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their **iniquity**; Judah also shall fall with them. Hosea 5:5

When I would have healed Israel, then the **iniquity** of Ephraim was discovered, and the wickedness of Samaria: for they commit falsehood; and the thief cometh in, and the troop of robbers spoileth without. Hosea 7:1

They sacrifice flesh for the sacrifices of mine offerings, and eat it; but the LORD accepteth them not; now will he remember their **iniquity**, and visit their sins: they shall return to Egypt. Hosea 8:13

The days of visitation are come, the days of recompence are come; Israel shall know it: the prophet is a fool, the spiritual man is mad, for the multitude of thine **iniquity**, and the great hatred...They have deeply corrupted themselves, as in the days of Gibeah: therefore he will remember their **iniquity**, he will visit their sins. Hosea 9:7, 9

O Israel, thou hast sinned from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of **iniquity** did not overtake them... Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped **iniquity**; ye have eaten the fruit of lies: because thou didst trust in thy way, in the multitude of thy mighty men. Hosea 10:9, 13

And Ephraim said, Yet I am become rich, I have found me out substance: in all my labours they shall find none **iniquity** in me that were sin...Is there **iniquity** in Gilead? Surely they are vanity: they sacrifice bullocks in Gilgal; yea, their altars are as heaps in the furrows of the fields. Hosea 12:8, 11

O Israel, return unto the LORD thy God; for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity. Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips. Hosea 14:1-2

You only have I known of all the families of the earth: therefore I will punish you for all your **iniquities**. Amos 3:2

Woe to them that devise **iniquity**, and work evil upon their beds! When the morning is light, they practice it, because it is in the power of their hand. Micah 2:1

Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth **iniquity**, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? He retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth in mercy. He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our **iniquities**; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Micah 7:18-19

Why dost thou shew me **iniquity**, and cause me to behold grievance? For spoiling and violence are before me: and there are that raise up strife and contention. Habakkuk 1:3

Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on **iniquity**: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, and holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth the man that is more righteous than he? Habakkuk 1:13

Woe to him that buildeth a town with blood, and stablisheth a city by iniquity! Habakkuk 2:12

The just LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do **iniquity**: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame. Zephaniah 3:5

The remnant of Israel shall not do **iniquity**, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Zephaniah 3:13

And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine **iniquity** to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment. Zechariah 3:4

For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, saith the LORD of hosts, and I will remove the **iniquity** of that land in one day. Zechariah 3:9

The law of truth was in his mouth, and **iniquity** was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from **iniquity**. Malachi 2:6

INIQUITY IN THE NEW COVENANT

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work **iniquity**. Matthew 7:22-23

The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do **iniquity**; Matthew 13:41

Even so ye also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within ye are full of hypocrisy and **iniquity**. Matthew 23:28

And because **iniquity** shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. Matthew 24:12

But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of *iniquity*. Luke 13:27

Now this man purchased a field with the reward of **iniquity**; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. Acts 1:18

For I perceive that thou art in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of iniquity. Acts 8:23

Saying, Blessed are they whose **iniquities** are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Romans 4:7

I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to **iniquity** unto **iniquity**; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. Romans 6:19

Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; 1 Corinthians 13:6

For the mystery of *iniquity* doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. 2 Thessalonians 2:7

Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from **iniquity**. 2 Timothy 2:19

Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all **iniquity**, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Titus 2:14

Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated **iniquity**; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows. Hebrews 1:9

For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. Hebrews 8:12

He had said before, This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and **iniquities** will I remember no more. Hebrews 10:15-17

And the tongue is a fire, a world of **iniquity**: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell. James 3:6

But was rebuked for his **iniquity**: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. 2 Peter 2:16

For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities. Revelations 18:5

MISCHIEF

But Benjamin, Joseph's brother, Jacob sent not with his brethren; for he said, Lest peradventure **mischief** befall him. Genesis 42:4

And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if **mischief** befall him by the way in the which ye go, then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave. Genesis 42:38

And if ye take this also from me, and **mischief** befall him, ye shall bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave. Genesis 44:29

If men strive, and hurt a woman with child, so that her fruit depart from her, and yet no **mischief** follow: he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the judges determine. And if any **mischief** follow, then thou shalt give life for life... Exodus 21:22-23

Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For **mischief** did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people. Exodus 32:12

And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they are set on **mischief**. Exodus 32:22

I will heap **mischiefs** upon them; I will spend mine arrows upon them. Deuteronomy 32:23

And David knew that Saul secretly practised **mischief** against him; and he said to Abiathar the priest, Bring hither the ephod. 1 Samuel 23:9

The LORD hath returned upon thee all the blood of the house of Saul, in whose stead thou hast reigned; and the LORD hath delivered the kingdom into the hand of Absalom thy son: and behold, thou art taken in thy mischief, because thou art a bloody man. 2 Samuel 16:8

And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the **mischief** that Hadad did: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria. 1 Kings 11:25

Then the king of Israel called all the elders of the land, and said, Mark, I pray you, and see how this man seeketh **mischief**; for he sent unto me for my wives, and for my children, and for my silver, and for my gold; and I denied him not. 1 Kings 20:7

Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some **mischief** will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household. 2 Kings 7:9

That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in some one of the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me **mischief**. Nehemiah 6:2

And Esther spake yet again before the king, and fell down at his feet, and besought him with tears to put away the **mischief** of Haman the Agagite, and his device that he had devised against the Jews. Esther 8:3

They conceive **mischief**, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit. Job 15:35

Behold, he travaileth with iniquity, and hath conceived **mischief**, and brought forth falsehood. He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch which he made. His **mischief** shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate. Psalm 7:14-16

His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue is **mischief** and vanity. Psalm 10:7

Thou hast seen it; for thou beholdest **mischief** and spite, to requite it with thy hand: the poor committeth himself unto thee; thou art the helper of the fatherless. Psalm 10:15

For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a **mischievous** device, which they are not able to perform. Psalm 21:11

In whose hands is **mischief**, and their right hand is full of bribes. Psalm 26:10

Draw me now away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity, which speak peace to their neighbours, but **mischief** is in their hearts. Psalm 28:3

He deviseth **mischief** upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way that is not good; he abhorreth not evil. Psalm 36:4

They also that seek after my life lay snares for me: and they that seek my hurt speak **mischievous** things, and imagine deceits all the day long. Psalm 38:12

Why boastest thou thyself in **mischief**, O mighty man? The goodness of God endureth continually. Thy tongue deviseth **mischiefs**; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully. Psalm 52:1-2

Day and night they go about it upon the walls thereof: **mischief** also and sorrow are in the midst of it. Psalm 55:10

How long will ye imaging **mischief** against a man? Ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall shall ye be, and as a tottering fence. Psalm 62:3

Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth **mischief** by a law? Psalm 94:20

They draw nigh that follow after **mischief**: they are far from the law. Psalm 119:150

Deliver me, O Lord, from the evil man... Which imagine **mischiefs** in their heart; continually are they gathered together for war. Psalm 140:2

As for the head of those that compass me about, let the **mischief** of their own lips cover them. Psalm 140:9

For they sleep not, except they have done **mischief**; and their sleep is taken away, unless they cause some to fall. Proverbs 4:16

Frowardness is in his heart, he deviseth **mischief** continually; he soweth discord. Proverbs 6:14

An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to **mischief**. Proverbs 6:18

It is as sport to a fool to do **mischief**; but a man of understanding hath wisdom. Proverbs 10:23

He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him. Proverbs 11:27

There shall no evil happen to the just; but the wicked shall be filled with **mischief**. Proverbs 12:21

A wicked messenger falleth into **mischief**: but a faithful ambassador is health. Proverbs 13:17

He that hath a froward heart findeth no good: and he that hath a perverse tongue falleth into **mischief**. Proverbs 17:20

PRIDE

Now I know that the LORD is greater than all gods: for in the thing wherein they dealt **proudly** he was above them. Exodus 18:11

I will break the **pride** of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass: Leviticus 26:19

Talk no more so exceeding **proudly**; let not **arrogancy** come out of your mouth: for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed. 1 Samuel 2:3

Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why camest thou down hither? and with whom hast thou left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know thy **pride**, and the naughtiness of thine heart; for thou art come down that thou mightest see the battle. 1 Samuel 17:28

Nothwitstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the **pride** of his heart, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah. 2 Chronicles 32:26

And shewedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt **proudly** against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as it is this day... They and our fathers dealt **proudly**, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments... and testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt **proudly**, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear. Nehemiah 9:10, 16, 29

If God will not withdraw his anger, the **proud** helpers do stoop under him. He divideth the sea with his power, and by his understanding he smiteth through the **proud**. Job 9:13, 26:12

For God speaketh once, yea twice, yet man perceiveth it not. In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed; Then openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction, That he withdraw man from his purpose, and hide **pride** from man. He keepth back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword. Job 33:14-18

There they cry, but none giveth answer, because of the **pride** of evil men. Surely God will not hear vanity, neither will the Almighty regard it. Job 35:12-13

Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence from the **pride** of man: thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues... O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the **proud** doer. Psalm 31:20, 23

Let not the foot of **pride** come against me, and let not the hand of the wicked remove me. Psalm 36:11

Blessed is that man that maketh the LORD his trust, and respecteth not the **proud**, nor such as turn aside to lies. Psalm 40:4

For the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips let them even be taken in their **pride**: and for cursing and lying which they speak. Psalm 59:12

I was envious at the foolish, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. For there are no bands in their death: but their strength is firm. They are not in trouble as other men: neither are they plagued like other men. Therefore **pride** compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them as a garment. Psalm 73:3-6

O God, the **proud** are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them. Psalm 86:14

Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the **proud**. Psalm 94:2

Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a **proud** heart will not I suffer. Psalm 101:5

Thou hast rebuked the **proud** that are cursed, which do err from thy commandments. Psalm 119:21

The **proud** have had me greatly in derision: yet have I not declined from thy law. Psalm 119:51

The **proud** have forged a lie against me: but I will keep thy precepts with my whole heart...Let the **proud** be ashamed; for they dealt perversely with me without a cause: but I will meditate in thy precepts. Psalm 119:69, 78

The **proud** have digged pits for me, which are not after thy law. Psalm 119:85

Be surety for thy servant for good: let not the **proud** oppress me. Psalm 119:122

Our soul is exceedingly filled with the scorning of those that are at ease, and with the contempt of the **proud**. Psalm 123:4

Then they had swallowed us up quick, when their wrath was kindled against us: then the waters had overwhelmed us, the stream had gone over our soul: Then the **proud** waters had gone over our soul. Psalm 124:3-5

Though the LORD be high, yet hath he respect unto the lowly: but the **proud** he knoweth afar off. Psalm 138:6

The **proud** have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah. Psalm 140:5

These six things doth the LORD hath: yea, seven are an abomination unto him: A **proud** look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief. A false witness that speaketh lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19

The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: **pride**, and **arrogancy**, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate. Proverbs 8:13

When **pride** cometh, then cometh shame: but with the lowly is wisdom. Proverbs 11:2

Only by **pride** cometh contention: but with the well advised is wisdom. Proverbs 13:10

In the mouth of the foolish is a rod of **pride**: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them. Proverbs 14:3

The LORD will destroy the house of the **proud**: but he will establish the border of the widow. Proverbs 15:25

Every one that is **proud** in heart is an abomination to the LORD: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished...**Pride** goeth before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the **proud**. Proverbs 16:5, 18-19

An high look, and a **proud** heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin...**Proud** and haughty scorner is his name, who dealeth in **proud** wrath. Proverbs 21:4, 24

He that is of a **proud** heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat. Proverbs 28:25

A man's **pride** shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit. Proverbs 29:23

Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the patient in spirit is better than the **proud** in spirit. Ecclesiastes 7:8

For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is **proud** and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low: Isaiah 2:12

And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself **proudly** against the ancient, and the base against the honourable. Isaiah 3:5

And all the people shall know, even Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria, that say in the **pride** and stoutness of heart, The bricks are fallen down, but we will build with hewn stones... Isaiah 9:9-10

And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the **arrogancy** of the **proud** to cease, and will lay low the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:11

We have heard of the **pride** of Moab; he is very **proud**: even of his haughtiness, and his **pride**, and his wrath: but his lies shall not be so. Isaiah 16:6

The Lord of hosts hath purposed it, to stain the **pride** of all glory, and to bring into contempt all the honourable of the earth. Isaiah 23:9

And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swimmeth spreadeth forth his hands to swim: and he shall bring down their **pride** together with the spoils of their hands. Isaiah 25:11

Woe to the crown of **pride**, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty is a fading flower, which are on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine! Then spake Azariah the son of Hoshaiah, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the **proud** men, saying unto Jeremiah, Thou speakest falsely: the LORD our God hath not sent thee to say, Go not into Egypt to sojourn there: Jeremiah 43:2

We have heard the pride of Moab, (he is exceeding proud) his loftiness, and his **arrogancy**, and his **pride**, and the haughtiness of his heart. Jeremiah 48:29

Thy terribleness hath deceived thee, and the **pride** of thine heart, O thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, that holdest the height of the hill: thou thou shouldest make thy nest as high as the eagle, I will bring thee down from thence, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 49:16

Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her: for she hath been **proud** against the LORD, against the Holy One of Israel. Jeremiah 50:29

Behold, I am against thee, O thou most **proud**, saith the Lord GOD of hosts: for thy day is come, the time that I will visit thee. And the most **proud** shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him. Jeremiah 50:31-32

Behold, the day, behold, it is come: the morning is gone forth; the rod hath blossomed, **pride** hath budded. Ezekiel 7:10

Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, **pride**, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy...For thy sister Sodom was not mentioned by thy mouth in the day of thy **pride**... Ezekiel 16:49, 56

Thus saith the LORD; they also that uphold Egypt shall fall; and the **pride** of her power shall come down: from the tower of Syene shall they fall in it by the sword, saith the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 30:6

All the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth...Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works are truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in **pride** he is able also to abase. Daniel 4:37

When his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in **pride**, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him...till he knew that the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men. Daniel 5:20

The **pride** of Israel doth testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them...and the **pride** of Israel testifieth to his face: and they do not return to the LORD their God, nor seek him for all this. Hosea 5:5, 7:10

The **pride** of thine heart hath deceived thee, thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that saith in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground?...But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest thou have spoken **proudly** in the day of distress. Obadiah 1:3, 12

Yea, also, because he transgresseth by wine, he is a **proud** man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people: Habakkuk 2:5

This shall they have for their **pride**, because they have reproached and magnified themselves against the people of the LORD of hosts. Zephaniah 2:10

In that day shalt thou be not ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy **pride**, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my holy mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and he will smite her power in the sea...A bastard shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will cut off the **pride** of the Philistines. Zechariah 9:6

He shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves of the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the **pride** of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away. Zechariah 10:11

There is a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the **pride** of Jordan is spoiled. Zechariah 11:3

Now we call the **proud** happy; yea, they that work wickedness are set up; yea, they that tempt God are even delivered. Malachi 3:15

NEW COVENANT PRIDE

For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, **pride**, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man. Mark 7:21-23

He hath shewed strength with his arm; he hath scattered the **proud** in the imagination of their hearts. Luke 1:51

... They did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28-32

A bishop then must be...one that ruleth well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he then take care of the church of God?) Not a novice, lest being lifted up with **pride** he fall into the condemnation of the devil. 1 Timothy 3:4-6

If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness He is **proud**, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. But godliness with contentment is great gain. 1 Timothy 6:3-5

This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, **proud**, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 2 Timothy 3:1-5

From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts. Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? Whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up. James 4:1-10

Ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the **proud**, and giveth grace to the humble. Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you. 1 Peter 5:5-7

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the **pride** of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. 1.John 2:15-17

SNARES

Pharoah's servants said unto him, How long shall this man be a **snare** unto us? Let the men go, that they may serve the LORD their God: knowest thou not yet that Egypt is destroyed! Exodus 10:7

They shall not dwell in thy land, lest they make thee sin against me: for if thou serve other gods, it will surely be a **snare** unto thee. Exodus 23:33

