The spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD: Isaiah 11:2

THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD

The Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid, and he had nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done. Judges 14:6

The Spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word was in my tongue. 2 Samuel 23:2

And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of the LORD, that ye cannot prosper? Because ye have forsaken the LORD, he hath also forsaken you. 2 Chronicles 24:20

The Spirit of God hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life. Job 33:4

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right **spirit** within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy **holy spirit** from me. Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free **spirit**...the sacrifices of God are a broken **spirit**: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. Psalm 51:10-12, 17

Whither shall I go from thy spirit? Or whither shall I flee from thy presence? Psalm 139:7

Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy **spirit** is good; lead me into the land of uprightness. Psalm 143:10

Turn you at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you. Proverbs 1:23

A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the *spirit*. Proverbs 15:4

The **spirit** of man is the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly. Proverbs 20:27

The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because **the spirit of the LORD** bloweth upon it: surely the people is grass... Who hath directed **the Spirit of the LORD**, or being his counsellor hath taught him? Isaiah 40:7, 13

Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my **spirit** upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles...Isaiah 42:1

So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, **the Spirit of the LORD** shall lift up a standard against him. Isaiah 59:19

Then the **spirit** took me up, and I heard behind me a voice of a great rushing, saying, Blessed be the glory of the LORD from his place...so the **spirit** lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my **spirit**; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me. Ezekiel 3:12, 14

And the Spirit of the LORD fell upon me, and said unto me, Speak; Thus saith the LORD; Thus have ye said, O house of Israel: for I know the things that come into your mind, every one of them. Ezekiel 11:5

The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in **the spirit of the LORD**, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones. *Ezekiel* 37:1

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my **spirit** upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: and also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my **spirit**. Joel 2:28-29

Straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and **the** *Spirit* like a dove descending upon him: and there came a voice from heaven, saying, Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. And immediately the *Spirit* driveth him into the wilderness. Mark 1:10-11

Jesus returned in the power of the **Spirit** into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. Luke 4:14

But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in **spirit** and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him God is a **Spirit**: and they that worship him must worship him in **spirit** and in truth. John 4:23-24

But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even **the Spirit** of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me: John 15:26

Wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with **the Holy Ghost** not many days hence...but ye shall receive power, after that **the Holy Ghost** is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. Acts 1:4-5, 8 Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, by stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. When they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the **Holy Ghost**, and they spake the word of God with boldness. Acts 4:29-31

They sent unto them Peter and John...who, when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive **the Holy Ghost**: (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.) Then laid they their hands on them, and they received **the Holy Ghost**. Acts 8:14-17

Then **the Spirit** said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot. And Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Understandest thou what thou readest? ... Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus... When they were come up out of the water, **the Spirit of the Lord** caught away Phillip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. Acts 8:29-30, 35, 39

For he was a good man, and full of **the Holy Ghos**t and of faith: and much people was added unto the Lord. Acts 11:24

Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) filled with **the Holy Ghost**, set his eyes on him, and said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? Acts 13:9-10

We glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope: and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by **the Holy Ghost** which is given unto us. Romans 5:3-5

Likewise **the Spirit** helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but **the Spirit** maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of **the Spirit**, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. Romans 8:26-27

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by **the Spirit of our God**. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11

THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM

He hath filled him with the spirit of God, in **wisdom**, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship; Exodus 35:31

Keep therefore and do them; for this is your **wisdom** and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a **wise** and understanding people. Deuteronomy 4:6

God gave Solomon **wisdom** and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. 1 Kings 4:29

Jonathan David's uncle was a counsellor, a wise man, and a scribe: 1 Chr 27:32

Whence then cometh **wisdom**? And where is the place of understanding?...And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is **wisdom**; and to depart from evil is understanding. Job 28:20, 28

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making **wise** the simple. Psalm 19:7

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of **wisdom**: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever. Psalm 111:10

The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools. Pro 3:35

The tongue of the wise useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness. Proverbs 15:2

A **wise** man scaleth the city of the mighty, and casteth down the strength of the confidence thereof. Proverbs 21:22

She openeth her mouth with **wisdom**; and in her tongue is the law of kindness. She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness. Her children rise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her. Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all. Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:26-30

