BELIEVE

The people **believed**: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that he had looked upon their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshipped. Exodus 4:31

Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the LORD, and **believed** the LORD, and his servant Moses. Exodus 14:31

The LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? And how long will it be ere they **believe** me, for all the signs which I have shewed among them? Numbers 14:11

I had fainted, unless I had **believed** to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. Wait on the LORD: be of good courage... Psalm 27:13-14

Then believed they his words; they sang his praise... Psalm 106:12

The simple **believeth** every word: but the prudent man looketh well to his going. A wise man feareth, and departeth from evil: Proverbs 14:15-16a

Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he **believed** in his God. Daniel 6:23

Whoso shall offend one of these little ones which **believe** in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea. Matthew 18:6

The baptism of John, whence was it? From heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then **believe** him? Matthew 21:25

Except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days. Then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here is Christ; or, lo, he is there; **believe** him not: For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall shew signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were possible, even the elect. Mark 13:20-22

As soon as Jesus heard the word that was spoken, he saith unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only **believe**. Mark 5:36

Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that **believeth**. And straitway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I **believe**; help thou mine unbelief. Mark 9:23-24

Blessed is she that **believed**: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord. Luke 1:45

When Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: **believe** only, and she shall be made whole. Luke 8:50

Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to **believe** all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? Luke 24:25-26

Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, **believest** thou? Thou shalt see greater things than these. John 1:50

When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they **believed** the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said. John 2:22

If I have told you earthly things, and ye believe not, how shall ye believe, if I tell you of heavenly things? And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven. As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:12-18

Many of the Samaritans of that city **believed** on him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did...and many more **believed** because of his own word. And said unto the woman, Now we **believe**, not because of thy saying: for we have heard him ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world. John 4:39, 41-42

There was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum. When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death. Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe. The nobleman saith unto him, Sir come down ere my child die. Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way... So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house. John 4:47-50, 53

He that heareth my word, and **believeth** on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. John 5:24

He that **believeth** on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that **believe** on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:38-39

He said unto them, Ye are from beneath; I am from above; ye are of this world; I am not of this world. I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye **believe** not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins. John 8:23-24

Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that **believeth** in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever liveth and **believeth** in me shall never die. **Believest** thou this? John 11:25-26

Walk while ye have the light, lest darkness come upon you...while ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. John 12:36

Let not your heart be troubled: ye **believe** in God, **believe** also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. John 14:1-4

For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have **believed** that I came out from God. I came forth from the Father... John 16:27-28

For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have **believed** that thou didst send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them... Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall **believe** on me through their word; that they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us; that the world may **believe** that thou hast sent me. John 17:8-10, 20-21

The multitude of them that **believed** were of one heart and of one soul: Acts 4:32

Many that believed came, and confessed, and shewed their deeds. Acts 19:18

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that **believeth**; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. Romans 1:16