Take heed to thyself, lest thou make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land whither thou goest, lest it be for a **snare** in the midst of thee. Exodus 34:12

Thou shalt consume all the people which the LORD thy God shall deliver thee; thine eye shall have no pity upon them: neither shalt thou serve their gods; for that will be a **snare** unto thee. Deuteronomy 7:16

Know for a certainty that the LORD your God will no more drive out any of these nations from before you; but they shall be **snares** and traps unto you, and scourges in your sides, and thorns in your eyes, until ye perish from off this good land which the LORD your God hath given you. I also said, I will not drive them out from before you; but they shall be as thorns in your sides, and their gods shall be a **snare** unto you. Judges 2:3

The woman said unto him, Behold, thou knowest what Saul hath done, how he hath cut off those that have familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land: wherefore then layest thou a **snare** for my life, to cause me to die? 1 Samuel 28:9

The sorrows of hell compassed me about; the **snares** of death prevented me. 2 Samuel 22:6

For he is cast into a net by his own feet, and he walketh upon a **snare**. The gin shall take him by the heel, and the robber shall prevail against him. The **snare** is laid for him in the ground, and a trap for him in the way. Job 18:8-10

Therefore **snares** are round about thee, and sudden fear troubleth thee... *Job 22:10*

He taketh it with his eyes: his nose pierceth through snares. Job 40:24

Upon the wicked he shall rain **snares**, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: this shall be the portion of their cup. Psalm 11:6

The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the **snares** of death prevented me. Psalm 18:5

They encourage themselves in an evil matter: they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them? Psalm 64:5

Let their table become a **snare** before them: and that which should have been for their welfare, let it become a trap. Psalm 69:22

Surely he shall deliver thee from the **snare** of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. Psalm 91:3

They served their idols: which were a snare unto them. Psalm 106:36

The wicked have laid a **snare** for me: yet I erred not from thy precepts. Psalm 119:110

Our soul is escaped as a bird out of the **snare** of the fowlers: the **snare** is broken, and we are escaped. Psalm s124:7

The proud have hid a **snare** for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah. Psalm 140:5

Keep me from the **snares** which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity. Psalm 141:9

When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a **snare** for me. Psalm 142:3

With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him. He goeth after her straitway, as an ox goeth to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks; Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hasteth to the **snare**, and knoweth not that it is for his life. Proverbs 7:21-23

The law of the wise is a fountain of life, to depart from the **snares** of death. Proverbs 13:14

The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the **snares** of death. Proverbs 14:27

A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the **snare** of his soul. Proverbs 18:7

It is a **snare** to the man who devoureth that which is holy, and after vows to make enquiry. Proverbs 20:25

Thorns and **snares** are in the way of the froward: he that doth keep his soul shall be far from them. Proverbs 22:5

Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go: lest thou learn his ways, and get a **snare** to thy soul. Proverbs 22:24-25

In the transgression of an evil man there is a **snare**: but the righteous doth sing and rejoice. Proverbs 29:6

Scornful men bring a city into a **snare**; but wise men turn away wrath. Proverbs 29:8

The fear of man bringeth a **snare**: but whoso putteth his trust in the LORD shall be safe. Proverbs 29:25

I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart is **snares** and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her. Ecclesiastes 7:26

For man also knoweth not his time: as the fishes that are taken in an evil net, and as the birds that are caught in the **snare**; so are the sons of men **snared** in an evil time, when it falleth suddenly upon them. Ecclesiastes 9:12

He shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a **snare** to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Isaiah 8:14

Fear, and the pit, and the **snare**, are upon thee, O inhabitant of the earth. And it shall come to pass, that he who fleeth from the noise of the fear shall fall into the pit; and he that cometh up out of the midst of the pit shall be taken in the **snare**: for the windows from on high are open, and the foundations of the earth do shake. Isaiah 24:17-18

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for iniquity are cut off: That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a **snare** for him that reproveth in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought. Isaiah 29:20-21

For among my people are found wicked men: they lay wait, as he that setteth **snares**; they set a trap, they catch men. Jeremiah 5:26

Let a cry be heard from their houses, when thou shalt bring a troop suddenly upon them: for they have digged a pit to take me, and hid **snares** for my feet. Jeremiah 18:22

Fear, and the pit, and the **snare**, shall be upon thee, O inhabitant of Moab, saith the LORD. He that fleeth from the fear shall fall into the pit; and he that getteth up out of the pit shall be taken in the **snare**: for I will bring upon it, even upon Moab, the year of their visitation, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 48:43-44

I have laid a **snare** for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD. Jeremiah 50:24

Fear and a **snare** is come upon us, desolation and destruction. Lamentations 3:45

My net also will I spread upon him, and he shall be taken in my **snare**: and I will bring him to Babylon to the land of the Chaldeans; yet shall he not see it, though he shall die there. Ezekiel 12:13

I will spread my net upon him, and he shall be taken in my **snare**, and I will bring him to Babylon, and will plead with him there for his trespass that he hath trespassed against me. Ezekiel 17:20

Hear ye this, O priests; and hearken, ye house of Israel; and give ye ear, O house of the king; for judgment is toward you, because ye have been a **snare** on Mizpah, and a net spread upon Tabor. Hosea 5:1

The watchman of Ephraim was with my God: but the prophet is a **snare** of a fowler in all his ways, and hatred in the house of his God. Hosea 9:8

Can a bird fall in a **snare** upon the earth, where no gin is for him? Shall one take up a **snare** from the earth, and have taken nothing at all? Amos 3:5

SNARE IN THE NEW COVENANT

Take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. For as a **snare** shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man. Luke 21:34-36

David saith, Let their table be made a **snare**, and a trap, and a stumblingblock, and a recompence unto them... Romans 11:9

There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit; but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband. This I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a **snare** upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction. 1 Corinthians 7:34-35

A bishop then must be blameless...Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the **snare** of the devil. 1 Timothy 3:2, 7

Having food and raiment let us be therewith content. But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a **snare**, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. 1 Timothy 6:8-9

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the **snare** of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:26

TRUTH ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

The **transgressors** shall be destroyed together: the end of the wicked shall be cut off. Psalm 37:38

I beheld the **transgressors**, and was grieved; because they kept not thy word. Psalm 119:158

The wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the **transgressors** shall be rooted out of it. Proverbs 2:22

The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them... The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them: but transgressors shall be taken in their own naughtiness. Proverbs 11:3, 6

A man shall eat good by the fruit of his mouth: but the soul of the transgressors shall eat violence. Proverbs 13:2

Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of the **transgressors** is hard. Proverbs 13:15

A divine sentence is in the lips of the king: his mouth **transgresseth** not in judgement. Proverbs 16:10

The wicked shall be a ransom for the righteous, and the **transgressor** for the upright. Proverbs 21:18

A whore is a deep ditch; and a strange woman is a narrow pit. She also lieth in wait as for a prey, and increaseth the **transgressors** among men. Proverbs 23:27-28

To have respect of persons is not good: for for a piece of bread that man will transgress. Proverbs 28:21

Wherefore will ye plead with me? Ye all have transgressed against me, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 2:29

If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well: But if ye have respect to persons, ye commit sin, and are convinced of the law as **transgressors**. James 2:9

Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law; for sin is the transgression of the law. 1 John 3:4

TEACHINGS ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

Why do thy disciples **transgress** the tradition of the elders? For they wash not their hands when they eat bread. But he answered and said unto them, Why do ye also **transgress** the commandment of God by your tradition? Matthew 15:2-3

He answering said to his father, Lo, these many years do I serve thee, neither **transgressed** I at any time thy commandment: and yet thou never gavest me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends: But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf. And he said unto him, Son, thou art ever with me, and all that I have is thine. It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found. Luke 15:29-32

If the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision? and shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcison dost **transgress** the law? For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God. Romans 2:26-29

If I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor... Wherefore then serveth the law? It was added because of transgressions, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made; and it was ordained by angels in the hand of a mediator. Galatians 2:18, 3:19

He is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the **transgression**s that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. Hebrews 9:15

For he that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if thou commit no adultery, yet if thou kill, thou art become a **transgressor** of the law. James 2:11