Wisdom strengtheneth the *wise* more than ten mighty men which are in the city. *Ecclesiastes* 7:19

The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. **Wisdom** and knowledge shall be the stability of their times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure. Isaiah 33:5-6

He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his **wisdom**, and hath stretched out the heaven by his understanding. When he uttereth his voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens; and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth: he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures. Jeremiah 51:15-16

Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for **wisdom** and might are his: And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth **wisdom** unto the **wise**, and knowledge to them that know understanding: Daniel 2:20-21

Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the **wise** shall understand. Daniel 12:10

Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a **wise** man, which built his house upon a rock: Matthew 7:24

When the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? And what **wisdom** is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands? Mark 6:2

Therefore also said the **wisdom** of God, I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they shall slay and persecute: Luke 11:49

For I will give you a mouth and **wisdom**, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. Luke 21:15

Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and **wisdom**, whom we may appoint over this business. Acts 6:3

O the depth of the riches both of the **wisdom** and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! Romans 11:33

Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all **wisdom** and prudence; That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of **wisdom** and revelation in the knowledge of him: Ephesians 1:17

See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise... Ephesians 5:15

That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; In whom are hid all the treasures of **wisdom** and knowledge. Colossians 2:3

For it is written, I will destroy the **wisdom** of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. Where is the **wise**? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Hath not God made foolish the **wisdom** of this world? For after that in the **wisdom** of God the world by **wisdom** knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after **wisdom**. But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the **wisdom** of God. Because the foolishness of God is **wiser** than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many **wise** men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble are called: but God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the **wise**; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty. 1 Corinthians 1:19-27

Who is a **wise** man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of **wisdom**. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This **wisdom** descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the **wisdom** that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace. James 3:13-18

Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only **wise** God, be honour and glory for ever and ever. Amen. 1Timothy 1:17

That from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee **wise** unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. 2 Timothy 3:15-17

I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands. Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and **wisdom**, and strength, and honor, and glory and blessing. Revelation 5:11-12

All the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, Saying, Amen: blessing, and glory, and **wisdom**, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. Revelation 7:11-12

THE SPIRIT OF UNDERSTANDING

He hath filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in **understanding**, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship. Exodus 35:31

Take you wise men, and **understanding**, and known among your tribes, and I will make them rulers over you. And ye answered me, and said, the thing which thou hast spoken is good for us to do. Deuteronomy 1:13-14

Keep therefore and do them; for this is your wisdom and your **understanding** in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, surely this great nation is a wise and **understanding** people. Deuteronomy 4:6

Now the name of the man was Nabal; and the name of his wife Abigail: and she was a woman of good **understanding**, and of a beautiful countenance: but the man was churlish and evil in his doing... 1 Samuel 25:3

Give therefore thy servant an **understanding** heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people? ...And God gave Solomon wisdom and **understanding** exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. 1 Kings 3:9, 4:29

The children of Issachar...were men that had **understanding** of the times, to know what Israel ought to do... 1 Chronicles 12:32

He read therein...from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could **understand**; and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law...So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to **understand** the reading... Nehemiah 8:3, 8

The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did **understand**, and seek God. Psalm 14:2

For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with **understanding**. *Psalm* 47:7

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good **understanding** have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever. Psalm 111:10

Give me **understanding**, and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe it with my whole heart... Thy hands have made me and fashioned me: give me **understanding** that I may learn thy commandments... The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth **understanding** unto the simple... Psalm 119:34, 73, 130

When wisdom entereth into thine heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto thy soul; discretion shall preserve thee, **understanding** shall keep thee: Pro 2:10-11

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own *understanding*. Proverbs 3:3-5

My son, attend unto my wisdom, and bow thine ear to my **understanding**: that thou mayest regard discretion, and that thy lips may keep knowledge. Pro 5:1-2

The knowledge of the holy is understanding. Proverbs 9:10b

Good **understanding** giveth favour: but the way of the transgressor is hard...a scorner seeketh wisdom, and findeth it not: but knowledge is easy unto him that **understandeth**. Proverbs 13:15, 14:6

He that refuseth instruction despiseth his own soul: but he that heareth reproof getteth **understanding**. Proverbs 15:32

