### ANGER

He said unto him, Oh let not the Lord be **angry**, and I will speak: Peradventure there shall thirty be found there. And he said, I will not do it, if I find thirty there...and he said, Oh let not the Lord be **angry**, and I will speak yet but this once: Peradventure ten shall be found there. And he said, I will not destroy it for ten's sake. Genesis 18:30, 32

Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, Am I in God's stead, who has withheld from you the fruit of the womb? Genesis 30:2

Then Judah came near unto him, and said, Oh my lord, let your servant, I pray you, speak a word in my lord's ears, and let not your **anger** burn against your servant: for you are even as Pharaoh. Genesis 44:18

Now therefore be not grieved, nor **angry** with yourselves, that you sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life. Genesis 45:5

O my soul, come not into their secret; unto their assembly, mine honor, be not united: for in their **anger** they slew a man, and in their self will they dug down a wall. Cursed be their **anger**, for it was fierce; and their **wrath**, for it was cruel: I will divide them in Jacob, and scatter them in Israel. Genesis 49:6-7

The **anger** of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and he said, Is not Aaron the Levite your brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he comes forth to meet you: and when he see you, he will be glad in his heart. Exodus 4:14

All these your servants shall come down unto me, and bow down themselves unto me, saying, Get out, and all the people that follow you: and after that I will go out. And he went out from Pharaoh in a great anger. Exodus 11:8

It came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' **anger** waxed **hot**, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and broke them beneath the mount...And Moses said unto Aaron, What did this people unto you, that you have brought so great a sin upon them? And Aaron said, Let not the **anger** of my lord wax **hot**: you know the people, that they are set on mischief. For they said unto me, Make us gods... Exodus 32:19, 21-23

Moses diligently sought the goat of the sin offering, and, behold, it was burnt: and he was **angry** with Eleazar and Ithamar, the sons of Aaron which were left alive... Leviticus 10:16

When the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard it; and his **anger** was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed them that were in the uttermost parts of the camp... Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the **anger** of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased. Numbers 11:1, 10

The **anger** of the LORD was kindled against them; and he departed. Numbers 12:9

God's anger was kindled because he went: and the angel of the LORD stood in the way for an adversary against him. Now he was riding upon his ass, and his two servants were with him...And when the ass saw the angel of the LORD, she fell down under Balaam: and Balaam's anger was kindled, and he smote the ass with a staff. Numbers 22:22, 27

Israel joined himself unto Baal-peor: and the **anger** of the LORD was kindled against Israel. And the LORD said unto Moses, Take all the heads of the people, and hang them up before the LORD against the sun, that the **fierce anger** of the LORD may be turned away from Israel. Numbers 25:3-4

The LORD'S anger was kindled the same time, and he swore, saying, Surely none of the men that came up out of Egypt, from twenty years old and upward, shall see the land which I swore unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob; because they have not wholly followed me: Save Caleb...and Joshua...And the LORD'S anger was kindled against Israel, and he made them wander in the wilderness forty years, until all the generation, that had done evil in the sight of the LORD, was consumed. And, behold, you are risen up in your fathers' stead, an increase of sinful men, to augment yet the fierce anger of the LORD toward Israel. Numbers 32:10-14

The LORD was **angry** with me for your sakes, saying, You also shall not go in thither. But Joshua the son of Nun, which stands before you, he shall go in thither: encourage him: for he shall cause Israel to inherit it. Deuteronomy 1:37-38

Furthermore the LORD was **angry** with me for your sakes, and swore that I should not go over Jordan, and that I should not go in unto that good land, which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance: Deuteronomy 4:21

When you shall beget children, and children's children, and you shall have remained long in the land, and shall corrupt yourselves, and make a graven image, or the likeness of any thing, and shall do evil in the sight of the LORD your God, to provoke him to anger: I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that you shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto you go over Jordan to possess it; you shall not prolong your days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed. Deuteronomy 4:25-26

(For the LORD your God is a jealous God among you) lest the **anger** of the LORD your God be kindled against you, and destroy you from off the face of the earth. Deuteronomy 6:15

For they will turn away your son from following me, that they may serve other gods: so will the **anger** of the LORD be kindled against you, and destroy you suddenly. Deuteronomy 7:4

Also in Horeb you provoked the LORD to wrath, so that the LORD was angry with you to have destroyed you...And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water, because of all your sins which you sinned, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger. For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also. And the LORD was very angry with Aaron to have destroyed him: and I prayed for Aaron also the same time. Deuteronomy 9:8, 18-20

There shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the LORD may turn from the **fierceness of his anger**, and shew you mercy, and have compassion upon you, and multiply you, as he has sworn unto your fathers; When you shall hearken to the voice of the LORD your God, to keep all his commandments... Deuteronomy 13:17-18

The LORD will not spare him, but then the **anger** of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. Deuteronomy 29:20

The whole land thereof is brimstone, and salt, and burning, that it is not sown, nor bears, nor any grass grows therein, like the overthrow of Sodom, and Gomorrah, Admah, and Zeboim, which the LORD overthrew in his anger, and in his wrath... Deuteronomy 29:23

Even all nations shall say, Wherefore has the LORD done thus unto this land? What means **the heat of this great anger**? ... And the **anger** of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book: And the LORD rooted them out of their land in **anger**, and in **wrath**, and in great **indignation**, and cast them into another land, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 29:24, 27-28

Then my **anger** shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God is not among us? Deuteronomy 31:17

For I know that after my death you will utterly corrupt yourselves, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you; and evil will befall you in the latter days; because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to **anger** through the work of your hands. Deuteronomy 31:29

They provoked him to jealousy with strange gods, with abominations provoked they him to anger... They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation. For a fire is kindled in my anger, and shall burn unto the lowest hell, and shall consume the earth with her increase, and set on fire the foundations of the mountains. Deuteronomy 32:16, 21-22

But the children of Israel committed a trespass in the accursed thing: for Aachan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and **the anger** of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel. Joshua 7:1

They raised over him a great heap of stones unto this day. So the LORD turned from the **fierceness of his anger**. Wherefore the name of that place was called, The vally of Achor, unto this day. Joshua 7:26

When you have transgressed the covenant of the LORD your God, which he commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the **anger** of the LORD be kindled against you, and you shall perish quickly from off the good land which he has given unto you. Joshua 23:16

They forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them out of the land of Egypt, and followed other gods, of the gods of the people that were round about them, and bowed themselves unto them, and provoked the LORD to anger...And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he delivered them into the hands of spoilers that spoiled them, and he sold them into the hands of their enemies round about, so that they could not any longer stand before their enemies...And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and he said, Because that this people have transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto my voice... Judges 2:12, 14, 20

Therefore the **anger** of the LORD was **hot** against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia: and the children of Israel served Chushan-rishathaim eight years. Judges 3:8

Gideon said unto God, Let not thine **anger** be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew. Judges 6:39

God has delivered into your hands the princes of Midian, Oreb and Zeeb: and what was I able to do in comparison of you? Then their **anger** was abated toward him, when he had said that. Judges 8:3

When Zebul the ruler of the city heard the words of Gaal the son of Ebed, his **anger** was kindled. Judges 9:30

The **anger** of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hands of the Philistines, and into the hands of the children of Ammon. Judges 10:7

The Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and slew thirty men of them, and took their spoil, and gave change of garments unto them which expounded the riddle. And his anger was kindled, and he went up to his father's house. Judges 14:19

The children of Dan said unto him, Let not your voice be heard among us, lest **angry** fellows run upon thee, and you lose your life, with the lives of your household. Judges 18:25

The Spirit of God came upon Saul when he heard those tidings, and his anger was kindled greatly. And he took a yoke of oxen, and hewed them in pieces, and sent them throughout all the coasts of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whoever comes not forth after Saul and after Samuel, so shall it be done unto his oxen. And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and they came out with one consent. 1 Samuel 11:6-7

Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spoke unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why came you down hither? And with whom have you left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know your pride, and the naughtiness of your heart; for you are come down that you might see the battle. 1 Samuel 17:28

Then Saul's **anger** was kindled against Jonathan, and he said unto him, **You** son of the perverse rebellious woman, do not I know that you have chosen the son of Jesse to your own confusion, and unto the confusion of your mother's nakedness? 1 Samuel 20:30

And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David. So Jonathan arose from the table in *fierce anger*, and did eat no meat the second day of the month: for he was grieved for David, because his father had done him shame. 1 Samuel 20:33-34

Uzzah put forth his hand to the ark of God, and took hold of it... The anger of the LORD was kindled against Uzzah; and God smote him there for his error; and there he died by the ark of God. 2 Samuel 6:6-7

David's **anger** was greatly kindled against the man; and he said to Nathan, As the LORD lives, the man that has done this thing shall surely die... 2 Samuel 12:5

All the men of Judah answered the men of Israel, Because the king is near of kin to us: why then are you **angry** for this matter? Have we eaten at all of the king's cost? Or has he given us any gift? 2 Samuel 19:42

Again the **anger** of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah. 2 Samuel 24:1

If they sin against thee, (for there is no man that sins not,) and you be angry with them, and deliver them to the enemy, so that they carry them away captives unto the land of the enemy, far or near, yet if they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto you in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness; and so return unto you with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto you toward their land, which you gave unto their fathers, the city which you have chosen, and the house which I have built for your name: Then hear you their prayer and their supplication in heaven your dwelling place, and maintain their cause. 1 Kings 8:46-49

The LORD was **angry** with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had appeared unto him twice... 1 Kings 11:9

...But has done evil above all that were before thee: for you have gone and made you other gods, and molten images, to provoke me to **anger**, and have cast me behind thy back: 1 Kings 14:9

For the LORD shall smite Israel, as a reed is shaken in the water, and he shall root up Israel out of this good land, which he gave to their fathers, and shall scatter them beyond the river, because they have made their groves, provoking the LORD to anger. 1 Kings 15:30

The word of the LORD came to Jehu the son of Hanani against Baasha, saying, Forasmuch as I exalted you out of the dust, and made thee prince over my people Israel; and you have walked in the way of Jeroboam, and have made my people Israel to sin, to provoke me to **anger** with their sins...And also by the hand of the prophet Jehu the son of Hanani came the word of the LORD against Baasha, and against his house, even for all the evil that he did in the sight of the LORD, in provoking him to **anger** with the work of his hands, in being like the house of Jeroboam; and because he killed him. 1 Kings 16:1-2, 7

For he walked in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin, to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger with their vanities...Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him. I Kings 16:26, 33

He served Baal, and worshipped him, and provoked to **anger** the LORD God of Israel, according to all that his father had done. 1 Kings 22:53

The anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he delivered them into the hand of Hazael king of Syria, and into the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael, all their days. 2 Kings 13:3

There they burnt incense in all the high places, as did the heathen whom the LORD carried away before them; and wrought wicked things to provoke the LORD to anger... They caused their sons and daughters to pass through the fire, and used divination and enchantments, and sold themselves to do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger. Therefore the LORD was very angry with Israel, and removed them out of his sight: there was none left but the tribe of Judah only. 2 Kings 17:11, 17-18

He made his son pass through the fire, and observed times, and used enchantments, and dealt with familiar spirits and wizards: he wrought much wickedness in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger... I will forsake the remnant of mine inheritance, and deliver them into the hand of their enemies; and they shall become a prey and a spoil to all their enemies; Because they have done that which was evil in my sight, and have provoked me to anger, since the day their fathers came forth out of Egypt, even unto this day. Moreover Manasseh shed innocent blood very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another...doing that which was evil... 2 Kings 21:6, 14-16

Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to **anger** with all the works of their hands; therefore my **wrath** shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched. 2 Kings 22:17

All the houses also of the high places that were in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke the LORD to anger, Josiah took away, and did to them according to all the acts that he had done in Beth-el...Notwitstanding the LORD turned not from the fierceness of his great wrath, wherewith his anger was kindled against Judah, because of all the provocation that Mannasseh had provoked him withal. 2 Kings 23:19, 26

The **anger** of the LORD was kindled against Uzza, and he smote him, because he put his hand to the ark: and there he died before God. 1 Chronicles 13:10

If they sin against you, (for there is no man which sins not,) and you are angry with them, and deliver them over before their enemies, and they carry them away captives unto a land far off or near... If they return to you with all their heart and with all their soul... Then hear you from the heavens, even from your dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive your people which have sinned against you. 2 Chronicles 6:36-39

Then Amaziah separated them, to wit, the army that was come to him out of Ephraim, to go home again: wherefore their **anger** was greatly kindled against Judah, and they returned home in great **anger**... Wherefore the **anger** of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why have you sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand? 2 Chronicles 25:10, 15

He caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger...Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore my wrath shall be poured out upon this place, and shall not be quenched. 2 Chronicles 33:6, 34:25

Cover not their iniquity, and let not their sins be blotted out from before you: for they have provoked you to **anger** before the builders... There was a great cry of the people...against their brethren the Jews... I was very **angry** when I heard their cry and these words. Nehemiah 4:5, 5:1, 6

They and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to your commandments. And refused to obey, neither were mindful of your wonders that you did among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but you are a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsook them not. Nehemiah 9:16-17

Should we again break your commandments, and join in affinity with the people of these abominations? Would not you be **angry** with us till you had consumed us, so that there should be no remnant nor escaping? Ezra 9:14

But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by his chamberlains: therefore was the king **very wroth**, and his **anger burned** in him. Esther 1:12

How can man be just with God? ...He is wise in heart, and mighty in strength: who has hardened himself against him, and has prospered? Which removes the mountains, and they know not: which overturns them in his **anger**. Which shakes the earth out of her place, and the pillars thereof tremble. Which commands the sun, and it rises not; and seals up the stars. Which alone spreads out the heavens, and treads upon the waves of the sea. Job 9:1, 4-8

How oft is the candle of the wicked put out? And how oft cometh their destruction upon them! God distributes sorrows in his **anger**. Job 21:17

Kiss the Son, lest he be **angry**, and you perish from the way, when his **wrath** is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him. Psalm 2:12

O LORD, rebuke me not in your **anger**, neither chasten me in **your hot displeasure**. Psalm 6:1

Arise, O LORD, in your **anger**, lift up yourself because of the **rage** of mine enemies; and awake for me to the judgment that you have commanded. So shall the congregation of the people compass you about: for their sakes therefore return you on high. Psalm 7:6-7

God judges the righteous, and God is **angry** with the wicked every day. Psalm 7:11

You shall make them as a fiery oven in the time of your **anger**: the LORD shall swallow them up in his **wrath**, and the fire shall devour them. Psalm 21:9

Hide not your face far from me; put not your servant away in **anger**; you have been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation. Psalm 27:9

For his **anger** endures but a moment; in his favor is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning. Psalm 30:5

Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not yourself in any wise to do evil. Psalm 37:8

There is no soundness in my flesh because of your **anger**; neither is there any rest in my bones because of my sin. Psalm 38:3

Shall they escape by iniquity? In your **anger** cast down the people, O God. Psalm 56:7

Pour out your indignation upon them, and let your wrathful anger take hold of them. Psalm 69:24

O God, why have you cast us off for ever? Why does your **anger** smoke against the sheep of your pasture? Psalm74:1

You, even you, are to be feared: and who may stand in your sight when once you are angry? Psalm 76:7

Has God forgotten to be gracious? Has he in **anger** shut up his tender mercies? Selah. Psalm 77:9

Therefore the LORD heard this, and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel... Psalm 78:21

But he, being full of compassion, forgave their iniquity, and destroyed them not: yea, many a time turned he his **anger** away, and did not stir up all his **wrath**. Psalm 78:38

He cast upon them the fierceness of his **anger**, **wrath**, **and indignatio**n, and trouble, by sending evil angels among them. He made a way to his **anger**; he spared not their soul from death, but gave their life over to the pestilence... Psalm 78:49-50

For they provoked him to anger with their high places, and moved him to jealousy with their graven images. Psalm 78:58

How long, LORD? Will you be **angry** for ever? Shall your jealousy burn like fire? Psalm 79:5

O LORD God of hosts, how long will you be **angry** against the prayer of your people? Psalm 80:4

You have taken away all your wrath: you have turned yourself from the fierceness of your anger. Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause your anger toward us to cease. Will you be angry with us for ever? Will you draw out your anger to all generations? Psalm 85:3-5

For we are consumed by your **anger**, and by your **wrath** are we troubled... Who knows the power of your **anger**? Even according to your fear, so is your **wrath**. Psalm 90:7, 11

The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to **anger**, and plenteous in mercy. He will not always chide: neither will he keep his **anger** for ever. Psalm 103:8-9

They joined themselves also unto Baalpeor, and ate the sacrifices of the dead. Thus they provoked him to anger with their inventions; and the plague brake in upon them. Then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment; and so the plague was stayed. And that was counted unto him for righteousness unto all generations for evermore. They angered him also at the waters of strife, so that it went ill with Moses for their sakes: Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips. Psalm 106:28-32

The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. Psalm 145:8

He that is soon **angry** deals foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated. Proverbs 14:17

A soft answer turns away **wrath**: but grievous words stir up **anger**. Proverbs 15:1

A wrathful man stirs up strife: but he that is slow to anger appeases strife. Proverbs 15:18

He that is slow to **anger** is better than the mighty; and he that rules his spirit than he that takes a city. Proverbs 16:32

The discretion of a man defers his **anger**; and it is his glory to pass over a transgression. Proverbs 19:11

The fear of a king is as the roaring of a lion: whoso **provokes** him to **anger** sins against his own soul. Proverbs 20:2

A gift in secret pacifies **anger**: and a reward in the bosom **strong wrath**. Proverbs 21:14

It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an **angry** woman. Proverbs 21:19

He that sows iniquity shall reap vanity: and the rod of his **anger** shall fail. Proverbs 22:8