Whosoever **transgresseth**, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. 2 John 1:9

PROPHECIES ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

Yea, thou heardest not; yea, thou knewest not; yea, from that time that thine ear was not opened: for I knew that thou wouldest deal very treacherously, and was called a **transgressor** from the womb. For my name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut thee not off. Isaiah 48:8-9

Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the **transgressors**; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the **transgressors**. Isaiah 53:12

They shall go forth, and look upon the carcases of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh. Isaiah 66:24

In the latter time of their kingdom, when the **transgressors** are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up. And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practise, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people. And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand. Daniel 8:23-25

In that day shalt thou not be ashamed for all thy doings, wherein thou hast transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of thee them that rejoice in thy pride, and thou shalt no more be haughty because of my holy mountain. I will also leave in the midst of thee an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD. The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Zephaniah 3:11-13

The scripture was fulfilled, which saith, And he was numbered with the transgressors. Mark 15:28

The Lord said...For I say unto you, that this that is written must yet be accomplished in me, And he was reckoned among the **transgressors**: for the things concerning me have an end. Luke 22:37

CONSEQUENCES OF TRANSGRESSION

Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your **transgressions**: for my name is in him. But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. Exodus 23:20-22

And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: Leviticus 16:21

They rose up early in the morning, and gat them up into the top of the mountain, saying, Lo, we be here, and will go up unto the place which the LORD hath promised: for we have sinned. And Moses said, Wherefore now do ye transgress the commandment of the LORD? But it shall not prosper. Go not up, for the LORD is not among you; that ye be not smitten before your enemies...But they presumed to go up unto the hill top: nevertheless the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and Moses, departed not out of the camp. Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanite which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, even unto Hormah. Numbers 14:41-45

He shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their **transgressions** in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remaineth among them in the midst of their uncleanness. Leviticus 16:16

If there be found among you, within any of thy gates which the LORD thy God giveth thee, man or woman, that hath wrought wickedness in the sight of the LORD thy God, in **transgressing** his covenant, and hath gone and served other gods, and worshipped them, either the sun, or moon, or any of the host of heaven, which I have not commanded; and it be told thee, and thou hast heard of it, and inquired diligently, and, behold, it be true, and the thing certain, that such abomination is wrought in Israel: Then shalt thou bring forth that man or that woman, which have committed that wicked thing, unto thy gates, even that man or that woman, and shalt stone them with stones, till they die. Deut 17:2-5

Israel hath sinned, and they have also **transgressed** my covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put it even among their own stuff...And it shall be, that he that is taken with the accursed thing shall be burnt with fire, he and all that he hath: because he hath **transgressed** the covenant of the LORD, and because he hath wrought folly in Israel. Joshua 7:11, 15

When ye have **transgressed** the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and ye shall perish quickly from off the good land which he hath given unto you. Joshua 23:16

Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD. And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve...And Joshua said unto the people, Ye cannot serve the LORD: for he is an holy God; he is a jealous God; he will not forgive your **transgressions** nor your sins. If ye forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then he will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that he hath done you good. And the people said unto Joshua, Nay; but we will serve the LORD. Joshua 24:14-21

The anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people hath **transgressed** my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice; I also will not henceforth drive out any from before them of the nations which Joshua left when he died. Judges 2:20-21

Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And he said unto them, Why do ye such things? For I hear of your evil dealings by all this people. Nay, my sons; for it is no good report that I hear: ye make the LORD'S people to **transgress**. If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall entreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them...And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him... This shall be a sign unto thee, that shall come upon thy two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas; in one day they shall die both of them. 1 Samuel 2:22-25, 27,36

The people flew upon the spoil, and took sheep, and oxen, and calves, and slew them on the ground: and the people did eat them with the blood. They told Saul, saying, Behold, the people sin against the LORD, in that they eat with the blood. And he said, Ye have **transgressed**: roll a great stone unto me this day. 1 Samuel 14:32-33

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king. And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and thy words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD. And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with thee: for thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD hath rejected thee from being king over Israel. 1 Samuel 15:23-26

The king of Assyria did carry away Israel unto Assyria...Because they obeyed not the voice of the LORD their God, but **transgressed** his covenant, and all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded, and would not hear them, nor do them. 2 Kings 13:11-12

They **transgressed** against the God of their fathers, and went a whoring after the gods of the people of the land, whom God destroyed before them. And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away, even the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh, and brought them unto Halah, and Habor, and Hara, and to the river Gozan, unto this day. 1 Chronicles 5:25-26

It came to pass, when Rehoboam had established the kingdom, and had strengthened himself, he forsook the law of the LORD, and all Israel with him. And it came to pass that in the fifth year of king Rehoboam Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, because they had **transgressed** against the LORD... 2 Chronicles 12 1-2

The Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? Because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you. 2 Chronicles 24:20

When he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: for he transgressed against the LORD his God, and went into the temple of the LORD to burn incense upon the altar of incesses. 2 Chronicles 26:16

For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and **transgressed** sore against the LORD. 2 Chronicles 28:19

Moreover all the chief of the priests, and the people, **transgressed** very much after all the abominations of the heathen; and polluted the house of the LORD which he had hallowed in Jerusalem. 2 Chronicles 36:14

Ezra the priest stood up, and said unto them, Ye have **transgressed**, and have taken strange wives, to increase the trespass of Israel...but the people are many, and it is a time of much rain, and we are not able to stand without, neither is this a work of one day or two: for we are many that have **transgressed** in this thing. Ezra 10:10, 13

Remember, I beseech thee, the word that thou commandedst thy servant Moses, saying, If ye **transgress**, I will scatter you abroad among the nations. Nehemiah 1:8

Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? Yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish women cause to sin. Shall we then hearken unto you to do all this great evil, to **transgress** against our God in marrying strange wives? Nehemiah 13:26-27

Behold, God is mighty, and despiseth not any: he is mighty in strength and wisdom. He preserveth not the life of the wicked: but giveth right to the poor. He withdraweth not his eyes from the righteous: but with kings are they on the throne; yea, he doth establish them for ever, and they are exalted. And if they be bound in fetters, and be holden in cords of affliction; Then he sheweth them their work, and their transgressions that they have exceeded. He openeth also their ear to discipline, and commandeth that they return from iniquity. If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures. But if they obey not, they shall perish by the sword, and they shall die without knowledge. But the hypocrites in heart heap up wrath: they cry not when he bindeth them. Job 36:5-13

The eyes of the LORD preserve knowledge, and he overthroweth the words of the transgressor. Proverbs 22:12

The great God that formed all things both rewardeth the fool, and rewardeth transgressors. Proverbs 26:10

The destruction of the **transgressors** and of the sinners shall be together, and they that forsake the LORD shall be consumed. Isaiah 1:28

The earth mourneth and fadeth away, the world languisheth and fadeth away, the haughty people of the earth do languish. The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have **transgressed** the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore hath the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell therein are desolate: therefore the inhabitants of the earth are burned, and few men left. Isaiah 24:4-6

Thy first father hath sinned, and thy teachers have **transgressed** against me...Remember this, and shew yourselves men: bring it again to mind, O ye **transgressors**. Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying My counsel shall stand... Isaiah 43:27, 46:9-10

Thus saith the LORD, Where is the bill of your mother's divorcement, whom I have put away? Or which of my creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold, for your iniquities have ye sold yourselves, and for your transgressions is your mother put away. Isaiah 50:1

For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them; In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment. And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his righteousness, it sustained him. Isaiah 59:12-16

The priests said not, Where is the LORD? And they that handled the law knew me not: the pastors also **transgressed** against me, and the prophets prophesied by Baal, and walked after things that do not profit... For of old time I have broken thy yoke, and burst thy bands; and thou saidst, I will not **transgress**; when upon every high hill and under every green tree thou wanderest, playing the harlot. Jeremiah 2:8, 20

Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast **transgressed** against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 3:13

Wherefore a lion out of the forest shall slay them, and a wolf of the evenings shall spoil them, a leopard shall watch over their cities: every one that goeth out thence shall be torn in pieces: because their **transgressions** are many, and their backslidings are increased. Jeremiah 5:6

