JOY & REJOICING

*Jethro **rejoiced** for all the goodness which the LORD had done to Israel, whom he had delivered out of the hand of the Egyptians. Exodus 18:9*

*Ye shall take you on the first day the boughs of goodly trees, branches of palm trees, and the boughs of thick trees, and willows of the brook; and ye shall **rejoice** before the LORD your God seven days. Leviticus 23:40*

*Then shall the land **enjoy** her sabbaths, as long as it lieth desolate, and ye be in your enemies' land; even then shall the land rest, and **enjoy** her sabbaths. The land also shall be left of them, and shall **enjoy** her sabbaths, while she lieth desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised my judgments, and because their soul abhorred my statutes. Leviticus 26:43*

*And every daughter, that possesseth an inheritance in any tribe of the children of Israel, shall be wife unto one of the family of the tribe of her father, that the children of Israel may **enjoy** every man the inheritance of his fathers. Numbers 36:8*

*There ye shall eat before the LORD your God, and ye shall **rejoice** in all that ye put your hand unto, ye and your households, wherein the LORD your God hath blessed thee. Ye shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatsoever is right in his own eyes. For ye are not as yet come to the rest and to the inheritance, which the LORD your God giveth you...And ye shall **rejoice** before the LORD your God, ye, and your sons, and your daughters, and your menservants, and your maidservants, and the Levite that is within your gates; forasmuch as he hath no part nor inheritance with you. Deuteronomy 12:7, 12*

*But thou must eat them before the LORD thy God in the place which the LORD thy God shall choose, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite that is within thy gates: and thou shalt **rejoice** before the LORD thy God in all that thou puttest thine hands unto Deuteronomy 12:18*

*Thou shalt bestow that money for whatsoever thy soul lusteth after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever thy soul desireth: and thou shalt eat there before the LORD thy God, and thou shalt **rejoice**, thou, and thine household... Deuteronomy 14:26*

*Thou shalt **rejoice** before the LORD thy God, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite that is within thy gates, and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are among you, in the place which the LORD thy God hath chosen to place his name there. Deuteronomy 16:11*

*Thou shalt **rejoice** in thy feast, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levites, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are within thy gates. Seven days shalt thou keep a solemn feast unto the LORD thy God in the place which the LORD shall choose: because the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thine increase, and in all the works of thine hands, therefore thou shalt surely **rejoice**. Deuteronomy 16:14-15*

*And thou shalt **rejoice** in every good thing which the LORD thy God hath given unto thee, and unto thine house, thou, and the Levites, and the stranger that is among you. Deuteronomy 26:11*

*Thou shalt offer peace offerings, and shalt eat there, and **rejoice** before the LORD thy God. Deuteronomy 27:7*

*Thou shalt beget sons and daughters, but thou shalt not **enjoy** them; for they shall go into captivity. Deuteronomy 28:41*

*All these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed: because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee...Because thou servedst not the LORD thy God with **joyfulness**, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things... Deuteronomy 28:45-47*

*The LORD thy God will make thee plenteous in every work of thine hand, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy land, for good: for the LORD will again **rejoice** over thee for good, as he **rejoiced** over thy fathers: Deuteronomy 30:9*

***Rejoice**, O ye nations, with his people: for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and will render vengeance to his adversaries, and will be merciful unto his land, and to his people. Deuteronomy 32:43*

*Of Zebulun he said, **Rejoice**, Zebulun, in thy going out; and, Issachar, in thy tents. Deuteronomy 33:18*

*Until the LORD have given your brethren rest, as he hath given you, and they also have possessed the land which the LORD your God giveth them: then ye shall return unto the land of your possession, and **enjoy** it. Joshua 1:15*

*Hannah prayed, and said, My heart **rejoiceth** in the LORD, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because **I rejoice** in thysalvation. 1 Samuel 2:1*

*They of Beth-shemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley: and they lifted up their eyes, and saw the ark, and **rejoiced** to see it. 1 Samuel 6:13*