Make no friendship with an **angry** man; and with a **furious** man you shall not go... Proverbs 22:24

The north wind drives away rain: so does an **angry** countenance a backbiting tongue. Proverbs 25:23

**Wrath** is cruel, and **anger** is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy? Proverbs 27:4

An angry man stirs up strife, and a furious man abounds in transgression. Proverbs 29:22

Suffer not your mouth to cause your flesh to sin; neither say you before the angel, that it was an error: wherefore should God be **angry** at your voice, and destroy the work of your hands? Ecclesiastes 5:6

Surely oppression makes a wise man mad... The patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. Be not hasty in your spirit to be **angry**: for **anger** rests in the bosom of fools. Ecclesiastes 7:7-9

Look not upon me, because I am black, because the sun has looked upon me: my mother's children were **angry** with me; they made me the keeper of the vineyards; but mine own vineyard have I not kept. Song of Solomon 1:6

Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto **anger**, they are gone away backward. Isaiah 1:4

Therefore is the **anger** of the LORD kindled against his people, and he has stretched forth his hand against them, and has smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcases were torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his **anger** is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still. Isaiah 5:25

Therefore the Lord shall have no joy in their young men, neither shall have mercy on their fatherless and widows: for every one is an hypocrite and an evildoer, and every mouth speaks folly. For all this his **anger** is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still. Isaiah 9:17

O Assyrian, the rod of mine **anger**, and the staff in their hand is mine indignation...For yet a little while, and the indignation shall cease, and mine **anger** in their destruction. Isaiah 10:5, 25

In that day you shall say, O LORD, I will praise you: though you were angry with me, your anger is turned away, and you comforted me. Isaiah 12:1

I have commanded my sanctified ones, I have also called my mighty ones for my **anger**, even them that rejoice in my highness. Isaiah 13:3

Behold, the day of the LORD comes, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it... Therefore I will shake the heavens, and the earth shall remove out of her place, in the wrath of the LORD of hosts, and in the day of his fierce anger. Isaiah 13:9, 13

You shall take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say, How has the oppressor ceased! The golden city ceased! The LORD has broken the staff of the wicked, and the scepter of the rulers. He who smote the people in wrath with a continual stroke, he that ruled the nations in anger, is persecuted, and none hinders. Isaiah 14:4-6

Behold, the name of the LORD comes from far, burning his **anger**, and the burden thereof is heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire... The LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard, and shall show the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of his **anger**, and with the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, and tempest, and hailstones. Isaiah 30:27, 30

Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? Did not the LORD? He against whom we have sinned? For they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law. Therefore he has poured upon him the fury of his anger, and the strength of the battle: and it has set him on fire round about, yet he knew not; and it burned him, yet he laid it not to heart. Isaiah 42:24-25

For my name's sake will I defer mine **anger**, and for my praise will I refrain for thee, that I cut you not off. Behold, I have refined you, but not with silver; I have chosen you in the furnace of affliction. For mine own sake, even for mine own sake, will I do it: for how should my name be polluted? And I will not give my glory unto another. Isaiah 48:9-11

I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people there was none with me: for I will tread them in mine **anger**, and trample them in my **fury**; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment... Isaiah 63:3

I will tread down the people in mine **anger**, and make them drunk in my **fury**, and I will bring down their strength to the earth. Isaiah 63:6

I have spread out my hands all the day, unto a rebellious people, which walk in a way that was not good, after their own thoughts; A people that provoke me to **anger** continually to my face; that sacrifice in gardens, and burn incense upon altars of brick... Isaiah 65:2-3

For, behold, the LORD will come with fire, and with his chariots like a whirlwind, to render his **anger** with **fury**, and his rebuke with flames of fire. Isaiah 66:15

Yet you say, Because I am innocent, surely his **anger** shall turn from me. Behold, I will plead with thee, because you say, I have not sinned. Jeremiah 2:35

Will he reserve his **anger** for ever? Will he keep it to the end? Behold, you have spoken and done evil things as you could... Jeremiah 3:5

Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say, Return, you backsliding Israel, says the LORD; and I will not cause mine **anger** to fall upon you: for I am merciful, says the LORD, and I will not keep **anger** for ever. Jeremiah 3:12

For this gird you with sackcloth, lament and howl: for the **fierce anger of** the LORD is not turned back from us... Jeremiah 4:8

I beheld, and, lo, the fruitful place was a wilderness, and all the cities thereof were broken down at the presence of the LORD, and by his **fierce** anger. Jeremiah 4:26

The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead their dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger. Do they provoke me to anger? saith the LORD: do they not provoke themselves to the confusion of their own faces? Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, my anger and my fury shall be poured out upon this place, upon man, and upon beast, and upon the trees of the field, and upon the fruit of the ground; and it shall burn, and shall not be quenched. Jeremiah 7:18-20

O LORD, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walks to direct his steps. O LORD, correct me, but with judgment; not in your **anger**, lest you bring me to nothing. Pour out your **fury** upon the heathen that know you not, and upon the families that call not on your name: for they have eaten up Jacob, and devoured him, and consumed him, and have made his habitation desolate. Jeremiah 10:23-25

They have sown wheat, but shall reap thorns: they have put themselves to pain, but shall not profit: and they shall be ashamed of your revenues because of the fierce anger of the LORD. Jeremiah 12:13

You, even yourself, shall discontinue from your heritage that I gave you; and I will cause you to serve thine enemies in the land which you know not: for you have kindled a fire in mine **anger**, which shall burn for ever. Jeremiah 17:4

Yet, LORD, you know all their counsel against me to slay me: forgive not their iniquity, neither blot out their sin from your sight, but let them be overthrown before thee; deal thus with them in the time of your anger. Jeremiah 18:23

I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in **anger**, and in **fury**, and in **great wrath**. Jeremiah 21:5

The **anger** of the LORD shall not return, until he has executed, and till he has performed the thoughts of his heart: in the latter days you shall consider it perfectly. Jeremiah 23:20

Go not after other gods to serve them, and to worship them, and provoke me not to **anger** with the works of your hands; and I will do you no hurt. Jeremiah 25:6

Yet you have not hearkened unto me, says the LORD; that you might provoke me to anger with the works of your hands to your own hurt... And the peaceable habitations are cut down because of the fierce anger of the LORD. He has forsaken his covert, as the lion: for their land is desolate because of the fierceness of the oppressor, and because of his fierce anger. Jeremiah 25:7, 37-38

The **fierce anger** of the LORD shall not return, until he has done it, and until he has performed the intents of his heart: in the latter days ye shall consider it. Jeremiah 30:24

For this city hath been to me as a provocation of mine anger and of my fury from the day that they built it even unto this day; that I should remove it from before my face, Because of all the evil of the children of Israel and of the children of Judah, which they have done to provoke me to anger, they, their kings, their princes, their priests, and their prophets, and the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem...Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them in my anger, and in my fury, and in great wrath; and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely: Jeremiah 32:31-32,37

For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As my **anger** and my **fury** has been poured forth upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem; so shall my **fury** be poured forth upon you, when you shall enter Egypt: and you shall be an execration, and an astonishment, and a curse, and a reproach; and you shall see this place no more. Jeremiah 42:18

Because of their wickedness which they have committed to provoke me to anger, in that they went to burn incense, and to serve other gods, whom they knew not, neither they, you, nor your fathers... Wherefore my fury and my anger was poured forth, and was kindled in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem; and they are wasted and desolate, as at this day. Jeremiah 44:3, 6

My people, go you out of the midst of her, and deliver you every man his soul from the **fierce anger** of the LORD. Jeremiah 51:45

Is it nothing to you, all you that pass by? Behold, and see if there be any sorrow like unto my sorrow, which is done unto me, wherewith the LORD has afflicted me in the day of his **fierce ange**r. Lamentations 1:12

How has the Lord covered the daughter of Zion with a cloud in his anger, and cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, and remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger? ...He has cut off in his fierce anger all the horn of Israel: he has drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, and he burned against Jacob like a flaming fire, which devours round about...He has violently taken away his tabernacle, as if it were of a garden: he has destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD has caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and has despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest. Lamentations 2:1,3,6

The young and the old lie on the ground in the streets: my virgins and my young men are fallen by the sword; you have slain them in the day of your anger; you have killed, and not pitied. You have called as in a solemn day my terrors round about, so that in the day of **the LORD'S anger** none escaped nor remained: those that I have swaddled and brought up have mine enemy consumed. Lamentations 2:21-22

You have covered with **anger**, and persecuted us: you have slain, you have not pitied...Give them sorrow of heart, your curse be unto them. Persecute and destroy them in **anger** from under the heavens of the LORD. Lamentations 3:43, 66

The LORD has accomplished **his fury**; he has poured out **his fierce anger**, and has kindled a fire in Zion, and it has devoured the foundations thereof. Lamentations 4:11

Thus shall my **anger** be accomplished, and I will cause my **fury** to rest upon them, and I will be comforted: and they shall know that I the LORD have spoken it in my zeal, when I have accomplished my **fury** in them... So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that are round about **you**, when I shall execute judgments in you in **anger** and in **fury** and in **furious** rebukes. I the LORD have spoken it. Ezekiel 5:13, 15

Now is the end come upon you, and I will send my **anger** upon you, and will judge you according to your ways, and will recompense upon you all your abominations...Now will I shortly pour out my **fury** upon you, and accomplish my **anger** upon you: and I will judge you according to your ways, and will recompense thee for all your abominations. Ezekiel 7:3, 8

Then he said unto me, Have you seen this, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? For they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to **anger**: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose. Ezekiel 8:17

Because, even because they have seduced my people, saying, Peace; and there was no peace; and one built up a wall, and, lo, others daubed it with untempered mortar: Say unto them which daub it with untempered mortar, that it shall fall: there shall be an overflowing shower; and you, O great hailstones, shall fall; and a stormy wind shall rend it. Lo, when the wall is fallen, shall it not be said unto you, Where is the daubing wherewith you have daubed it? Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; I will even rend it with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in my anger, and great hailstones in my fury to consume it... Thus will I accomplish my wrath upon the wall, and upon them that have daubed it with untempered mortar, and will say unto you, The wall is no more, neither they that daubed it; To wit, the prophets of Israel which prophesy concerning Jerusalem, and which see visions of peace for her, and there is no peace, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 13:10-16

They shall burn your houses with fire, and execute judgments upon you in the sight of many women: and I will cause you to cease from playing the harlot, and you also shall give no hire any more... So will I make my fury toward you to rest, and my jealousy shall depart from thee, and I will be quiet, and will be no more angry. Ezekiel 16:41-42

Nothwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them, which if a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness. Ezekiel 20:21

As they gather silver, and brass, and iron, and lead, and tin, into the midst of the furnace, to blow the fire upon it, to melt it; so will I gather you in my anger and in my fury, and I will leave you there, and melt you. Ezekiel 22:20

Therefore, as I live, says the Lord GOD, I will even do according to your anger, and according to your envy which you have used out of your hatred against them; and I will make myself known among them, when I have judged you. Ezekiel 35:11

He said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcases of their kings in their high places. In their setting of their threshold by my thresholds, and their post by my posts, and the wall between me and them, they have even defiled my holy name by their abominations that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in mine anger. Now let them put away their whoredom, and the carcases of their kings, far from me, and I will dwell in the midst of them for ever. Ezekiel 43:7-9

For this cause the king was **angry** and very **furious**, and commanded to destroy all the wise men of Babylon. And the decree went forth that the wise men should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain. Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom... Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven. Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his... He reveals the deep and secret things... I thank you, and praise you, O God of my fathers, who has given me wisdom and might... Daniel 2:12-14, 19

O Lord, according to all your righteousness, I beseech you, let your anger and your fury be turned away from your city Jerusalem, your holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and your people are become a reproach to all that are about us. Daniel 9:16

Then shall stand up in his estate a raiser of taxes in the glory of the kingdom: but within few days he shall be destroyed, neither in **anger**, nor in battle. Daniel 11:20

I will not execute **the fierceness of mine anger**, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am God, and not man; the Holy One in the midst of you: and I will not enter into the city. Hosea 11:9

I gave you a king in my **anger**, and took him away in my **wrath**. Hosea 13:11

O Israel, return unto the LORD thy God; for you have fallen by your iniquity. Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips. Asshur shall not save us; we will not ride upon horses: neither will we say any more to the work of our hands, You are our gods: for in thee the fatherless finds mercy. I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for **mine anger** is turned away from him. Hosea 14:1-4

Therefore also now, says the LORD, turn you even to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning: And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repents him of evil. Who knows if he will return and repent, and leave a blessings behind him; even a meat offering and a drink offering unto the LORD your God? ...Let the priests, the ministers of the LORD, weep between the porch and the altar... Joel 2:12-14, 17

Let man and beast be covered with sackcloth, and cry mightily unto God; yes, let them turn every one from his evil way, and from the violence that is in their hands. Who can tell if God will turn and repent, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not? And God saw their works, that they turned from their evil way; and God repented of the evil, that he had said he would do unto them; and he did it not. Jonah 3:8-10

But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very **angry**. And he prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a gracious God, and merciful, slow to **anger**, and of great kindness, and you repent of the evil. Jonah 4:1-2

And God said to Jonah, Do you well to be **angry** for the gourd? And he said, I do well to be **angry**, even unto death. Then said the LORD, You have had pity on the gourd... Should not I spare Nineveh..? Jonah 4:9-11

I will execute vengeance in **anger and fury** upon the heathen, such as they have not heard. Micah 5:15

Who is a God like unto you, that pardons iniquity, and passes by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? He retains not his **anger** for ever, because he delights in mercy. He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and you will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Micah 7:18-19

God is jealous, and the LORD revenges; the LORD revenges, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserves wrath for his enemies. The LORD is slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit the wicked: the LORD has his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds are the dust of his feet. Naham 1:2-3

Who can stand before his indignation? And who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? His fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him. The LORD is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and he knows them that trust in him. But with an overrunning flood he will make an utter end of the place thereof, and darkness shall pursue his enemies. Nahum 1:6-8

You did march through the land in indignation, you did thresh the heathen in **anger**. You went forth for the salvation of your people, even for salvation with your anointed; you wounded the head out of the house of the wicked, by discovering the foundation unto the neck. Selah. Habakkuk 3:12-13

Gather yourselves together, yes, gather together, O nation not desired; ...Before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD'S anger come upon you. Seek you the LORD, all you meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be you shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger. Zephaniah 2:3

Wait you upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them in mine indignation, even all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy. Zephaniah 3:8

For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd. Mine **anger** was kindled against the shepherds, and I punished the goats: for the LORD of hosts has visited his flock the house of Judah, and has made them as his goodly horse in the battle. Zechariah 10:2-3

## **NEW COVENANT ANGER**

But I say unto you, That whoever is **angry** with his brother, without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whoever shall say, Thou fool, shall be in danger of hell fire. Matthew 5:22

When he had looked round about on them with **anger**, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he said to the man, Stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other. Mark 3:5

So that servant came, and showed his lord these things. Then the master of the house being **angry** said to his servant, Go out quickly into the streets and lanes of the city, and bring in hither the poor, and the maimed, and the halt, and the blind. Luke 14:21

And he was **angry**, and would not go in: therefore came his father out, and intreated him. Luke 15:28

If a man on the sabbath day receive circumcision, that the law of Moses should not be broken; are you **angry** at me, because I have made a man every whit whole on the sabbath day? John 7:23

But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by them that are no people, and by a foolish nation I will anger you. Romans 10:19

Be you **angry**, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your **wrath**: Neither give place to the devil. Ephesians 4:26-27

Let all bitterness, and **wrath**, and **anger**, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: Ephesians 4:31

But now you also put off all these; **anger, wrath**, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. Colossians 3:8

Fathers, provoke not your children to **anger**, lest they be discouraged. Colossians 3:21

For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon **angry**, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; Titus 1:7

And the nations were **angry**, and your **wrath** is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that you should give reward unto your servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear your name, small and great; and should destroy them which destroy the earth. Revelation 11:18

# ABOMINATION AND ABOMINABLE

They set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that is an **abomination** unto the Egyptians... You shall say, Your servants' trade hath been about cattle from our youth even until now, both we, and also our fathers: that you may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd is an **abomination** unto the Egyptians. Genesis 43:32, 46:34

Pharaoh called for Moses and for Aaron, and said, Go you, sacrifice to your God in the land. And Moses said, It is not meet so to do; for we shall sacrifice the **abomination** of the Egyptians to the LORD our God: lo, shall we sacrifice the **abomination** of the Egyptians before their eyes, and will they not stone us? Exodus 8:26

If any of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offers it: it shall be an **abomination**, and the soul that eats of it shall be his iniquity...Moreover the soul that shall touch any unclean thing, as the uncleanness of man, or any unclean beast, or any **abominable** unclean thing, and eat of the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which pertain unto the LORD, even that soul shall be cut off from his people. Leviticus 7:18, 21

All that have not fins and scales in the seas, and in the rivers, of all that move in the waters, and of any living thing which is in the waters, they shall be an **abomination** unto you: They shall be even an **abomination** unto you; you shall not eat of their flesh, but you shall have their carcases in abomination. Whatsoever has no fins nor scales in the waters, that shall be an **abomination** unto you. And these are they which you shall have in **abomination** among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they are an **abomination**: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray... Leviticus 11:13

All fowls that creep, going upon all four, shall be an abomination unto you...But all other flying creeping things, which have four feet, shall be an abomination unto you...And every creeping thing that creeps upon the earth shall be an abomination; it shall not be eaten. Whatsoever goes upon the belly, and whatsoever goes upon all four, or whatsoever has more feet among all creeping things that creep upon the earth, them you shall not eat; for they are an abomination. You shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creeps, neither shall you make yourselves unclean with them, that you should be defiled thereby. Leviticus 11:20, 23, 41-43

