GOD'S GLORY

Ye shall tell my father of all my **glory** in Egypt, and of all that ye have seen; and ye shall haste and bring down my father hither. And he fell upon his brother Benjamin's neck, and wept; and Benjamin wept upon his neck. Moreover he kissed all his brethren... Genesis 45:13-15

Moses said unto Pharoah, **Glory** over me: when shall I entreat for thee, and for thy servants, and for thy people, to destroy the frogs from thee and thy houses, that they may remain in the river only? Exodus 8:9

Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed **gloriously**: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. The LORD is my strength and my song, and he is become my salvation: Exodus 15:1-2

The depths have covered them: they sank into the bottom as a stone. Thy right hand, O LORD, is become **glorious** in power: thy right hand, O LORD, hath dashed in pieces the enemy... Thou didst blow with thy wind, the sea covered them: they sank as lead in the mighty waters. Who is like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? Who is like thee, **glorious** in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders? Exodus 15:5-6, 10-11

Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances. And Miriam answered them, Sing ye to the LORD, for he hath triumphed **gloriously**; the horse and the rider hath he thrown into the sea. Exodus 15:20-21

In the morning, then ye shall see the **glory** of the LORD; for that he heareth your murmurings against the LORD: and what are we, that ye murmur against us? And Moses said, This shall be, when the LORD shall give you in the evening flesh to eat, and in the morning bread to the full; for that the LORD heareth your murmurings which ye murmur against him: and what are we? Your murmurings are not against us, but against the LORD. Exodus 16:7-8

As Aaron spake unto the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness, and behold, the **glory** of the LORD appeared in the cloud. Exodus 16:10

The **glory** of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day he called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud. And the sight of the **glory** of the LORD was like a devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel. Exodus 24:16-17

Thou shalt make holy garments for Aaron thy brother for glory and for beauty. Exodus 28:2

There I will meet with the children of Israel, and the tabernacle shall be sanctified by my glory. Exodus 29:43

He said, I beseech thee, shew me thy **glory**...It shall come to pass, while my **glory** passeth by, that I will put thee in a clift of the rock, and will cover thee with my hand while I pass by: Exodus 33:18, 22

Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the **glory** of the LORD filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and the **glory** of the LORD filled the tabernacle. Exodus 40:34-35

This is the thing which the LORD commanded that ye should do: and the **glory** of the LORD shall appear unto you. And Moses said unto Aaron, Go unto the altar, and offer thy sin offering, and thy burnt offering, and make an atonement for thyself, and for the people... Leviticus 9:6-7

Moses and Aaron went into the tabernacle of the congregation, and came out, and blessed the people: and the **glory** of the LORD appeared unto all the people. Leviticus 9:23

There went out fire from the LORD, and devoured them, and they died before the LORD. Then Moses said unto Aaron, This is it that the LORD spake, saying, I will be sanctified in them that come nigh me, and before all the people I will be **glorified**. Leviticus 10:3 [Nadab and Abihu]

And the **glory** of the LORD appeared in the tabernacle of the congregation before all the children of Israel. Numbers 14:10

Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. And the LORD said, I have pardoned according to thy word: But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the **glory** of the LORD. Numbers 14:19-21

Korah gathered all the congregation against them unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation: and the **glory** of the LORD appeared unto all the congregation...And it came to pass, when the congregation was gathered against Moses and against Aaron, that they looked toward the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: and the **glory** of the LORD appeared. Numbers 16:19, 42

Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they fell upon their faces: and the **glory** of the LORD appeared unto them. Numbers 20:6

Behold, the LORD our God hath shewed us his **glory** and his greatness, and we have heard his voice out of the midst of the fire: we have seen this day that God doth talk with man, and he liveth. Deuteronomy 5:24

If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this **glorious** and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD; Then the LORD will make thy plagues wonderful, and the plagues of thy seed, even great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance. Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee. Also every sickness, and every plague, which is not written in the book of this law, them will the LORD bring upon thee, until thou be destroyed. Deuteronomy 28:58-61

And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the LORD be his land...His **glory** is like the firstling of his bullock, and his horns are like the horns of unicorns: with them he shall push the people together to the ends of the earth: and they are the ten thousands of Ephraim, and they are the thousands of Manasseh. Deuteronomy 33:13, 17

Joshua said unto Achan, My son, give, I pray thee, **glory** to the LORD God of Israel, and make confession unto him; and tell me now what thou hast done; hide it not from me. And Achan answered Joshua, and said, Indeed I have sinned against the LORD God of Israel, and thus and thus have I done: Joshua 7:19

He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of **glory**: for the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them. 1 Samuel 2:8

She said, The **glory** is departed from Israel: because the ark of God was taken. 1 Samuel 4:22

It came to pass, when the priests were come out of the holy place, that the cloud filled the house of the LORD, So that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud: for the **glory** of the LORD had filled the house of the LORD. 1 Kings 8:11

Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. 1 Chronicles 16:9-10

Declare his **glory** among the heathen; his marvellous works among all nations. For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the people are idols: but the LORD made the heavens. **Glory** and honour are in his presence; strength and gladness are in his place. Give unto the LORD, ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD **glory** and strength. Give unto the LORD the **glory** due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness. Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved. Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let men say among the nations, The LORD reigneth. Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields rejoice, and all that is therein. Then shall the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD; for he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever. 1 Chronicles 16:24-34

David said, Solomon my son is young and tender, and the house that is to be builded for the LORD must be exceeding magnifical, of fame and of **glory** throughout all countries: I will therefore now make preparation for it. So David prepared abundantly before his death. 1 Chronicles 22:5

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the **glory**, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy **glorious** name. 1 Chronicles 29:11-13

So that the priests could not stand to minister by reason of the cloud: for the **glory** of the LORD had filled the house of God. 2 Chronicles 5:14

Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the **glory** of the LORD filled the house. 2 Chronicles 7:1

And the priests could not enter into the house of the LORD, because the **glory** of the LORD had filled the LORD's house. 2 Chronicles 7:2

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the **glory** of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever. 2 Chronicles 7:3

Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah, said, Stand up and bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be thy **glorious** name, which is exalted above all blessings and praise. Thou, even thou, art LORD alone; thou hast made the heaven... Nehemiah 9:5-6

Thou, *O* LORD, art a shield for me; my **glory**, and the lifter up of my head. Psalms 3:3

O LORD our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! Who hast set thy **glory** above the heavens...For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with **glory** and honour. Psalm 8:1, 5

The heavens declare the **glory** of God; and the firmament sheweth his handiwork. Psalms 19:1

I will declare thy name unto my brethren: in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee. Ye that fear the LORD, praise him; all ye the seed of Jacob, **glorify** him; and fear him, all ye the seed of Israel. Psalm 22:22-23

Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of **glory** shall come in. Who is this King of **glory**! The LORD of hosts, he is the King of **glory**. Selah. Psalm 24:9-10

The voice of the LORD is upon the waters: the God of **glory** thundereth: the LORD is upon many waters... The voice of the LORD maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of his **glory**. Psalms 29:3, 9

Gird thy sword upon thy thigh, O most mighty, with thy **glory** and thy majesty. And in thy majesty ride prosperously... The king's daughter is all **glorious** within: her clothing is of wrought gold. Psalms 45:3-4, 13

Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High: And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt **glorify** me. Psalm 50:14-15

Whoso offereth praise **glorifeth** me: and to him that ordereth his conversation aright will I shew the salvation of God. Psalm 50:23

Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens; let thy **glory** *be above all the earth. Psalm* 57:5

O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is; To see thy power and thy **glory**, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary. Psalm 63:1-2

Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands: Sing forth the honour of his name: make his praise **glorious**. Psalms 66:1-2

His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed. Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wonderous things. And blessed be his **glorious** name for ever: and let the whole earth be filled with his **glory**; Amen, and Amen. Psalm 72:17-19

Thou art more **glorious** and excellent than the mountains of prey. *Psalm* 76:4

For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and *glory*: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly. OLORD of hosts, blessed is the man that trusteth in thee. Psalm 84:11-12

All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall **glorify** thy name. For thou art great, and doest wondrous things: thou art God alone. Psalm 86:9-10

Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name. I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will **glorify** thy name for evermore. Psalm 86:11-12

His foundation is in the holy mountains. The LORD loveth the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob. **Glorious** things are spoken of thee, O city of God. Selah. Psalms 87:1-3

Sing unto the LORD, bless his name...Declare his **glory** among the heathen, his wonders among all people. Psalms 96:2-3

The LORD reigneth; let the earth rejoice... The heavens declare his righteousness, and all the people see his **glory**. Psalms 97:1, 6

The heathen shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth thy **glory**. When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his **glory**. He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer. Psalms 102:15-17

The **glory** of the LORD shall endure for ever: the LORD shall rejoice in his works. He looketh on the earth, and it trembleth: Psalm 104:31-32

Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. Seek the LORD and his strength... Psalm 105:3-4

The works of the LORD are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein. His work is honourable and **glorious**: and his righteousness endureth for ever. He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD is gracious and full of compassion. He hath given meat to them that fear him. Psalm 111:2-5

The LORD is high above all nations, and his **glory** above all the heavens. Who is like unto the LORD our God... Psalms 113:4-5

When they hear the words of thy mouth... Yea, they shall sing in the ways of the LORD: for great is the **glory** of the LORD. Psalms 138:4-5

Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts. I will speak of the **glorious** honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works. Psalm 145:2-5 They shall speak of the **glory** of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power. To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the **glorious** majesty of his kingdom. Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations. Psalms 145:11-13

Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his **glory** is above all the earth and heaven. Psalms 148:13

Let the saints be joyful in **glory**: let them sing aloud upon their beds. Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand; Psalm 149:5-6

The wise shall inherit glory; but shame shall be the promotion of fools. Proverbs 3:35

Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth. Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding. Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her. She shall give to thine head an ornament of grace: a crown of **glory** shall she deliver to thee. Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many. I have taught thee in the way of wisdom; I have led thee in right paths. When thou goest, thy steps shall not be straitened; and when thou runnest, thou shalt not stumble. Take fast hold of instruction; let her not go: keep her; for she is thy life. Proverbs 4:9-13

The hoary head is a crown of **glory**, if it be found in the way of righteousness. Proverbs 16:31

Children's children are the crown of old men; and the **glory** *of children are their fathers. Proverbs* 17:6

He that getteth wisdom loveth his own soul: he that keepth understanding shall find good... The discretion of a man deferreth his anger; and it is his **glory** to pass over a transgression. Proverbs 19:8, 11

The **glory** of young men is their strength: and the beauty of old men is the gray head. Proverbs 19:29

It is the **glory** of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings is to search out a matter. Proverbs 25:2

It is not good to eat much honey: so for men to search their own **glory** is not glory. He that hath no rule over his own spirit is like a city that is broken down, and without walls. Proverbs 25:27-28

When righteous men do rejoice, there is great **glory**: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden. Proverbs 28:12

Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust, for fear of the LORD, and for the **glory** of his majesty... They shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the **glory** of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2:10, 19

To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for fear of the LORD, and for the **glory** of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2: 21

In that day shall the branch of the LORD be beautiful and **glorious**, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of Israel. And it shall come to pass, that he that is left in Zion, and he that remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem: When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of judgment, and by the spirit of burning. And the LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of a flaming fire by night: for upon all the **glory** shall be a defence. Isaiah 4:2-5

Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his **glory**. Isaiah 6:2-3

Therefore shall the Lord, the Lord of hosts, send among his fat ones leanness; and under his **glory** he shall kindle a burning like the burning of a **fire**. And the light of Israel shall be for a **fire**, and his Holy One for a flame: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day... Isaiah 10:16-17

In that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his rest shall be **glorious**. Isaiah 11:10

I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah. And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open. And I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place; and he shall be for a **glorious** throne to his father's house. Isaiah 22:21-23

They shall lift up their voice, they shall sing for the majesty of the LORD, they shall cry aloud from the sea. Wherefore **glorify** ye the LORD in the fires, even the name of the LORD God of Israel in the isles of the sea. From the uttermost part of the earth have we heard songs, even **glory** to the righteous. Isaiah 24:14-16

Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the LORD of hosts shall reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients **gloriously**. Isaiah 24:23

Therefore shall the strong people **glorify** thee, the city of the terrible nations shall fear thee. For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones is as a storm against the wall. Isaiah 25:3-4

Thou hast increased the nation, O LORD, thou hast increased the nation: thou art **glorified**: thou hadst removed it far unto all the ends of the earth. Isaiah 26:15

In that day shall the LORD of hosts be for a crown of **glory**, and for a diadem of beauty, unto the residue of his people, and for a spirit of judgment to him that sitteth in judgment, and for strength to them that turn the battle to the gate. Isaiah 28:5-6

Ye shall have a song, as in the night when a holy solemnity is kept; and gladness of heart, as when one goeth with a pipe to come into the mountain of the LORD, to the mighty One of Israel. And the LORD shall cause his **glorious** voice to be heard, and shall shew the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of his anger, and with the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, and tempest, and hailstones. Isaiah 30:29-30

Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a quiet habitation, a tabernacle that shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken. But there the **glorious** LORD will be unto us a place of broad rivers and streams; Isaiah 33:20-21a

Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain: And the **glory** of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it. Isaiah 40:4-5

I am the LORD: that is my name: and my **glory** will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images...Let them give **glory** unto the LORD, and declare his praise in the islands. Isaiah 42:8, 12

Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my **glory**, I have formed him; yea, I have made him. Isaiah 43:5-7

Sing, O ye heavens; for the LORD hath done it; shout, ye lower parts of the earth: break forth into singing, ye mountains, O forest, and every tree therein: for the LORD hath redeemed Jacob, and **glorified** himself in Israel. Isaiah 44:23

In the LORD shall all the seed of Israel be justified, and shall glory. Isaiah 45:25

For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do it; for how should my name be polluted? And I will not give my **glory** unto another. Isaiah 48:11

Now saith, the LORD that formed me from the womb to be his servant, to bring Jacob again to him, Though Israel be not gathered, yet shall I be **glorious** in the eyes of the LORD, and my God shall be my strength. Isaiah 49:5

Behold, thou shalt call a nation that thou knowest not, and nations that knew not thee shall run unto thee because of the LORD thy God, and for the Holy One of Israel; for he hath **glorified** thee. Isaiah 55:5 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the **glory** of the LORD shall be thy rereward. Isaiah 58:6-8

So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his **glory** from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him. Isaiah 59:19

Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the **glory** of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his **glory** shall be seen upon thee. Isaiah 60:1-2

The multitude of camels shall cover thee, the dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; all they from Sheba shall come: they shall bring gold and incense; and they shall shew forth the praises of the LORD. All the flocks of Kedar shall be gathered together unto thee, the rams of Nebaioth shall minister unto thee: they shall come up with acceptance on mine altar, and I will **glorify** the house of my **glory**. Who are these that fly as a cloud, and as the doves to their windows? Surely the isles shall wait for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he hath **glorified** thee. Isaiah 60:6-9

The glory of Lebanon shall come unto thee, and the box together, to beautify the place of my sanctuary; and I will make the place of my feet glorious. The sons also of them that afflicted thee shall come bending down unto thee; and all they that despised thee shall bow themselves down at the soles of thy feet; and they shall call thee, The city of the LORD, The Zion of the Holy One of Israel. Whereas thou hast been forsaken and hated, so that no man went through thee, I will make thee an eternal excellency, a joy of many generations. Isaiah 60:13-15

The sun shall no more be thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee: but the LORD shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy **glory**. Isaiah 60:19

To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousnes, the planting of the LORD, that he might be **glorified**. Isaiah 61:3

The Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy **glory**: and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD shall name. Thou shalt also be a crown of **glory** in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God. Isaiah 62:2-3

Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dved garments from Bozrah? This that is **glorious** in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save. Wherefore art thou red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat? I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment... Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, and his people, saying, Where is he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? Where is he that put his holy Spirit within him? That led them by the right hand of Moses with his glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make himself an everlasting name? That led them through the deep, as an horse in the wilderness, that they should not stumble? As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name. Isaiah 63:1-3, 11-14

Hear the word of the LORD, ye that tremble at his word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the LORD be **glorified**: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed...For I know their works and their thoughts: it shall come, that I will gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come, and see my **glory**. Isaiah 66:5, 18

If thou wilt return, O Israel, saith the LORD, return unto me: and if thou wilt put away thine abominations out of my sight, then shalt thou not remove. Thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they **glory**. Jeremiah 4:1-2

Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise man **glory** in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man **glory** in his might, let not the rich man **glory** in his riches: But let him that **glorieth glory** in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 9:23-24

A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary. O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters. Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise. Jeremiah 17:12-14

Out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of them that make merry: and I will multiply them, and they shall not be few; I will also **glorify** them, and they shall not be small. Their children also shall be as aforetime, and their congregation shall be established before me, and I will punish all that oppress them. Jeremiah 30:19-20

As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the **glory** of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake. Ezekiel 1:28

Then the spirit took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, saying, Blessed be the **glory** of the LORD from his place. I heard also the noise of the wings of the living creatures...Ezekiel 3:12-13

Then I arose, and went forth into the plain: and, behold, the **glory** of the LORD stood there, as the **glory** which I saw by the river of Chebar: and I fell on my face. Then the spirit entered into me... Ezekiel 3:23-24

One man among them was clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, and stood beside the brasen altar. The **glory** of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon he was, to the threshold of the house. And he called to the man clothed with linen, which had the writer's inkhorn by his side. And the LORD said unto him, Go through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark on the foreheads of the men that sigh and cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof. Ezekiel 9:2-4 Then the **glory** of the LORD went up from the cherub, and stood over the threshold of the house; and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of the LORD'S **glory**... Then the **glory** of the LORD departed from off the threshold of the house, and stood over the cherubims. Ezekiel 10:4,18

And the cherubims lift up their wings, and the wheels beside them; and the **glory** of the God of Israel was over them above. And the **glory** of the LORD went up from the midst of the city, and stood upon the mountain which is on the east side of the city. Ezekiel 11:22-23

When I shall bring thee down with them that descend into the pit, with the people of old time, and shall set thee in the low parts of the earth, in places desolate of old, with them that go down to the pit, that thou be not inhabited; and I shall set **glory** in the land of the living. Ezekiel 26:20

Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against thee, O Zidon; and I will be **glorified** in the midst of thee: and they shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall have executed judgments in her, and shall be sanctified in her, for I will send into her pestilence, and blood into her streets; and the wounded shall be judged in the midst of her by the sword upon her on every side; and they shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 28:22-23

Seven months shall the house of Israel be burying of them, that they may cleanse the land. Yea, all the people of the land shall bury them; and it shall be to them a renown the day that I shall be **glorified**, saith the Lord GOD...And I will set my **glory** among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see my judgment that I have executed, and my hand that I have laid upon them. Ezekiel 39:12-13, 21

Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the east: And, behold, the **glory** of the God of Israel came from the way of the east: and his voice was like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his **glory**. Ezekiel 43:1-2

Then brought he me the way of the north gate before the house: and I looked, and, behold, the **glory** of the LORD filled the house of the LORD: and I fell on my face. Ezekiel 44:4

Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and **glory**. Daniel 2:37

At the same time my reason returned unto me; and for the **glory** of my kingdom, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me; and I was established in my kingdom, and excellent majesty was added unto me. Daniel 4:36

O thou king, the most high God gave Nebuchadnezzar thy father a kingdom, and majesty, and glory, and honour: And for the majesty that he gave him, all people, nations, and languages, trembled and feared before him: whom he would he slew; and whom he would he kept alive; and whom he would he set up; and whom he would he put down. But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him...till he knew that the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men, and that he appointeth over it whomsoever he will. And thou his son, O Belshazzar, hast not humbled thine heart, though thou knewest all this; But has lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven...And the God in whose hand thy breath is, and whose are all thy ways, hast thou not glorified: Daniel 5:18-20, 21-23

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and **glory**, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed. Daniel 7:13-14

He that cometh against him shall do according to his own will, and none shall stand before him: and he shall stand in the **glorious** land, which by his hand shall be consumed...He shall enter also into the **glorious** land, and many countries shall be overthrown...and he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the **glorious** holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him. Daniel 11:16, 41, 45

O thou that art named the house of Jacob, is the spirit of the LORD straitened? Are these his doing? Do not my words do good to him that walketh uprightly? ... The women of my people have ye cast out from their pleasant houses; from their children have ye taken away my **glory** for ever. Arise ye, and depart; for this is not your rest: Micah 2:7, 9-10

For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the **glory** of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. Habakkuk 2:14

A prayer of Habakkuk the prophet upon Shigionoth. O LORD, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy. God came from Teman, and the Holy One from mount Paran. Selah. His **glory** covered the heavens, and the earth was full of his praise. Habakkuk 3:1-3

Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Consider your ways. Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take pleasure in it, and I will be **glorified**, saith the LORD. Haggai 1:8

Who is left among you that saw this house in her first **glory**? And how do ye see it now? Is it not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing? Yet now be strong...be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work: for I am with you, saith the LORD of hosts: According to the word that I covenanted with you...And I will shake the nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with **glory**, saith the LORD of hosts. Haggai 2:3-5, 7

The **glory** of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts; and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts. Haggai 2:9

For I, saith the LORD, will be unto her a wall of fire round about, and will be the **glory** in the midst of her...Deliver thyself, O Zion, that dwellest with the daughter of Babylon. For thus saith the LORD of hosts; After the **glory** hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye. Zechariah 2:5, 7-8

Even he shall build the temple of the LORD; and he shall bear the **glory**, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both. Zechariah 6:13

The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the **glory** of the house of David and the **glory** of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify themselves against Judah. In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David shall be as God, as the angel of the LORD before them. And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come up against Jerusalem. And I will pour upon the house of David, and pour upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. Zechariah 12:7-10

And now, O ye priests, this commandment is for you. If ye will not hear, and if ye will not lay it to heart, to give **glory** unto my name, saith the LORD of hosts, I will even send a curse upon you, and I will curse your blessings: yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay it to heart...My covenant was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before my name. The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity. For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts...Have we not all one father? Hath not one God created us? Why do we deal treacherously...? Malachi 2:2, 5-7, 10

GLORY IN THE NEW COVENANT

Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? It is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid...Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and **glorify** your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:13-14, 16