Ye have not hearkened unto me, in proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother, and every man to his neighbour; behold, I proclaim a liberty for you, saith the LORD, to the sword, to the pestilence, and to the famine; and I will make you to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth. And I will give the men that have **transgressed** my covenant, which have not performed the words of the covenant which they had made before me, when they cut the calf in twain, and passed between the parts thereof... I will even give them into the hand of their enemies... Jeremiah 34:17-20

For the LORD hath afflicted her for the multitude of her transgressions: her children are gone into captivity before the enemy... The yoke of my transgressions is bound by his hand: they are wreathed, and come up upon my neck: he hath made my strength to fail, the Lord hath delivered me into their hands, from whom I am not able to rise up. Lam 1:5, 14

Son of man, I send thee to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that hath rebelled against me: they and their fathers have **transgressed** against me, even unto this very day. Ezekiel 2:3

They shall bear the punishment of their iniquity: the punishment of the prophet shall be even as the punishment of him that seeketh unto him; That the house of Israel may go no more astray from me, neither be polluted any more with all their **transgressions**; but that they may be my people, and I may be their God, saith the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 14:10-11

Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel? Ezekiel 18:30-31

If the wicked will turn from all his sins that he hath committed, and keep all my statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die. All his **transgressions** that he hath committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he hath done he shall live. Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? Saith the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live? ... When the wicked man turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive. Because he considereth, and turneth away from all his **transgressions** that he hath committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die. Ezekiel 18:21-23, 27-28

I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that **transgress** against me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and ye shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 20:38

Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have made your iniquity to be remembered, in that your **transgressions** are discovered, so that in all your doings your sins do appear; because, I say, that ye are come to remembrance, ye shall be taken with the hand. Ezekiel 21:24

Therefore, O thou son of man, speak unto the house of Israel; Thus ye speak, saying, If our transgressions and our sins be upon us, and we pine away in them, how should we then live? Say unto them, As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel? Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turneth from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his righteousness in the day that he sinneth. Ezekiel 33:10-12

According to their uncleanness and according to their **transgressions** have I done unto them, and hid my face from them. Ezekiel 39:24

Yea, all Israel have **transgressed** thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against him. Daniel 9:11

O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? For your goodness is as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away. Therefore have I hewed them by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of my mouth: and thy judgments are as the light that goeth forth. For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings. But they like men have **transgressed** the covenant: there have they dealt treacherously against me. Hosea 6:4-7

Woe unto them! For they have fled from me: destruction unto them! Because they have transgressed against me: though I have redeemed them, yet they have spoken lies against me. And they have not cried unto me with their heart, when they howled upon their beds: they assemble themselves for corn and wine, and they rebel against me. Hosea 7:13-14

Set the trumpet to thy mouth. He shall come as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have **transgressed** my covenant, and trespassed against my law. Hosea 8:1

Who is wise, and he shall understand these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the LORD are right, and the just shall walk in them; but the **transgressors** shall fall therein. Hosea 14:9

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Damascus, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have threshed Gilead with threshing instruments of iron... Amos 1:3

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Gaza, and for four, will not turn away the punishment thereof, because they carried away captive the whole captivity, to deliver them up to Edom... Amos 1:6

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Tyrus, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof, because they delivered up the whole captivity to Edom, and remembered not the brotherly covenant... Amos 1:9

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever. Amos 1:11

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of the children of Ammon, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have ripped up the women with child of Gilead, that they might enlarge their border... Amos 1:13

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Moab, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof, because he burned the bones of the king of Edom into lime... Amos 2:1

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have despised the law of the LORD, and have not kept his commandments, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked... Amos 2:4

Thus saith the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof, because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes... Amos 2:6

Come to Bethel, and transgress; at Gilgal multiply transgression; and bring your sacrifices every morning, and offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving with leaven, and proclaim and publish the free offerings: for this liketh you, O ye children of Israel, saith the Lord GOD. And I also have given you cleanness of teeth in all your cities, and want of bread in all your places: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD. Amos 4:4-6

For I know your manifold **transgressions**, and your mighty sins: they afflict the just, they take a bribe, and they turn aside the poor in the gate from their right. Amos 5:12

Yea, also because he **transgresseth** by wine, he is a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people; Habakkuk 2:5

PRAYERS ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

Forgive thy people that have sinned against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them: 1 Kings 8:50

If I covered my transgressions as Adam, by hiding mine iniquity in my bosom...Behold, my desire is, that the Almighty would answer me, and that mine adversary had written a book. Job 31:33, 35

Destroy thou them, O God; let them fall by their own counsels; cast them out in the multitude of their **transgressions**; for they have rebelled against thee. Psalm 5:10

Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, that goeth not out of feigned lips. Let my sentence come forth from thy presence; let thine eyes behold the things that are equal. Thou hast proved mine heart; thou hast visited me in the night; thou hast tried me, and shalt find nothing; I am purposed that my mouth shall not **transgress**. Psalm 17:1-3

Yea, let none that wait on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause. Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths. Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy loving kindness; for they have been ever of old. Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness' sake, O LORD. Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way. The paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies. Psalm 25:3-10

I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my **transgression**s unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah. For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him. Thou art my hiding place; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah. I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye. Psalm 32:5-8

Deliver me from all my transgressions: make me not the reproach of the foolish...Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I am a stranger with thee, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were. O spare me, that I may recover strength, before I go hence, and be no more. Psalm 39:8, 12-13

Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God: defend me from them that rise up against me. Deliver me from the workers of iniquity, and save me from bloody men. For, lo, they lie in wait for my soul: the mighty are gathered against me; not for my transgression, not for my sin, O LORD. They run and prepare themselves without my fault: awake to help me, and behold. Thou therefore, O LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel, awake to visit all the heathen: be not merciful to any wicked transgressors. Selah. Psalm 59:1-5

O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come. Iniquities prevail against me: as for our **transgressions**, thou shalt purge them away. Psalm 65:2-3

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest. Behold, I was shapen in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice. Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit. Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee. Psalm 51:1-3, 10-13

Let all their wickedness come before thee; and do unto them, as thou hast done unto me for all my **transgressions**: for my sighs are many, and my heart is faint... We have **transgressed** and have rebelled: thou hast not pardoned. Lamentations 1:22, 3:42

PROMISES ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

... Then thou shalt say before the LORD thy God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of mine house, and also have given them unto the Levite, and unto the stranger, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all thy commandments which thou hast commanded me: I have not transgressed thy commandments, neither have I forgotten them: I have not eaten thereof in my mourning, neither have I taken away aught thereof for any unclean use, nor given aught thereof for the dead: but I have hearkened to the voice of the LORD my God, and have done according to all that thou hast commanded me. Deuteronomy 26:13-14

For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our **transgressions** from us. Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him. Psalm 103:11-13

I, even I am he that blotteth out thy **transgressions** for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins...I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy **transgressions**, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed thee. Isaiah 43:25, 44:22

Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form or comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed... Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors. Isaiah 53:1-6, 10-12

I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me, and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have **transgressed** against me. Jeremiah 33:8

Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their **transgressions**: but I will save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be my people, and I will be their God. Ezekiel 37:23

TRESPASSES

Jacob was wroth, and chode with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What is my trespass? What is my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me? Genesis 31:36

So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the **trespass** of thy brethren, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the **trespass** of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him. Genesis 50:17

For all manner of **trespass**, whether it be for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, or for any manner of lost thing, which another challengeth to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the judges; and whom the judges shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbor. Exodus 22:9

He shall bring his **trespass** offering unto the LORD for his sin which he hath sinned, a female from the flock, a lamb or a kid of the goats, for a sin offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his sin. And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, unto the LORD; one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering. Leviticus 5:6-7

If a soul commit a **trespass**, and sin through ignorance, in the holy things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with thy estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a **trespass** offering: And he shall make amends for the harm that he hath done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the **trespass** offering and it shall be forgiven him. Leviticus 5: 15-16

And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a **trespass** offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist it not, and it shall be forgiven him. It is a **trespass** offering: he hath certainly **trespassed** against the LORD. Leviticus 5:18-19