You shall not lie with mankind, as with womankind: it is **abomination**... Therefore shall you keep mine ordinance, that you commit not any one of these **abominable** customs, which were committed before you, and that you defile not yourselves therein: I am the LORD your God. Leviticus 18:30

If you offer a sacrifice of peace offerings unto the LORD...If it be eaten at all on the third day, it is **abominable**; it shall not be accepted. Leviticus 19:5, 7

If a man also lie with mankind, as he lies with a woman, both of them have committed an **abomination**: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them. Leviticus 20:13

You shall therefore put difference between clean beasts and unclean, and between unclean fowls and clean: and you shall not make your souls **abominable** by beast, or by fowl, or by any manner of living thing that creeps on the ground, which I have separated from you as unclean. Leviticus 20:25

The graven images of their gods shall you burn with fire: you shall not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto you, lest you be snared therein: for it is an **abomination** to the LORD your God. Neither shall you bring an **abomination** into your house, lest you be a cursed thing like it: but you shall utterly detest it, and you shall utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing. Deuteronomy 7:25-26

You shall not do so unto the LORD your God: for every **abomination** to the LORD, which he hates, have they done unto their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods. Deuteronomy 12:31

If you shall hear say in one of your cities, which the LORD your God has given you to dwell there, saying, Certain men, the children of Belial, are gone out from among you, and have withdrawn the inhabitants of their city, saying, Let us go and serve other gods, which you have not known; Then shall you enquire, and make search, and ask diligently; and, behold, if it be truth, and the thing certain, that such **abomination** is wrought among you; You shall surely smite the inhabitants of that city with the edge of the sword, destroying it utterly, and all that is therein, and the cattle thereof, with the edge of the sword. Deuteronomy 13:12-15

For you are a holy people unto the LORD your God, and the LORD has chosen you to be a peculiar people unto himself, above all the nations that are upon the earth. You shall not eat any **abominable** thing. Deuteronomy 14:3

You shall not sacrifice unto the LORD your God any bullock, or sheep, wherein is blemish, or any evilfavouredness: for that is an **abomination** unto the LORD your God. If there be found among you, within any of your gates which the LORD your God gives you, man or woman, that has wrought wickedness in the sight of the LORD thy God, in transgressing his covenant, And has gone and served other gods, and worshiped them, either the sun, or moon, or any of the hosts of heaven, which I have not commanded; And it be told you, and you have heard of it, and enquired diligently, and, behold, it be true, and the thing certain, that such **abomination** is wrought in Israel: Then shall you bring forth that man or woman, which has committed that wicked thing, unto your gates, even that man or that woman, and shall stone them with stones, till they die. Deuteronomy 17:1-5

For all that do these things are an **abomination** unto the LORD: and because of these **abominations** the LORD your God does drive them out from before you. Deuteronomy 18:12

The woman shall not wear that which pertains unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so are **abomination** unto the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 23:18

You shall not bring the hire of a whore, or the price of a dog, into the house of the LORD your God for any vow: for even both these are an **abomination** unto the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 23:18

Her former husband, which sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, after she is defiled; for that is **abomination** before the LORD: and you shall not cause the land to sin, which the LORD thy God gives thee for an inheritance. Deuteronomy 24:4

...For all that do such things, and all that do unrighteously, are an **abomination** unto the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 25:16

Cursed be the man that makes any graven or molten image, an **abomination** unto the LORD, the work of the hands of the craftsman, and puts it in a secret place. Deuteronomy 27:15

All Israel heard say that Saul had smitten a garrison of the Philistines, and that Israel also was had in **abomination** with the Philistines. And the people were called together after Saul to Gilgal. 1 Samuel 13:4

For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites. And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as did David his father. Then did Solomon build a high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that is before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon. And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods. And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had appeared unto him twice. 1 Kings 11:5-9

The high places that were before Jerusalem, which were on the right hand of the mount of corruption, which Solomon the king of Israel had built for Ashtoreth the **abomination** of the Zidonians, and for Chemosh the **abomination** of the Moabites, and for Milcom the **abomination** of the children of Ammon, did the king defile. 2 Kings 23:13

Joab gave the sum of the number of the people unto David. But Levi and Benjamin counted he not among them: for the king's word was abominable to Joab. 1 Chronicles 21:5-6

When Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the **abominable** idols out of all the land...and renewed the altar of the LORD... 2 Chronicles 15:8

How much more **abominable** and filthy is man, which drinks iniquity like water? Job 15:16

The fool has said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done **abominable** works, there is none that does good. Psalm 14:1

The fool has said in his heart, There is no God. Corrupt are they, and have done **abominable** iniquity: there is none that does good. Psalm 53:1

You have put away mine acquaintances far from me; you have made me an **abomination** unto them: I am shut up, and I cannot come forth. Psalm 88:8

Envy not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways. For the froward is **abomination** to the LORD: but his secret is with the righteous. Proverbs 3:31-32

These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an **abomination** unto him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood. A heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19

Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right things. For my mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness is an **abomination** to my lips. Proverbs 8:6-7

A false balance is **abomination** to the LORD: but a just weight is his delight. Proverbs 11:1

They that are of a froward heart are **abomination** to the LORD: but such as are upright in their way are his delight. Proverbs 11:20

Lying lips are **abomination** to the LORD: but they that deal truly are his delight. Proverbs 12:22

The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but it is **abomination** to fools to depart from evil. Proverbs 13:19

The sacrifice of the wicked is an **abomination** to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright is his delight. The way of the wicked is an **abomination** unto the LORD: but he loves him that follows after righteousness. Proverbs 15:8-9

The thoughts of the wicked are an **abomination** to the LORD: but the words of the pure are pleasant words. Proverbs 15:26

Every one that is proud in heart is an **abomination** to the LORD: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished. Proverbs 16:5

It is an **abomination** to kings to commit wickedness: for the throne is established by righteousness. Proverbs 16:12

He that justifies the wicked, and he that condemns the just, even they both are **abomination** to the LORD. Proverbs 17:15

Divers weights, and divers measure, both of them are alike **abomination** to the LORD...Divers weights are an **abomination** unto the LORD; and a false balance is not good. Proverbs 20:10, 23

The sacrifice of the wicked is **abomination**: how much more, when he brings it with a wicked mind? Proverbs 21:27

The thought of foolishness is sin: and the scorner is an **abomination** to men. Proverbs 24:9

He that turns away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be an **abomination**. Proverbs 28:9

An unjust man is an **abomination** to the just: and he that is upright in the way is **abomination** to the wicked. Proverbs 29:27

Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an **abomination** unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting. Isaiah 1:13

You are cast out of your grave like an **abominable** branch, and as the raiment of those that are slain, thrust through with a sword, that go down to the stones of the pit; as a carcase trodden under feet. Isaiah 14:19

Behold, you are of nothing, and your work of nought: an **abomination** is he that chooses you. Isaiah 41:24

None considers in his heart, neither is there knowledge nor understanding to say, I have burned part of it in the fire; yea, also I have baked bread upon the coals thereof; I have roasted flesh, and eaten it: and shall I make te residue thereof an **abomination**? Shall I fall down to the stock of a tree? Isaiah 44:19

I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people... Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of **abominable** things is in their vessels... Isaiah 65:4

They that sanctify themselves, and purify themselves in the gardens behind one tree in the midst, eating swine's flesh, and the **abomination**, and the mouse, shall be consumed together, saith the LORD. Isaiah 66:17

I brought you into a plentiful country, to eat the fruit thereof and the goodness thereof; but when you entered, you defiled my land, and made mine heritage an **abomination**. Jeremiah 2:7

Were they ashamed when they had committed **abomination**? No, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: in the time of their visitation they shall be cast down, says the LORD. Jeremiah 8:12

First I will recompense their iniquity and their sin double; because they have defiled my land, they have filled mine inheritance with the carcases of their detestable and **abominable** things. Jeremiah 16:18

They built the high places of Baal, which are in the valley of the son of Hinnom, to cause their sons and their daughter to pass through the fire unto Molech; which I commanded them not, neither came it into my mind, that they should do this **abomination**, to cause Judah to sin. Jeremiah 32:35

Howbeit I sent unto you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending them, saying, Oh, do not this **abominable** thing that I hate. Jeremiah 44:4

Then said I, Ah Lord GOD! Behold, my soul has not been polluted: for from my youth up even till now have I not eaten of that which died of itself, or is torn in pieces; neither came there **abominable** flesh into my mouth. Ezekiel 4:14

So I went in and saw; and behold every form of creeping things, and abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel, portrayed upon the wall round about. Ezekiel 8:10

They were haughty, and committed **abomination** before me: therefore Itook them away as I saw good. Ezekiel 16:50

You also, who have judged your sisters, bear your own shame for your sins that you have committed more **abominable** than they: they are more righteous than you: yes, be confounded also, and bear your shame, in that you have justified your sisters. Ezekiel 16:52

If he beget a son that...has oppressed the poor and needy, has spoiled by violence, has not restored the pledge, and has lifted up his eyes to the idols, has committed **abomination**...shall he then live? Ezekiel 18:10, 12-13

Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, Now, son of man, will you judge, will you judge the bloody city? Yes, you shall show her all her **abominations**...And one has committed **abomination** with his neighbor's wife; and another has lewdly defiled his daughter-in-law; and another in you has humbled his sister, his father's daughter. Ezekiel 22;1, 11

You stand upon your sword, you work **abomination**, and you defile every one his neighbor's wife: and shall you possess the land? Ezekiel 33:26

He shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant. And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the **abomination** that makes desolate. Daniel 11:30-31

From the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the **abomination** that makes desolate set up, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days. Daniel 12:11

He has showed thee, O man what is good; and what does the LORD require of you, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God? ... Are there yet the treasure of wickedness in the house of the wicked, and the scant measure that is **abominable**? Micah 6:8,10

I will cast **abominable** filth upon you, and make thee vile, and will set you as a gazingstock. Nahum 3:6

Judah has dealt treacherously, and an **abomination** is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah has profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and has married the daughter of a strange god. Malachi 2:11

When you therefore shall see the **abomination** of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso reads, let him understand:) Then let them which be in Judea flee into the mountains; Let him which is on the housetop not come down to take any thing out of his house: Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes. Matthew 24:15-18

But when you shall see the **abomination** of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that reads understand,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains: And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither entered therein, to take any thing out of his house: And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment. Mark 13:14-16

And he said unto them, You are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knows your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is **abomination** in the sight of God. The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presses into it. And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail. Luke 16:15-16

They profess that they know God; but in works they deny him, being **abominable**, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate. Titus 1:16

For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and **abominable** idolatries: Wherein they think it strange that you run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you: Who shall give account to him that is ready to judge the quick and the dead. 1 Peter 4:3-5

But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the **abominable**, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. Revelation 21:8

The gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there... There shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defiles, neither whatsoever works **abomination**, or makes a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life. Revelation 21:25, 27

### **BITTERNESS**

When Esau heard the words of his father, he cried with a great and exceeding **bitter** cry, and said unto his father, Bless me, even me also, O my father. Genesis 27:34

They made their lives **bitter** with hard bondage, in morter, and in brick, and in all manner of service in the field: all their service, wherein they made them serve, was with rigour. Exodus 1:14

They shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it. Exodus 12:8

When they came to Marah, they could not drink of the waters of Marah, for they were **bitter**: therefore the name of it was Marah. Exodus 15:23

The priest shall set the woman before the Lord, and uncover the woman's head, and put the offering of memorial in her hands, which is the jealousy offering: and the priest shall have in his hand the bitter water that causes the curse. And the priest shall charge her by an oath, and say unto the woman, If no man have lain with you, and if you have not gone aside to uncleanness with another instead of your husband, be free from this bitter water that causes the curse...And the priest shall write these curses in a book, and he shall blot them out with the bitter water. And he shall cause the woman to drink the bitter water that cases the curse: and the water that causes the curse shall enter into her, and become bitter...And when he has made her drink the water, then it shall come to pass, that, if she be defiled, and have done trespass against her husband, that the water that causes the curse shall enter into her, and become bitter, and her belly shall swell, and her thigh shall rot: and the woman shall be a curse among her people. Numbers 27:18-19, 23-24, 27

...He shall keep the passover unto the LORD. The fourteenth day of the second month at even they shall keep it, and eat it with unleavened bread and **bitter** herbs. Numbers 9:10-11

They shall be burnt with hunger, and devoured with burning heat, and with bitter destruction: I will also send the teeth of beasts upon them, with the poison of serpents of the dust...For their vine is of the vine of Sodom, and of the fields of Gomorrah: their grapes are grapes of gall, for their clusters are bitter... Deuteronomy 32:24, 32

Curse you Meroz, said the angel of the Lord, curse you bitterly the inhabitants thereof, because they came not to the help of the Lord, to the help of the Lord against the mighty. Judges 5:23

She said unto them, Call me not Naomi, call em Mara: for the Almighty has dealt very bitterly with me. Ruth 1:20

She was in **bitterness** of soul, and prayed unto the Lord, and wept sore. 1 Samuel 1:10

Then said Samuel, Bring hither to me Agag the king of the Amalekites. And Agag came unto him delicately. And Agag said, Surely the **bitterness** of death is past. 1 Samuel 15:32

Then Abner called to Joab, and said, shall the sword devour for ever? Know you not that it will be **bitterness** in the latter end? How long shall it be then, ere you bid the people return from following their brethren? 2 Samuel 2:26

When Mordecai perceived all that was done, Mordecai rent his clothes, and put on sackcloth with ashes, and went out into the midst of the city, and cried with a loud and a **bitter** cry... Esther 4:1

Wherefore is light given to him that is in misery, and life unto the **bitter** in soul... Job 3:20

Therefore I will not refrain my mouth; I will speak in the anguish of my spirit; I will complain in the **bitterness** of my soul. Job 7:11

He will not suffer me to take my breath, but fills me with **bitterness**. Job 9:18

My soul is weary of my life; I will leave my complaint upon myself; I will speak in the **bitterness** of my soul. Job 10:1

For you write **bitter** things against me, and make me possess the iniquities of my youth. Job 13:26

Another dies in the **bitterness** of his soul, and never eats with pleasure. Job 21:25

Even to day is my complaint bitter: my stroke is heavier than my groaning. Job 23:2

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; and from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity. Who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even **bitter** words... They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the heart, is deep. Psalm 64:1-3, 6

Her end is **bitter** as wormwood, sharp as a twoedged sword. Proverbs 5;4

The heart knows his own **bitterness**; and a stranger does not intermeddle with his joy. Proverbs 14:10

A foolish son is a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him. Proverbs 17:25

The full soul loathes an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul every bitter thing is sweet. Proverbs 27:7

I find more **bitter** than death the woman, whose heart is snares and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleases God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her. Ecclesiastes 7:26

Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put **bitter** for sweet, and sweet for **bitter**! Isaiah 5:20

Therefore said I, Look away from me; I will weep **bitterly**, labor not to comfort me, because of the spoiling of the daughter of my people. Isaiah 22:4

They shall not drink wine with a song; strong drink shall be **bitter** to them that drink it. Isaiah 24:9

Behold, their valiant ones shall cry without: the ambassadors of peace shall weep **bitterly**. Isaiah 33:7

What shall I say? He has both spoken unto me, and himself has done it: I shall go softly all my years in the **bitterness** of my soul. O Lord, by these things is the life of my spirit: so will you recover me, and make me to live. Behold, for peace I had great **bitterness**: but you have in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for you have cast all my sins behind your back. Isaiah 38:15-17

Your own wickedness shall correct you, and your backslidings shall reprove you: know therefore and see that it is an evil things and **bitter**, that you have forsaken the Lord your God, and that my fear is not in you, says the Lord God of hosts. Jeremiah 2:19

Your way and your doings have procured these things unto you; this is your wickedness, because it is **bitter**, because it reaches unto your heart. Jeremiah 4:18

O daughter of my people, gird yourself with sackcloth, and wallow yourself in ashes: make you mourning, as for an only son, most **bitter** lamentation: for the spoiler shall suddenly come upon us. Jeremiah 6:26

Thus says the Lord; A voice was heard in Ramah, lamentation, and **bitter** weeping; Rahel weeping for her children refused to be comforted for her children, because they were not. Jeremiah 31:15

The ways of Zion do mourn, because none come to the solemn feasts: all her gates are desolate: her priests sigh, her virgins are afflicted, and she is in **bitterness**. Lamentations 1:4

He has filled me with **bitterness**, he has made me drunken with wormwood. Lamentations 3:15

So the spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in **bitterness**, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the Lord was strong upon me. F.zekiel 3:14

Sigh therefore, you son of man, with the breaking of your loins; and with bitterness sigh before their eyes. Ezekiel 21:6

...And shall cause their voice to be heard against you, and shall cry bitterly, and shall cast up dust upon their heads, they shall wallow themselves in the ashes: And they shall make themselves utterly bald for you, and gird them with sackcloth, and they shall weep for you with bitterness of heart and bitter wailing. Ezekiel 26:30-31

Ephraim provoked him to anger most **bitterly**: therefore shall he leave his blood upon him, and his reproach shall his Lord return unto him. Hosea 12:14

I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation; and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head; and I will make it as the mourning of an only son, and the end thereof as a bitter day. Amos 8:10

For, lo, I raise up the Chaldeans, that **bitter** and hasty nation, which shall march through the breadth of the land, to possess the dwellingplaces that are not theirs. Habakkuk 1:6

The great day of the Lord is near, it is near, and hastens greatly, even the voice of the day of the Lord: the mighty man shall cry there **bitterly**. Zephaniah 1:14

And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in **bitterness** for him, as one that is in **bitterness** for his firstborn. Zechariah 12:10

Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, you shall deny me three times. And he went out, and wept **bitterly**. Matthew 26:75