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the **glory**, for ever. Amen. Matthew 6:13

Consider the lilies of the field...I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his **glory** was not arrayed like one of these. Matthew 6:28-29

Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house. And he arose, and departed to his house. But when the multitudes saw it, they marvelled, and **glorifed** God, which had given such power unto men. Matthew 9:6-9

Great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus feet; and he healed them: Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see; and they **glorified** the God of Israel. Matthew 15:30-31

When the Son of man shall come in the **glory** of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works. Matthew 16:27

Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his **glory**, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. Matthew 19:28

Then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great **glory**. Matthew 24:30

When the Son of man shall come in his **glory**, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his **glory**: Matthew 24:31

I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house. And immediately he arose, took up his bed, and went forth before them all; insomuch that they were all amazed, and **glorified** God, saying, We never saw it on this fashion. Mark 2:12

Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the **glory** of his Father with the holy angels. Mark 8:38

They said unto him, Grant unto us that we may sit, one on thy right hand, and the other on thy left hand, in thy **glory**. Mark 10:37

Then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and **glory**. Mark 13:26

Lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the **glory** of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid...And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, **Glory** to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men...The shepherds returned, **glorifying** and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told unto them. Luke 2:8, 13-14, 20

Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: For mine eyes have seen thy salvation, Which thou hast prepared before the face of the people; A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the **glory** of thy people Israel. Luke 2:29-32

Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. And he taught in their synagogues, being **glorified** of all. Luke 4:14-15

I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house. And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, **glorifying** God. And they were all amazed, and they **glorified** God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day. Luke 5:24-26 He that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother. And there came a fear on all: and they **glorified** God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people. Luke 7:15-16

For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own **glory**, and in his Father's, and of the holy angels. Luke 9:26

He took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to pray. And as he prayed, the fashion of his countenance was altered, and his raiment was white and glistering. And, behold, there talked with him two men, which were Moses and Elias: Who appeared in **glory**, and spake of his decease which he should accomplish at Jerusalem. But Peter and they that were with him were heavy with sleep: and when they were awake, they saw his **glory**, and the two men that stood with him. Luke 9:31-32

Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his **glory** was not arrayed like one of these. Luke 12:27

There was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself...And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and **glorified** God...Ought not this woman being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day? And when he had said these things, all his adversaries were ashamed: and all the people rejoiced for all the **glorious** things that were done by him. Luke 13:11-13, 16-17

As he entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: And they lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. And when he saw them, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed. And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice **glorified** God, and fell down on his face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan. And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? There are not found that returned to give **glory** to God, save this stranger. Luke 17:12-18 What wilt thou that I shall do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight. Jesus said unto him, Receive thy sight: thy faith hath saved thee. And immediately he received his sight, and followed him, **glorifying** God: and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise unto God. Luke 18:42-43

As he went, they spread their clothes in the way. And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen; Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and **glory** in the highest. Luke 19:38

When Jesus had cried with a loud voice, he said, Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit: and having said thus, he gave up the ghost. Now when the centurion saw what was done, he **glorified** God, saying, Certainly this was a righteous man. Luke 23:46-47

There shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. Then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great **glory**. Luke 21:25-27

Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his **glory**? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself. Luke 24:26-27

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his **glory**, the **glory** as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John 1:14

Thou hast kept the good wine until now. This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his **glory**; and his disciples believed on him. John 2:11

If any man will do his will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God, or whether I speak of myself. He that speaketh of himself seeketh his own **glory**: but he that seeketh his **glory** that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him. John 7:17-18

(But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:39

Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me. And I seek not mine own **glory**: there is one that seeketh and judgeth. John 8:49-50

His sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom thou lovest is sick. When Jesus heard that, he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the **glory** of God, that the Son of God might be **glorified** thereby. John 11:4

Jesus saith unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the **glory** of God? ...He that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go. Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus did, believed on him. John 11:40, 44-45

And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written, Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt. These things understood not his disciples at the first: but when Jesus was **glorified**, then remembered they that these things were written of him, and that they had done these things unto him. John 12:14-16

Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be **glorified**. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit. He that loveth his life shall lose it; and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour. Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour. Father, **glorify** thy name. Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both **glorified** it, and will **glorify** it again. John 12:23-28 These things said Esaias, when he saw his **glory**, and spake of him. Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue: John 12:41-42

Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of man *glorified*, and God is *glorified* in him. If God be *glorified* in him, God shall also *glorify* him in himself, and shall straightway *glorify* him. John 13:31-32

He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be **glorified** in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. John 14:12-14

If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father **glorified**, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. These things have I spoken unto you, that your joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. John 15:6-11

When he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall **glorify** me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. John 16:13-14

These things have I spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; **glorify** thy Son, that thy Son also may **glorify** thee: John 16:33, 17:1

I have **glorified** thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. And now, O Father, **glorify** thou me with thine own self with the **glory** which I had with thee before the world was. I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am **glorified** in them. John 17:4-10

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe The **glory** which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast love them, as thou hast love me. Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my **glory**, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world. John 17:22-24

When thou wast young, thou girdedest thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry thee whither thou wouldest not. This spake he, signifying by what death he should **glorify** God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. John 21:18-19

Ye men of Israel, why marvel ye at this? Or why look ye so earnestly on us, as though by our own power or holiness we had made this man to walk? The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath **glorified** his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go. But he denied the Holy One and the Just... Acts 3:12-14

Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God, judge ye, For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard. So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men **glorified** God for that which was done. Acts 4:19-20

He said, Men, brethren, and father, hearken; The God of **glory** appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran. And said unto him, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and come into the land which I shall shew thee. Acts 7:2-3

Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye... When they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth. He, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the **glory** of God, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God. And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing at the right hand of God. Acts 7:51, 54-56

Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as he did unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God? When they heard these things, they held their peace, and **glorified** God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life. Acts 11:17-18

Upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his throne, and made an oration unto them. And the people gave a shout, saying, It is the voice of a god, and not of a man. And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the **glory**: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost. Acts 12:23

When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and **glorified** the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed. Acts 13:48

The day following Paul went in with us unto James; and all the elders were present. And when he had saluted them, he declared particularly what things God had wrought among the Gentiles by his ministry. And when they heard it, they **glorified** the Lord...Acts 20:18-20a

He declared particularly what things God had wrought among the Gentiles by his ministry. And when they heard it, they **glorified** the Lord, and said unto him, Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which believe; and they are all zealous of the law. Acts 21:19-20

As I made my journey, and was come nigh to Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me... When I could not see for the **glory** of that light, being led by the hand of them that were with me, I came into Damascus. Acts 22:6, 11

When they knew God, they **glorified** him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools, and changed the **glory** of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four-footed beasts, and creeping things. Romans 1:21-23

To them by patient continuance in well doing seek for **glory** and honour and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; But **glory**, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile: For there is no respect of persons with God. Romans 2:8-11

But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of God, what shall we say? Is God unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (I speak as a man) God forbid: for then how shall God judge the world? For if the truth of God hath more abounded through my lie unto his **glory**; why yet am I also judged as a sinner? Romans 3:7

But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference. For all have sinned, and come short of the **glory** of God; Romans 3:21-23

For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to **glory**; but not before God. Romans 4:2

He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving **glory** to God; and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. Romans 4:20-21

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the **glory** of God. And not only so, but we **glory** in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope: and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:2-5 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the **glory** of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Romans 6:4

The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also **glorified** together. For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the **glory** which shall be revealed in us. Romans 8:16-18

We know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. Romans 8:28-30

For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God. For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him who hath subjected the same in hope, Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the **glorious** liberty of the children of God. Romans 8:12-21

For I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh: Who are Israelites; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the **glory**, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises; Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen. Romans 9:2-5

O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been his counseller? Or who hath first given to him, and it shall be recompensed unto him again? For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be **glory** for ever. Amen. Romans 11:33-36 Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind and one mouth **glorify** God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Wherefore receive ye one another, as Christ also received us to the **glory** of God. Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers: And that the Gentiles might **glorify** God for his mercy; as it is written... Romans 15:5-9

I have therefore whereof I may **glory** through Jesus Christ in those things which pertain to God. For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ hath wrought by me, to make the Gentiles obedient by word and deed, Through mighty signs and wonders, by the power of the Spirit of God... Romans 15:17-19

Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began but now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith. To God only wise, be **glory** through Jesus Christ for ever. Amen. Romans 16:25-27

But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; and base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are: That no flesh should **glory** in his presence. But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption: That, according as it is written, He that **glorieth**, let him **glory** in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 1:27-31

But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our **glory**: Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of **glory**. 1 Corinthians 2:7-8

Therefore let no man **glory** *in men. For all things are yours...And ye are Christ's; and Christ is God's.* 1 *Corinthians 3:21, 23*

What? Know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price; therefore **glorify** God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20

They which preach the gospel should live of the gospel. But I have used none of these things: neither have I written these things, that it should be so done unto me: for it were better for me to die, than that any man should make my **glorying** void. For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to **glory** of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel! 1 Corinthians 9:14-16

Whether...ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the **glory** of God. Give none offence, neither to the Jew, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God: Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved. 1 Corinthians 10:31

For man indeed ought not to cover his head, forasmuch as he is the image and **glory** of God: but the woman is the **glory** of the man...But if a woman have long hair, it is a **glory** to her; for her hair is given her for a covering. 1 Corinthians 11:7, 15

There are also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the **glory** of the celestial is one, and the **glory** of the terrestrial is another. There is one **glory** of the sun, and another **glory** of the moon, and another **glory** of the stars: for one star differeth from another star in **glory**. 1 Cor 15:40-41

So also is the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in incorruption: It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in **glory**: it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power: It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. 1 Corinthians 15:42-44

Do I purpose according to the flesh, that with me there should be yea yea, and nay nay? But as God is true, our word toward you was not yea and nay. For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us...was not yea and nay, but in him was yea. For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the **glory** of God by us. 2 Corinthians 1:17-20 If the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was **glorious**, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the **glory** of his countenance; which **glory** was to be done away: How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather **glorious**? For if the ministration of condemnation be **glory**, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in **glory**. For even that which was made **glorious** had no **glory** in this respect, by reason of the **glory** that excelleth. For if that which is done away was **glorious**, much more that which remaineth is **glorious**. 2 Corinthians 3:7-11

Even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart. Nevertheless when it shall turn to the Lord, the vail shall be taken away. Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the **glory** of the Lord, are changed into the same image from **glory** to **glory**, even as by the Spirit of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:15-18

But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the **glorious** gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the knowledge of the **glory** of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 2 Corinthians 4:6

For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the **glory** of God. For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of **glory**; While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal. 2 Corinthians 4:15-18

For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to **glory** on our behalf, that ye may have somewhat to answer them which glory in appearance, and not in heart. 2 Corinthians 5:12

We have sent with him the brother, whose praise is in the gospel throughout all the churches; Not that only, but who was also chosen of the churches to travel with us with this grace, which is administered by us to the **glory** of the same Lord, and declaration of your ready mind. 2 Corinthians 8:18-19

We have sent with them our brother, whom we have oftentimes proved diligent in many things, but now much more diligent, upon the great confidence which I have in you. Whether any do enquire of Titus, he is my partner and fellow-helper concerning you: or our brethren be enquired of, they are messengers of the churches, and the **glory** of Christ. 2 Corinthians 8:22-23