Understanding is a wellspring of life unto him that hath it: but the instruction of fools is folly... Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of **understanding** will draw it out. Proverbs 16:22, 20:5

The spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and **understanding**, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; and shall make him of quick **understanding** in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: Isaiah 11:2-3

They also that erred in spirit shall come to **understanding**, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine... Isaiah 29:24

Thus saith the LORD, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: but let him that glorieth glory in this, that he **understandeth** and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 9:23-24

He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heaven by his **understanding**. Jer 51:15

As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had **understanding** in all visions and dreams...and in all matters of wisdom and **understanding**, that the king inquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm. Daniel 1:17, 20

When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and **understandeth** it not, then cometh the wicked one, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side...He that received seed into the good ground is he that heareth the words, and **understandeth** it; which also beareth fruit, and bringeth forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. Matthew 13:19, 23

How is it that ye do not **understand** that I spake it not to you concerning bread, that ye should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees? Then **understood** they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees. Matthew 16:11-12

Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God; but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parbles: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not **understand**; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them. Mark 4:12

The scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he: and to love him with all the heart, and with all the **understanding**, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from the kingdom of God. Mark 12:32-34

When ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth **understand**,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains: and let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house... Mark 13:14-15

He said unto them, these are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfiled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me. Then opened he their **understanding**, that they might **understand** the Scriptures. Luke 24:44-45

Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passest all **understanding**, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:5-7

My son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus...Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee **understanding** in all things. Remember that Jesus of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel: 2 Timothy 2:1, 7-8

THE SPIRIT OF COUNSEL

Blessed is the man that walketh not in the **counsel** of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. Psalm 1:1

I will bless the LORD, who hath given me **counsel**: my reins also instruct me in the night seasons. I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved. Psalm 16:7-8

Grant thee according to thine own heart, and fulfil all thy counsel. Psalm 20:4

The LORD bringeth the **counsel** of the heathen to nought: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect. The **counsel** of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations. Psalm 33:10-11

Thou shalt guide me with thy **counsel**, and afterward receive me to glory... My flesh and my heart faileth: but God is the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever. Psalm 73:24, 26

A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise **counsels**: to understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings. Proverbs 1:5-6

Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength. By me kings reign, and princes decree justice. Proverbs 8:14-15

The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkeneth unto **counsel** *is wise. Proverbs* 12:15

Hear **counsel**, and receive instruction, that thou mayest be wise in thy latter end. There are many devices in a man's heart; nevertheless the **counsel** of the LORD, that shall stand. Proverbs 19:20-21

Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out...Every purpose is established by **counsel**: and with good advice make war. Proverbs 20:5, 18

Have not I written to thee excellent things in **counsels** and knowledge, that I might make thee know the certainty of the words of truth; that thou mightest answer the words of truth to them that send unto thee? Proverbs 22:20-21

For by wise **counsel** thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of **counsellors** there is safety. Proverbs 24:6

Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so doth the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty **counsel**. Proverbs 27:9

A man's wisdom maketh his face to shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed. I **counsel** thee to keep the king's commandment, and that in regard of the oath of God. Ecclesiastes 8:1-2

God thundereth marvellously with his voice; great things doeth he, which we cannot comprehend...By watering he wearieth the thick cloud: he scattereth his bright cloud: it is turned round about by his **counsels**: that they may do whatsoever he commandeth them upon the face of the world in the earth. He causeth it to come, whether for correction, or for his land, or for mercy...Stand still, and consider the wonderous works of God. Dost thou know when God disposed them, and caused the light of his cloud to shine? Job 37:5, 11-15

Unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and...his name shall be called Wonderful, **Counsellor**, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom to order it... Isaiah 9:6-7

OLORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy **counsels** of old are faithfulness and truth... This also cometh forth from the LORD of hosts, which is wonderful in **counsel**, and excellent in working. Isaiah 25:1, 28:29

Who hath directed the spirit of the LORD, or being his **counsellor** hath taught him? With whom took he **counsel**, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him knowledge, and shewed to him the way of understanding? Isaiah 40:13-14