For I perceive that you are in the gall of **bitterness**, and in the bond of iniquity. Acts 8:23

There is none that understands, there is none that seeks after God. They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that does good, no, not one. Their throat is an open sepulcher; with their tongues they have used deceit; the poison of asps is under their lips: whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness: Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways: And the way of peace have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes. Romans 3:11-18

Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be you kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you. Be you therefore followers of God, as dear children; And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us, and has given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savor. Ephesians 4:31-32, 5:1-2

Husbands, love your wives, and be not **bitter** against them. Colossians 3:19

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of **bitterness** springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled... Hebrews 12:14-15

But the tongue can no man tame; it is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. Therewith we bless God, even the Father, and therewith we curse men, which are made after the similitude of God. Out of the same mouth proceeds blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. Does a fountain send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter? Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? Either a vine, figs? So can no fountain both yield salt water and fresh. Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him show out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But if you have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descends not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace. James 3:8-18

The name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made **bitter**. Revelation 8:11

I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make your belly **bitter**, but it shall be in your mouth sweet as honey. And I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my belly was **bitter**. Revelation 10:9-10

## CONTENDING AND CONTENTION

The LORD said unto me, Distress not the Moabites, neither **contend** with them in battle: for I will not give thee of their land for a possession; because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot for a possession. Deuteronomy 2:9

Pass over the river Arnon: behold, I have given into your hand Sihon the Amorite, king of Heshbon, and his land: begin to possess it, and **contend** with him in battle. Deuteronomy 2:24

Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place... Then I contended with the nobles of Judah, and said unto them, What evil thing is this that you do, and profane the sabbath day? ... And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, saying, You shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves. Nehemiah 13:11, 17, 25

Only by pride comes **contention**: but with the well advised is wisdom. Proverbs 13:10

The beginning of strife is as when one lets out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with. Proverbs 17:14

A fool's lips enter into **contention**, and his mouth calls for strokes. Proverbs 18:6

The lot causes **contentions** to cease, and parts between the mighty. A brother offended is harder to be won than a strong city: and their **contentions** are like the bars of a castle. Proverbs 18:18-19

It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a **contentious** and an angry woman. Proverbs 21:19

Cast out the scorner, and **contention** shall go out; yes, strife and reproach shall cease. Proverbs 22:10

As coals are to burning coals, and wood to fire; so is a **contentious** man to kindle strife. Proverbs 26:21

A continual dropping in a very rainy day and a contentious woman are alike. Proverbs 27:15

They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them...If a wise man contends with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, there is no rest. Proverbs 28:4, 29:9

That which has been is named already, and it is known that it is man: neither may he **contend** with him that is mightier than he. Ecclesiastes 6:10

You shall seek them, and shall not find them, even them that **contended** with you: they that war against you shall be as nothing, and as a thing of nought. Isaiah 41:12

Thus says the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will **contend** with him that **contends** with you, and I will save your children. Isaiah 49:25

He is near that justifies me; who will **contend** with me? Let us stand together: who is mine adversary? Let him come near to me. Isaiah 50:8

For I will not **contend** for ever, neither will I always be wroth: for the spirit should fall before me, and the souls which I have made. Isaiah 57:16

If you have run with the footmen, and they have wearied you, then how can you **contend** with horses? And if in the land of peace, wherein you trusted, they wearied you, then how will you do in the swelling of Jordan? Jeremiah 12:5

Woe is me, my mother, that you have borne me a man of strife and a man of **contention** to the whole earth! I have neither lent on usury, nor men have lent to me on usury; yet everyone of them does curse me. The LORD said, Verily it shall be well with thy remnant; verily I will cause the enemy to entreat you well in the time of evil and in the time of affliction. Jeremiah 15:10

Give heed to me, O LORD, and hearken to the voice of them that **contend** with me. Jeremiah 18:19

Thus has the Lord God showed unto me; and, behold, the Lord GOD called to **contend** by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part. Amos 7:4

Hear you now what the LORD says; Arise, contend you before the mountains, and let the hills hear your voice. Micah 6:1

When Peter was come up to Jerusalem, they that were of the circumcision **contended** with him. Acts 11:2

The **contention** was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus... Acts 15:39

To them who by patient continuance in well-doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are **contentious**, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that does evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; but glory, honor, and peace, to every man that works good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile: For there is no respect of persons with God. Romans 2:7-11

The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds... Philippians 1:16

But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as you know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much **contention**. For our exhortation was not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile: But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which tries our hearts. For neither at any time used we flattering words, as you know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God is witness: Neither of men sought we glory... 1 Thessalonians 2:2-6

Beloved...it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that you should earnestly **contend** for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. Jude 1:3

Yet Michael the archangel, when **contending** with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, dared not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke you. Jude 1:9

## FOOLS AND FOLLY

The sons of Jacob came out of the field when they heard it: and the men were grieved, and they were very wroth, beacuse he had wrought **folly** in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter; which thing ought not to be done. Genesis 34:7

Then they shall bring out the damsel to the door of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her with stones that she die: because she has wrought **folly** in Israel, to play the whore in her father's house: so shall you put evil away from among you. Deuteronomy 22:21

Do you thus requite the LORD, O **foolish** people and unwise? is not he your father that has bought you? has he not made you, and established you? Deuteronomy 32:6

They have moved me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked me to anger with their vanities: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a **foolish** nation. Deuteronomy 32:21

And it shall be, that he that is taken with the accursed thing shall be burnt with fire, he and all that he has: because he has transgressed the covenant of the LORD, and because he has wrought **folly** in Israel. Joshua 7:15

And the man, the master of the house, went out unto them, and said unto them, No, my brethren, no, I pray you, do not sowickedly; seeing that this man is come into mine house, do not this **folly**. Judges 19:23

I took my concubine, and cut her in pieces, and sent her throughout all the country of the inheritance of Israel: for they have committed lewdness and **folly** in Israel. Judges 20:6

We will take ten men of an hundred throughout all the tribes of Israel, and an hundred of a thousand, and a thousand out of ten thousand, to fetch victual for the people, that they may do, when they come to Gibeah of Benjamin, according to all the **folly** that they have wrought in Israel. Judges 20:10

Let my lord, I pray thee, regard this man of Belial, even Nabal: for as his name is, so is he; Nabal is his name, and **folly** is with him: 1 Samuel 25:25

Then said Saul, I have sinned: return, my son David: for I will no more do **you** harm, because my soul was precious in your eyes this day: behold, I have played the **fool**, and have erred exceedingly. 1 Samuel 26:21

The king lamented over Abner, and said, Died Abner as a **fool** dies? 2 Samuel 3:33

She answered him, No, my brother, do not force me; for no such thing ought to be done in Israel: do not you this **folly**. And I, whither shall I cause my shame to go? and as for you, you shall be as one of the **fools** in Israel. Now therefore, I pray you, speak unto the king; for he will not withhold me from you. 2 Samuel 13:12-13

And one told David, saying, Ahithophel is among the conspirators with Absalom. And David said, O LORD, I pray thee, turn the counsel of Ahithophel into **foolishness**. 2 Samuel 15:31

But he said unto her, You speak as one of the **foolish** women speak. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips. Job 2:10

Behold, he put no trust in his servants; and his angels he charged with folly... Job 4:18

For wrath kills the **foolish** man, and envy slays the silly one. Job 5:2

I have seen the **foolish** taking root: but suddenly I cursed his habitation. Job 5:3

He leads counsellors away spoiled, and makes judges fools. Job 12:17

Men groan from out of the city, and the soul of the wounded cries out: yet God lays not **folly** to them. Job 24:12

Go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you after your **folly**, in that ye have not spoken of me the thing which is right, like my servant Job. Job 42:8

The **foolish** shall not stand in my sight: you hate all workers of iniquity. Psalm 5:5

The **fool** has said in his heart, There is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that does good. Psalm 14:1

My wounds stink and are corrupt because of my foolishness. Psalm 38:5

Deliver me from all my transgressions: make me not the reproach of the foolish. Psalm 39:8

For he sees that wise men die, likewise the **fool** and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others. Psalm 49:10

They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; None of them can redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceases for ever.) This their way is their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings. Selah. Psalm 49:13

The **fool** has said in his heart, There is no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: there is none that does good. Psalm 53:1

O God, you know my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee. Psalm 69:5

For I was envious at the **foolish**, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. Psalm 73:3

So foolish was I, and ignorant: I was as a beast before you. Psalm 73:22

Remember this, that the enemy has reproached, O LORD, and that the **foolish** people have blasphemed your name. Psalm 74:18

Arise, O God, plead your own cause: remember how the **foolish** man reproaches thee daily. Psalm 74:22

I said unto the **fools**, Deal not **foolishly**: and to the wicked, Lift not up the horn... Psalm 75:4

I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to **folly**. Psalm 85:8

A brutish man knows not; neither does a fool understand this. Psalm 92:6

Understand, you brutish among the people: and you **fools**, when will you be wise? Psalm 94:8

**Fools** because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. Psalm 107:17

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but **fools** despise wisdom and instruction. Proverbs 1:7

How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? And the scorners delight in their scorning, and **fools** hate knowledge? Proverbs 1:22

For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of **fools** shall destroy them. Proverbs 1:32

The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of **fools**. *Proverbs* 3:35

He shall die without instruction; and in the greatness of his **folly** he shall go astray. Proverbs 5:23

I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding... So she caught him, and kissed him...He goes after her straightway, as an ox goes to the slaughter, or as a **fool** to the correction of the stocks... Proverbs 7:7, 13, 22

O you simple, understand wisdom: and, you **fools**, be you of an understanding heart. Proverbs 8:5

Forsake the **foolish**, and live; and go in the way of understanding. Proverbs 9:6

A foolish woman is clamorous: she is simple, and knows nothing. Proverbs 9:13

The proverbs of Solomon, A wise son makes a glad father: but a **foolish** son is the heaviness of his mother. Proverbs 10:1

The wise in heart will receive commandments: but a prating **fool** shall fall...He that winks with the eye causes sorrow: but a prating **fool** shall fall. Proverbs 10:8-10

Wise men lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the **foolish** is near destruction. Proverbs 10:14

He that hides hatred with lying lips, and he that utters a slander, is a **fool**. Proverbs 10:18

The lips of the righteous feeds many: but **fools** die for want of wisdom. Proverbs 10:21

It is as sport to a **fool** to do mischief: but a man of understanding has wisdom. Proverbs 10:23

He that troubles his own house shall inherit the wind: and the **fool** shall be servant to the wise of heart. Proverbs 11:29

The way of a **fool** is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkens unto counsel is wise. Proverbs 12:15

A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent man covers shame. Proverbs 12:16

A prudent man conceals knowledge: but the heart of **fools** proclaims **foolishness**. Proverbs 12:23

Every prudent man deals with knowledge: but a **fool** lays open his **folly**. Proverbs 13:16

The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but it is abomination to **fools** to depart from evil. Proverbs 13:19

He that walks with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of **fools** shall be destroyed. Proverbs 13:20

Every wise woman builds her house: but the **foolish** plucks it down with her hands. Proverbs 14:1

In the mouth of the **foolish** is a rod of pride: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them. Proverbs 14:3

Go from the presence of a **foolish** man, when you perceive not in him the lips of knowledge. Proverbs 14:7

The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way: but **the folly of fools** is deceit. Proverbs 14:8

**Fools** make a mock at sin: but among the righteous there is favor. Proverbs 14:9

A wise man fears, and departs from evil: but **the fool** rages, and is confident. Proverbs 14:16

The simple inherit **folly**: but the prudent are crowned with knowledge. Proverbs 14:18

The crown of the wise is their riches: but **the foolishness of fools is folly**. Proverbs 14:24

He that is slow to wrath is of great understanding: but he that is hasty of spirit exalts **folly**. Proverbs 14:29

Wisdom rests in the heart of him that has understanding: but that which is in the midst of **fools** is made known. Proverbs 14:33

The tongue of the wise uses knowledge aright: but the mouth of **fools** pours out **foolishness**. Proverbs 15:2

A **fool** despises his father's instruction: but he that regards reproof is prudent. Proverbs 15:5

The lips of the wise disperse knowledge: but the heart of the **foolish** does not so. Proverbs 15:7

The heart of him that has understanding seeks knowledge: but the mouth of **fools** feeds on **foolishness**. Proverbs 15:14

A wise son makes a glad father: but a **foolish** man despises his mother. Proverbs 15:20

**Folly** is joy to him that is destitute of wisdom: but a man of understanding walks uprightly. Proverbs 15:21

Understanding is a wellspring of life unto him that has it: but the instruction of **fools is folly**. Proverbs 16:22

Excellent speech becomes not a **fool**: much less do lying lips a prince. Proverbs 17:7

A reproof enters more into a wise man than an hundred stripes into a **fool**. Proverbs 17:10

Let a bear robbed of her whelps meet a man, rather than **a fool in his folly**. Proverbs 17:12

Wherefore is there a price in the hand of a **fool** to get wisdom, seeing he has no heart to it? Proverbs 17:16

He that begets a **fool** does it to his sorrow: and the father of a **fool** has no joy. Proverbs 17:21

A foolish son is a grief to his father, and bitterness to her that bare him. Proverbs 17:25

Wisdom is before him that has understanding; but the eyes of a **fool** are in the ends of the earth. Proverbs 17:28

Even a **fool**, when he holds his peace, is counted wise: and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a man of understanding. Proverbs 17:28

A fool has no delight in understanding, but that his heart may discover itself. Proverbs 18:2

A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calls for strokes. A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the snare of his soul. Proverbs 18:6-7

He that answers a matter before he hears it, it is **folly** and shame unto him. Proverbs 18:13

Better is the poor that walks in his integrity, than he that is perverse in his lips, and is a **fool**. Proverbs 19:1

The **foolishness** of man perverts his way: and his heart frets against the LORD. Proverbs 19:3

Delight is not seemly for a **fool**; much less for a servant to have rule over princes. Proverbs 19:10

A **foolish** son is the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife are a continual dropping. Proverbs 19:13

Judgments are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of **fools**. Proverbs 19:29

It is an honor for a man to cease from strife: but every **fool** will be meddling. Proverbs 20:3

There is treasure to be desired and oil in the dwelling of the wise; but a **foolish** man spends it up. Proverbs 21:20

**Foolishness** is bound in the heart of a child; but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him. Proverbs 22:15

Speak not in the ears of a **fool**: for he will despise the wisdom of your words. Proverbs 23:9

Wisdom is too high for a **fool**: he opens not his mouth in the gate. Proverbs 24:7

The thought of **foolishness** is sin: and the scorner is an abomination to men. Proverbs 24:9

As snow in summer, and as rain in harvest, so honor is not seemly for a fool. Proverbs 26:1

A whip for the horse, a bridle for the ass, and a rod for the **fool's** back. Proverbs 26:3

Answer not a **fool** according to his **folly**, lest you also be like unto him. Answer a **fool** according to his **folly**, lest he be wise in his own conceit. Proverbs 26:4-5

He that sends a message by the hand of a **fool** cuts off the feet, and drinks damage. The legs of the lame are not equal: so is a parable in the mouth of **fools**. He that binds a stone in a sling, so is he that gives honor to a **fool**. Proverbs 26:6-8

As a thorn goes up into the hand of a drunkard, so is a parable in the mouth of **fools**. The great God that formed all things both rewards **the fool**, and rewards transgressors. Proverbs 26:9-10

As a dog returns to his vomit, so a **fool** return**s** to his **folly**. See you a man wise in his own conceit? There is more hope of a **fool** than of him. Proverbs 26:11-12

A stone is heavy, and the sand weighty; but a **fool's** wrath is heavier than them both. Proverbs 27:3

Though you should bray a **fool** in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, yet will not his **foolishness** depart from him. Proverbs 27:22

He that trusts in his own heart is a **fool**: but whoso walks wisely, he shall be delivered. Proverbs 28:26

If a wise man contends with a **foolish** man, whether he rage or laugh, there is no rest. Proverbs 29:9

A fool utters all his mind: but a wise man keeps it in till afterwards. Proverbs 29:11

See you a man that is hasty in his words? There is more hope of a **fool** than of him. Proverbs 29:20

For three things the earth is disquieted, and for four which it cannot bear: For a servant when he reigns; and a **fool** when he is filled with meat; For an odious woman when she is married; and an handmaid that is heir to her mistress. Proverbs 30:21-23

I gave my heart to know wisdom, and to know madness and **folly**: I perceived that this also is vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 1:17

I sought in mine heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting mine heart with wisdom; and to lay hold on **folly**, till I might see what was that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life. Ecclesiastes 2:3

And I turned myself to behold wisdom, and madness, and **folly**; for what can the man do that comes after the king? even that which has been already done. Ecclesiastes 2:12

Then I saw that wisdom excells **folly**, as far as light excells darkness. The wise man's eyes are in his head; but the **fool** walks in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happens to them all. Then said I in my heart, As it happens to the **fool**, so it happens even to me; and why was I then more wise? Then I said in my heart, that this also is vanity. For there is no remembrance of the wise more than of the **fool** for ever, seeing that which now is in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dies the wise man? As the **fool**. Ecclesiastes 2:13-16

Who knows whether he be a wise man or a **fool**? yet shall he have rule over all my labor wherein I have labored, and wherein I have showed myself wise under the sun. This is also vanity. Ecclesiastes 2:19

The fool folds his hands together, and eats his own flesh. Ecclesiastes 4:5

Better is a poor and a wise child than an old and **foolish** king, who will no more be admonished. Ecclesiastes 4:13

Keep your foot when you go to the house of God, and be more ready to hear, than to give the sacrifice of **fools**: for they consider not that they do evil. Ecclesiastes 5:1

For a dream comes through the multitude of business; and a **fool's** voice is known by the multitude of words. Ecclesiastes 5:3