For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they **glorify** God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men; and by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you. 2 Corinthians 9:13-14

But he that **glorieth**, let him **glory** in the Lord. For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth. 2 Corinthians 10:17-18

What I do, that I will do, that I may cut off occasion from them which desire occasion; that wherein they **glory**, they may be found even as we. For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 2 Corinthians 11:12-14

He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather **glory** in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong. I am become a fool in **glorying**; ye have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing. Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds. 2 Corinthians 12:9-12 Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ, Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father: To whom be **glory** for ever and ever. Amen. Galatians 1:5

They had heard only, that he which persecuted us in times past now preacheth the faith which once he destroyed. And they **glorified** God in me. Galatians 1:23-24

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be desirous of vain **glory**, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 5:22-26

For neither they themselves who are circumcised keep the law; but desire to have you circumcised, that they may **glory** in your flesh. But God forbid that I should **glory**, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world. Galatians 6:13-14

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love... To the praise of the **glory** of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. Ephesians 1:3-4, 6

That we should be to the praise of his **glory**, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the words of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his **glory**. Ephesians 1:12-14

I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations for you, which is your **glory**. For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named. Ephesians 3:13-15 After I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of **glory**, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the **glory** of his inheritance in the saints, And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to usward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all. Ephesians 1:17-23

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his **glory**, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, Unto him be **glory** in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen. Ephesians 3:16-21

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, that he might present it to himself a **glorious** church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. Ephesians 5:25-27

For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ. This I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the **glory** and praise of God. Philippians 1:8-11
Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the **glory** of God the Father. Philippians 2:5-11

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.) For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself. Philippians 3:17-21

But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in **glory** by Christ Jesus. Now unto God and our Father be **glory** for ever and ever. Amen. Philippians 4:19-20

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding. That ye may walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; Strengthened with all might, according to his **glorious** power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness: Colossians 1:9-11

The mystery which hath been hid...but now is made manifest to his saints: To whom God would make known to you what is the riches of the **glory** of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of **glory**: Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: Colossians 1:27-28 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God. When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in **glory**. Colossians 3:3-4

Ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children, That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and **glory**. 1 Thessalonians 2:11-12

For what is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming? For ye are our **glory** and joy. 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20

We ourselves **glory** in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure: Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also suffer: Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; 2 Thessalonians 1:4-6

And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the **glory** of his power; When he shall come to be **glorified** in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day. Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power: That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be **glorified** in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-12

We are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the **glory** of our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14

Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be **glorified**, even as it is with you: 2 Thessalonians 3:1

According to the **glorious** gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust. And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry. 1 Timothy 1:11-12

Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only wise God, be honour and **glory** for ever and ever. Amen. 1 Timothy 1:15-17

These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly: But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth. Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. 1 Timothy 3:14-16

Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal **glory**. 2 Timothy 2:10

The Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be **glory** for ever and ever. Amen. 2 Timothy 4:18

For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed hope, and the **glorious** appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Titus 2:12-14 God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, Hath in these last days spoken unto us by his Son, of all things, by whom also he made the worlds; Who being the brightness of his **glory**, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high; Hebrews 1:1-3

What is man, that thou art mindful of him? Or the son of man, that thou visitest him? Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with **glory** and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands: Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing that is not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him. But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with **glory** and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto **glory**, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. Hebrews 2:7-11

Holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. For this man was counted worthy of more **glory** than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house. For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God. Hebrews 3:1-4

No man taketh this honour unto himself, but he that is called of God, as was Aaron. So also Christ **glorified** not himself to be made an high priest; but he that said unto him, Thou art my Son, to day have I begotten thee. Hebrews 5:4-5

The first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary. For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shewbread; which is called the sanctuary. And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all; Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant; And over it the cherubims of **glory** shadowing the mercyseat; Hebrews 9:1-5

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be **glory** for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:20-21

My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons. James 2:1

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you, Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations: That the trial of your faith being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and **glory** at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of **glory**: Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls. 1 Peter 1:3-9

Of which salvation the prophets have inquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you: Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the **glory** that should follow. 1 Peter 1:10-11

Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him **glory**; that your faith and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:18-21 Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, **glorify** God in the day of visitation...For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully. Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens; A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man. For every high priest is ordained to offer gifts and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer. For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law: Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, that thou make all things according to the pattern shown to thee in the mount. But now hath he obtained a more **excellent** ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises. For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. Hebrews 8:1-7

For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from **the excellent glory**,

HIS ROYAL MAJESTY

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the **majesty**: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. 1 Chronicles 29:11

The LORD magnified Solomon exceedingly in the sight of all Israel, and bestowed upon him such **royal majesty** as had not been on any king before him in Israel. 1 Chronicles 29:25

Hear thou therefore the word of the LORD: I saw the LORD sitting on *his throne*, and all the host of heaven standing by him on his right hand and on his left. 1 Kings 22:19

I saw the LORD sitting upon **his throne**, and all the host of heaven standing on his right hand and on his left. And the LORD said, Who shall entice Ahab king of Israel, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? ... Then there came out a spirit, and stood before the LORD, and said, I will entice him. And the LORD said unto him, Wherewith? And he said, I will go out, and be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And the LORD said, Thou shalt entice him, and thou shalt also prevail: go out, and do even so. 2 Chronicles 18:18-21

He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing. He bindeth up the waters in his thick clouds; and the cloud is not rent under them. I will praise thee, O LORD, with my whole heart...For thou hast maintained my right and my cause; thou satest in the **throne** judging right. Thou hast rebuked the heathen, thou hast destroyed the wicked, thou hast put out their name for ever and ever. O thou enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and thou hast destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them. But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his **throne** for judgment. And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness. Psalm 9:1-8 The LORD is in his holy temple, the LORD'S **throne** is in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men. Psalm 11:4

Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. Psalm 45:6

For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth. He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet. He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah. God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. Sing praises to God, sing praises; sing praises unto our King, sing praises. For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding. God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the **throne** of his holiness. The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted. Psalm 47:2-9

The heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD: thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints. For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? Who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD? God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him. O LORD God of hosts, who is a strong LORD like unto thee? Or to thy faithfulness round about thee? Thou rulest the raging of the sea: when the waves thereof arise, thou stillest them. Thou hast broken Rahab in pieces, as one that is slain; thou hast scattered thine enemies with thy strong arm. The heavens are thine, the earth also is thine: as for the world and the fulness thereof, thou hast founded them. The north and the south thou hast created them: Tabor and Hermon shall rejoice in thy name. Thou hast a mighty arm: strong is thy hand, and high is thy right hand. Justice and judgment are the habitation of **thy throne**: mercy and truth shall go before thy face. Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance. In thy name shall they rejoice all the day; and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted. For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted. For the LORD is our defence; and the Holy One of Israel is our king. Psalm 89:5-18

The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved. Thy **throne** is established of old: thou art from everlasting. Psalm 93:2

The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the LORD of the whole earth. The heavens declare his righteousness, and all the people see his glory. Psalm 97:1-6

The LORD hath prepared his **throne in the heavens**; and his kingdom ruleth over all. Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. Psalm 103:19-20

In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a *throne*, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke. Then said I, Woe is me! For I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts. Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: and he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin is purged. Isaiah 6:1-7

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon **the throne** of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. Isaiah 9:6-7 In mercy shall the **throne** be established: and he shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness. Isaiah 16:5

The key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open. And I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place; and he shall be for a glorious **throne** to his father's house. Isaiah 22:22-23

Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my **throne**, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? And where is the place of my rest? For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of a contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word. Isaiah 66:1-2

At that time they shall call Jerusalem the **throne** of the LORD; and all the nations shall be gathered unto it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem: neither shall they walk any more after the imagination of their evil heart. Jeremiah 3:17

Hast thou utterly rejected Judah? Hath thy soul loathed Zion? Why hast thou smitten us, and there is no healing for us? We looked for peace, and there is no good; and for the time of healing, and behold trouble! We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, and the iniquity of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee. Do not abhor us, for thy name's sake, do not disgrace the **throne** of thy glory: remember, break not thy covenant among us. Are there any among the vanities of the Gentiles that can cause rain? Or can the heavens give showers? Art not thou he, O LORD our God? Therefore we will wait upon thee: for thou hast made all these things. Jeremiah 14:19-22

A glorious high **throne** from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary. O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters. Jeremiah 17:12-13

Thou, O LORD, remainest for ever; thy **throne** from generation to generation. Wherefore dost thou forget us for ever, and forsake us so long time? Turn thou us unto thee, O LORD, and we shall be turned; renew our days as of old. Lamentations 5:19-21

Above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a **throne**, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the **throne** was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it. And I saw as the colour of amber, as the appearance of fire round about within it, from the appearance of his loins even upward, and from the appearance of his loins even downward, I saw as it were the appearance of fire, and it had brightness round about. As the appearance of the bow that is in the cloud in the day of rain, so was the appearance of the brightness round about. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the LORD. And when I saw it, I fell upon my face, and I heard a voice of one that spake. Ezekiel 1:26-28

Then I looked, and, behold, in the firmament that was above the head of the cherubims there appeared over them as it were a sapphire stone, as the appearance of the likeness of a **throne**. And he spake unto the man clothed with linen, and said, Go in between the wheels, even under the cherub, and fill thine hand with the coals of fire from between the cherubims, and scatter them over the city. And he went in in my sight. Now the cherubims stood on the right side of the house, when the man went in; and the cloud filled the inner court. Then the glory of the LORD went up from the cherub, and stood over the threshold of the house; and the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of the LORD's glory. Ezekiel 10:1-4

He said unto me, Son of man, the place of my **throne**, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcases of their kings in their high places. Ezekiel 43:7

I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment was white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: *his throne* was like the fiery flame, and his wheels as burning fire. A fiery stream came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened... I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed. I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of my body, and the visions of my head troubled me...I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them; until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High: and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom...and the kingdom and the dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him. Daniel 7:9-15, 21-22, 27

Even he shall build the temple of the LORD; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his **throne**; and he shall be a priest upon his **throne**: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both. Zechariah 6:13

NEW COVENANT THRONES

Ye have heard that it hath been said by them of old time, Thou shalt not forswear thyself, but shalt perform unto the Lord thine oaths: but I say unto you, Swear not at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's **throne**: Nor by the earth; for it is his footstool: neither by Jerusalem; for it is the city of the great King. Matthew 5:33-35

Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the **throne** of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve **thrones**, judging the twelve tribes of Israel. Matthew 19:28

Whoso shall swear by the temple, swearth by it, and by him that dwelleth therein. And he that shall swear by heaven, sweareth by **the throne** of God, and by him that sitteth thereon. Matthew 23:21-22

When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the **throne** of his glory: and before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats: and he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left. Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world... Matthew 25:31-34

Behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the **throne** of his father David: and he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. Luke 1:31-33

Men and brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day. Therefore being a prophet, and know that God had sworn with an oath to him, that of the fruit of his loins, according to the flesh, he would raise up Christ to sit on his **thron**e; he seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption. This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear. Acts 2:29-34 The most High dwelleth not in temples made with hands; as saith the prophet, Heaven is my **throne**, and earth is my footstool: what house will ye build me? saith the Lord: or what is the place of my rest? Hath not my hand made all these things? Acts 7:48-50