*It came to pass as they came, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women came out of all cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet king Saul, with tabrets, with **joy**, and with instruments of musick. 1 Samuel 18:6*

*For he did put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great salvation for all Israel: thou sawest it, and didst **rejoice**: wherefore then wilt thou sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause? 1 Samuel 19:5*

*All the people came up after him, and the people piped with pipes, and rejoiced with great **joy**, so that the earth rent with the sound of them...And Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet have anointed him king in Gihon: and they are come up from thence **rejoicing**, so that the city rang again. This is the noise that ye have heard. 1 Kings 1:40, 45*

*It came to pass, when Hiram heard the words of Solomon, that he **rejoiced** greatly, and said, Blessed be the LORD this day, which hath given unto David a wise son over this great people. 1 Kings 5:7*

*He sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went unto their tents **joyful** and glad of heart for all the goodness that the LORD had done for David his servant, and for Israel his people. 1 Kings 8:66*

*All the people of the land **rejoiced**, and the city was in quiet: and they slew Athaliah with the sword beside the king's house. 2 Kings 11:20*

Moreover they that were nigh them, even unto Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, brought bread on asses, and on camels, and on mules, and on oxen, and meat, meal, cakes of figs, and bunches of raisins, and wine, and oil, and oxen, and sheep abundantly: for there was **joy** in Israel.
1 Chronicles 12:40

David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren to be the singers with instruments of musick, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with **joy**. 1 Chronicles 15:16

So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the house of Obed-edom with **joy**. 1 Chronicles 15:25

Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them **rejoice** that seek the LORD. 1 Chronicles 16:10

Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth **rejoice** that seek the LORD. Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields **rejoice**, and all that is therein. 1 Chronicles 16:31-32

I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with **joy** thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee... Then the people **rejoiced**, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also **rejoiced** with great **joy**.
1 Chronicles 29:7, 9

Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O Lord, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints **rejoice** in goodness. 2 Chronicles 6:41

All Judah **rejoiced** at the oath: for they had sworn with all their heart, and sought him with their whole desire; and he was found of them: and the LORD gave them rest round about. 2 Chronicles 15:15

They returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with **joy**; for the LORD had made them to **rejoice** over their enemies. 2 Chronicles 20:27

*Also Jehoiada appointed the offices of the house of the LORD by the hand of the priests the Levites, whom David had distributed in the house of the LORD, to offer the burnt offerings of the LORD, as it is written in the law of Moses, with **rejoicing** and with singing, as it was ordained by David. 2 Chronicles 23:18*

*All the princes and all the people **rejoiced**, and brought in, and cast into the chest, until they had made an end. 2 Chronicles 24:10*

*Hezekiah **rejoiced**, and all the people, that God had prepared the people: for the thing was done suddenly. 2 Chronicles 29:36*

*All the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, **rejoiced**. There was great **joy** in Jerusalem: for since the time of Solomon the son of David king of Israel there was not the like in Jerusalem. 2 Chronicles 30:25-26*

*The children of Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the rest of the captivity, kept the dedication of this house of God with **joy**. Ezra 6:16*

*Many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, who were ancient men, that had seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, wept with a loud voice; and many shouted aloud for **joy**: So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of **joy** from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off. Ezra 3:12-13*

*The children of Israel...kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with **joy**: for the LORD had made them **joyful**, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria unto them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel. Ezra 6:21-22*

*Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the **joy** of the LORD is your strength. Nehemiah 8:10*

*Also that day they offered great sacrifices, and **rejoiced**: for God had made them **rejoice** with great **joy**: the wives also and the children **rejoiced**: so that the **joy** of Jerusalem was heard even afar off. Nehemiah 12:43*

*And at that time were some appointed over the chambers for the treasures, for the offerings, for the firstfruits, and for the tithes, to gather into them out of the fields of the cities the portions of the law for the priests and Levites: for Judah **rejoiced** for the priests and for the Levites that waited. Nehemiah 12:44*

*Then went Haman forth that day **joyful** and with a glad heart: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai. Esther 5:9*