When thou vow a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for he has no pleasure in **fools**: pay that which you have vowed. Ecclesiastes 5:4

For what has the wise more than the **fool**? What has the poor, that knows to walk before the living? Ecclesiastes 6:8

The heart of the wise is in the house of mourning; but the heart of **fools** is in the house of mirth. Ecclesiastes 7:4

It is better to hear the rebuke of the wise, than for a man to hear the song of **fools**. Ecclesiastes 7:5

For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so is the laughter of the **fool**... this also is vanity. Ecclesiastes 7:6

Be not hasty in your spirit to be angry: for anger rests in the bosom of **fools**. Ecclesiastes 7:9

Be not over much wicked, neither be you **foolish**: why should you die before your time? Ecclesiastes 7:17

I applied mine heart to know, and to search, and to seek out wisdom, and the reason of things, and to know the wickedness of **folly**, even of **foolishness** and madness... Ecclesiastes 7:25

The words of wise men are heard in quiet more than the cry of him that rules among **fools**. Ecclesiastes 9:17

Dead flies cause the ointment of the apothecary to send forth a stinking savor: so does a little **folly** him that is in reputation for wisdom and honor. Ecclesiastes 10:1

A wise man's heart is at his right hand; but a **fool's** heart at his left. Yes also, when he that is a **fool** walks by the way, his wisdom fails him, and he says to every one that he is a **fool**. Ecclesiastes 10:2

The words of a wise man's mouth are gracious; but the lips of a **fool** will swallow up himself. Ecclesiastes 10:12

The beginning of the words of his mouth is **foolishness**: and the end of his talk is mischievous madness. Ecclesiastes 10:13

A **fool** also is full of words: a man cannot tell what shall be; and what shall be after him, who can tell him? The labor of the **foolish** wearies every one of them, because he knows not how to go to the city. Ecclesiastes 10:14-15

Folly is set in great dignity, and the rich sit in low place. Ecclesiastes 10:6

Therefore the Lord shall have no joy in their young men, neither shall have mercy on their fatherless and widows: for every one is an hypocrite and an evildoer, and every mouth speaks **folly**. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still. Isaiah 9:17

In that day you shall say, O LORD, I will praise you: though you were angry with me, your anger is turned away, and you comforted me. Isaiah 12:1

Surely the princes of Zoan are **fools**, the counsel of the wise counselors of Pharaoh is become brutish: how say you unto Pharaoh, I am the son of the wise, the son of ancient kings? Where are they? where are your wise men? and let them tell me now, and let them know what the LORD of hosts has purposed upon Egypt. The princes of Zoan are become **fools**, the princes of Noph are deceived... Isaiah 19:11-13

And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called, The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it shall be for those: the wayfaring men, though **fools**, shall not err therein. Isaiah 35:8

Thus says the LORD, your redeemer, and he that formed you from the womb, I am the LORD that makes all things; that stretches forth the heavens alone; that spreads abroad the earth by myself; That frustrates the tokens of the liars, and makes diviners mad; that turns wise men backward, and makes their knowledge **foolish**... Isaiah 44:24-25

For my people is **foolish**, they have not known me; they are sottish children, and they have none understanding: they are wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge. Jeremiah 4:22

Therefore I said, Surely these are poor; they are **foolish**: for they know not the way of the LORD, nor the judgment of their God. Jeremiah 5:4

Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not... They are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock is a doctrine of vanities. Jeremiah 5:21, 10:8

As the partridge sits on eggs, and hatches them not; so he that gets riches, and not by right, shall leave them in the midst of his days, and at his end shall be a **fool**. Jeremiah 17:11

I have seen **folly** in the prophets of Samaria; they prophesied in Baal, and caused my people Israel to err. Jeremiah 23:13

Thy prophets have seen vain and **foolish** things for you: and they have not discovered your iniquity, to turn away your captivity; but have seen for you false burdens and causes of banishment. Lamentations 2:14

Thus says the Lord GOD; Woe unto the **foolish** prophets, that follow their own spirit, and have seen nothing! Ezekiel 13:3

The days of visitation are come, the days of recompense are come; Israel shall know it: the prophet is a **fool**, the spiritual man is mad, for the multitude of your iniquity, and the great hatred. Hosea 9:7

And the LORD said unto me, take unto you yet the instruments of a **foolish** shepherd. Zechariah 11:15

But I say unto you, that whosoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the judgment: and whosoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whoever shall say, Thou **fool**, shall be in danger of hell fire. Matthew 5:22

You **fools** and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifies the gold? And, Whosoever shall swear by the altar, it is nothing; but whosoever swears by the gift that is upon it, he is guilty. You **fools** and blind: for whether is greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifies the gift? Matthew 23:17-19

And five of them were wise, and five were **foolish**. They that were **foolish** took their lamps, and took no oil with them: And the **foolish** said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. Matthew 25:2-3, 8

For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness... Mark 7:21-22

You **fools**, did not he that made that which is without make that which is within also? Luke 11:40

But God said unto him, You **fool**, this night your soul shall be required of you: then whose shall those things be, which you have provided? Luke 12:20

Then he said unto them, O **fools**, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken. Luke 24:25

Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their **foolish** heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be wise, they became **fools**, and changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and four footed beasts, and creeping things. Romans 1:21-23

An instructor of the **foolish**, a teacher of babes, which has the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law. Romans 2:20

But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by them that are no people, and by a **foolish** nation I will anger you. Romans 10:19

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. for it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after wisdom: 1 Corinthians 1:18-22

We preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; but unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men: and the weakness of God is stronger than men. For you see your calling, brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble, are called: But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise... 1 Corinthians 1:23-27

But the natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are **foolishness** unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 1 Corinthians 2:14

Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seems to be wise in this world, let him become a **fool**, that he may be wise. For the wisdom of this world is **foolishness** with God. For it is written, He takes the wise in their own craftiness. 1 Corinthians 3:18-19

We are **fools** for Christ's sake, but you are wise in Christ; we are weak, but you are strong; you are honorable, but we are despised. 1 Corinthians 4:10

But some man will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they come? You **fool**, that which you sow is not quickened, except it die... 1 Corinthians 15:35-36

Would to God you could bear with me a little in my **folly**: and indeed bear with me. 2 Corinthians 11:1

I say again, Let no man think me a **fool**; if otherwise, yet as a **fool** receive me, that I may boast myself a little. That which I speak, I speak it not after the Lord, but as it were **foolishly**, in this confidence of boasting. Seeing that many glory after the flesh, I will glory also. For you suffer **fools** gladly, seeing you yourselves are wise. For you suffer, if a man bring you into bondage, if a man devour you, if a man take of you, if a man exalt himself, if a man smite you on the face... 2 Corinthians 11:16-20

Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a **fool**) I am more; in labors more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft. 2 Corinthians 11:23

For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a **fool**; for I will say the truth: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he sees me to be, or that he hears of me...I am become a **fool** in glorying; you have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing. 2 Corinthians 12:6, 11

Ofoolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? Galatians 3:1

Are you so **foolish**? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now made perfect in the flesh? Galatians 3:3

But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becomes saints; Neither filthiness, nor **foolish** talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks. Ephesians 5:3-4

See then that you walk circumspectly, not as **fools**, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:15-16

They that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many **foolish** and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. 1 Timothy 6:9

But **foolish** and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes. 2 Timothy 2:23

But they shall proceed no further: for their **folly** shall be manifest unto all men, as theirs also was. 2 Timothy 3:9

For we ourselves also were sometimes **foolish**, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. Titus 3:3

But avoid **foolish** questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain. Titus 3:9

For so is the will of God, that with well doing you may put to silence the ignorance of **foolish** men: As free, and not using your liberty for a cloak of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. 1 Peter 2:15-16

## **GUILE & GUILT**

Abimilech said, What is this you have done unto us? One of the people might lightly have lien with your wife, and you should have brought guiltiness upon us. Genesis 26:10

They said one to another, We are very **guilty** concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us. Genesis 42:21

You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain; for the LORD will not hold him **guiltless** that takes his name in vain. Exodus 20:7

If a man come presumptuously upon his neighbor, to slay him with **guile**; you shall take him from mine altar, that he may die. Exodus 21:14

The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the **guilty**; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:6-7

If the whole congregation of Israel sin through ignorance, and the thing be hid from the eyes of the assembly, and they have done somewhat against any of the commandments of the LORD concerning things which should not be done, and are guilty: When the sin, which they have sinned against it, is known, then the congregation shall offer a young bullock for the sin, and bring him before the tabernacle of the congregation. And the elders of the congregation shall lay their hands upon the head of the bullock before the LORD: and the bullock shall be killed before the LORD. And the priest that is anointed shall bring of the bullocks's blood to the tabernacle of the congregation: and the priest shall dip his finger in some of the blood, and sprinkle it seven times before the LORD, even before the veil. And he shall put some of the blood upon the horns of the altar which is before the LORD, that is in the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall pour out all the blood at the bottom of the altar of the burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And he shall take all his fat from him, and burn it upon the altar. And he shall do with the bullock as he did with the bullock for a sin offering, so shall he do with this: and the priest shall make an atonement for them, and it shall be forgiven them. Leviticus 4:13-20

If a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and is a witness, whether he has seen or known of it; if he do not utter it, then he shall bear his iniquity. Or if a soul touch any unclean thing, whether it be a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and if it be hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty. Or if he touch the uncleanness of man, whatever uncleanness it be that a man shall be defiled withal, and it be hid from him; when he knows of it, then he shall be guilty. Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with his lips to do evil, or to do good, whatever it be that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knows of it, then he shall be guilty in one of these. And it shall be, when he shall be guilty in one of these things, that he shall confess that he has sinned in that thing: And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD for his sin which he has sinned, a female from the flock, a lamb or a kid of the goats, for a sin offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his sin...And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD: though he know it not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his iniquity. Leviticus 5:1-6, 17

Then it shall be, because he has sinned, and is **guilty**, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he has deceitfully gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found. Leviticus 6:4

The LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to do a trespass against the LORD, and that person be **guilty**; Then they shall confess their sin which they have done; and he shall recompense his trespass with the principal thereof, and add unto it the fifth part thereof, and give it unto him against whom he has trespassed. But if the man have no kinsman to recompense the trespass unto, let the trespass be recompensed unto the LORD, even to the priest; beside the ram of the atonement, whereby an atonement shall be made for him. Numbers 5:5-7

This is the law of jealousies, when a wife goes aside to another... When the spirit of jealousy comes upon him, and he be jealous over his wife, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all the law, Then shall the man be **guiltless** from iniquity, and this woman shall bear her iniquity. Numbers 5:29-31

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the **guilty**, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Numbers 14:18

Moses said unto them, If you will do this thing, if you will go armed before the LORD to war, and will go all of you armed over Jordan before the LORD, until he has driven out his enemies from before him, and the land be subdued before the LORD: then afterward you shall return, and be guiltless before the LORD, and before Israel; and this land shall be your possession before the LORD. But if you will not do so, behold, you have sinned against the LORD: and be sure your sin will find you out. Numbers 32:20-23

If the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled; And the revenger of blood find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of blood kill the slayer; he shall not be **guilty** of blood: Because he should have remained in the city of his refuge until the death of the high priest: but after the death of the high priest the slayer shall return into the land of his possession. Numbers 35:26-28

Moreover you shall take no satisfaction for the life of a murderer, which is **guilty** of death: but he shall be surely put to death. Numbers 35:31

You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain: for the LORD will not hold him **guiltless** that takes his name in vain. Deuteronomy 5:11

Your eye shall not pity him, but you shall put away the **guilt** of innocent blood from Israel, that it may go well with thee. Deuteronomy 19:13

They shall answer and say...Be merciful, O LORD, unto your people... And the blood shall be forgiven them...So shall you put away the **guilt** of innocent blood from among you, when you shall do that which is right in the sight of the LORD. Deuteronomy 21:7-9

When we come into the land, you shall bind this line of scarlet thread in the window...It shall be, that whoever shall go out of the doors of your house into your street, his blood shall be upon his head, and we will be guiltless: and whosoever shall be with you in the house, his blood shall be on our head, if any hand be upon him. Joshua 2:18-19

It shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be favorable unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for you did not give unto them at this time, that you should be **guilty**. Judges 21:22

David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be **guiltless**? 1 Samuel 26:9

Afterward when David heard it, he said, I and my kingdom are **guiltless** before the LORD for ever from the blood of Abner the son of Ner... 2 Samuel 3:28

The woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the iniquity be on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his throne be guiltless. 2 Samuel 14:9

Now therefore hold him not **guiltless**: for you are a wise man, and know what you ought to do unto him; but his hoar head bring down to the grave with blood. 1 Kings 2:9

They gave their hands that they would put away their wives; and being guilty, they offered a ram of the flock for their trespass. Ezra 10:19

Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputes not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no **guile**. Psalm 32:2 (guile= deceitful cunning)

Keep your tongue from evil, and your lips from speaking guile. Psalm 34:13

Wickedness is in the midst thereof: deceit and **guilt** depart not from her streets. Psalm 55:11

Accuse not a servant unto his master, lest he curse thee, and you be found guilty. Proverbs 30:10

You are become **guilty** in your blood that you have shed; and have defiled yourself in your idols which you have made; and you have caused thy days to draw near, and are come even unto your years: therefore have I made you a reproach unto the heathen, and a mocking to all countries. Ezekiel 22:4

Feed the flock of the slaughter; Whose possessors slay them, and hold themselves not **guilty**: and they that sell them say, Blessed be the LORD; for I am rich: and their own shepherds pity them not. Zechariah 11:4-5

If you had known what this means, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, you would not have condemned the **guiltless**. Matthew 12:7

Woe unto you, you blind guides, which say, Whoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor! You fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifies the gold? And, Whosoever shall swear by the altar, it is nothing; but whoever swears by the gift that is upon it, he is **guilty**. You fools and blind: for whether is greater, the gift, or the altar that sanctifies the gift? Matthew 23:16-19

The high priest arose, and said unto him, Answer you nothing? What is it which these witness against you? But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure you by the living God, that you tell us whether you be the Christ, the Son of God. Jesus said unto him, You have said: nevertheless I say unto you, hereafter shall you see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven. Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He has spoken blasphemy; what further, need have we of witnesses? Behold, now you have heard his blasphemy. What think you? They answered and said, he is guilty of death. Matthew 26:62-66

You have heard the blasphemy: what think you? And they all condemned him to be **guilty** of death. Mark 14:64

Jesus saw Nathanael coming to him, and said of him, Behold an Israelite indeed, in whom is no **guile**! John 1:47

Now we know that what things soever the law said, it says to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all they may become **guilty** before God. Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall be no flesh be justified in his sight; for by the law is the knowledge of sin. Romans 3:19-20

For as often as you eat this bread, and drink this cup, you do show the Lord's death till he come. Wherefore whoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be **guilty** of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eats and drinks unworthily eats and drinks damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. 1 Corinthians 11:27

I will very gladly spend and be spent for you; though the more abundantly I love you, the less I be loved. But be it so, I did not burden you: nevertheless, being crafty, I caught you with guile. 2 Corinthians 12:15-16

For our exhortation was not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in **guile**: But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which tries our hearts. For neither at any time used we flattering words, as you know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God is witness: Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor yet of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ. But we were gentle among you, even as a nurse cherishes her children. 1 Thessalonians 2:3-7

If you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is **guilty** of all. James 2:9-10

Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all **guile**, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, as newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that you may grow thereby: If so be you have tasted that the Lord is gracious. 1 Peter 2:1-3

For even hereunto were you called: Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judges righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripe you were healed. For you were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls. 1 Peter 2:21-25

For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no **guile**: For the eyes of the LORD are over the righteous, and his ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the LORD is against them that do evil. 1 Peter 3:10-12

These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goes. These were redeemed from among men, being the first fruits unto God and to the Lamb. And in their mouth was found no **guile**: for they are without fault before the throne of God. Revelation 14:4-5

## HATRED

And they blessed Rebekah, and said to her, You are our sister, be you the mother of thousands of millions, and let your seed possess the gate of those which **hate** them. Genesis 24:60

And Isaac said to them, Why come you to me, seeing you hate me, and have sent me away from you? Genesis 26:27

And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing with which his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob. Genesis 27:41

And when the LORD saw that Leah was **hated**, he opened her womb: but Rachel was barren...And she conceived again, and bore a son; and said, Because the LORD has heard I was **hated**, he has therefore given me this son also: and she called his name Simeon. Genesis 29:31, 33

And when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they hated him, and could not speak peaceably to him. And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told it his brothers: and they hated him yet the more...And his brothers said to him, Shall you indeed reign over us? or shall you indeed have dominion over us? And they hated him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. Genesis 37:4-5, 8

The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and hated him: Genesis 49:23

And when Joseph's brothers saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure **hate** us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did to him. Genesis 50:15

You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation of them that **hate** me; And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Exodus 20:5-6

If you see the ass of him that **hates** you lying under his burden, and would forbear to help him, you shall surely help with him. Exodus 23:5

You shall not **hate** your brother in your heart: you shall in any wise rebuke your neighbor, and not suffer sin on him. Leviticus 19:17

And I will set my face against you, and you shall be slain before your enemies: they that **hate** you shall reign over you; and you shall flee when none pursues you. Leviticus 26:17

And it came to pass, when the ark set forward, that Moses said, Rise up, LORD, and let your enemies be scattered; and let them that **hate** you flee before you. Numbers 10:35

And you murmured in your tents, and said, Because the LORD **hated** us, he has brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us. Deuteronomy 1:27

That the slayer might flee thither, which should kill his neighbor unawares, and **hated** him not in times past; and that fleeing to one of these cities he might live... Deuteronomy 4:42