For by him were all things created, that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be **thrones**, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: Colossians 1:16

But unto the Son he saith, Thy **throne**, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the **sceptre** of thy kingdom. Hebrews 1:8

Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession. For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the **throne** of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:14-16

Now of the things which we have spoken this is the sum: We have such an high priest, who is set on the right hand of the **throne** of the Majesty in the heavens; A minister of the sanctuary, and of the true tabernacle, which the Lord pitched, and not man. Hebrews 8:1-2

Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of **the throne** of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my **throne**, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his **throne**. Revelation 3:21

After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, Come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter. And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne. And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald. And round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold. And out of the throne proceeded lightnings and thunderings and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal: and in the midst of the throne, and round about the throne, were four beasts full of eves before and behind. And the first beast was like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast was like a flying eagle. And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come. And when those beasts give glory and honour and thanks to him that sat on the **throne**, who liveth for ever and ever, the four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created. Revelation 4:1-11

I saw in the right hand of him that sat on the **throne** a book written within and on the backside, sealed with seven seals...and I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the **throne** and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. And he came and took the book out of the right hand of him that sat upon the **throne**. Revelation 5:1, 6-7

Every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the **throne**, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever. Revelation 5:13-14 The kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and lie in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on **the throne**, and from the wrath of the Lamb... Revelation 6:15-16

After this I beheld, and lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; and cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb. All the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the **throne** on their faces, and worshipped God, saving, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? And whence came they? And I said unto him. Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore are they before the **throne** of God, and serve him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the **throne** shall dwell among them. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. Revelation 7:9-17

And another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden altar which was before **the throne**. Revelation 8:3

She brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his **throne**. Revelation 12:5

And I looked. and. lo. a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: and they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God. And I saw another angel flv in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, saving with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. Revelation 14:1-7

And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from **the throne**, saying, It is done. And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquke, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great. Revelation 16:17-21 I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honour, and power, unto the Lord our God: For true and righteous are his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand. And again they said, Alleluia. And her smoke rose up for ever and ever. And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshipped God that sat on the **throne**, saying, Amen; Alleluia. And a voice came out of the **throne**, saying, Praise our God, all ye his servants, and ye that fear him, both small and great. And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigneth. Revelation 19:1-6

I saw a great white **throne**, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. Revelation 20:11

And he that sat upon the **throne** said, Behold, Imake all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. Revelation 21:5-7

He shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the **throne** of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the **throne** of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him: Revelation 22:1-3

THRONE AND SCEPTRE VERSES

Thou shalt be over my house, and according unto thy word shall all my people be ruled: only in the **throne** will I be greater than thou. Genesis 41:40

The *sceptre* shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be. Genesis 49:10

All the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his **throne**, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts. Exodus 11:5

And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his **throne** unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of the cattle. Exodus 12:29

I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a **Sceptre** shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth. Numbers 24:17

It shall be, when he sitteth upon the **throne** of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: Deuteronomy 17:18

To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up **the throne** of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beer-sheba. 2 Samuel 3:10

And the woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the iniquity be on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his **throne** be guiltless. 2 Samuel 14:9

He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the **throne** of his kingdom for ever...and thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy **throne** shall be established for ever. 2 Samuel 7:13, 16

Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my **throne**? Why then doth Adonijah reign?...She said unto him, My lord, thou swarest by the LORD thy God unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon the **throne**. 1 Kings 1:13, 17

My lord, O king, the eyes of all Israel are upon thee, that thou shouldest tell them who shall sit on the **throne** of my lord the king after him...Nathan said, My lord, O king, hast thou said, Adonijah shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my **throne**? ... Is this thing done by my lord the king, and thou hast not shewed it unto thy servant, who should sit on the **throne** of my lord the king after him? 1 Kings 1:20, 24, 27

Even as I sware unto thee by the LORD God of Israel, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my **throne** in my stead; even so will I certainly do this day... Then ye shall come up after him, that he may come and sit upon **my throne**; for he shall be king in my stead: and I have appointed him to be ruler over Israel and over Judah... As the LORD hath been with my lord the king, even so be he with Solomon, and make his throne greater than the **throne** of my lord king David. 1 Kings 1:30, 35, 37

Solomon sitteth on the **throne** of the kingdom. And moreover the king's servants came to bless our lord king David, saying, God make the name of Solomon better than thy name, and make his **throne** greater than **thy throne**. And the king bowed himself upon the bed. Also thus said the king, Blessed be the LORD God of Israel, which hath given one to sit on my **throne** this day, mine eyes seeing it. 1 Kings 1:46-48

That the LORD may continue his word which he spake concerning me, saying, If thy children take heed to their way, to walk before me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul, there shall not fail thee (said he) a man on the **throne** of Israel. 1 Kings 2:4

Then sat Solomon upon the **throne** of David his father; and his kingdom was established greatly...1 Kings 2:12

Bath-sheba therefore went unto king Solomon, to speak unto him for Adonijah. And the king rose up to meet her, and bowed himself unto her, and sat down on his **throne**, and caused a seat to be set for the king's mother; and she sat on his right hand. 1 Kings 2:19

Now therefore, as the LORD liveth, which hath established me, and set me on the **throne** of David my father, and who hath made me an house, as he promised, Adonijah shall be put to death this day. 1 Kings 2:24

Their blood shall therefore return upon the head of Joab, and upon the head of his seed for ever: but upon David, and upon his seed, and upon his house, and upon his **throne**, shall there be peace for ever from the LORD. 1 Kings 2:33

King Solomon shall be blessed, and the **throne** of David shall be established before the LORD for ever. 1 Kings 2:45

Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on **his throne**, as it is this day. 1 Kings 3:6

Behold, I purpose to build an house unto the name of the LORD my God, as the LORD spake unto David my father, saying, Thy son, whom I will set upon thy **throne** in thy room, he shall build an house unto my name. 1 Kings 5:5

Then he made a porch for the **throne** where he might judge, even the porch of judgment: and it was covered with cedar from one side of the floor to the other. 1 Kings 7:7

The LORD hath performed his word that he spake, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the **throne** of Israel, as the LORD promised, and have built an house for the name of the LORD God of Israel... Therefore now, Lord God of Israel, keep with thy servant David my father that thou promisest him, saying, there shall not fail thee a man in my sight to sit upon thy **throne** of Israel; so that thy children take heed to their way, that they walk before me as thou hast walked before me. 1 Kings 8:20, 25

Then I will establish the **throne** of thy kingdom upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man upon the **throne** of Israel. 1 Kings 9:5

Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee, to set thee on the **throne** of Israel: because the LORD loved Israel for ever, therefore made he thee king, to do judgment and justice. 1 Kings 10:9

Moreover the king made a great **throne** of ivory, and overlaid it with the best gold. The **throne** had six steps, and the top of **the throne** was round behind: and there were stays on either side on the place of the seat, and two lions stood beside the stays. 1 Kings 10:18-19

And it came to pass, when he began to reign, as soon as he sat on his *throne*, that he slew all the house of Baasha: he left not one that pisseth against a wall, neither of his kinsfolks, nor of his friends. 1 Kings 16:11

The king of Israel and Jehoshaphat the king of Judah sat each on his *throne*, having put on their robes, in a void place in the entrance of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them. 1 Kings 22:10

And the LORD said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing that which is right in mine eyes, and hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that was in mine heart, thy children of the fourth generation shall sit on the **throne** of Israel. 2 Kings 10:30

And he took rulers over hundreds, and the captains, and the guard, and all the people of the land; and they brought down the king from the house of the LORD, and came by way of the gate of the guard to the king's house. And he sat on the **throne** of the kings. 2 Kings 11:19

Joash slept with his fathers; and Jeroboam sat upon his **throne**: and Joash was buried in Samaria with the kings of Israel. 2 Kings 13:13

This was the word of the LORD which he spake unto Jehu, saying, Thy sons shall sit on the **throne** of Israel unto the fourth generation. And so it came to pass. 2 Kings 15:12

He spake kindly to him, and set his **throne** above the **throne** of the kings that were with him in Babylon; 2 Kings 25:28

He shall build me an house, and I will stablish his **throne** for ever. I will settle him in mine house and in my kingdom for ever: and his **throne** shall be established for evermore. 1 Chronicles 17:12, 14

He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the **throne** of his kingdom over Israel for ever. 1 Chronicles 22:10 *Of all my sons, (for the LORD hath given my many sons,) he hath chosen Solomon my son to sit upon the throne of the kingdom of the LORD over Israel. 1 Chronicles 28:5*

Then Solomon sat on the **throne** of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel obeyed him. 1 Chronicles 29:23

The LORD therefore hath performed his word that he hath spoken: for I am risen up in the room of David my father, and am set on the **throne** of Israel, as the LORD promised, and have built the house for the name of the LORD God of Israel. 2 Chronicles 6:10

God of Israel, keep with thy servant David my father that which thou hast promised him, saying, There shall not fail thee a man in my sight to sit upon the **throne** of Israel; yet so that thy children take heed to their way to walk in my law, as thou hast walked before me. 2 Chronicles 6:16

Blessed be the LORD thy God, which delighted in thee to set thee on his **throne**, to be king for the LORD thy God: because thy God loved Israel, to establish them for ever, therefore made he thee king over them, to do judgment and justice. 2 Chronicles 9:8

Moreover the king made a great **throne** of ivory, and overlaid it with pure gold. And there were six steps to the **throne**, with a footstool of gold, which were fastened to the throne, and stays on each side of the sitting place, and two lions standing by the stays. 2 Chronicles 9:17-18

The king of Israel and Jehoshaphat king of Judah sat either of them on his **throne**, clothed in their robes, and they sat in a void place at the entering in of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them... 2 Chronicles 18:9

He took the captains of hundred, and the nobles, and the governors of the people, and all the people of the land, and brought down the king from the house of the LORD: and they came through the high gate into the king's house, and set the king upon the **throne** of the kingdom. 2 Chronicles 23:20

Next unto them repaired Melatiah the Gibeonite, and Jadon the Meronothite, the men of Gibeon, and of Mizpah, unto the **throne** of the governor on this side the river. Nehemiah 3:7

That in those days, when the king Ahasuerus sat on the **throne** of his kingdom, which was in Shushan the palace, in the third year of his reign, he made a feast... Esther 1:2

All the king's servants, and the people of the king's provinces, do know, that whosoever, whether man or woman, shall come unto the king into the inner court, who is not called, there is one law of his to put him to death, except such to whom the king shall hold out the golden **sceptre**, that he may live: but I have not been called to come in unto the king these thirty days. Esther 4:11

Now it came to pass on the third day, that Esther put on her royal apparel, and stood in the inner court of the king's house, over against the king's house: and the king sat upon his royal **throne** in the royal house, over against the gate of the house. And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, that she obtained favour in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden **sceptre** that was in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the **sceptre**. Esther 5:1-2

Then the king held out the golden **sceptre** toward Esther. So Esther arose, and stood before the king. Esther 8:4

He withdraweth not his eyes from the righteous: but with kings are they on the throne; yea, he doth establish them for ever, and they are exalted. Job 36:7