*And Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, and with a great crown of gold, and with a garment of fine linen and purple: and the city of Shushan **rejoiced** and was glad. The Jews had light, and gladness, and **joy**, and honour. And in every province, and in every city, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had **joy** and gladness, a feast and a good day. And many of the people of the land became Jews; for the fear of the Jews fell upon them. Esther 8:16-17*

*As the days wherein the Jews rested from their enemies, and the month which was turned unto them from sorrow to **joy**, and from mourning into a good day: that they should make them days of feasting and **joy**, and of sending portions one to another, and gifts to the poor. Esther 9:22*

*They take the timbrel and harp, and **rejoice** at the sound of the organ. Job 21:12*

*The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for **joy**. Job 29:13*

*He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with **joy**: for he will render unto man his righteousness. Job 33:26*

*Where wast thou...when the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for **joy**? Job 38:4, 7*

*Hast thou given the horse strength?...He paweth in the valley, and **rejoiceth** in his strength: he goeth on to meet the armed men. Job 39:21*

*In his neck remaineth strength, and sorrow is turned into **joy** before him. Job 41:22*

*Serve the LORD with fear, and **rejoice** with trembling. Psalm 2:11*

*Let all those that put their trust in thee **rejoice**: let them ever shout for **joy**, because thou defendest them: let them also that love thy name be **joyful** in thee. Psalm 5:11*

*I will be glad and **rejoice** in thee: I will sing praise to thy name, O thou most High. Psalm 9:2*

*Have mercy upon me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that hate me, thou that liftest me up from the snares of death: That I may show forth all thy praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion: I will **rejoice** in thy salvation. Psalm 9:13-14*

*Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death; Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me **rejoice** when I am moved. but I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall **rejoice** in thy salvation. Psalm 13:3-5*

*Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory **rejoiceth**: my flesh also shall rest in hope. For thou wilt not leave my soul in hell; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Thou wilt shew me the path of life: in thy presence is fulness of **joy**; at thy right hand there are pleasures for evermore. Psalm 16:9-11*

*Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall **rejoice**, and Israel shall be glad. Psalm 14:7*

*The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament showeth his handiwork...In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun, which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and **rejoiceth** as a strong man to run a race. Psalm 19:1, 4-5*

*The statutes of the LORD are right, **rejoicing** the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. Psalm 19:8*

*We will **rejoice** in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all thy petitions. Psalm 20:5*

*The king shall **joy** in thy strength, O LORD; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he **rejoice**! Psalm 21:1*

*Now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacles sacrifices of **joy**; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD. Psalm 27:6*

*I will extol thee, O LORD; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to **rejoice** over me. Psalm 30:1*

*For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but **joy** cometh in the morning. Psalm 30:5*

*I will be glad and **rejoice** in thy mercy: for thou hast considered my trouble; thou hast known my soul in adversities; Psalm 31:7*

*Be glad in the LORD, and **rejoice**, ye righteous: and shout for **joy**, all ye that are upright in heart. Psalm 32:11*

***Rejoice** in the LORD, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright. Psalm 33:1*

*For our heart shall **rejoice** in him, because we have trusted in his holy name. Psalm 33:21*

*My soul shall be **joyful** in the LORD: it shall **rejoice** in his salvation. Psalm 35:9*

*Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully **rejoice** over me: neither let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause. Psalm 35:19*

*Judge me, O LORD my God, according to thy righteousness; and let them not **rejoice** over me...Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that **rejoice** at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify themselves against me. Let them shout for **joy**, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant. And my tongue shall speak of thy righteousness and of thy praise all the day long. Psalm 35:24, 26-28*

*For I said, Hear me, lest otherwise they should **rejoice** over me: when my foot slippeth, they magnify themselves against me. Psalm 38:16*

*Let all those that seek thee **rejoice** and be glad in thee: let such as love thy salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified. Psalm 40:16*

*When I remember these things, I pour out my soul in me: for I had gone with the multitude, I went with them to the house of God, with the voice of **joy** and praise, with a multitude that kept holyday. Psalm 42:4*

*Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding **joy**: yea, upon the harp will I praise thee, O God my God. Psalm 43:4*

*With gladness and **rejoicing** shall they be brought: they shall enter into the king's palace. Psalm 45:15*

*Beautiful for situation, the **joy** of the whole earth, is mount Zion, on the sides of the north, the city of the great King. Psalm 48:2*

*Let mount Zion **rejoice**, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments. Psalm 48:11*

*Make me to hear **joy** and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may **rejoice**...Restore unto me the **joy** of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit. Psalm 51:8, 11*

*Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! When God bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall **rejoice**, and Israel shall be glad. Psalm 53:6*

*The righteous shall **rejoice** when he seeth the vengeance... Psalm 58:10*

*God hath spoken in his holiness; I will **rejoice**... Psalm 60:6*

*My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise thee with **joyful** lips: When I remember thee upon my bed, and meditate on thee in the night watches. Because thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy wings will I **rejoice**. Psalm 63:5-7*

*The king shall **rejoice** in God; every one that sweareth by him shall glory: Psalm 63:11*

*Thou makest the outgoings of the morning and evening to **rejoice**. Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it: thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, which is full of water...The little hills **rejoice** on every side. The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for **joy**, they also sing. Psalm 65:8-9, 12-13*

*Make a **joyful** noise unto God, all ye lands... Psalm 66:1*

*He turned the sea into dry land: they went through the flood on foot: there did we **rejoice** in him. Psalm 66:6*

*O let the nations be glad and sing for **joy**: for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon the earth. Selah. Psalm 67:4*

*Let the righteous be glad; let them **rejoice** before God: yea, let them exceedingly **rejoice**. Sing unto God, sing praises to his name: extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and **rejoice** before him. Psalm 68:3-4*

*Let all those that seek thee **rejoice** and be glad in thee: and let such as love thy salvation say continually, Let God be magnified. Psalm 70:4*

*My lips shall greatly **rejoice** when I sing unto thee; and my soul, which thou hast redeemed. Psalm 71:23*

*Sing aloud unto God our strength: make **a joyful noise** unto the God of Jacob. Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery. Psalm 81:1-2*

*Wilt thou not revive us again: that thy people may **rejoice** in thee? Psalm 85:6*

***Rejoice** the soul of thy servant: for unto thee, O Lord, do I lift up my soul. Psalm 86:4*

*The north and the south thou hast created them: Tabor and Hermon shall **rejoice** in thy name. Psalm 89:12*

*Blessed is the people that know **the joyful sound**: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance. In thy name shall they **rejoice** all the day: and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted. Psalm 89:15-16*

*O satisfy us early with thy mercy; that we may **rejoice** and be glad all our days. Psalm 90:14*

*O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make **a joyful noise** to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make **a joyful noise** unto him with psalms. For the LORD is a great God, and a great King above all gods. Psalm 95:1-3*

*Let the heavens **rejoice**, and let the earth **be glad**; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof. Let the field **be joyful**, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees of the wood **rejoice**. Psalm 96:11-12*

*The LORD reigneth; let the earth **rejoice**; let the multitude of isles be glad thereof. Psalm 97:1*

*Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah **rejoiced** because of thy judgments, O LORD. Psalm 97:8*

***Rejoice** in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. Psalm 97:12*

*Make **a joyful noise** unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and **rejoice**, and sing praise. Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm. With trumpets and sound of cornet make **a joyful noise** before the LORD, the King. Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. Let the floods clap their hands: let the hills be **joyful** together before the LORD; for he cometh to judge the earth: with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity. Psalm 98:4-9*

*Make **a joyful noise** unto the LORD, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing...Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. Psalm 100:1-2, 4*

*The glory of the LORD shall endure for ever: the LORD shall **rejoice** in his works. Psalm 104:31*

*Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them **rejoice** that seek the LORD. Psalm 105:3*

*He brought forth his people with **joy**, and his chosen with gladness: Psalm 105:43*

*Remember me, O LORD, with the favour that thou bearest unto thy people: O visit me with thy salvation; that I may see the good of thy chosen, that I may **rejoice** in the gladness of thy nation, that I may glory with thine inheritance. Psalm 106:4-5*

*Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and **rejoice**: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Psalm 107:42*

*Let them curse, but bless thou: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let thy servant **rejoice**. Psalm 109:28*

*He maketh the barren woman to keep house, and to be a **joyful** mother of children. Praise ye the LORD. Psalm 113:9*

*The voice of **rejoicing** and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. Psalm 118:15*

*This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will **rejoice** and be glad in it. Psalm 118:24*

*I **rejoice** at thy word, as one that findeth great spoil. Psalm 119:162*

*They that sow in tears shall reap in **joy**. He that goeth forth and weepeth, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with **rejoicing**, bringing his sheaves with him. Psalm 126:5-6*

*Let thy priests be clothed with righteousness; and let thy saints shout for **joy**...I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for **joy**. Psalm 132:9, 16*

*If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief **joy**. Psalm 137:6*

*Let Israel **rejoice** in him that made him: let the children of Zion **be joyful** in their King. Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with timbrel and harp. For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation. Let the saints be **joyful** in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds. Psalm 149:2-5*

*Let thy fountain be blessed: and **rejoice** with the wife of thy youth. Proverbs 5:18*

*As one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, **rejoicing** always before him; **Rejoicing** in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights were with the sons of men. Proverbs 8:30-31*

*Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellors of peace is **joy**. Proverbs 12:20*

*When it goeth well with the righteous, the city **rejoiceth**: and when the wicked perish, there is shouting. Proverbs 11:10*

*The light of the eyes **rejoiceth** the heart: and a good report maketh the bones fat. Proverbs 15:30*

*He that begetteth a fool doeth it to his sorrow: and the father of a fool hath no **joy**. Proverbs 17:21*

*It is **joy** to the just to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. Proverbs 21:15*

*My son, if thine heart be wise, my heart shall **rejoice**, even mine. Yea, my reins shall **rejoice**, when thy lips speak right things. Proverbs 23:15-16*

*The father of the righteous shall greatly **rejoice**: and he that begetteth a wise child shall have **joy** of him. Thy father and thy mother shall be glad, and she that bare thee shall **rejoice**. Proverbs 23:24-25*

***Rejoice** not when thine enemy falleth, and let not thine heart be glad when he stumbleth: Proverbs 24:17*

*When righteous men do **rejoice**, there is great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden. Proverbs 28:12*

*When the righteous are in authority, the people **rejoice**: but when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn. Proverbs 29:2*

*Whoso loveth wisdom **rejoiceth** his father: but he that keepeth company with harlots spendeth his substance. Proverbs 29:3*

*In the transgression of an evil man there is a snare: but the righteous doth sing and **rejoice**. Proverbs 29:6*

*Strength and honour are her clothing; and she shall **rejoice** in time to come. Proverbs 31:25*

*I said in mine heart, Go to now, I will prove thee with mirth, therefore **enjoy** pleasure: and, behold, this also is vanity. Ecclesiastes 2:1*

*Whatsoever mine eyes desired I kept not from them, I withheld not my heart from any **joy**; for my heart **rejoiced** in all my labour: and this was my portion of all my labour. Ecclesiastes 2:10*

*There is nothing better for a man, than that he should eat and drink, and that he should make his soul **enjoy** good in his labour. This also I saw, that it was from the hand of God. Ecclesiastes 2:24*

*For God giveth to a man that is good in his sight wisdom, and knowledge, and **joy**: but to the sinner he giveth travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is vanity and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 2:26*

*I know that there is no good in them, but for a man to **rejoice**, and to do good in his life. And also that every man should eat and drink, and **enjoy** the good of all his labour, it is the gift of God. Ecclesiastes 3:12-13*

*I perceive that there is nothing better, than that a man should **rejoice** in his own works; for that is his portion: for who shall bring him to see what shall be after him? Ecclesiastes 3:22*