You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation of them that **hate** me, And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me and keep my commandments. Deuteronomy 5:9-10

The LORD your God, he is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations; And repays them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hates him, he will repay him to his face...And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which you know, on you; but will lay them on all them that hate you. Deuteronomy 7:9-10, 15

Lest the land from where you brought us out say, Because the LORD was not able to bring them into the land which he promised them, and because he **hated** them, he has brought them out to slay them in the wilderness. Deuteronomy 9:28

You shall not do so to the LORD your God: for every abomination to the LORD, which he **hates**, have they done to their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods. Deuteronomy 12:31

Neither shall you set you up any image; which the LORD your God **hates**. Deuteronomy 16:22

And this is the case of the slayer, which shall flee thither, that he may live: Whoever kills his neighbor ignorantly, whom he **hated** not in time past... he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live... Deuteronomy 19:4-5

Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he was not worthy of death, inasmuch as he hated him not in time past...But if any man hate his neighbor, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally that he die, and flees into one of these cities... Deuteronomy 19:6, 11

If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another hated, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the hated; and if the firstborn son be hers that was hated: Then it shall be, when he makes his sons to inherit that which he has, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the hated, which is indeed the firstborn: But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated for the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he has: for he is the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn is his. Deuteronomy 21:15-17

If any man take a wife, and go in to her, and hate her...And the damsel's father shall say to the elders, I gave my daughter to this man to wife, and he hates her... Deuteronomy 22:13, 16

And if the latter husband **hate** her, and write her a bill of divorce, and gives it in her hand, and sends her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her to be his wife... Deuteronomy 24:3

And the LORD your God will put all these curses on your enemies, and on them that **hate** you, which persecuted you. Deuteronomy 30:7

If I whet my glittering sword, and my hand take hold on judgment; I will render vengeance to my enemies, and will reward them that **hate** me. Deuteronomy 32:41

Bless, LORD, his substance, and accept the work of his hands; smite through the loins of them that rise against him, and of them that hate him, that they rise not again. Deuteronomy 33:11

And if the avenger of blood pursue after him, then they shall not deliver the slayer up into his hand; because he smote his neighbor unwittingly, and **hated** him not beforetime. Joshua 20:5 And Jephthah said to the elders of Gilead, Did not you **hate** me, and expel me out of my father's house? and why are you come to me now when you are in distress? Judges 11:7

And Samson's wife wept before him, and said, You do but **hate** me, and love me not: you have put forth a riddle to the children of my people, and have not told it me. And he said to her, Behold, I have not told it my father nor my mother, and shall I tell it you? Judges 14:16

And her father said, I truly thought that you had utterly **hated** her; therefore I gave her to your companion: is not her younger sister fairer than she? take her, I pray you, instead of her. Judges 15:2

David said on that day, Whoever gets up to the gutter, and smites the Jebusites, and the lame and the blind that are **hated** of David's soul, he shall be chief and captain. Wherefore they said, The blind and the lame shall not come into the house. 2 Samuel 5:8

Then Amnon hated her exceedingly; so that the **hatred** with which he **hated** her was greater than the love with which he had loved her. And Amnon said to her, Arise, be gone. 2 Samuel 13:15

Absalom spoke to his brother Amnon neither good nor bad: for Absalom hated Amnon, because he had forced his sister Tamar. 2 Samuel 13:22

You have shamed this day the faces of all your servants, which this day have saved your life, and the lives of your sons and of your daughters, and the lives of your wives... In that you love your enemies, and hate your friends. For you have declared this day, that you regard neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased you well. 2 Samuel 19:5-6

He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them that **hated** me: for they were too strong for me. 2 Samuel 22:18

You have also given me the necks of my enemies, that I might destroy them that hate me. 2 Samuel 22:41

And the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, There is yet one man, by whom we may inquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he never prophesied good to me, but always evil: the same is Micaiah the son of Imla. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so. 2 Chronicles 18:7

And Jehu the son of Hanani the seer went out to meet him, and said to king Jehoshaphat, Should you help the ungodly, and love them that **hate** the LORD? therefore is wrath on you from before the LORD. 2. Chronicles 19:2

Now in the twelfth month, Adar, on the thirteenth day, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews hoped to have power over them, (though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that **hated** them;) ... Thus the Jews smote all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, and slaughter, and destruction, and did what they would to those that **hated** them. Esther 9:1, 5

They that **hate** you shall be clothed with shame; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nothing. Job 8:22

He tears me in his wrath, who **hates** me: he gnashes on me with his teeth; my enemy sharpens his eyes on me. Job 16:9

If I rejoice at the destruction of him that **hated** me, or lifted up myself when evil found him: Neither have I suffered my mouth to sin by wishing a curse to his soul. Job 31:29-30

Shall even he that **hates** right govern? and will you condemn him that is most just? Job 34:17

The foolish shall not stand in your sight: you **hate** all workers of iniquity. Psalm 5:5

Have mercy on me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that **hate** me, you that lift me up from the gates of death... Psalm 9:13

The LORD tries the righteous: but the wicked and him that loves violence his soul **hates**. Psalm 11:5

He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which **hated** me: for they were too strong for me. Psalm 18:17

You have also given me the necks of my enemies; that I might destroy them that **hate** me. Psalm 18:40

Your hand shall find out all your enemies: your right hand shall find out those that **hate** you. Psalm 21:8

Consider my enemies; for they are many; and they **hate** me with cruel hatred. Psalm 25:19

I have **hated** the congregation of evil doers; and will not sit with the wicked. Psalm 26:5

I have **hated** them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD. Psalm 31:6

Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that **hate** the righteous shall be desolate. Psalm 34:21

Let not them that are my enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: neither let them wink with the eye that **hate** me without a cause. Psalm 35:19

For he flatters himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be hateful. Psalm 36:2

But my enemies are lively, and they are strong: and they that **hate** me wrongfully are multiplied. Psalm 38:19

All that **hate** me whisper together against me: against me do they devise my hurt. Psalm 41:7

But you have saved us from our enemies, and have put them to shame that **hated** us. Psalm 44:7

You make us to turn back from the enemy: and they which **hate** us spoil for themselves. Psalm 44:10

You love righteousness, and **hate** wickedness: therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Psalm 45:7

But unto the wicked God says, what have you to do to declare my statutes, or that you should take my covenant in you mouth? Seeing you hate instruction, and cast my words behind you. Psalm 50:17

Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast iniquity on me, and in wrath they hate me. Psalm 55:3

For it was not an enemy that reproached me; then I could have borne it: neither was it he that **hated** me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him: But it was you, a man mine equal, my guide, and mine acquaintance... Psalm 55:12-13

Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that **hate** him flee before him. Psalm 68:1

They that **hate** me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head: they that would destroy me, being my enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored that which I took not away. Psalm 69:4

Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that **hate** me, and out of the deep waters. Psalm 69:14

The **haters** of the LORD should have submitted themselves to him: but their time should have endured for ever. Psalm 81:15

For, see, your enemies make a tumult: and they that **hate** you have lifted up the head. Psalm 83:2

Show me a token for good; that they which **hate** me may see it, and be ashamed: because you, LORD, have helped me, and comforted me. Psalm 86:17

And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that **hate** him. Psalm 89:23

You that love the LORD, **hate** evil: he preserves the souls of his saints; he delivers them out of the hand of the wicked. Psalm 97:10

I will set no wicked thing before my eyes: I **hate** the work of them that turn aside; it shall not stick to me. Psalm 101:3

He turned their heart to **hate** his people, to deal subtly with his servants. Psalm 105:25

And he saved them from the hand of him that **hated** them, and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. Psalm 106:10

And he gave them into the hand of the heathen; and they that **hated** them ruled over them. Psalm 106:41

The LORD takes my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire on them that **hate** me. Psalm 118:7

Through your precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way. Psalm 119:104

Ihate vain thoughts: but your law do Ilove. Psalm 119:113

I love your commandments above gold... Therefore I esteem all your precepts concerning all things to be right; and I hate every false way... I hate and abhorlying: but your law do I love. Psalm 119:127-128, 163

My soul has long dwelled with him that hates peace. Psalm 120:6

Let them all be confounded and turned back that **hate** Zion. Psalm 129:5

Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate you? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against you? I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them my enemies. Psalm 139:21-22

How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools **hate** knowledge? Proverbs 1:22

For that they **hated** knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD: Proverbs 1:29

And say, How have I **hated** instruction, and my heart despised reproof... *Proverbs* 5:12

These six things does the LORD hate: yes, seven are an abomination to him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, An heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19

Receive my instruction, and not silver; and knowledge rather than choice gold. For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it... The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogance, and the evil way, and the fraudulent mouth, do I hate. Proverbs 8:13

But he that sins against me wrongs his own soul: all they that **hate** me love death. Proverbs 8:36

Reprove not a scorner, lest he **hate** you: rebuke a wise man, and he will love you. Proverbs 9:8

He that is surety for a stranger shall smart for it: and he that **hates** indebtedness is sure. Proverbs 11:15

Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge: but he that **hates** reproof is brutish. Proverbs 12:1

A righteous man hates lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and comes to shame. Proverbs 13:5

He that spares his rod **hates** his son: but he that loves him chastens him betimes. Proverbs 13:24

He that is soon angry deals foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated. Proverbs 14:17

The poor is **hated** even of his own neighbor: but the rich has many friends. Proverbs 14:20

Correction is grievous to him that forsakes the way: and he that hates reproof shall die. Proverbs 15:10

He that is greedy of gain troubles his own house; but he that **hates** gifts shall live. Proverbs 15:27

All the brothers of the poor do hate him: how much more do his friends go far from him? he pursues them with words, yet they are wanting to him. Proverbs 19:7

Withdraw your foot from your neighbor's house; lest he be weary of you, and so hate you. Proverbs 25:17

He that **hates** dissembles with his lips, and lays up deceit within him; Proverbs 26:24

A lying tongue **hates** those that are afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth works ruin. Proverbs 26:28

The prince that wants understanding is also a great oppressor: but he that hates covetousness shall prolong his days. Proverbs 28:16

The bloodthirsty hate the upright: but the just seek his soul. Proverbs 29:10

Whoever is partner with a thief **hates** his own soul: he hears cursing, and betrayeth it not. Proverbs 29:24

Therefore I hated life; because the work that is worked under the sun is grievous to me: for all is vanity and vexation of spirit. Yes, I hated all my labor which I had taken under the sun: because I should leave it to the man that shall be after me. Ecclesiastes 2:17-18

A time to love, and a time to **hate**; a time of war, and a time of peace. Ecclesiastes 3:8

Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul **hates**: they are a trouble to me; I am weary to bear them. Isaiah 1:14

Whereas you has been forsaken and **hated**, so that no man went through you, I will make you an eternal excellency, a joy of many generations. Isaiah 60:15

For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. Isaiah 61:8

Hear the word of the LORD, you that tremble at his word; Your brothers that **hated** you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed. Isaiah 66:5

My heritage is to me as a lion in the forest; it cries out against me: therefore have I hated it. Jeremiah 12:8

However, I sent to you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending them, saying, Oh, do not this abominable thing that I hate. Jeremiah 44:4

Behold, therefore I have stretched out my hand over you, and have diminished your ordinary food, and delivered you to the will of them that hate you, the daughters of the Philistines, which are ashamed of your lewd way...Behold, therefore I will gather all your lovers, with whom you have taken pleasure, and all them that you have loved, with all them that you have hated; I will even gather them round about against you, and will discover your nakedness to them, that they may see all your nakedness. Ezekiel 16:27, 37

For thus said the Lord GOD; Behold, I will deliver you into the hand of them whom you hate, into the hand of them from whom your mind is alienated. And they shall deal with you hatefully, and shall take away all your labor, and shall leave you naked and bare: and the nakedness of your prostitutions shall be discovered, both your lewdness and your prostitutions. Ezekiel 23:28-29

Therefore, as I live, says the Lord GOD, I will prepare you unto blood, and blood shall pursue thee: sith you have not **hated** blood, even blood shall pursue thee. Ezekiel 35:6

All their wickedness is in Gilgal: for there I hated them: for the wickedness of their doings I will drive them out of mine house, I will love them no more: all their princes are revolters. Hosea 9:15

I hated Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness. Malachi 1:3

Then Daniel, whose name was Belteshazzar, was astonied for one hour, and his thoughts troubled him. The king spake, and said, Belteshazzar, let not the dream, or the interpretation thereof, trouble thee. Belteshazar answered and said, My lord, the dream be to them that **hate** thee, and the interpretation thereof to thine enemies. Daniel 4:19

They hate him that rebuketh in the gate, and they abhor him that speaketh uprightly... Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph. Amos 5:10, 15

I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies. Amos 5:21

The Lord GOD has sworn by himself, saith the LORD the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and hate his palaces: therefore will Ideliver up the city with all that is therein. Amos 6:8

Isaid, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and you princes of the house of Israel; Is it not for you to know judgment? Who hate the good, and love the evil; who pluck off their skin from off them, and their flesh from off their bones; Micah 3:1-2

Let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbor; and love no false oath: for all these are things that I hate, says the LORD. Zechariah 8:17

For the LORD, the God of Israel, says that he **hates** putting away: for one cover violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously. Malachi 2:16

## ABOUT HATRED IN NEW COVENANT

You have heard that it has been said, You shall love your neighbor, and hate your enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you... Matthew 5:43-44

No man can serve two masters: for either he will **hate** the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Matthew 6:24

You shall be **hated** of all men for my name's sake: but he that endures to the end shall be saved. Matthew 10:22

Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and you shall be **hated** of all nations for my name's sake. Matthew 24:9

You shall be **hated** of all men for my name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. Mark 13:13

Blessed are you, when men shall **hate** you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake...But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which **hate** you, bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you. Luke 6:22, 27-28

If any man come to me, and **hate** not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple. Luke 14:26

But his citizens **hated** him, and sent a message after him, saying, We will not have this man to reign over us. Luke 19:14

And you shall be **hated** of all men for my name's sake. Luke 21:17

For every one that does evil **hates** the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. John 3:20

The world cannot **hate** you; but me it **hates**, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil. John 7:7

He that loves his live shall lose it; and he that **hates** his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal. John 12:25

If the world hate you, you know that it hated me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would love his own: but because you are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hate you. Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also. But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me. If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloak for their sin. He that hates me hates my Father also. If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father. But this comes to pass, that the world might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause. John 15:18-25

I have given them your word; and the world has **hated** them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. John 17:14

Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, covenant-breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:29-32

For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I hate, that do I. Romans 7:15

As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated. Romans 9:13

For no man ever yet **hated** his own flesh; but nourishes and cherishes it, even as the Lord the church... Ephesians 5:29

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasure, living in malice and envy, **hateful**, and **hating** one another. Titus 3:3

You have loved righteousness, and **hated** iniquity; therefore God, even your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above you fellows. Hebrews 1:9

He that says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness even until now. He that loves his brother abides in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. But he that hates his brother is in darkness, and walks in darkness, and knows not whither he goes, because that darkness has blinded his eyes. 1 John 2:9-11

Marvel not, my brethren, if the world **hate** you. We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. He that loves not his brother abides in death. Whosoever **hates** his brother is a murderer: and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. 1 John 3:13-15

If a man say, I love God, and **hates** his brother, he is a liar: for he that loves not his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not see? 1 John 4:20

But this you have, that you hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate...So have you also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. Revelation 2:6, 15

He cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great, is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and **hateful** bird. Revelation 18:2

#### OFFENCES

You shall not bring in the captives hither: for whereas we have **offended** against the LORD already, you intend to add more to our sins and to our trespass: for our trespass is great, and there is fierce wrath against Israel. 2 Chronicles 28:13

Great peace have they which love your law; and nothing shall offend them. Psalm 119:165

A brother **offended** is harder to be won than a strong city: and their contentions are like the bars of a castle. Proverbs 18:19

If the spirit of the ruler rise up against you, leave not you place; for yielding pacifies great offences. Ecclesiastes 10:4

He shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and a rock of **offence** to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Isaiah 8:14

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for iniquity are cut off: That make a man an **offender** for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproves in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought. Isaiah 29:20-21

I will go and return to my place, till they acknowledge their **offence**, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early. Hosea 5:15

He that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that hears the word, and anon with joy receives it; yet has he not root in himself, but dures for a while: for when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, by and by he is **offended**. Matthew 13:20-21

The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that **offend**, and them which do iniquity; and shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. Matthew 13:41

They were **offended** in him. But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honor, save in his own country, and in his own house. Mt 13:57

He turned, and said unto Peter, Get you behind me, Satan: you are an **offence** unto me: for you savorest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men. Matthew 16:23

Then shall many be **offended**, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another. Matthew 24:10

Jesus said unto them, All you shall be **offended** because of me this night; for it is written, I will smite the shepherd, and the sheep shall be scattered. But Peter said unto him, although all shall be **offended**, yet will not I. Mark 14:27, 29

Blessed is he, whosoever shall not be **offended** in me. Luke 7:23

It is impossible but that **offences** will come; but woe unto him, through whom they come! It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should **offend** one of these little ones. Luke 17:1-2

These things have I spoken unto you, that you should not be **offended**. John 16:1

I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of **offence** toward God, and toward men. Acts 24:16

Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him, but for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; who was delivered for our **offences**, and was raised again for our justification. Romans 4:23-25

For if by one man's **offence** death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ...Moreover the law entered, that the **offence** might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound... Romans 5:17-20

But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone; As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of **offence**: and whosoever believes on him shall not be ashamed. Romans 9:31-33

For meat destroy not the works of God. All things indeed are pure; but it is evil for that man who eats with **offence**. It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby thy brother stumbleth, or is **offended**, or is made weak. Romans 14:20-21

Mark them which cause divisions and **offences** contrary to the doctrine which you have learned; and avoid them. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple. Romans 16:17