Thy seed will I establish for ever, and build up thy **throne** to all generations. Selah...His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his **throne** as the days of heaven...His seed shall endure for ever, and his **throne** as the sun before me. Psalm 89:4, 29, 36

Thou hast made his glory to cease, and cast his throne to the ground. Psalm 89:44

Shall the **throne** of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law? Psalm 94:20

Jerusalem is builded as a city that is compact together: whither the tribes goes up, the tribes of the LORD, unto the testimony of Israel, to give thanks unto the name of the LORD. For there are set **thrones** of judgment, the **thrones** of the house of David. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee. Psalm 122:2-6 The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy **throne**. If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy **throne** for evermore. Psalm 132:11-12

It is an abomination to kings to commit wickedness: for the **throne** is established by righteousness. Proverbs 16:12

A king that sitteth in the **throne** of judgment scattereth away all evil with his eyes. Proverbs 20:8

Take away the wicked from before the king, and his **throne** shall be established in righteousness. Proverbs 25:5

The king that faithfully judgeth the poor, his **throne** shall be established for ever. Proverbs 29:14

The LORD hath broken the staff of the wicked, and the **sceptre** of the rulers...Hell from beneath is moved for thee to meet thee at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead for thee, even all the chief ones of the earth; it hath raised up from their **thrones** all the kings of the nations...How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my **throne** above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. Isaiah 14:5, 9, 13-15

I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place; and he shall be for a glorious **throne** to his father's house. Isaiah 22:23

Come down, and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon, sit on the ground: there is no **throne**, O daughter of the Chaldeans; for thou shalt no more be called tender and delicate. Isaiah 47:1

For, lo, I will call all the families of the kingdoms of the north, saith the LORD; and they shall come, and they shall set every one his **throne** at the entering of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all the walls thereof round about, and against all the cities of Judah. Jeremiah 1:15

Then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will fill all the inhabitants of this land, even the kings that sit upon David's **throne**, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, with drunkenness. Jeremiah 13:13

Then shall there enter into the gates of the city kings and prices sitting upon the **throne** of David, riding in chariots and on horses, they, and their princes, the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem: and this city shall remain for ever. Jeremiah 17:25

Hear the word of the LORD, O king of Judah, that sittest upon the **throne** of David, thou, and thy servants, and thy people that enter in by these gates. Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place. For if ye do this thing indeed, then shall there enter in by the gates of this house kings sitting upon the **throne** of David, riding in chariots and on horses, he, and his servants, and his people. Jeremiah 22:2-4

Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man that shall not prosper in his days: for no man of his seed shall prosper, sitting upon the **throne** of David, and ruling any more in Judah. Jeremiah 22:30

Know that thus saith the LORD of the king that sitteth upon the **throne** of David, and of all the people that dwelleth in this city, and of your brethren that are not gone forth with you into captivity; Jeremiah 29:16

For thus saith the LORD; David shall never want a man to sit upon the **throne** of the hosue of Israel...If ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; then may also the covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his **throne**; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. Jeremiah 33:17, 20-21

Thus saith the LORD of Jehoiakim king of Judah; He shall have none to sit upon the **throne** of David and his dead body shall be cast out in the day to the heat, and in the night to the frost. Jeremiah 36:30

And say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will send and take Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will set his **throne** upon these stones that I have hid; and he shall spread his royal pavilion over them. Jeremiah 43:10
And she had strong rods for the **sceptres** of them that bare rule, and her stature was exalted among the thick branches, and she appeared in her height with the multitude of her branches...And fire is gone out of a rod of her branches, which hath devoured her fruit, so that she hath no strong rod to be a **sceptre** to rule. This is a lamentation, and shall be for a lamentation. Ezekel 19:11, 14

Then all the princes of the sea shall come down from their **thrones**, and lay away their robes, and put off their broidered garments: they shall clothe themselves with trembling; they shall sit upon the ground, and shall tremble at every moment, and be astonished at thee. Ezekiel 26:16

But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly **throne**, and they took his glory from him: Daniel 5:20

I will break also the bar of Damascus, and cut off the inhabitant from the plain of Aven, and him that holdeth the **sceptre** from the house of Eden: and the people of Syria shall go into captivity unto Kir, saith the LORD...And I will cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and him that holdeth the **sceptre** from Ashkelon, and I will turn mine hand against Ekron: and the remnant of the Philistines shall perish, saith the Lord GOD. Amos 1:5, 8

For word came unto the king of Nineveh, and he arose from his **throne**, and he laid his robe from him, and covered him with sackcloth, and sat in ashes. Jonah 3:6

I will overthrow the **throne** of kingdoms, and I will destroy the strength of the kingdoms of the heathen; and I will overthrow the chariots, and those that ride in them; and the horses and their riders shall come down, every one by the sword of his brother. Haggai 2:22

And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the **sceptre** of Egypt shall depart away. Zechariah 10:11

THRONES IN THE NEW COVENANT

That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on **thrones** judging the twelve tribes of Israel. Luke 22:30

Upon a set day Herod, arrayed in royal apparel, sat upon his **throne**, and made an oration unto them. And the people gave a shout, saying, It is the voice of a god, and not of a man. And immediately the angel of the Lord smote him, because he gave not God the glory: and he was eaten of worms, and gave up the ghost. Acts 12:21-23

And I saw **thrones**, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. Revelation 20:4

CROWNS

Thou shalt put the mitre upon his head, and put the **holy crown** upon the mitre. Exodus 29:6

They made the plate of the **holy crown** of pure gold, and wrote upon it in writing, like to the engravings of a signet, HOLINESS TO THE LORD. Exodus 39:30

He put the mitre upon his head; also upon the mitre, even upon his forefront, did he put the golden plate, the **holy crown**; as the LORD commanded Moses. Leviticus 8:9

Neither shall he go out of the sanctuary, nor profane the sanctuary of his God; for **the crown** of the anointing oil of his God is upon him: I am the LORD. Leviticus 21:12

So I stood upon him, and slew him, because I was sure that he could not live after that he was fallen: and I took the **crown** that was upon his head, and the bracelet that was on his arm, and have brought them hither unto my lord. 2 Samuel 1:10

He took their king's **crown** from off his head, the weight whereof was a talent of gold with the precious stones: and it was set on David's head. And he brought forth the spoil of the city in great abundance. 2 Samuel 12:30

He brought forth the king's son, and put the **crown** upon him, and gave him the testimony; and they made him king, and anointed him; and they clapped their hands, and said, God save the king. 2 Kings 11:12

David took **the crown** of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and there were precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city. 1 Chronicles 20:2

Then they brought out the king's son, and put upon him **the crown**, and gave him the testimony, and made him king. And Jehoida and his sons anointed him, and said, God save the king. 2 Chronicles 23:11

The king was merry with wine, he commanded... To bring Vashti the queen before the king with **the crown** royal, to shew the people and the princes her beauty: for she was fair to look on. Esther 1:11

The king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal **crown** upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti. Exther 2:17

Let the royal apparel be brought which the king useth to wear, and the horse that the king rideth upon, and the **crown** royal which is set upon his head: Esther 6:8

Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, and with a great **crown** of gold, and with a garment of fine linen and purple: and the city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad. Esther 8:15

He hath stripped me of my glory, and taken the crown from my head. Job 19:9

Surely I would take it upon my shoulder, and bind it as a crown to me. Job 31:36

For thou preventest him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a **crown** of pure gold on his head. Psalm 21:3

Thou hast made void the covenant of thy servant: thou hast profaned his **crown** by casting it to the ground. Psalm 89:39

His enemies will I clothe with shame: but upon himself shall his crown flourish. Psalm 132:18

She shall give to thine head an ornament of grace: a **crown** of glory shall she deliver to thee. Proverbs 4:9

A virtuous woman is a **crown** to her husband: but she that maketh ashamed is as rottenness in his bones. Proverbs 12:4

The simple inherit folly: but the prudent are crowned with knowledge. Proverbs 14:18

The crown of the wise is their riches: but the foolishness of fools is folly. Proverbs 14:24

The hoary head is a **crown** of glory, if it be found in the way of righteousness. Proverbs 16:31

Children's children are the **crown** of old men; and the glory of children are their fathers. Proverbs 17:6

For riches are not for ever: and doth the **crown** endure to every generation? Proverbs 27:24

Go forth, O ye daughters of Zion, and behold king Solomon with the **crown** wherewith his mother crowned him in the day of his espousals, and in the day of the gladness of his heart. Song of Solomon 3:11

Woe to the **crown** of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty is a fading flower, which are on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine! ... The **crown** of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, shall be trodden under feet: Isaiah 28:1, 3

In that day shall the LORD of hosts be for a **crown** of glory, and for a diadem of beauty, unto the residue of his people...Thou shalt also be a **crown** of glory in the hand of the LORD, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God. Isaiah 28:5, 62:3

Say unto the king and to the queen, Humble yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, even the **crown** of your glory. Jeremiah 13:18

The **crown** *is fallen from our head: woe unto us, that we have sinned! Lamentations 5:16*

I put a jewel on thy forehead, and earrings in thine ears, and a beautiful **crown** upon thine head. Ezekiel 16:12

Thus saith the Lord GOD; Remove the diadem, and take off the **crown**: this shall not be the same: exalt him that is low, and abase him that is high. Ezekiel 21:26

A voice of a multitude being at ease was with her: and the men of the common sort were brought Sabeans from the wilderness, which put bracelets upon their hands, and beautiful **crowns** upon their heads. Ezekiel 23:42

Then take silver and gold, and make **crowns**, and set them upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest...and the **crowns** shall be to Helem, and to Tobijah, and to Jedaiah, and to Hen the son of Zephaniah, for a memorial in the temple of the LORD. Zecharial 6:11, 14

The LORD their God shall save them in that day as the flock of his people: for they shall be as the stones of a **crown**, lifted up as an ensign upon his land. Zechariah 9:16

When they had platted a **crown** of thorns, they put it upon his head, and a reed in his right hand: and they bowed the knee before him, and mocked him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews! Matthew 27:29

They clothed him with purple, and platted a crown of thorns, and put it about his head. Mark 15:17

The soldiers platted a **crown** of thorns, and put it on his head, and they put on him a purple robe... John 19:2

Then came Jesus forth, wearing the **crown** of thorns, and the purple robe. And Pilate saith unto them, Behold the man! John 19:5

Every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible **crow**n; but we an incorruptible. 1 Corinthians 9:25

Therefore, my brethren dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and **crown**, so stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved. Philippians 4:1

For what is our hope, or joy, or **crown** of rejoicing? Are not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming? 1 Thessalonians 2:19

And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not **crowned**, except he strive lawfully. 2 Timothy 2:5

Henceforth there is laid up for me a **crown** of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing. 2 Timothy 4:8

Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou **crownedst** him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands...but we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, **crowned** with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. Hebrews 2:7, 9

Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the **crown** of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him. James 1:12

Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind; Neither as being lords over God's heritage, but being ensamples to the flock. When the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a **crown** of glory that fadeth not away. 1 Peter 5:2-4

Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a **crown** of life. Revelation 2:10

Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy **crown**. Revelation 3:11

Round about the throne were four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads **crowns** of gold... The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their **crowns** before the throne, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created. Revelation 4:4, 10

I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat upon him had a bow; and a **crown** was given unto him: and he went forth conquering, and to conquer. Revelation 6:2

The shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were **crowns** like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men. Revelation 9:7

There appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a **crown** of twelve stars: Revelation 12:1

I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden **crown**, and in his hand a sharp sickle. Revelation John 14:14

His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on his head were many **crowns**: and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself. Revelation 19:12

REIGN

Thou shalt bring them in, and plant them in the mountain of thine inheritance, in the place, OLORD, which thou hast made for thee to dwell in, in the Sanctuary, O LORD, which thy hands have established. The LORD shall **reign** for ever and ever. Exodus 15:17-18

For the LORD thy God blesseth thee, as he promised thee: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, but thou shalt not borrow; and thou shalt **reign** over many nations, but they shall not **reign** over thee. Deuteronomy 15:6

The LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not **reign** over them... 1 Samuel 8:7

When ye saw that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon came against you, ye said unto me, Nay; but a king shall **reign** over us: when the LORD your God was your king. Now therefore behold the king whom ye have chosen, and whom ye have desired! And, behold, the LORD hath set a king over you. If ye will fear the LORD, and serve him, and obey his voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both ye and also the king that **reigneth** over you continue following the LORD your God... 1 Samuel 12:12-14

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou **reignest** over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name. 1 Chronicles 29:11-13

Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice: and let men say among the nations, The LORD reigneth. 1 Chronicles 16:31

All the congregation made a covenant with the king in the house of God. And he said unto them, Behold, the king's son shall **reign**, as the LORD hath said of the sons of David. 2 Chronicles 23:3

God **reigneth** over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness. Psalm 47:8

The LORD **reigneth**, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved. Psalm 93:1

Say among the heathen that the LORD **reigneth**: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously. Psalm 96:10

The LORD reigneth; *let the earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad thereof. Psalm 97:1*

The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble: he sitteth between the cherubims; let the earth be moved. The LORD is great in Zion; and he is high above all the people. Let them praise thy great and terrible name; for it is holy. Psalm 99:1-3

The LORD shall **reign** for ever, even thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD. Psalm 146:10

For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it...By me kings **reign**, and princes decree justice. Proverbs 8:11, 15

For three things the earth is disquieted, and for four which it cannot bear: For a servant when he **reigneth**; and a fool when he is filled with meat; For an odious woman when she is married; and an handmaid that is heir to her mistress. Proverbs 30:21-23

Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun ashamed, when the LORD of hosts shall **reign** in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously. Isaiah 24:23

Behold, a king shall **reign** in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgment. And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land. And the eyes of them that see shall not be dim, and the ears of them that hear shall hearken. Isaiah 32:1-3

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth! Isaiah 52:7

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David, a righteous Branch, and a King shall **reign** and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS. Jeremiah 23:5-6

Thus saith the LORD; if ye can break my covenant of the day, and my covenant of the night, and there should not be day and night in their season: Then may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to **reign** upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. Jeremiah 33:20-21

I will make her that halted a remnant, and her that was cast far off a strong nation: and the LORD shall **reign** over them in mount Zion from henceforth, even for ever. Micah 4:7

Behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: And he shall **reign** over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. Luke 1:31-33

A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom, and to return. And he called his ten servants, and delivered them ten pounds, and said unto them, Occupy till I come. But his citizens hated him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this man to **reign** over us. And it came to pass, that when he was returned, having received the kingdom, then he commanded these servants to be called unto him, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading...For I say unto you, That unto every one which hath shall be given: and from him that hath not, even that he hath shall be taken away from him. But those mine enemies, which would not that I should **reign** over them, bring hither, and slay them before me. Luke 19:12-15, 26-27

Let not sin therefore **reign** in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof. Romans 6:12

Esaias saith, There shall be a root of Jesse, and he that shall rise to **reign** over the Gentiles; in him shall the Gentiles trust. (For until the law sin was in the world...For if by one man's offence death **reigned** by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall **reign** in life by one, Jesus Christ.)...Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: That as sin hath **reigned** unto death, even so might grace **reign** through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 5:12-13, 17, 20-21

Then cometh the end, when he shall delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. For he must **reign**, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. 1 Corinthians 15:25

I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory...For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: If we suffer, we shall also **reign** with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: 2 Timothy 2:10-12

When he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odours, which are the prayers of saints. And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall **reign** on the earth. Revelation 5: 8-10

The seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall **reign** for ever and ever. And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God, Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast **reigned**. Revelation 11:15

I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent **reigneth**. Revelation 19:6

I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the words of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and **reigned** with Christ a thousand years. But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall **reign** with him a thousand years. Revelation 20:4-6

He servants shall serve him: And they shall see his face; and his name shall be in their foreheads. And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun: for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall **reign** for ever and ever. Revelation 22:3-5

KINGDOM

Ye shall be unto me a **kingdom** of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel. Exodus 19:6

It shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his **kingdom**, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests the Levites: And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the LORD his God, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them: That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: to the end that he may prolong his days in his **kingdom**, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel. Deuteronomy 17:18-20

Then Samuel told the people the manner of the **kingdom**, and wrote it in a book, and laid it up before the LORD. And Samuel sent all the people away, every man to his house. 1 Samuel 10:25

And Samuel said unto him, The LORD hath rent the **kingdom** of Israel from thee this day, and hath given it to a neighbour of thine, that is better than thou. 1 Samuel 15:28

David perceived that the LORD had established him king over Israel, and that he had exalted his **kingdom** for his people Israel's sake. 2 Samuel 5:12

When thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up thy seed after thee, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his **kingdom**. He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his **kingdom** for ever... And thine house and thy **kingdom** shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever. 2 Samuel 7:12-13, 16

Then Solomon sat upon the throne of David his father; and his **kingdom** was established greatly. 1 Kings 2:12

Then I will establish the throne of thy **kingdom** upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David thy father... 1 Kings 9:5

Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the **kingdom** from thee, and give it to thy servant. 1 Kings 11:11

Go, tell Jeroboam, Thus saitht he LORD God of Israel, Forasmuch as I have exalted thee from among the people, and made thee prince over my people Israel, And rent the **kingdom** away from the house of David, who kept my commandments, and who followed me with all his heart, to do that only which was right in mine eyes; But hast done evil above all that were before thee: for thou hast gone and made thee other gods, and molten images, to provoke me to anger, and hast cast me behind thy back: Therefore, behold, I will bring evil upon the hosue of Jeroboam... 1 Kings 14:7-10

These also are the chief of the mighty men whom David had, who strengthened themselves with him in his **kingdom**, and with all Israel, to make him king, according to the word of the LORD concerning Israel. 1 Chronicles 11:10

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine, thine is the **kingdom**, O LORD, and thou art exalted as heald above all. 1 Chronicles 29:11

The LORD was with Jehoshaphat, because he walked in the first ways of his father David, and sought not unto Baalim; But sought to the LORD God of his father, and walked in his commandments, and not after the doings of Israel. Therefore the LORD stablished the **kingdom** in his hand; and all Judah brought to Jehoshaphat presents; and he had riches and honour in abundance. 2 Chronicles 17:3-5

When he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers, and prayed unto him: and he was entreated of him, and heard his supplications, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his **kingdom**. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD he was God. 2 Chronicles 33:12-13

For the **kingdom** is the LORD'S: and he is the governor among the nations. Psalm 22:28

Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. Psalm 45:6

The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all. Psalm 103:19

They shall speak of the glory of thy **kingdom**, and talk of thy power; to make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his **kingdom**. Thy **kingdom** is an everlasting **kingdom**, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations. Psalm 145:11-13

Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his **kingdom**, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. Isaiah 9:7

This is the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king. Thou, O king, art a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory. And wheresoever the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath he given into thine hand, and hath made the ruler over them all. Thou art this head of gold. And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth. And the fourth **kingdom** shall be strong as iron: forasmuch as iron breaketh in pieces and subdueth all things: and as iron that breaketh all these, shall it break in pieces and bruise. And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided: but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay. And as the toes of the feet were part of iron, and part of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong, and partly broken. And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay. And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever. Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream is certain, and the interpretation thereof sure... The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a truth it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret. Daniel 2:36-47

How great are his signs! And how mighty are his wonders! His **kingdom** is an everlasting **kingdom**, and his dominion is from generation to generation. Daniel 4:3

This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand of the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the **kingdom** of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men... This dream I king Nebuchanezzar have seen. Now thou, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the wise men of my **kingdom** are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but thou art able; for the spirit of the holy gods is in thee. Daniel 4:17-18

They shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over thee, till thou know that the most High ruleth in the **kingdom** of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will... While the word was in the king's mouth, there fell a voice from heaven, saying, O king Nebuchadnezzar, to thee it is spoken; The **kingdom** is departed from thee. Daniel 4:25, 31

At the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his **kingdom** is from generation to generation: And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou? At the same time my reason returned unto me; and for the glory of my **kingdom**, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me; and I was established in my **kingdom**, and excellent majesty was added unto me. Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works are truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase. Daniel 4:34-37

Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the **kingdom**; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he ws faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him... Daniel 6:4

I make a decree, That in every dominion of my **kingdom** men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he is the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his **kingdom** that which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion shall be even unto the end. Daniel 6:26

There was given him dominion, and glory, and a **kingdom**, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his **kingdom** that which shall not be destroyed...But the saints of the most High shall take the **kingdom**, and possess the **kingdom** for ever, even for ever and ever. Daniel 7:14, 18

I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them; Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the **kingdom**. Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth **kingdom** upon earth, which shall be diverse from all **kingdoms**, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces. And the ten horns out of this **kingdom** are ten kings that shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings...And the **kingdom** and dominion, and the greatness of the **kingdom** under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose **kingdom** is an everlasting **kingdom**, and all dominions shall serve and obey him. Daniel 7:21-24, 27

In the latter time of the **kingdom**, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up... When he shall stand up, his **kingdom** shall be broken, and shall be divided toward the four winds of heaven; and not to his posterity, nor according to his dominion which he ruled: for his **kingdom** shall be plucked up, even for others beside those... The king of the south shall come into his kingdom, and shall return into his own land... He shall also set his face to enter with the strength of his whole **kingdom**, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, corrupting her: but she shall not stand on his side, neither be for him... Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the **kingdom**: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in anger, nor in battle. And in his estate shall stand up a vile person, to whom they shall not give the honour of the **kingdom**: but he shall come in peaceably, and obtain the **kingdom** by flatteries. Daniel 8:23, 11:4, 9, 17, 20-21

Behold, the eyes of the Lord GOD are upon the sinful **kingdom**, and I will destroy it from off the face of the earth; saving that I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob, saith the LORD. Amose 9:8

Saviours shall come up on mount Zion to judge the mount of Esau; and the **kingdom** shall be the LORD'S. Obadiah 1:21

And thou, O tower of the flock, the strong hold of the daughter of Zion, unto thee shall it come, even the first dominion; the **kingdom** shall come to the daughter of Jerusalem. Micah 4:8

NEW COVENANT KINGDOM

Repent ye: for the **kingdom** of heaven is at hand. Matthew 3:2

From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the **kingdom** of heaven is at hand. Matthew 4:17

Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the **kingdom**, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people. Matthew 4:23

Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the **kingdom** of heaven... Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness; sake: for theirs is the **kingdom** of heaven. Matthew 5:3, 10

Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the **kingdom** of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the **kingdom** of heaven. For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the **kingdom** of heaven. Matthew 5:20

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy **kingdom** come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the **kingdom**, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. Matthew 6:9-12

Seek ye first the **kingdom** of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Matthew 6:33

Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the **kingdom** of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Matthew 7:21

I say unto you, That many shall come from the east and west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the **kingdom** of heaven. But the children of the **kingdom** shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Matthew 8:11-12

Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the **kingdom**, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people. Matthew 9:35

As ye go, preach, saying, The **kingdom** of heaven is at hand. Matthew 10:7

Verily I say unto you, Among them that are born of women there hath not risen a greater than John the Baptist: notwithstanding he that is least in the **kingdom** of heaven is greater than he. And from the days of John the Baptist until now the **kingdom** of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force. Matthew 11:11-12

Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, Every **kingdom** divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand: And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his **kingdom** stand? ...But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the **kingdom** of God is come unto you. Matthew 12:25-26, 28

He...said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the **kingdom** of heaven, but to them it is not given. Matthew 13:11

When any one heareth the word of the **kingdom**, and understandeth it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. Matthew 13:19

Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The **kingdom** of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field...Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, the **kingdom** of heaven is like to a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and sowed into his field. Matt 13:24, 31 Another parable spake he unto them, The **kingdom** of heaven is like unto leaven, which a woman took, and hid in three measure of meal, till the whole ws leavened... The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the **kingdom**; but the tares are the children of the wicked one... Matthew 13:33, 41

The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his **kingdom** all things that offend, and them which do iniquity... Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the **kingdom** of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear... Matthew 13:41, 43

The **kingdom** of heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man hath found, he hideth and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath, and buyeth that field. Again, the **kingdom** of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls...Again, the **kingdom** of heaven is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind...Then said he unto them, Therefore every scribe which is instructed unto the **kingdom** of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure things new and old. Matthew 13:44-45, 47, 52

I will give unto thee the keys of the **kingdom** of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Matthew 16:19

Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his **kingdom**. Matthew 16:28

At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the **kingdom** of heaven? And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them, And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the **kingdom** of heaven. Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the **kingdom** of heaven. Matthew 18:1-4

Therefore is the **kingdom** of heaven likened unto a certain king, which would take account of his servants. Matthew 18:23

Suffer the little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the **kingdom** of heaven. Matthew 19:14

Then said Jesus unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the **kingdom** of heaven. And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. Matthew 19:23-24

For the **kingdom** of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire labourers into his vineyard. Matthew 20:1

He sais unto her, What wilt thou? She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy **kingdom**. Matthew 20:21

Whether of them twain did the will of his father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the **kingdom** of God before you. Matthew 21:31

Therefore say I unto you, The **kingdom** of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the fruits thereof. Matthew 21:43

The **kingdom** of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son. Matthew 22:2

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye shut up the **kingdom** of heaven against men: for ye neither go in yourselves, neither suffer ye them that are entered to go in. Matthew 23:23

For nation shall rise against nation, and **kingdom** against **kingdom**: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places...And this gospel of the **kingdom** shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come. Matthew 24:7, 14

Then shall the **kingdom** of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom. Matthew 25:1

The **kingdom** of heaven is as a man traveling into a far country, who called his own servants, and delivered unto them his goods. Matthew 25:14

Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the **kingdom** prepared for you from the foundation of the world. Matthew 25:34

I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's **kingdom**. Matthew 26:29

Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the **kingdom** of God. And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the **kingdom** of God is at hand: repent ye, and believe the gospel. Mark 1:14-15

If a **kingdom** be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. Mark 3:24

He said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the **kingdom** of God: but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables: Mark 4:11

He said, so is the **kingdom** of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground...And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the **kingdom** of God? Or with what comparison shall we compare it? It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth: but when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it. Mark 4:26, 30-32

He said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That there be some of them that stand here, which shall not taste of death, till they have seen the **kingdom** of God come with power. Mark 9:1

If thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the **kingdom** of God with one eye, than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire. Mark 9:47

When Jesus saw it, he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the **kingdom** of God. Verily I say unto you, Whosoever shall not receive the **kingdom** of God as a little child, he shall not enter therein. Mark 10:14-15

Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the **kingdom** of God! And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard it is for them that trust in riches to enter into the **kingdom** of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the **kingdom** of God. Mark 10:23-25 Blessed be the **kingdom** of our father David, that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest. Mark 11:10

When Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, thou art not far from the **kingdom** of God. And no man after that durst ask him any question. Mark 12:34

For nation shall rise against nation, and **kingdom** against **kingdom**: and there shall be earthquakes in divers places, and there shall be famines and troubles: these are the beginnings of sorrows. Mark 13:8

Verily I say unto you, I will drink no more of the fruit of the vine, until that day that I drink it new in the **kingdom** of God. Mark 14:25

Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the **kingdom** of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus. Mark 15:43

He shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. Luke 1:33

He said unto them, I must preach the kingdom of God to other cities also: for therefore am I sent. Luke 4:43

He lifted up his eyes on his disciples, and said, Blessed be ye poor: for yours is the kingdom of God. Luke 6:20

For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater prophet than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the **kingdom** of God is greater than he. Luke 7:28

It came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the **kingdom** of God: and the twelve were with him. Luke 8:1

He said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the **kingdom** of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand. Luke 8:10

He sent them to preach the **kingdom** of God, and to heal the sick... The people, when they knew it, followed him: and he received them, and spake unto them of the **kingdom** of God, and healed them that had need of healing. Luke 9:2, 11 I tell you of a truth, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the kingdom of God. Luke 9:27

Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the **kingdom** of God. And another also said, Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house. And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the **kingdom** of God. Luke 9:60-62

Into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you: And heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The **kingdom** of God is come nigh unto you. But into whatsoever city ye enter, and they receive you not, go your ways out into the streets of the same, and say, Even the very dust of your city, which cleaveth on us, we do wipe off against you: notwithstanding be ye sure of this, that the **kingdom** of God is come nigh unto you. But I say unto you, that it shall be more tolerable in that day for Sodom, than for that city. Luke 10:8-12

He said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy **kingdom** come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Luke 11:2

He, knowing their thoughts, said unto them, Every **kingdom** divided against itself is brought to desolation; and a house divided against a house falleth. If Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his **kingdom** stand? Because ye say that I cast out devils through Beelzebub. And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore shall they be your judges. But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the **kingdom** of God is come upon you. Luke 11:17-20

Seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind. For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things. But rather seek ye the **kingdom** of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the **kingdom**. Luke 12:31-32

Then said he, Unto what is the **kingdom** of God like? And whereunto shall I resemble it? It is like a grain of mustard seed, which a man took, and cast into his garden, and it grew, and waxed a great tree; and the fowls of the air lodged in the branches of it. And again he said, Whereunto shall I like the **kingdom** of God? Luke 13:18, 20

There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the **kingdom** of God, and you yourselves thrust out. And they shall come from the east, and from the west, and from the north, and from the south, and shall sit down in the **kingdom** of God. Luke 13:28-29

When one of them that sat at meat with him heard these things, he said unto him, Blessed is he that shall eat bread in the **kingdom** of God. Luke 14:15

The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the **kingdom** of God is preached, and every man presseth into it. Luke 16:16

When he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the **kingdom** of God should come, he answered them and said, The **kingdom** of God cometh not with observation: Neither shall they say, Lo here! Or, lo there! For, behold, the **kingdom** of God is within you. Luke 17:20-21

Jesus called them unto him, and said, Suffer little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the **kingdom** of God. Verily I say unto you, whosoever shall not receive the **kingdom** of God as a little child shall in no wise enter therein. Luke 18:16-17

When Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the **kingdom** of God! For it is easier for a camel to go through a needle's eye, that for a rich man to enter into the **kingdom** of God. Luke 18:24-25

He said unto them, Verily I say unto you, there is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the **kingdom** of God's sake, Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting. Luke 18:29-30

As they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the **kingdom** of God should immediately appear. He said therefore, A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a **kingdom**, and to return...And it came to pass, that when he was returned, having received the **kingdom**, then he commanded these servants to be called unto him, to whom he had given the money, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading. Luke 19:11-12, 15 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and **kingdom** against **kingdom**: And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven. Luke 21:10-11

So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the **kingdom** of God is nigh at hand. Luke 21:31

For I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the **kingdom** of God. And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves: For I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the **kingdom** of God shall come. Luke 22:16-18

I appoint unto you a **kingdom**, as my Father hath appointed unto me; that ye may eat and drink at my table in my **kingdom**, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel. Luke 22:29-30

He said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou cometh into thy kingdom. Luke 23:42

(The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;) he was of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the **kingdom** of God. Luke 23:51

Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the **kingdom** of God. Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the **kingdom** of God. John 3:3-5

Jesus answered, My **kingdom** is not of this world: if my **kingdom** were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my **kingdom** not from hence. John 18:36

The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen: To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the **kingdom**. Acts 1:1-3 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the **kingdom** to Israel? Acts 1:6

When they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. Acts 8:12

When they had preached the gospel to that city, and had taught many, they returned again to Lystra, and to Iconium, and Antioch, confirming the souls of the disciples, and exhorting them to continue in the faith, and that we must through much tribulation enter into the **kingdom** of God. Acts 14:21-22

He went into the synagogue, and spake boldly for the space of three months, disputing and persuading the things concerning the kingdom of God. Acts 19:8

And now, behold, I know that ye all, among whom I have gone preaching the **kingdom** of God, shall see my face no more. Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I am pure from the blood of all men. For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the counsel of God. Acts 20:25-27

When they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into his lodging: to whom he expounded and testified the **kingdom** of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and out of the prophets, from morning till evening...Preaching the **kingdom** of God, and teaching those things which concerns the Lord Jesus Christ, with all confidence, no man forbidding him. Acts 28:23, 31

For the **kingdom** of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. Romans 14:17

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the **kingdom** of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the **kingdom** of God. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the **kingdom** of God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. 1 Corinthians 15:24

This I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the **kingdom** *of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. 1 Corinthians* 15:50

...Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the **kingdom** of God. Galatians 5:21

For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the **kingdom** of Christ and of God. Ephesians 5:5

Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the **kingdom** of his dear Son: Colossians 1:12-13

Jesus, which is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. these only are my fellowworkers unto the **kingdom** of God, which have been a comfort unto me. Colossians 4:11

Ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children, That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his **kingdom** and glory. 1 Thessalonians 2:11-12

We ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure: Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the **kingdom** of God, for which ye also suffer: 2 Thessalonians 1:4-5

I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his **kingdom**...And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly **kingdom**: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. 2 Timothy 4:1, 18

But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy **kingdom**. Hebrews 1:8

Wherefore we receiving a **kingdom** which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear... Hebrews 12:28

Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the **kingdom** which he hath promised to them that love him? James 2:5

For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting **kingdom** of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 1:11

I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the **kingdom** and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. Revelation 1:9

I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the **kingdom** of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of the brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. Revelation 12:10

And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his **kingdom** was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain... Revelation 16:10

And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no **kingdom** as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast... For God hath put in their hearts to fulfil his will, and to agree, and give their **kingdom** unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled. Revelation 17:12, 17