Tell ye, and bring them near; yea, let them take **counsel** together: who hath declared this from ancient time? Who hath told it from that time? Have not I the LORD? And there is no God else beside me; a just God and a Saviour; there is none beside me...Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient time the things that are not yet done, saying, My **counsel** shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure. Isaiah 45:21, 46:10

For who hath stood in the **counsel** of the LORD, and hath perceived and heard his word? Who hath marked his word, and heard it? Jeremiah 23:18

Thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee...Great in **counsel**, and mighty in work: for thine eyes are open upon all the ways of the sons of men: to give every one according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings. Jer 32:17-19

O king, let my **counsel** be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by shewing mercy to the poor... Daniel 4:27

There was a man named Joseph, **a counsellor**; and he was a good man, and a just: (The same had not consented to the **counsel** and deed of them;) he was of Arimathea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the kingdom of God. This man went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus. Luke 23:50-52

Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate **counsel** and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain...Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said...Men and brethren, what shall we do? Acts 2:22-23, 37

Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I am pure from the blood of all men. For I have not shunned to declare unto you all the **counsel** of God. Acts 20:26-27

O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! For who hath known the mind of the Lord! Or who hath been his **counsellor**? Or who hath first given to him, and it shall be recompensed unto him again? For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: to whom be glory for ever. Amen. Romans 11:33-36

Yea, I judge not mine own self. For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that judgeth me is the Lord. Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the **counsels** of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God. 1 Corinthians 4:4-5

That in...the fulness of times he might gather togther in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him: in whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the **counsel** of his own will: That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. Ephesians 1:10-12

Men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife. Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his **counsel**, confirmed it by an oath: That by two immutable things...we might have a strong consolation. Hebrews 6:16-18

Thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: I **counsel** thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore and repent. Revelation 3:17-19

THE SPIRIT OF MIGHT

Joseph is a fruitful bough, even a fruitful bough by a well... The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him...But his bow abode in strength, and the arms of his hands were made strong by the hands of the **mighty** God of Jacob; (from thence is the shepherd, the stone of Israel:) Genesis 49:22-24

The children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding **mighty**; and the land was filled with them. Exodus 1:7

O Lord God, thou hast begun to shew thy servant thy greatness, and thy **mighty** hand: for what God is there in heaven or in earth, that can do according to thy works, and according to thy **might**? Deuteronomy 3:24

Thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy **might**. Deuteronomy 6:5

Thou shalt not be affrighted at them: for the LORD thy God is among you, a **mighty** God and terrible...For the LORD your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a **mighty**, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward...He is thy praise, and he is thy God. Deut 7:21, 10:17, 21

That all the people of the earth might know the hand of the LORD, that it is **mighty**: that ye might fear the LORD your God for ever...So Joshua ascended from Gilgal, he, and all the people of war with him, and all the **mighty** men of valour. Joshua 4:24, 10:7

The angel of the LORD appeared unto him, and said unto him, The LORD is with thee, thou **mighty** man of valour. Judges 6:12

Seek out a man, who is a cunning player on an harp... Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Beth-lehemite, that is cunning in playing, and a **mighty** valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the LORD is with him. 1 Samuel 16:16, 18

David danced before the LORD with all his might: 2 Samuel 6:14

David and all Israel played before God with all their **might**, and with singing, and with harps, and with psalteries, and with timbrels, and with cymbals, and with trumpets. 1 Chronicles 13:8

The LORD sent an angel, which cut off all the **mighty** men of valour, and the leaders and captains in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned with shame of face to his own land. And when he was come into the house of his god, they that came forth of his own bowels slew him there with the sword. 2 Chronicles 32:21

Now therefore, our God, the great, the **mighty**, and the terrible God, who keepest covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before thee. Nehemiah 9:32

Behold, God is **mighty**, and despiseth not any: he is **mighty** in strength and wisdom. Job 36:5

Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and **mighty**, the LORD **mighty** in battle... The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory... Gird thy sword upon thy thigh, O most **mighty**, with thy glory and thy majesty. Psalm 24:8, 10; 45:3

The LORD on high is **mightier** than the noise of many waters, yea, than the **mighty** waves of the sea. Psalm 93:4

He saved them for his name's sake, that he might make his **mighty** power to be known...Praise him for his **mighty** acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness. Psalm 106:8, 150:2