If meat make my brother to **offend**, I will eat no flesh while the world stands, lest I make my brother to **offend**. 1 Corinthians 8:13

Give none **offence**, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God: Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved. 2 Corinthians 10:32-33

Giving no **offence** in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed: but in all things approving ourselves as ministers of God... 2 Corinthians 6:3-4

Have I committed an **offence** in abasing myself that you might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?... Who is weak, and I am not weak? Who is **offended**, and I burn not? 2 Corinthians 11:7, 29

I, brethren, if I yet preach circumcision, why do I yet suffer persecution? Then is the **offence** of the cross ceased...For brethren, you have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; You shall love your neighbor as thyself. Galatians 5:11, 13-14

I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; that you may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without **offence** till the day of Christ. Philippians 1:9-10

Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet **offend** in one point, he is guilt of all...In many things we **offend** all. If any man **offend** not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body. James 2:10, 3:2

Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, and a stone of stumbling, and a rock of **offence**, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. But you are a chosen generation... 1 Peter 2:7-9

# **SHAME**

They were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed. Genesis 2:25

Judah said, Let her take it to her, lest we be **shamed**: behold, I sent this kid, and you have not found her. And it came to pass about three months after, that it was told Judah, saying, Tamar your daughter in law has played the harlot; and also, behold, she is with child by whoredom. And Judah said, Bring her forth, and let her be burnt. When she was brought forth, she sent to her father in law, saying, by the man, whose these are, am I with child...And Judah acknowledged them, and said, She hath been more righteous than I...And he knew her again no more. Genesis 38:23-26

When Moses saw that the people were naked; (for Aaron had made them naked unto their **shame** among their enemies:) Then Moses stood in the gate of the camp, and said, Who is on the LORD'S side? Let him come unto me. And all the sons of Levi gathered themselves... Exodus 32:25-26

They tarried till they were **ashamed**: and, behold, he opened not the doors of the parlor; therefore they took a key, and opened them: and, behold, their lord was fallen down dead on the earth. Judges 3:25

Then the five men departed, and came to Laish, and saw the people that were therein, how they dwelt careless, after the manner of the Zidonians, quiet and secure; and there was no magistrate in the land, that might put them to **shame** in any thing; and they were far from the Zidonians, and had no business with any man. Judges 18:7

So Jonathan arose from the table in fierce anger, and did eat no meat the second day of the month: for he was grieved for David, because his father had done him **shame**. 1 Samuel 20:34

Then David sent home to Tamar, saying, Go now to thy brother Amnon's house, and dress him meat. So Tamar went to her brother Amnon's house; and he was laid down...and said unto her, Come lie with me, my sister. And she answered him, Nay, my brother, do not force me... And I, whither shall I cause my **shame** to go? And as for thee, you shall be as one of the fools in Israel. Now therefore, I pray you, speak unto the king; for he will not withhold me from thee. Howbeit he would not hearken unto her voice: but, being stronger than she, forced her, and lay with her. Then Amnon hated her exceedingly... 2 Samuel 13:7-8, 11-14

The people gat them by stealth that day into the city, as people being ashamed steal away when they flee in battle. Joab came into the house of the king, and said, You have shamed this day the faces of all your servants, which this day have saved your life, and the lives of your sons and of your daughters, and the lives of your wives, and the lives of your concubines; In that you love thine enemies, and hate your friends... 2 Samuel 19:3, 5-6

And when they urged him till he was **ashamed**, he said, Send. They sent therefore fifty men; and they sought three days, but found him not. 2 Kings 2:17

Elisha said unto him, Go, say unto him, You may certainly recover: howbeit the LORD has showed me that he shall surely die. And he settled his countenance stedfastly, until he was **ashamed**: and the man of God wept. 2 Kings 8:10-11

There went certain, and told David how the men were served. And he sent to meet them: for the men were **greatly ashamed**. And the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and then return. 1 Chronicles 19:5

The LORD sent an angel, which cut off all the mighty men of valor, and the leaders and captains in the camp of the king of Assyria. So he returned with **shame** of face to his own land. And when he was come into the house of his god, they that came forth of his own bowels slew him there with the sword. 2 Chronicles 32:21

For I was **ashamed** to require of the king a band of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy in the way: because we had spoken unto the king, saying, The hand of our God is upon all them for good that seek him; but his power and his wrath is against all them that forsake him. Ezra 8:22

O my God, I am **ashamed** and blush to lift up my face to thee, my God: for our iniquities are increased over our head, and our trespass is grown up unto the heavens. Ezra 9:6

They that hate you shall be clothed with **shame**; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nought. Job 8:22

Ten times have you reproached me: you are not **ashamed** that you make yourselves strange to me. Job 19:3

O you sons of men, how long will you turn my glory into **shame**? How long will you love vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah. Psalm 4:2

Let all mine enemies be **ashamed** and sore vexed: let them return and be **ashamed** suddenly. Psalm 6:10

You have **shamed** the counsel of the poor, because the LORD is his refuge. Psalm 14:6

O my God, I trust in thee: let me not be **ashamed**, Let not mine enemies triumph over me. Yes, let none that wait on you be **ashamed**: let them be **ashamed** which transgress without cause... O keep my soul, and deliver me: let me not be **ashamed**; for I put my trust in thee. Psalm 25:2-3, 20

In you, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be **ashamed**: deliver me in you righteousness. Psalm 31:1

Let me not be **ashamed**, O LORD; for I have called upon you: let the wicked be **ashamed**, and let them be silent in the grave. Psalm 31:17

Let them be confounded and put to **shame** that seek after my soul: let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt. They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not **ashamed**... Let them be **ashamed** and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with **shame** and dishonor that magnify themselves against me. Psalm 35:4-5, 26

They shall not be **ashamed** in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. Psalm 37:19

Let them be **ashamed** and confounded together that seek after my soul to destroy it; let them be driven backward and put to **shame** that wish me evil. Let them be desolate for a reward of their **shame** that say unto me, Aha, aha. Psalm 40:14-15

You have saved us from our enemies, and have put them to **shame** that hated us...But you have cast off, and put us to **shame**; and go not forth with our armies...My confusion is continually before me, and the **shame** of my face has covered me...All this is come upon us; yet have we not forgotten you, neither have we dealt falsely in your covenant. Our heart is not turned back, neither have our steps declined from your way... Psalm 44:7, 9, 15, 17-18

Have the workers of iniquity no knowledge? Who eat up my people as they eat bread: They have not called upon God. There were they in great fear, where no fear was: for God has scattered the bones of him that encamps against you: you have put them to **shame**, because God has despised them. Psalm 53:4-5

Let not them that wait on you, O Lord GOD of hosts, be ashamed for my sake: let not those that seek you be confounded for my sake, O God of Israel. Because for your sake I have borne reproach; shame has covered my face... You have known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonor: mine adversaries are all before thee. Psalm 69:6-7, 19

Let them be **ashamed** and confounded that seek after my soul: let them be turned backward, and put to confusion, that desire my hurt. Let them be turned back for a reward of their **shame** that say, Aha, aha. Psalm 70:2-3

My tongue also shall talk of your righteousness all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought unto **shame**, that seek my hurt. Psalm 71:24

O let not the oppressed return **ashamed**: let the poor and needy praise thy name. Psalm 74:21

Fill their faces with **shame**; that they may seek your name, O LORD. Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yes, let them be put to **shame**, and perish... Psalm 83:16-17

Show me a token for good; that they which hate me may see it, and be ashamed: because you, LORD, have helped me, and comforted me. Psalm 86:17

The days of his youth have you shortened: you have covered him with shame. Selah. Psalm 89:45

Let them curse, but bless you: when they arise, let them be **ashamed**; but let your servant rejoice. Let mine adversaries be clothed with **shame**, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle. Psalm 109:29

O that my ways were directed to keep your statutes! Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all your commandments. Psalm 119:6

I have stuck unto your testimonies: O LORD, put me not to **shame**. Psalm 119:31

I will speak of your testimonies also before kings, and will not be ashamed. Psalm 119:46

Let the proud be **ashamed**; for they dealt perversely with me without a cause: but I will meditate in your precepts. Psalm 119:78

Let my heart be sound in your statutes; that I be not ashamed. Psalm 119:80

Uphold me according unto your word, that I may live: and let me not be ashamed of my hope. Psalm 119:116

Happy is the man that has his quiver full of them: they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate. Psalm 127:5

His enemies will I clothe with **shame**: but upon himself shall his crown flourish. Psalm 132:18

The wise shall inherit glory: but **shame** shall be the promotion of fools. Proverbs 3:35

He that reproves a scorner gets to himself **shame**: and he that rebukes a wicked man gets himself a blot. Proverbs 9:7

He that gathers in summer is a wise son: but he that sleeps in harvest is a son that causes **shame**. Proverbs 10:5

When pride comes, then comes **shame**: but with the lowly is wisdom. Proverbs 11:2

A virtuous woman is a crown to her husband: but she that makes ashamed is as rottenness in his bones. Proverbs 12:4

A fool's wrath is presently known: but a prudent man covers **shame**. Proverbs 12:16

A righteous man hates lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and comes to **shame**. Proverbs 13:5

Poverty and **shame** shall be to him that refuses instruction: but he that regards reproof shall be honored. Proverbs 13:18

The king's favor is toward a wise servant: but his wrath is against him that causes **shame**. Proverbs 14:35

A wise servant shall have rule over a son that causes **sham**e, and shall have part of the inheritance among the brethren...He that answers a matter before he hears it, it is folly and **shame** unto him. Proverbs 17:2, 18:13

He that wastes his father, and chases away his mother, is a son that causes **shame**, and brings reproach. Proverbs 19:26

Go not forth hastily to strive, lest you know not what to do in the end thereof, when your neighbor has put you to **shame**. Debate your cause with your neighbor himself; and discover not a secret to another: Lest he that hears it put you to **shame**, and your infamy turn not away. Proverbs 25:8-10

The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself brings his mother to **shame**. Proverbs 29:15

For they shall be **ashamed** of the oaks which you have desired, and you shall be confounded for the gardens that you have chosen. For you shall be as an oak whose leaf fades, and as a garden that has no water. Isaiah 1:29-30

So shall the king of Assyria lead away the Egyptians prisoners, and the Ethiopians captives, young and old, naked and barefoot, even with their buttocks uncovered, to the **shame** of Egypt. And they shall be afraid and **ashamed** of Ethiopia their expectation, and of Egypt their glory. Isaiah 20:4-5

He will surely violently turn and toss you like a ball into a large country: there shall you die, and there the chariots of your glory shall be the **shame** of your lord's house. Isaiah 22:18

Be you **ashamed**, O Zidon: for the sea has spoken, even the strength of the sea, saying, I travail not, nor bring forth children, neither do I nourish up young men, nor bring up virgins. Isaiah 23:4

The earth shall reel to and fro like a drunkard, and shall be removed like a cottage... Then the moon shall be confounded, and the sun **ashamed**, when the LORD of hosts shall reign in mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before his ancients gloriously. Isaiah 24:20, 23

Woe to the rebellious children, says the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin: That walk to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at my mouth... Therefore shall the strength of Pharaoh be your **shame**, and the trust in the shadow of Egypt your confusion...they were all **ashamed** of a people that could not profit them, nor be an help nor profit, but a **shame**, and also a reproach. Isaiah 30:1, 3, 5

The earth mourns and languishes: Lebanon is **ashamed** and hewn down: Sharon is like a wilderness; and Bashan and Carmel shake off their fruits. Isaiah 33:9

Behold, all that were incensed against you shall be **ashamed** and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with you shall perish. Isaiah 41:11

They shall be turned back, they shall be greatly **ashamed**, that trust in graven images, that say to the molten images, You are our gods. Isaiah 42:17

They that make a graven image are all of them vanity; and their delectable things shall not profit; and they are their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be **ashamed**. Who has formed a god, or molten a graven image that is profitable for nothing? Behold, all his fellows shall be **ashamed**: and the workmen, they are of men: let them all be gathered together, let them stand up; yet they shall fear, and they shall be **ashamed** together. Isaiah 44:9-11

They shall be **ashamed**, and also confounded, all of them: they shall go to confusion together that are makers of idols. But Israel shall be saved in the LORD with an everlasting salvation: you shall not be **ashamed** nor confounded world without end... Surely, shall none say, in the LORD have I righteousness and strength: even to him shall men come; and all that are incensed against him shall be **ashamed**. Isaiah 45:16-17, 24

Your nakedness shall be uncovered, yes, your **shame** shall be seen: I will take vengeance, and I will not meet you as a man. Isaiah 47:3

And kings shall be your nursing fathers, and their queens your nursing mothers: they shall bow down to you with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of your feet; and you shall know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be **ashamed** that wait for me. Isaiah 49:23

The Lord GOD has opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back. For the Lord GOD will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be **ashamed**. I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from **shame** and spitting. Isaiah 50:5-7

Fear not; for you shall not be **ashamed**: neither be you confounded; for you shall not be put to **shame**: for you shall forget the **shame** of your youth, and shall not remember the reproach of your widowhood any more. Isaiah 54:4

For your **shame** you shall have double; and for confusion they shall rejoice in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting joy shall be unto them. Isaiah 61:7

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD, Behold my servants shall eat, but you shall be hungry: behold, my servants shall drink, but you shall be thirsty: behold, my servants shall rejoice, but you shall be **ashamed**: Isaiah 65:13

Hear the word of the LORD, you that tremble at his word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be **ashamed**. Isaiah 66:5

As the thief is **ashamed** when he is found, so is the house of Israel **ashamed**; they, their kings, their princes, and their priests, and their prophets, Saying to a stock, You are my father; and to a stone, you have brought me forth... Jeremiah 2:26-27

You have polluted the land with your whoredoms and with your wickedness. Therefore the showers have been withholden, and there has been no latter rain; and you had a whore's forehead, you refused to be ashamed. Jeremiah 3:2-3

For **shame** has devoured the labor of our fathers from our youth; their flocks and their herds, their sons and their daughters. We lie down in our **shame**, and our confusion covers us: for we have sinned against the LORD our God, we and our fathers, from our youth even unto this day, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD our God. Jeremiah 3:24-25

Were they **ashamed** when they had committed abomination? No, they were not at all **ashamed**, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: at the time that I visit them they shall be cast down, says the LORD. Jeremiah 6:15

The wise men are **ashamed**, they are dismayed and taken: lo, they have rejected the word of the LORD; and what wisdom is in them?... Were they **ashamed** when they had committed abomination? No, they were not at all **ashamed**, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: in the time of their visitation they shall be cast down, says the LORD. Jeremiah 8:9, 12

For according to the number of your cities were your gods, O Judah; and according to the number of the streets of Jerusalem have you set up altars to that **shameful** thing, even altars to burn incense unto Baal. Therefore pray not you for this people, neither lift up a cry of prayer for them: for I will not hear them in the time that they cry unto me for their trouble. Jeremiah 11:13-14

They have sown wheat, but shall reap thorns: they have put themselves to pain, but shall not profit: and they shall be **ashamed** of your revenues because of the fierce anger of the LORD. Jeremiah 12:13

Therefore will I discover your skirts upon thy face, that your **shame** may appear. Jeremiah 13:26

Their nobles have sent their little ones to the waters: they came to the pits, and found no water; they returned with their vessels empty; they were **ashamed** and confounded, and covered their heads. Because the ground is chapped, for there was no rain in the earth, the plowmen were **ashamed**, they covered their heads. Jeremiah 14:3-4

She that hath borne seven languishes: she has given up the ghost; her sun is gone down while it was yet day: she has been **ashamed** and confounded: and the residue of them will I deliver to the sword before their enemies, says the LORD. Jeremiah 15:9

O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake you shall be **ashamed**, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters. Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved... Jeremiah 17:13-14

The LORD is with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall stumble, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly **ashamed**, for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall not be forgotten... Wherefore came I forth out of the womb to see labour and sorrow, that my days should be consumed with **shame**? Jeremiah 20:11, 18

The wind shall eat up all your pastors, and your lovers shall go into captivity: surely then shall you be **ashamed** and confounded for all your wickedness. Jeremiah 22:22

I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a perpetual **shame**, which shall not be forgotten. Jeremiah 23:40

Surely after that I was turned, I repented; and after that I was instructed, I smote upon my thigh: I was **ashamed**, yes, even confounded, because I did bear the reproach of my youth. Jeremiah 31:19

The nations have heard of your **shame**, and your cry has filled the land: for the mighty man have stumbled against the mighty, and they are fallen both together. Jeremiah 46:12

Moab shall be **ashamed** of Chemosh, as the house of Israel was ashamed of Beth-el their confidence. They shall howl, saying, How is it broken down? How has Moab turned the back with **shame**? So shall Moab be a derision and a dismaying to all them about him. Jeremiah 48:38-39

Your mother shall be sore confounded; she that bare you shall be **ashamed**: behold, the hindermost of the nations shall be a wilderness, a dry land, and a desert. Jeremiah 50:12

We are confounded, because we have heard reproach: **shame** has covered our faces: for strangers are come into the sanctuaries of the LORD'S house. Jeremiah 51:51

They shall also gird themselves with sackcloth, and horror shall cover them; and **shame** shall be upon all faces, and baldness upon all their heads. Ezekiel 7:18

Behold, therefore I have stretched out my hand over you, and have diminished your ordinary food, and delivered you unto the will of them that hate you, the daughters of the Philistines, which are **ashamed** of **your** lewd way. Ezekiel 16:27

You also, which have judged your sisters, bear your own **shame** for your sins that you have committed more abominable than they: they are more righteous than you: yes, be you confounded also, and bear your **shame**, in that you have justified your sisters. When I shall bring again their captivity, the captivity of Sodom and her daughters, and the captivity of Samaria and her daughters, then will I bring again the captivity of your captives in the midst of them. That thou may bear your own **shame**, and may be confounded in all that you have done, in that you are a comfort unto them. Ezekiel 16:52-54