*Behold that which I have seen: it is good and comely for one to eat and to drink, and to **enjoy** the good of all his labour that he taketh under the sun all the days of his life, which God giveth him: for it is his portion. Every man also to whom God hath given riches and wealth, and hath given him power to eat thereof, and to take his portion, and to **rejoice** in his labour; this is the gift of God. For he shall not much remember the days of his life; because God answereth him in the **joy** of his heart. Ecclesiastes 5:18-20*

*In the day of prosperity be **joyful**, but in the day of adversity consider: God also hath set the one over against the other to the end that man should find nothing after him. Ecclesiastes 7:14*

*If a man live many years, and **rejoice** in them all; yet let him remember the days of darkness; for they shall be many. **Rejoice**, O young man, in thy youth; and let thy heart cheer thee in the days of thy youth, and walk in the ways of thine heart, and in the sight of thine eyes: but know thou, that for all these things God will bring thee into judgment. *He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were willing for a season to **rejoice** in his light. John 5:35*

As sorrowful, yet alway **rejoicing**; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. 2 Corinthians 6:10

Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding **joyful** in all our tribulation. 2 Corinthians 7:4

...Not by his coming only, but by the consolation wherewith he was comforted in you, when he told us your earnest desire, your mourning, your fervent mind toward me; so that I **rejoiced** the more...Now I **rejoice**, not that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner, that ye might receive damage by us in nothing. 2 Corinthians 7:7, 9

*Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve. And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them. They were **glad**, and covenanted to give him money. Luke 22:3-5*

*When Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding **glad**: for he was desirous to see him of a long season, because he had heard many things of him; and he hoped to have seen some miracle done by him. Luke 23:8*

*Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was **glad**. John 8:56*

*I am **glad** for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent ye may believe; nevertheless let us go unto him. John 11:15*

*When he had so said, he shewed unto them his hands and his side. Then were the disciples **glad**, when they saw the Lord. John 20:20*

*Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was **glad**; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope. Acts 2:26*

*Then they that **gladly** received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls...And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with **gladness** and singleness of heart, Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. Acts 2:41, 46-47*

*They sent forth Barnabas...who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was **glad**, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord. Acts 11:22-23*

*When she knew Peter's voice, she opened not the gate for **gladness**, but ran in, and told how Peter stood before the gate. Acts 12:14*

*He was seen many days of them which came up with him from Galilee to Jerusalem, who are his witnesses unto the people. And we declare unto you **glad** tidings, how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he hath raised up Jesus again... Acts 13:31-33*

*When the Gentiles heard this, they were **glad**, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed. Acts 13:48*

*Nevertheless he left not himself without witness, in that he did good, and gave us rain from heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and **gladness**. Acts 14:17*

*How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring **glad** tidings of good things! Romans 10:14-15*

*For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am **glad** therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil. Romans 16:19*

*For if I make you sorry, who is he that maketh me **glad**, but the same which is made sorry by me? 2 Corinthians 2:2*

*For ye suffer fools **gladly**, seeing ye yourselves are wise. 2 Corinthians 11:19*

*My grace is sufficient for the: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most **gladly** therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 2 Corinthians 12:9*

*I will very **gladly** spend and be spent for you; though the more abundantly I love you, the less I be loved. 2 Corinthians 12:15*

*For we are **glad**, when we are weak, and ye are strong: and this also we wish, even your perfection. 2 Corinthians 13:9*

*Receive him therefore in the Lord with all **gladness**; and hold such in reputation: Philippians 2:29*

*Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of **gladness** above thy fellows. Hebrews 1:9*

*Rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be **glad** also with exceeding joy. 1 Peter 4:13*

*Let us be **glad** and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready. Revelation 19:7*

MERRY

*And he took and sent messes unto them from before him: but Benjamin's mess was five times so much as any of theirs. And they drank, and were **merry** with him. Genesis 43:34*

*And they went out into the fields, and gathered their vineyards, and trode the grapes, and made **merry**, and went into the house of their god, and did eat and drink, and cursed Abimelech. Judges 9:27*

*And it came to pass, when their hearts were **merry**, that they said, call for Samson, that he may make us sport. And they called for Samson out of the prison house; and he made them sport: and they set him between the pillars. Judges 16:25*