Hear, ye that are far off, what I have done; and, ye that are near, acknowledge my **might**. Isaiah 33:13

Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these things, that bringeth out their host by number: he calleth them all by names by the greatness of his **might**, for that he is strong in power; not one faileth...He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no **might** he increaseth strength. Isaiah 40:26-29

The LORD shall go forth as a **mighty** man, he shall stir up jealousy like a man of war: he shall cry, yea, roar; he shall prevail against his enemies. Isaiah 42:13

The LORD is with me as a **mighty** terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten. Jeremiah 20:11

Thou shewest lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompensest the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the **Mighty** God, the LORD of hosts, is his name. Jeremiah 32:18

Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and shew thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not. Jeremiah 33:3

I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and **might**, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast made known unto us the king's matter. Daniel 2:23

It shall be said...Fear thou not: and to Zion, Let not thy hand be slack. The LORD thy God in the midst of thee is **mighty**; he will save, he will rejoice over thee with joy; he will rest in his love, he will joy over thee with singing. Zephaniah 3:17

I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is **mightier** than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire: Matthew 3:11

Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his **mighty** works were done, because they repented not: Woe unto thee, Chorazin! Woe unto thee, Bethsaida! For if the **mighty** works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes....It shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the day of judgment... Matthew 11:20-22

Mary said...He that is *mighty* hath done to me great things. Luke 1:49

When he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the **mighty** works that they had seen... Luke 19:37

The weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but **mighty** through God to the pulling down of strong holds.. Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and **mighty** deeds. 2 Cor 10:4, 12:12

Paul writing... Ye seek a proof of Christ speaking in me, which to youward is not weak, but is **mighty** in you. For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he liveth by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall live with him by the power of God toward you. 2 Corinthians 13:3-4

I bow my knees...that he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with **might** by his Spirit in the inner man... Ephesians 3:14, 16

My brethren, be strong in the LORD, and in the power of his **might**. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand... Ephesians 6:10-11

We...pray for you...that ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing...Strengthened with all **might**, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness...Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me **mightily**. Colossians 1:9-11, 29

To you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his **mighty** angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power... 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9

Humble yourselves therefore under the **mighty** hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: 1 Peter 5:6

Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and **might**, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. Revelations 7:12

THE SPIRIT OF KNOWLEDGE

Talk no more so exceedingly proudly; let not arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD is a God of **knowledge**, and by him actions are weighed. 1 Samuel 2:3

My words shall be of the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter **knowledge** clearly. Job 33:3

O LORD, thou hast searched me, and **known** me. Thou **knowest** my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou **knowest** it altogether. Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me. Such **knowledge** is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it. Whither shall I go from thy spirit?..or flee from thy presence? Psalm 139:1-7

Teach me good judgment and **knowledge**: for I have believed thy commandments. Psalm 119:66

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the **knowledge** of the holy is understanding. Proverbs 9:10

Who hath directed the spirit of the LORD, or being his counsellor hath taught him? With whom took he counsel, and who instructed him, and taught him in the path of judgment, and taught him **knowledge**, and shewed to him the way of understanding? Isaiah 40:13-14

The LORD hath given me **knowledge** of it, and I know it: then thou shewest me their doings. Jeremiah 11:18

As for these four children, God gave them **knowledge** and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams. Daniel 1:17

There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom is the spirit of the holy gods...and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him...Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and **knowledge**, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and shewing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel...the king thought to set him over the whole realm. Daniel 5:11-12, 6:3

My people are destroyed for lack of **knowledge**: because thou hast rejected **knowledge**, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children. As they were increased, so they sinned against me: therefore will I change their glory into shame. Hosea 4:6-7

The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity. For the priest's lips should keep **knowledge**, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts. Malachi 2:6-7

Woe unto you, lawyers! For ye have taken away the key of **knowledge**: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered. Luke 11:52

Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were unlearned and ignorant men, they marvelled; and they took **knowledge** of them, that they had been with Jesus. Acts 4:13

O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and **knowledge** of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been his counsellor? Romans 11:33-34

I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all **knowledge**, able also to admonish one another. Romans 15:14