If a soul sin, and commit a **trespass** against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbour in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or hath deceived his neighbour...Or all that about which he hath sworn falsely; he shall restore it in the principal, and shall add the fifth part more thereto, and give it unto him to whom it appertaineth, in the day of his **trespass** offering. And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD, a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a **trespass** offering, unto the priest: Leviticus 6:2-6

It shall not be baken with leaven. I have given it unto them for their portion of my offerings made by fire; it is most holy, as is the sin offering, and as the **trespass** offering. Leviticus 6:17

Likewise this is the law of the **trespass** offering: it is most holy. In the place where they kill the burnt offering shall they kill the **trespass** offering: and the blood thereof shall he sprinkle round about upon the altar. Leviticus 7:1-2

This is the law of the burnt offering, of the meat offering, and of the sin offering, and of the **trespass** offering, and of the consecrations, and of the sacrifice of the peace offerings; Leviticus 7:37

And the priest shall take the lamb of the **trespass** offering, and the log of oil, and the priest shall wave them for a wave offering before the LORD: And he shall kill the lamb of the **trespass** offering, and the priest shall take some of the blood of the **trespass** offering, and put it upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot...And the priest shall put of the oil that is in his hand upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot, upon the place of the blood of the **trespass** offering: Leviticus 14:24-25, 28

The priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the **trespass** offering...and the sin which he hath done shall be forgiven him. Levi 19:22

They shall not profane the holy things of the children of Israel, which they offer unto the LORD; or suffer them to bear the iniquity of **trespass**, when they eat their holy things: for I the LORD do sanctify them. Leviticus 22:15-16

They that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them. If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their **trespass** which they **trespassed** against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto me: and that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies: if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: Then will I remember my covenant with Jacob, and also my covenant with Isaac, and also my covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land. Leviticus 26:26:40-42

But the children of Israel committed a **trespass** in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel. Joshua 7:1

Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest said unto the children of Reuben, and to the children of Gad, and to the children of Manasseh, This day we perceive that the LORD is among us, because ye have not committed this **trespass** against the LORD: now ye have delivered the children of Israel out of the hand of the LORD. Joshua 22:31

I pray thee, forgive the **trespass** of thine handmaid: for the LORD will certainly make my lord a sure house; because my lord fighteth the battles of the LORD, and evil hath not been found in thee all thy days. 1 Samuel 25:28

If any man trespass against his neighbour, and an oath be laid upon him to cause him to swear, and the oath come before thine altar in this house: Then hear thou in heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness. 1 Kings 8:31-32

For they dealt faithfully. The **trespass** money and sin money was not brought into the house of the LORD: it was the priests'. 2 Kings 12:15-16

What cause soever shall come to you of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and judgments, ye shall even warn them that they **trespass** not against the LORD, and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and ye shall not **trespass**. 2 Chronicles 19:10

They left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served groves and idols: and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem for this their trespass. 2 Chronicles 24:18

They withstood Uzziah the king, and said unto him, It appertaineth not unto thee, Uzziah, to burn incense unto the LORD, but to the priests the sons of Aaron, that are consecrated to burn incense: go out of the sanctuary; for thou hast **trespassed**; neither shall it be for thine honour from the LORD God. 2 Chronicles 26:18

For our fathers have **trespassed**, and done that which was evil in the eyes of the LORD our God, and have forsaken him, and have turned away their faces from the habitation of the LORD, and turned their backs. 2 Chronicles 29:6

Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his prayer unto his God, and the words of the seers that spake to him in the name of the LORD God of Israel, behold, they are written in the book of the kings of Israel. His prayer also, and how God was intreated of him, and all his sin, and his trespass, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was humbled: behold, they are written among the sayings of the seers. 2 Chronicles 33:18-19

Amon sacrificed unto all the carved images which Manasseh his father had made, and served them; And humbled not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had humbled himself; but Amon **trespassed** more and more. 2 Chronicles 33:22-23

O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to thee, my God: for our iniquities are increased over our head, and our **trespass** is grown up unto the heavens. Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great **trespass** unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day... We cannot stand before thee because of this. Ezra 9:6-7, 15

Shechaniah the son of Jehiel, one of the sons of Elam, answered and said unto Ezra, We have **trespassed** against our God, and have taken strange wives of the people of the land; yet now there is hope in Israel concerning this thing... Ye have transgressed, and have taken strange wives, to increase the **trespass** of Israel...And they gave their hands that they would put away their wives; and being guilty, they offered a ram of the flock for their **trespass**. Ezra 10:2, 10, 16

Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah. He that is our God is the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord belong the issues from death. But God shall wound the head of his enemies, and the hairy scalp of such an one as goeth on still in his **trespasses**. Psalm 68:19-21

I will spread my net upon him, and he shall be taken in my snare, and I will bring him to Babylon, and will plead with him there for his **trespass** that he hath **trespassed** against me. Ezekiel 17:20

When the righteous turneth away from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, and doeth according to all the abominations that the wicked man doeth, shall he live? All his righteousness that he hath done shall not be mentioned: in his **trespass** that he hath trespassed, and his sin that he hath sinned, in them shall he die. Ezekiel 18:24

The heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they **trespassed** against me, therefore hid I my face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword. According to their uncleanness and according to their trasgressions have I done unto them, and hid my face from them... After that they have borne their shame, and all their **trespasses**...shall they know that I am the I.ORD their God... Ezekiel 39:23-27

O Lord, righteousness belongeth unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, that are near, and that are far off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their **trespass** that they have **trespassed** against thee. Daniel 9:7

Set the trumpet to thy mouth. He shall come as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed my covenant, and trespassed against my law. Hosea 8:1

TRESPASS IN NEW COVENANT

For if ye forgive men their **trespasses**, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their **trespasses**, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. Matthew 6:14-15

Moreover if thy brother shall **trespass** against thee, go and tell him his fault between thee and him alone: if he shall hear thee, thou hast gained thy brother...So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their **trespasses**. Matthew 18:15, 35

When ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your **trespasses**. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your **trespasses**. Mark 11:25-26

Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother **trespass** against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. And if he **trespass** against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him. Luke 17:3-4

Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passes away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their **trespasses** unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:17-19

You hath he quickened, who were dead in **trespasses** and sins; wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience... Ephesians 2:1-2

Ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power...And you, being dead in your sins and uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it. Colossians 2:10, 13-15

VANITY

Let there more work be laid upon the men, that they may labour therein; and let them not regard **vain** words. Exodus 5:9

Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. Exodus 20:7

I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and ye shall sow your seed in **vain**, for your enemies shall eat it. Leviticus 26:16

And your strength shall be spent in **vain**: for your land shall not yield her increase, neither shall be trees of the land yield their fruits. Leviticus 26:20

Thou shalt not take the name of the LORD thy God in vain: for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain. Deuteronomy 5:11

I will hide my face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith. They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation. Deuteronomy 32:20-21

For it is not a **vain** thing for you; because it is your life: and through this thing ye shall prolong your days in the land, whither ye go over Jordan to possess it. Deuteronomy 32:47

And they gave him threescore and ten pieces of silver out of the house of Baal-berieth, wherewith Abimelech hired **vain** and light persons, which followed him. Judges 9:4

Then Jephthah fled from his brethren, and dwelt in the land of Tob: and there were gathered vain men to Jephthah, and went out with him. Judges 11:3

And turn ye not aside: for then should ye go after vain things, which cannot profit nor deliver; for they are vain. 1 Samuel 12:21

Now David had said, Surely in **vain** have I kept all that this fellow hath in the wilderness, so that nothing was missed of all that pertained unto him: and he hath requited me evil for good. 1 Samuel 25:21

Then David returned to bless his household. And Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David, and said, How glorious was the king of Israel today, who uncovered himself today in the eyes of the handmaids of her servants, as one of the **vain** fellows shamelessly uncovereth himself! 2 Samuel 6:20

For the sins of Baasha, and the sins of Elah his son, by which they sinned, and by which they made Israel to sin, in provoking the LORD God of Isarel to anger with their **vanities**. 1 Kings 16:13

For he walked in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin, to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger with their **vanities**. 1 Kings 16:26

And they rejected his statutes, and his covenant that he made with their fathers, and his testimonies which he testified against them; and they followed **vanity**, and became **vain**, and went after the heathen that were round about them, concerning whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them. 2 Kings 17:15

