FOLLOWING GOD

Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers. And he saith unto them, **Follow me**, and I will make you fishers of men. And they straighway left their nets, and **followed him.** And going on from thence, he saw other two brethren, James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he called them. And they immediately left the ship and their father, and **followed him.** Matthew 4:18-22

There **followed him** great multitudes of people from Galilee, and from Decapolis, and from Jerusalem, and from Judaea, and from beyond Jordan... When he was come down from the mountain, great multitudes **followed him**. Matthew 4:25, 8:1

A certain scribe came, and said unto him, Master, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest. And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath no where to lay his head. And another of his disciples said unto him, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father. But Jesus said unto him, Follow me; and let the dead bury their dead. And when he was entered into a ship, his disciples followed him. Matthew 8:19-23

He that taketh not his cross, and **followeth after me**, is not worthy of me. Matthew 10:38

When Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all; Matthew 12:15

He departed thence by ship into a desert place apart: and when the people had heard thereof, they **followed him** on foot out of the cities. Matthew 14:13

Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and **follow me**. Matthew 16:24

When Jesus had finished these sayings, he departed from Galilee, and came into the coasts of Judaea beyond Jordan; and great multitudes **followed him**; and he healed them there. Matthew 19:2

As they departed from Jericho, a great multitude followed him. Matthew 20:29

So Jesus had compassion on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they **followed him**. Matthew 20:34

The multitudes that went before, and that **followed**, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. Matthew 21:9

When the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God. Many women were there beholding afar off, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him: Matthew 27:54-55

As he passed by, he saw Levi the son of Alphaeus sitting at the receipt of custom, and said unto him. Follow me. And he arose and followed him. Mark 2:14

But Jesus withdrew himself with his disciples to the sea: and a great multitude from Galilee **followed him**, and from Judaea...A great multitude, when they had heard what great things he did, came unto him. Mark 3:7-8

Whosoever will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me. Mark 8:34

The people, when they knew it, **followed him**: and he received them, and spake unto them of the kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing. Luke 9:11

He said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and **follow me**. Luke 9:23

Immediately he received his sight, and **followed him**, glorifying God; and all the people, when they saw it, gave praise to God. Luke 18:43

He came out, and went, as he was wont, to the mount of Olives; and his disciples also **followed him**. Luke 22:39

The day following Jesus would go forth into Galilee, and findeth Philip, and saith unto him, **Follow me**. John 1:43

A great multitude **followed him**, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased. John 6:2

Then spake Jesus...saying, I am the light of the world: he that **followeth me** shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life. John 8:12

He that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the porter openeth; and the sheep hear his voice; and he calleth his own sheep by name, and leadeth them out. And when he putteth forth his own sheep, he goeth before them, and the sheep **follow him**: for they know his voice. And a stranger will they not **follow**, but will flee from him: for they know not the voice of strangers...My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they **follow me**; and I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish... John 10:1-5

If any man serve me, let him **follow me**; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man serve me, him will my Father honour. John 12:26

Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, Whither I go, thou canst not **follow me** now; but thou shalt **follow me** afterwards. John 13:36

When thou wast young, thou girdedst thyself, and walkedst whither thou wouldest: but when thou shalt be old, thou shalt stretch forth thy hands, and another shall gird thee, and carry thee whither thou wouldest not. This spake he, signifying by what death he should glorify God. And when he had spoken this, he saith unto him, Follow me. Then Peter turning about, seeth the disciple whom Jesus loved following...Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? Follow thou me. John 21:18-22

Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ. 1 Corinthians 11:1

Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; Ephesians 5:1

Brethren, be **followers** together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample. Philippians 3:17

Ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost. 1 Thessalonians 1:6

Hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should **follow his steps**: who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. 1 Peter 2:21-25

And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: and they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth.