Then you shall remember your ways, and be **ashamed**, when you shall receive your sisters, your elder and your younger: and I will give them unto your for daughters, but not by your covenant. Ezekiel 16:61

That you may remember, and be confounded, and never open your mouth any more because of your **shame**, when I am pacified toward you for all that you have done, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 16:63

There is Elam and all her multitude round about her grave, all of them slain, fallen by the sword, which are gone down uncircumcised into the nether parts of the earth, which caused their terror in the land of the living; yet have they borne their **shame** with them that go down to the pit. They have set her a bed in the midst of the slain with all her multitude; her graves are round about him: all of them uncircumcised, slain by the sword: though their terror was caused in the land of the living, yet have they borne their **shame** with them that go down to the pit: he is put in the midst of them that be slain... There be the princes of the north, all of them, and all the Zidonians, which are gone down with the slain; with their terror they are **ashamed** of their might; and they lie uncircumcised with them that be slain by the sword, and bear their **shame** with them that go down to the pit. Ezekiel 32:24-25, 30

I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the **shame** of the heathen any more. Ezekiel 34:29

Prophesy...unto the mountains, and to the hills, to the rivers, and to the valleys, Thus says the Lord GOD; Behold I have spoken in my jealousy and in my fury, because you have borne the **shame** of the heathen: Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; I have lifted up mine hand, Surely the heathen that are about you, they shall bear their **shame**...Ezekiel 36:6-7

Neither will I cause men to hear in thee the **shame** of the heathen any more, neither shalt thou bear the reproach of the people any more, saith the Lord GOD...After that they have borne their **shame**, and all their trespasses whereby they have trespassed against me, when they dwelt safely in their land, and none made them afraid. Ezekiel 39:15, 26

Not for your sake do I this, saith the Lord GOD, be it known unto you: be **ashamed** and confounded for your own ways, O house of Israel. Ezekiel 36:32

Thou son of man, shew the house to the house of Israel, that they may be **ashamed** of their iniquities: and let them measure the pattern. And if they be **ashamed** of all that they have done, shew them the form of the house...and all the laws thereof: and write it in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof...and do them. Ezekiel 43:10-11

The Levites that are gone away far from me...Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Israel to fall into iniquity; therefore have I lifted up mine hand against them, saith the Lord GOD, and they shall bear their iniquity. And they shall not come near unto me, to do the office of a priest unto me, nor to come near to any of my holy things, in the most holy place: but they shall bear their **shame**, and their abominations which they have committed...But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, that kept the charge of my sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from me, they shall come near to me to minister unto me, and they shall stand before me to offer unto me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord GOD: They shall enter into my sanctuary, and they shall come near to my table, to minister unto me, and they shall keep my charge. Ezekiel 44:10, 12-13, 15-16

Many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to **shame** and everlasting contempt. And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. Daniel 12:2-3

For their mother has played the harlot: she that conceived them has done **shamefully**; for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give me my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink. Therefore, behold, I will hedge up your way with thorns, and make a wall, that she shall not find her paths. Hosea 2:4-5

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because you have rejected knowledge, I will also reject you, that you shall be no priest to me: seeing you have forgotten the law of your God, I will also forget your children. As they were increased, so they sinned against me: therefore will I change their glory into **shame**. Hosea 4:6-7

Their drink is sour: they have committed whoredom continually: her rulers with **shame** do love, Give you. The wind has bound her up in her wings, and they shall be **ashamed** because of their sacrifices. Hosea 4:18-19 (Sowthewind-reapthewhirlwind)

I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the first ripe in the fig tree at her first time: but they went to Baal-peor, and separated themselves unto that **shame**; and their abominations were according as they loved. Hosea 9:10

It shall be also carried unto Assyria for a present to king Jareb: Ephraim shall receive **shame**, and Israel shall be **ashamed** of his own counsel. ... Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD... Hosea 10:6, 12

Be you **ashamed**, O you husbandmen; howl, O you vinedressers, for the wheat and for the barley; because the harvest of the field is perished. Joel 1:11

You shall eat in plenty, and be satisfied, and praise the name of the LORD your God, that has dealt wonderously with you: and my people shall never be **ashamed**. And you shall know that I am...the LORD your God, and none else; and my people shall never be **ashamed**. Joel 2:26-27

For your violence against your brother Jacob **shame** shall cover you, and you shall be cut off for ever. Obadiah 1:10

Pass you away, you inhabitant of Saphir, having your **shame** naked: the inhabitant of Zaanan came not forth in the mourning of Beth-ezel; he shall receive of you his standing. For the inhabitant of Maroth waited carefully for good: but evil came down from the LORD unto the gate of Jerusalem. Micah 1:11-12

Prophesy you not, say they to them that prophesy: they shall not prophesy to them, that they shall not take **shame**. O you that are named the house of Jacob, is the spirit of the LORD straitened? Are these his doings? Do not my words do good to him that walks uprightly? Micah 2:6-7

Then shall the seers be **ashamed**, and the diviners confounded: yes, they shall all cover their lips; for there is no answer of God. Micah 3:7

Then she that is mine enemy shall see it, and **shame** shall cover her which said unto me, Where is the LORD your God? Mine eyes shall behold her: now shall she be trodden down as the mire of the streets. Micah 7:10

Behold, I am against you, says the LORD of hosts; and I will discover your skirts upon your face, and I will shew the nations your nakedness, and the kingdoms your **shame**. Nahum 3:5

You have consulted **shame** to your house by cutting off many people, and have sinned against your soul... You are filled with **shame** for glory: drink you also, and let your foreskin be uncovered: the cup of the LORD'S right hand shall be turned unto you, and **shameful** spewing shall be on your glory. Habakkuk 2:10, 16

In that day shall you not be **ashamed** for all your doings, wherein you have transgressed against me: for then I will take away out of the midst of you them that rejoice in your pride, and you shall no more be haughty because of my holy mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

The just LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning does he bring his judgment to light, he fails not; but the unjust knows no **shame**...Behold, at that time I will undo all that afflict thee: and I will save her that halts, and gather her that was driven out; and I will get them praise and fame in every land where they have been put to **shame**. Zephaniah 3:19

Ashkelon shall see it, and fear; Gaza also shall see it, and be very sorrowful, and Ekron; for her expectation shall be **ashamed**; and the king shall perish from Gaza, and Ashkelon shall not be inhabited. Zechariah 9:5

It shall come to pass in that day, that the prophets shall be **ashamed** every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to deceive. Zechariah 13:4

At the season he sent to the husbandmen a servant, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the fruit of the vineyard. And they caught him, and beat him, and sent him away empty. And again he sent unto them another servant; and at him they cast stones, and wounded him in the head, and sent him away **shamefully** handled. Mark 12:2-4

Whosoever therefore shall be **ashamed** of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be **ashamed**, when he comes in the glory of his Father with the holy angels. Mark 8:38

For whosoever shall be **ashamed** of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be **ashamed**, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father's and of the holy angels. Luke 9:26

When he had said these things, all his adversaries were **ashamed**: and all the people rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by him. Luke 13:17

When you are bidden of any man to a wedding, sit not down in the highest room; lest a more honorable man than you be bidden of him: And he that bade you and him come and say to you, Give this man place; and you begin with **shame** to take the lowest room. Luke 14:9

The steward said within himself, What shall I do? For my lord takes away from me the stewardship: I cannot dig; to beg I am **ashamed**. Luke 16:3

They departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer **shame** for his name. Acts 5:41

For I am not **ashamed** of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believes; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. Romans 1:16

And hope makes not **ashamed**; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:5

What fruit had you then in those things whereof you are now **ashamed**? For the end of those things is death. Romans 6:21

As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believes on him shall not be **ashamed**. Romans 9:33

For the scripture says, Whoever believes on him shall not be ashamed. Romans 10:11

I write not these things to **shame** you, but as my beloved sons I warn you. For though you have ten thousand instructors in Christ, yet have you not many fathers: for in Christ Jesus I have begotten you through the gospel. Wherefore I beseech you, be you followers of me. 1 Corinthians 4:14-16

I speak to your **shame**. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? No, not one that shall be able to judge between his brethren? But brother goes to law with brother, and that before the unbelievers. 1 Corinthians 6:5

Every woman that prays or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonors her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven. For if the woman be not covered, let her also be shorn: but if it be a **shame** for a woman to be shorn or shaven, let her be covered... 1 Corinthians 11:5-6

Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered? Does not even nature itself teach you, that, if a man have long hair, it is a **shame** unto him? 1 Corinthians 11:13-14

Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under obedience, as also says the law. And if they will learn any thing, let them ask their husbands at home; for it is a **shame** for women to speak in the church. 1 Corinthians 14:34-35

Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: Ispeak this to your **shame**. 1 Corinthians 15:34

For if I have boasted any thing to him of you, I am not **ashamed**; but as we spake all things to you in truth, even so our boasting, which I made before Titus, is found a truth. 2 Corinthians 7:14

Do you look on things after the outward appearance? If any man trust to himself that he is Christ's, let him of himself think this again, that, as he is Christ's even so are we Christ's. For though I should boast somewhat more of our authority, which the Lord has given us for edification, and not for your destruction, I should not be **ashamed**. 2 Corinthians 10:7-8

Have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. For it is a **shame** even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret. Ephesians 5:11-12

According to my earnest expectation and my hope, that in nothing I shall be **ashamed**, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death. Philippians 1:20

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as you have us for an example. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their **shame**, who mind earthly things.) For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. Philippians 3:17-20

For yourselves, brethren, know our entrance in unto you, that it was not in vain: But even after that we had suffered before, and were **shamefully** treated, as you know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention... 1 Thessalonians 2:1-2

If any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be **ashamed**. 2 Thessalonians 3:14

Be not you therefore **ashamed** of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be you a partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God...For the which cause I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not **ashamed**: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. 1 Timothy 1:8, 12

The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not **ashamed** of my chains... 2 Timothy 1:16

Study to shew yourself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be **ashamed**, rightly dividing the word of truth. 2 Timothy 2:15

In all things showing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine showing uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be **ashamed**, having no evil thing to say of you. Titus 2:7-8

For both he that sanctifies and they who are sanctified are all of one: for which cause he is not **ashamed** to call them brethren... Hebrews 2:11

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open **shame**. Hebrews 6:4-6

But now they desire a better country, that is, an heavenly: wherefore God is not **ashamed** to be called their God: for he hath prepared for them a city. Hebrews 11:16

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the **shame**, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be **ashamed** that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ. 1 Peter 3:16

If any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be **ashamed**; but let him glorify God on this behalf. 1 Peter 4:16

Little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be **ashamed** before him at his coming. 1 John 2:28

These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withers, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own **shame**; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever. Jude 1:12-13

I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou may be rich; and white raiment, that thou may be clothed, and that the **shame** of your nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eye salve, that you may see. Revelation 3:18

Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his **shame**. Revelation 16:15

## **STRIFE**

There was a **strife** between the herdmen of Abram's cattle and the herdmen of Lot's cattle: and the Canaanite and the Perizzite dwelled in the land. And Abram said unto Lot, Let there be no **strife**, I pray you, between me and you, and between my herdmen and tyour herdmen; for we are brethren. Genesis 13:7-8

How can I myself alone bear your cumbrance, and your burden, and your **strife**? Take you wise men, and understanding, and known among your tribes, and I will make them rulers over you. Deuteronomy 1:12-13

The men of Ephraim gathered themselves together...and said unto Jephthah, Wherefore passed you over to fight against the children of Ammon, and did not call us to go with you? We will burn thine house upon you with fire. And Jephthah said unto them, I and my people were at great strife with the children of Ammon; and when I called you, you delivered me not out of their hands. And when I saw that you delivered me not, I put my life in my hands, and passed over against the children of Ammon, and the LORD delivered them into my hand: wherefore then are you come up unto me this day, to fight against me? Judges 12:1-2

All the people were at **strife** throughout all the tribes of Israel, saying, The king saved us out of the hand of our enemies, and he delivered us out of the hand of the Philistines; and now he is fled out of the land for Absalom. 2 Samuel 19:9

You shall hide them in the secret of your presence from the pride of man: you shall keep them secretly in a pavilion from the **strife** of tongues. Psalm 31:20

Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that **strive** with me: fight against them that fight against me. Take hold of shield and buckler, and stand up for mine help. Draw out also the spear, and stop the way against them that persecute me: say unto my soul, I am your salvation. Psalm 35:1-3

Destroy, O Lord, and divide their tongues: for I have seen violence and strife in the city. Psalm 55:9

They angered him also at the waters of **strife**, so that it went ill with Moses for their sakes: Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips. Psalm 106:32-33

**Strive** not with a man without cause, if he have done you no harm. Proverbs 3:30

Hatred stir up strifes: but love covers all sins. Proverbs 10:12

A wrathful man stirs up **strife**: but he that is slow to anger appeases **strife**. Proverbs 15:18

A froward man sows **strife**: and a whisperer separates chief friends. Proverbs 16:28

Better is a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than an house full of sacrifices with **strife**... The beginning of **strife** is as when one lets out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with... He loves transgression that loves **strife**: and he that exalts his gate seeks destruction. Proverbs 17:1, 14, 19

It is an honor for a man to cease from **strife**: but every fool will be meddling. Proverbs 20:3

Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yes, **strife** and reproach shall cease. Proverbs 22:10

Go not forth hastily to **strive**, lest you know not what to do in the end thereof, when your neighbor has putyou to shame. Proverbs 25:8

He that passes by, and meddles with **strife** belonging not to him, is like one that takes a dog by the ears. Proverbs 26:17, 20-21

He that is of a proud heart stirs up **strife**: but he that puts his trust in the LORD shall be made fat. Proverbs 28:25

An angry man stirs up **strife**, and a furious man abounds in transgression. Proverbs 29:22

Surely the churning of milk brings forth butter, and the wringing of the nose brings forth blood: so the forcing of wrath brings forth strife. Proverbs 30:33

You fast for strife and debate... Isaiah 58:4

O LORD, how long shall I cry, and you will not hear! Even cry out unto you of violence, and you will not save! Why do you show me iniquity, and cause me to behold grievance? For spoiling and violence are before me: and there are that raise up **strife** and contention. Habakkuk 1:2-3

There was also a **strife** among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest. Luke 22:24

Let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in **strife** and envying. But put you on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof. Romans 13:12-14

For you are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and **strife**, and divisions, are you not carnal, and walk as men? 1 Corinthians 3:3

For I fear...Lest there be debates, envyings, wraths, **strifes**, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults... 2 Corinthians 12:20

Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, **strife**, seditions, heresies, Envyings, murders, drunkensness, revelings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. Galatians 5:19-21

Some indeed preach Christ even of envy and strife; and some also of good will: The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds: but the other of love... Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; And in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God...Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Philippians 1:15-17, 27-28, 2:3-4

Foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes. 2 Timothy 2:23

If you have bitter envying and **strife** in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This wisdom descends not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and **strife** is, there is confusion and every evil work. James 3:14-16

## GOD'S WRATH

While the flesh was yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague. Numbers 11:33

Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, has turned my wrath away from the children of Israel, while he was zealous for my sake among them, that I consumed not the children of Israel in my jealousy. Numbers 25:11

Remember, and forget not, how you provoked the LORD your God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that you did depart out of the land of Egypt, until you came unto this place, you have been rebellious against the LORD. Deuteronomy 9:7

Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and you turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them: and then the LORD'S wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain... The LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 11:16-17, 29:28

Go you, enquire of the LORD for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: for great is **the wrath of the LORD** that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book...Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore **my wrath** shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched. 2 Kings 22:13, 17

They mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until the **wrath** of the LORD arose against his people, till there was no remedy. 2 Chronicles 36:16

After that our fathers had provoked the God of heaven unto **wrath**, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon...who destroyed this house, and carried the people away into Babylon. Ezra 5:12

Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? Yet you bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath. Nehemiah 13:18

Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and you perish from the way, when **his** wrath is kindled but a little: Blessed are all they that put their trust in him. Psalm 2:12

But he, being full of compassion, forgave their iniquity, and destroyed them not: yes, many a time turned he his anger away, and did not stir up all his wrath. Psalm 78:38

He cast upon them the fierceness of his anger, wrath, and indignation, and trouble, by sending evil angels among them. Psalm 78:49

Who knows the power of thine anger? Even according to your fear, so is your wrath. Psalm 90:11

Behold the day of the LORD comes, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it...I will shake the heavens, and the earth shall remove out of her place, in the wrath of the LORD of hosts, and in the day of his fierce anger. Isaiah 13: 9, 13

For a small moment have I forsaken you; but with great mercies will I gather you. In a little **wrath** I hid my face from you for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on you, says the LORD your Redeemer. Isaiah 54:7-8

The LORD is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at his **wrath** the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. Jeremiah 10:10

They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of **the wrath of the LORD**: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumbling block of their iniquity. Ezekiel 7:19

God is jealous, and the LORD revenges; the LORD revenges, and is furious; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserves wrath for his enemies. Nahum 1:2

Yes, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came **a great wrath** from the LORD of hosts. Zechariah 7:12

When he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who has warned you to flee from the wrath to come? Matthew 3:7

He that believes on the Son has everlasting life: and he that believes not the Son shall not see life; but **the wrath of God** abides on him. John 3:36

**The wrath of God** is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Romans 1:18

After your hardness and impenitent heart treasure up unto yourself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God...unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that does evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile... Romans 2:5, 8-9

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things' sake **the wrath of God** comes on the children of disobedience... Colossians 3:5-6

The kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves...and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come: and who shall be able to stand? Revelation 6:15-17

The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb...and the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. Revelation 14:10, 19

Out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. Revelation 19:15