Thou sayest, (but they are but **vain** words,) I have counsel and strength for the war. Now on whom dost thou trust, that thou rebellest against me? 2 Kings 18:20

There are gathered unto him **vain** men, the children of Belial, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and tenderhearted, and could not withstand them. 2 Chronicles 13:7

So am I made to possess months of **vanity**, and wearisome nights are appointed to me. Job 7:3

I loathe it; I would not live alway: let me alone; for my days are **vanity**...If I be wicked, why then labour I in **vain**? Job 7: 16, 9:29

For he knoweth vain men: he seeth wickedness also; will he not then consider it? For vain man would be wise, though man be born like a wild ass's colt. Job 11:11-12

Should a wise man utter **vain** knowledge, and fill his belly with the east wind? Job 15:2

Let not him that is deceived trust in vanity: for vanity shall be his recompence. Job 15:31

They conceive mischief, and bring forth **vanity**, and their belly prepareth deceit. Job 15:35

Shall vain words have an end? Or what emboldeneth thee that thou answereth? Job 16:3

How then comfort ye me in **vain**, seeing in your answers there remaineth falsehood? Job 21:34

Behold, all ye yourselves have seen it; why then are ye thus altogether vain? Job 27:12

If I have walked with **vanity**, or if my foot hath hasted to deceit; Let me be weighed in an even balance, that God may know mine integrity. Job 31:5-6

Surely God will not hear **vanity**, neither will the Almighty regard it. Job 35:13

Therefore doth Job open his mouth in **vain**; he multiplieth words without knowledge. Job 35:16

She is hardened against her young ones, as though they were not hers: her labour is in vain without fear; Job 39:16

Behold, they hope of him is in **vain**: shall not one be cast down even at the sight of him? Job 41:9

Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? Psalm 2:1

O ye sons of men, how long will ye turn my glory into shame? How long will ye love vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah. Psalm 4:2

His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue is mischief and vanity. Psalm 10:7

They speak **vanity** every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak. Psalm 12:2

He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto **vanity**, nor sworn deceitfully. Psalm 24:4

I have not sat with **vain** persons, neither will I go in with dissemblers. Psalm 26:4

I have hated them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD. Psalm 31:6

An horse is a **vain** thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength. Psalm 33:17

Behold, thou hast made my days as an handbreadth; and mine age is as nothing before thee: verily every man at his best state is altogether vanity. Selah. Surely every man walketh in a vain shew: surely they are disquieted in vain: he heapeth up riches, and knoweth not who shall gather them. Psalms 39:5-6

When thou with rebukes dost correct man for iniquity, thou makest his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man is **vanity**. Selah. Psalm 39:11

And if he come to see me, he speaketh **vanity**: his heart gathereth iniquity to itself; when he goeth abroad, he telleth it. Psalm 41:6

Give us help from trouble: for vain is the help of man. Psalm 60:11

Surely men of low degree are **vanity**, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than **vanity**. Trust not in oppression, and become not **vain** in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart upon them. Psalm 62:9-10

Verily I have cleansed my heart in vain, and washed my hands in innocency. Psalm 73:13

Therefore their days did he consume in **vanity**, and their years in trouble. Psalm 79:33

Remember how short my time is: wherefore hast thou made all men in vain? Psalm 89:47

The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity. Psalm 94:11

Give us help from trouble: for vain is the help of man. Psalms 108:12

Turn away mine eyes from beholding **vanity**; and quicken thou me in thy way. Psalm 119:37

I hate vain thoughts: but thy law do I love. Psalm 119:113

Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain. It is vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so he giveth his beloved sleep. Psalm 127:1-2

For they speak against thee wickedly, and thine enemies take thy name in vain. Psalm 139:20

Blessed be the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, and my fingers to fight: My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and he in whom I trust; who subdueth my people under me. LORD, what is man, that thou takest knowledge of him? Or the son of man, that thou makest account of him? Man is like to vanity: his days are as a shadow that passeth away... Whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood. Psalm 144:1-8

Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood. Psalm 144:11

Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird. Proverbs 1:17

He that tilleth his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that followeth vain persons is void of understanding. Proverbs 12:11

Wealth gotten by **vanity** shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase. Proverbs 13:11

The getting of treasure by a lying tongue is a vanity tossed to and fro of them that seek death. Proverbs 21:6

He that soweth iniquity shall reap **vanity**: and the rod of his anger shall fail. Proverbs 22:8

He that tilleth his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that followeth after vain persons shall have poverty enough. Proverbs 28:19

Remove far from me **vanity** and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny thee, and say, Who is the LORD? Or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God in **vain**. Proverbs 30:8-9

Favour is deceitful, and beauty is **vain**: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

Vanity of **vanities**, saith the Preacher, **vanity** of **vanities**; all is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 1:2

I have seen all the works that are done under the sun; and behold, all is vanity and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 1:14

I said in mine heart, Go to now, I will prove thee with mirth, therefore enjoy pleasure: and, behold, this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:1

Then I looked on all the works that my hands had wrought, and on the labour that I had laboured to do: and, behold, all was **vanity** and vexation of spirit, and there was no profit under the sun. Eccl 2:11

Then said I in my heart, As it happeneth to the fool, so it happeneth even to me; and why was I then more wise? Then I said in my heart, that this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:15

Therefore I hated life; because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: for all is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 2:17

And who knoweth whether he shall be a wise man or a fool? Yet shall he have rule over all my labour wherein I have laboured, and wherein I have shewed myself wise under the sun. This is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:19

For there is a man whose labour is in wisdom, and in knowledge, and in equity; yet to a man that hath not laboured therein shall he leave it for his portion. This also is **vanity** and a great evil. Ecclesiastes 2:21

For all his days are sorrows, and his travail grief; yea, his heart taketh not rest in the night. This is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:23

For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 2:26

For that which befalleth the sons of men befalleth beasts; even one thing befalleth them: as the one dieth, so dieth the other; yea, they have all one breath; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 3:19

Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this man is envied of his neighbour. This is also **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 4:4

Then I returned, and I saw vanity under the sun. There is one alone, and there is not a second; yea, he hath neither child nor brother: yet is there no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither saith he, For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good: This is also vanity, yea, it is a sore travil. Ecclesiastes 4:7-8

There is no end of all the people, even of all that have been before them: they also that come after shall not rejoice in him. Surely this also is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 4:16

For in the multitude of dreams and many words there are also divers vanities: but fear thou God. Ecclesiastes 5:7

He that loveth silver will not be satisfied with silver; nor he that loveth abundance with increase: this is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 5:10

A man to whom God hath given riches, wealth, and honour, so that he wanteth nothing for his soul of all that he desireth, yet God giveth him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eateth it: this is **vanity**, and it is an evil disease. Ecclesiastes 6:2

For he cometh in with **vanity**, and departeth in darkness, and his name shall be covered with darkness. Ecclesiastes 6:4

Better is the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the desire: this is also vanity and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 6:9

Seeing there be many things that increase **vanity**, what is man the better? For who knoweth what is good for man in this life, all the days of his **vain** life which he spendeth as a shadow? For who can tell a man what shall be after him under the sun? Ecclesiastes 6:11-12

For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so is the laughter of the fool: this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 7:6

All things have I seen in the days of my **vanity**: there is a just man that perisheth in his righteousness, and there is a wicked man that prolongeth his life in his wickedness. Ecclesiastes 7:15

And so I saw the wicked buried, who had come and gone from the place of the holy, and they were forgotten in the city where they had so done: this is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 8:10

There is a **vanity** which is done upon the earth; that there be just men, unto whom it happeneth according to the work of the wicked; again, there be wicked men, to whom it happeneth according to the work of the righteous: I said that this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 8:14

Live joyfully with the wife whom thou lovest all the days of the life of thy vanity, which he hath given thee under the sun, all the days of thy vanity: for that is thy portion in this life, and in thy labour which thou takest under the sun. Ecclesiastes 9:9

But if a man live many years, and rejoice in them all; yet let him remember the days of darkness; for they shall be many. All that cometh is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 11:8

