GIFTS

Many brought **gifts** unto the LORD to Jerusalem, and presents to Hezekiah king of Judah: so that he was magnified in the sight of all nations from thenceforth. 2 Chronicles 32:23

As the days wherein the Jews rested from their enemies, and the month which was turned unto them from sorrow to joy, and from mourning into a good day: that they should make them days of feasting and joy, and of sending portions one to another, and **gifts** to the poor. Esther 9:22

A **gift** is as a precious stone in the eyes of him that hath it: whithersoever it turneth, it prospereth. Proverbs 17:8

A man's **gift** maketh room for him, and bringeth him before great men. Proverbs 18:16

A **gift** in secret pacifieth anger: and a reward in the bosom strong wrath. Proverbs 21:14

Whoso boasteth himself of a false **gift** is like clouds and wind without rain. Proverbs 25:14

Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the **gift** of the Holy Ghost. Acts 2:38

Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the **gift** of God may be purchased with money. Acts 8:20

They of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the **gift** of the Holy Ghost. Acts 10:45

Follow after charity, and desire spiritual **gifts**, but rather that ye may prophesy...Forasmuch as ye are zealous of spiritual **gifts**, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church. 1 Corinthians 14:1, 12

For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the **gift** of God... Ephesians 2:8

Whereof I was made a minister, according to the **gift** of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power. Ephesians 3:7

But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the **gift** of Christ. Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave **gifts** unto men. Ephesians 4:7-8

Every high priest...is ordained... that he may offer both **gifts** and sacrifices for sins... We have such an high priest... For every high priest is ordained to offer **gifts** and sacrifices: wherefore it is of necessity that this man have somewhat also to offer... How much more shall the blood of Christ who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?...