*And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be **merry**...and when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day growth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be **merry**; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go hom...Now as they were making their hearts **merry**, behold, the men of the city, certain sons of Belial, beset the house round about, and beat at the door, and spake to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring forth the man that came into thine house, that we may know him. Judges 19:6, 9, 22*

*And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was **merry**, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly, and uncovered his feet, and laid her down. Ruth 3:7*

*Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a feast in his house, like the feast of a king; and Nabal's heart was **merry** within him, for he was very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light. 1 Samuel 25:36*

*Now Absalom had commanded his servants, saying, mark ye now when Amnon's heart is **merry** with wine, and when I say unto you, smite Amnon; then kill him, fear not: have not I commanded you? be courageous, and be valiant. 2 Samuel 13:28*

*Judah and Israel were many, as the sand which is by the sea in multitude, eating and drinking, and making **merry**. And Solomon reigned over all kingdoms from the river unto the land of the Philistines, and unto the border of Egypt: they brought presents, and served Solomon all the days of his life. 1 Kings 4:20-21*

*And Jezebel his wife said unto him, Dost thou now govern the kingdom of Israel? arise, and eat bread, and let thine heart be **merry**: I will give thee the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite. 1 Kings 21:7*

*On the three and twentieth day of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, glad and **merry** in heart for the goodness that the LORD had shewed unto David, and to Solomon, and to Israel his people. 2 Chronicles 7:10*

*On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was **merry** with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Beztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king, to bring Vashti the queen... Esther 1:10-11*

*Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in **merrily** with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made. Esther 5:14*

*A **merry** heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken. Proverbs 15:13*

*All the days of the afflicted are evil: but he that is of a **merry** heart hath a continual feast. Proverbs 15:15*

*A **merry** heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones. Proverbs 17:22*

*Then I commended mirth, because a man hath no better thing under the sun, than to eat, and to drink, and to be **merry**: for that shall abide with him of his labour the days of his life, which God giveth him under the sun. Ecclesiastes 8:15*

*Go thy way, eat thy bread with joy, and drink thy wine with a **merry** heart; for God now accepteth thy works. Ecclesiastes 9:7*

*A feast is made for laughter, and wine maketh **merry**: but money answereth all things. Ecclesiastes 10:19*

*The new wine mourneth, the vine languisheth, all the **merryhearted** do sigh. Isaiah 24:7*

*Out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of them that make **merry**: and I will multiply them, and they shall not be few; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small. Jeremiah 30:19*

*Wherefore didst thou flee away secretly, and steal away from me; and didst not tell me, that I might have sent thee away with **mirth**, and with songs, with tabret, and with harp? Genesis 31:27*

*And all the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions, and to make great **mirth**, because they had understood the words that were declared unto them. Nehemiah 8:12*

*For there they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and they that wasted us required of us **mirth**, saying, Sing us one of the songs of Zion. Psalm 137:3*

*Even in laughter the heart is sorrowful; and the end of that **mirth** is heaviness. Proverbs 14:13*

*I said in mine heart, Go to now, I will prove thee with **mirth**, therefore enjoy pleasure: and, behold, this also is vanity. I said of laughter, it is mad: and of **mirth**, What doeth it? Ecclesiastes 2:1-2*

*The mirth of tabrets ceaseth, the noise of them that rejoice endeth, the joy of the harp ceaseth... There is a crying for wine in the streets; all joy is darkened, the **mirth** of the land is gone. Isaiah 24:8, 11*

*I will cause to cease out of this place in your eyes, and in your days, the voice of **mirth**, and the voice of gladness... Jeremiah 16:9*

Wherefore, sirs, be of good **cheer**: for I believe God, that it shall be even as it was told me... Then were they all of good **cheer**, and they also took some meat. Acts 27:22, 25, 36*

*Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith; Or ministry, let us wait on our ministry: or he that teacheth, on teaching; or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth mercy, with **cheerfulness**. Romans 12:6-8*