Rejoice, O young man, in thy youth; and let thy heart cheer thee in the days of thy youth, and walk in the ways of thine heart, and in the sight of thine eyes: but know thou, that for all these things God will bring thee into judgement. Therefore remove sorrow from thy heart, and put away evil from thy flesh: for childhood and youth are vanity. Ecclesiastes 11:10

Vanity of vanities, saith the preacher; all is vanity. Ecclesiastes 12:8

Bring no more **vain** oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting. Isaiah 1:13

Woe unto them that draw iniquity with cords of **vanity**, and sin as it were with a cart rope: Isaiah 5:18

For the Egyptians shall help in **vain**, and to no purpose: therefore have I cried concerning this, Their strength is to sit still. Isaiah 30:7

And his breath, as an overflowing stream, shall reach to the midst of the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of **vanity**: and there shall be a bridle in the jaws of the people, causing them to err. Isaiah 30:28

I say, sayest thou, (but they are but **vain** words) I have counsel and strength for war: now on whom dost thou trust, that thou rebellest against me? Isaiah 36:5

All nations before him are as nothing; and they are counted to him less than nothing, and vanity. Isaiah 40:17

That bringeth the princes to nothing; he maketh the judges of the earth as vanity. Isaiah 40:23

Behold, they are all **vanity**; their works are nothing: their molten images are wind and confusion. Isaiah 41:29

They that make a graven image are all of them **vanity**; and their delectable things shall not profit; and they are their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed. Isaiah 44:9

For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else. I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right. Isaiah 45:18-19

Then I said, I have laboured in **vain**, I have spent my strength for nought, and in **vain**: yet surely my judgment is with the LORD, and my work with my God. Isaiah 49:4

When thou criest, let thy companies deliver thee; but the wind shall carry them all away; **vanity** shall take them: but he that putteth his trust in me shall possess the land, and shall inherit my holy mountain; Isaiah 57:13

None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in **vanity**, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. Isaiah 59:4

Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am. If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking **vanity**; Isaiah 58:9

They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. Isaiah 65:23

Thus saith the LORD, What iniquity have your fathers found in me, that they are gone far from me, and have walked after **vanity**, and are become **vain**? Jeremiah 2:5

In **vain** have I smitten your children; they received no correction: your own sword hath devoured your prophets, like a destroying lion. Jeremiah 2:30

Truly in **vain** is salvation hoped for from the hills, and from the multitude of mountains: truly in the LORD our God is the salvation of Israel. *Jeremiah* 3:23

O Jerusalem, wash thine heart from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy **vain** thoughts lodge within thee? ... And when thou art spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in **vain** shalt thou make thyself fair; thy lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life. Jeremiah 4:14, 30

The bellows are burned, the lead is consumed of the fire; the founder melteth in vain: for the wicked are not plucked away. Jeremiah 6:29

How do ye say, We are wise, and the law of the LORD is with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he it, the pen of the scribes is in vain. Jeremiah 8:8

Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: Is not the LORD in Zion? Is not her king in her? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, and with strange vanities? Jeremiah 8:19

The customs of the people are **vain**: for one cutteth a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the axe. Jeremiah 10:3

But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock is a doctrine of vanities... Jeremiah 10:8

They are **vanity**, and the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish. Jeremiah 10:15

Are there any among the **vanities** of the Gentiles that can cause rain? Or can the heavens give showers? Art not thou he, O LORD our God? Therefore we will wait upon thee: for thou hast made all these things. Jeremiah 14:22

O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, **vanity**, and things wherein there is no profit. Jeremiah 16:19

Because my people hath forgotten me, they have burned incense to **vanity**, and they have caused them to stumble in their ways from the ancient paths, to walk in paths, in a way not cast up; Jeremiah 18:15

Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you **vain**: they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of the LORD. Jeremiah 23:16

Go up into Gilead, and take balm, O virgin, the daughter of Egypt: in vain shalt thou use many medicines; for thou shalt not be cured. Jeremiah 46:11

For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows shall be as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain. Jeremiah 50:9

Every man is brutish by his knowledge; every founder is confounded by the graven image: for his molten image is falsehood, and there is no breath in them. They are **vanity**, the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish. They portion of Jacob is not like them; for he is the former of all things: and Israel is the rod of his inheritance: the LORD of hosts is his name. Jeremiah 51:17-19

Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in **vain**, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary. Jeremiah 51:58

Thy prophets have seen **vain** and foolish things for thee: and they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens and causes of banishment. Lamentations 2:14

As for us, our eyes as yet failed for our **vain** help: in our watching we have watched for a nation that could not save us. Lamentations 4:17

And they shall know that I am the LORD, and that I have not said in **vain** that I would do this evil unto them. Ezekiel 6:10

For there shall be no more any **vain** vision nor flattering divination within the house of Israel. Ezekiel 12:24

They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD saith: and the LORD hath not sent them: and they have made others to hope that they would confirm the word. Have ye not seen a vain vision, and have ye not spoken a lying divination, whereas ye say, The LORD saith it; albeit I have not spoken? Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Because ye have spoken vanity, and seen lies, therefore, behold, I am against you, saith the Lord GOD. And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I am the Lord GOD... Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 13:6-9, 23

While they see **vanity** unto thee, while they divine a lie unto thee, to bring thee upon the necks of them that are slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their iniquity shall have an end. Ezekiel 21:29

And her prophets have daubed them with untempered morter, seeing vanity, and divining lies unto them, saying, Thus saith the Lord GOD, when the LORD hath not spoken. Ezekiel 22:28

Is there iniquity in Gilead? Surely they are **vanity**: they sacrifice bullocks in Gilgal; yea, their altars are as heaps in the furrows of the fields. Hosea 12:11

They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy. Jonah 2:8

Behold, is it not of the LORD of hosts that the people shall labour in the very fire, and the people shall weary themselves for very **vanity**? Habakkuk 2:13

For the idols have spoken **vanity**, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in **vain**: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd. Zechariah 10:2

Ye have said, It is **vain** to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts? Malachi 3:14

But when ye pray, use not **vain** repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. Matthew 6:7

In **vain** do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men... Matthew 15:9, Mark 7:7

This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the **vanity** of their mind... Ephesians 4:17

Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? Acts 4:25

And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these **vanities** unto the living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein: Acts 14:15

Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became **vain** in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Romans 1:21

For the creature was made subject to **vanity**, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope, Romans 8:20

For he is the minister of God to thee for good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in **vain**: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. Romans 13:4

And again, The Lord knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain. 1 Corinthians 3:20

By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. 1 Corinthians 15:2

But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in **vain**; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. 1 Corinthians 15:10

If Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain. 1 Corinthians 15:14

And if Christ be not raised, your faith is **vain**; ye are yet in your sins. 1 Corinthians 15:17

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in **vain** in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 15:58

We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the grace of God in vain. 2 Corinthians 6:1

Yet have I sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in **vain** in this behalf; that, as I said, ye may be ready: 2 Corinthians 9:3

And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain. Galatians 2:2.

I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain. Galatians 2:21

Have ye suffered so many things in vain? If it be yet in vain. Galatians 3:4

I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain. Galatians 4:11

Let us not be desirous of **vain** glory, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 5:26

Let no man deceive you with **vain** words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. Ephesians 5:6

Let nothing be done through strife or **vainglory**; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Philipians 2:3

Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in **vain**, neither laboured in **vain**. Philippians 2:16

Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind... Colossians 2:18

For yourselves, brethren, know our entrance in unto you, that it was not in vain... 1 Thessalonians 2:1

For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain. 1 Thessalonians 3:5

Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned: From which some having swerved have turned aside unto **vain** jangling. 1 Timothy 1:5-6

O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: 1 Timothy 6:20

But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. 2 Timothy 2:16

For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision: Titus 1:10

But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain. Titus 3:9

If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion is **vain**. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. James 1:26-27

But wilt thou know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? James 2:20

Do ye think that the scripture saith in **vain**, The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? James 4:5

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your **vain** conversation received by tradition from your fathers; but with the precious blood of Christ...1 Peter 1:18-19

For when they speak great swelling words of **vanity**, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. 2 Peter 2:18