That in everything ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all **knowledge**; even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you... 1 Cor 1:5-6

For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of **knowledge** by the same spirit; To another faith by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit... 1 Corinthians 12:8-9

For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the **knowledge** of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 2 Corinthians 4:5-6

I pray, that your love may abound more and more in **knowledge** and in all judgment; that ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; Philippians 1:9-10

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the **knowledge** of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the **knowledge** of God; Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power... Col 1:9-11

... To the **acknowledgment** of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; in whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and **knowledge**. Col 2:2-3

Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the **knowledge** of God; Ispeak this to your shame. 1 Corinthians 15:34

For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. For God, who commanded the light to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give the light of the **knowledge** of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us. 2 Cor 4:5-7

I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the **knowledge** of him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may **know** what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: and hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all. Ephesians 1:16-23

This I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in **knowledge** and in all judgment; that ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God. Philippians 1:9-11

Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds; and have put on the new man, which is renewed in **knowledge** after the image of him that created him... Colossians 3:9-10

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; who will have all men come unto the **knowledge** of the truth. 1 Timothy 2:1-4

His divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the **knowledge** of him that hath called us to glory and virtue....Grow in grace, and in the **knowledge** of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen. 2 Peter 1:3, 3:18

THE FEAR OF GOD

Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people *feared the LORD*, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses. Exodus 14:31

O that there were such an heart in them, that they would **fear me**, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever! Deuteronomy 5:29

The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spoke to me, He that rules over men must be just, ruling in **the fear of God**. 2 Samuel 23:3

Hear thou from heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart thou knowest...that they may **fear** *thee*, to walk in thy ways... 2 Chronicles 6:30-31

Now let **the fear of the LORD** be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts...And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in **the fear of the LORD**, faithfully, and with a perfect heart. 2 Chronicles 19:7, 9

Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him. Psalm 2:11-12

What man is he that **feareth the LORD**? Him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. The secret of the LORD is with them that **fear him**; and he will shew them his covenant. Psalm 25:12-14

Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that **fear him**, and upon them that hope in his mercy; To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. Psalm 33:18-19

Come and hear, all ye that **fear God**, and I will declare what he hath done for my soul. I cried unto him with my mouth, and he was extolled with my tongue. If I regard iniquity in my heart, the LORD will not hear me. But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer. Psalm 66:16-19

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts. O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: **fear before him**, all the earth. Psalm 96:8-9

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments; his praise endureth forever. Psalm 111:10

Let them that **fear the LORD** say, that his mercy endureth for ever. I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, and set me in a large place. The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me? Psalm 118:4-6

Blessed is every one that **feareth the LORD**; that walketh in his ways. For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands: happy shall thou be, and it shall be well with thee. Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house: thy children like olive plants round about thy table. Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that **feareth the LORD**. Psalm 128:1-4

Be not wise in thine own eyes: **fear the LORD**, and depart from evil. It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones. Proverbs 3:7-8

In the fear of the LORD is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge. The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death. Proverbs 14:26-27

Favour is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that **feareth the LORD**, she shall be praised. Give her of the fruit of her hands; and let her own works praise her in the gates. Proverbs 31:30-31

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: **Fear God**, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. Ecclesiastes 12:13

Enter into the rock, and hide thee in the dust, for **fear of the LORD**, and for the glory of his majesty. The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is filled up; and he shall be brought low...and they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for **fear of the LORD**, and for the glory of his majesty, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2:10-12, 19

Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it? Jeremiah 5:22

They shall be my people, and I will be their God: and I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may **fear me** for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them: and I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put **my fear** in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me...I will cleanse them from all their iniquity...they shall **fear** and tremble for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it. Jeremiah 32:39-40, 33:8-9 They that **feared the LORD** spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that **feared the LORD**, and that thought upon his name. And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked...Malachi 3:16-18

Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in **the fear of the Lord**, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied. Acts 9:31

Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: but in every nation he that **feareth** him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him. Acts 10:34-35

Come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the LORD, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you, and will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty. Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in **the fear of God**. 2 Corinthians 6:17-18, 7:1

Without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him. By faith, Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with **fear**, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. Hebrews 11:6-7

And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven. and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication. And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with the fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: and the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. Revelation 14:6-12
