GOD'S WRATH

While the flesh was yet between their teeth, ere it was chewed, the wrath of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD smote the people with a very great plague. Numbers 11:33

Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, hath turned my wrath away from the children of Israel, while he was zealous for my sake among them, that I consumed not the children of Israel in my jealousy. Numbers 25:11

Remember, and forget not, how thou provokedst the LORD thy God to **wrath** in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the LORD. Deuteronomy 9:7

Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them: and then the LORD'S wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain... The LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 11:16-17, 29:28

Go ye, enquire of the LORD for me, and for the people, and for all Judah, concerning the words of this book that is found: for great is **the wrath of the LORD** that is kindled against us, because our fathers have not hearkened unto the words of this book...Because they have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, that they might provoke me to anger with all the works of their hands; therefore **my wrath** shall be kindled against this place, and shall not be quenched. 2 Kings 22:13, 17

Jehu...said to king Jehoshaphat...Shouldest thou help the ungodly, and love them that hate the LORD? Therefore is **wrath** upon thee... 2 Chronicles 19:2

They mocked the messengers of God, and despised his words, and misused his prophets, until **the wrath of the LORD** arose against his people, till there was no remedy. 2 Chronicles 36:16

After that our fathers had **provoked the God of heaven unto wrath**, he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon... Ezra 5:12

Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? Yet ye bring more **wrath** upon Israel by profaning the sabbath. Nehemiah 13:18

Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when **his wrath** is kindled but a little: Blessed are all they that put their trust in him. Psalm 2:12

But he, being full of compassion, forgave their iniquity, and destroyed them not: yea, many a time turned he his **anger** away, and did not stir up all **his** wrath. Psalm 78:38

He cast upon them the fierceness of **his anger, wrath, and indignation**, and trouble, by sending evil angels among them. Psalm 78:49

Who knoweth the power of **thine anger**? Even according to thy fear, so is thy wrath. Psalm 90:11

Behold the day of the LORD cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it... I will shake the heavens, and the earth shall remove out of her place, in the wrath of the LORD of hosts, and in the day of his fierce anger. Isaiah 13: 9, 13

For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee. In a little **wrath** I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer. Isaiah 54:7-8

The LORD is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at **his** wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation. Jeremiah 10:10

I myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger, and in fury, and in great wrath. Jeremiah 21:5

They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in **the day of the wrath of the LORD**: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumbling block of their iniquity. Ezekiel 7:19

God is jealous, and the LORD revengeth; the LORD revengeth, and is **furious**; the LORD will take vengeance on his adversaries, and he reserveth **wrath** for his enemies. Nahum 1:2

Yea, they made their hearts as an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came **a great wrath** from the LORD of hosts. Zechariah 87:12

When he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from **the wrath** to come? Matthew 3:7

He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but **the wrath of God** abideth on him. John 3:36

The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness; Romans 1:18

After thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God...Unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, **indignation and wrath**, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile... Romans 2:5, 8-9

No whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh **the wrath of God** upon the children of disobedience. Ephesians 5:5-6

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things' sake **the wrath of God** cometh on the children of disobedience... Colossians 3:5-6

The kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves...and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come: and who shall be able to stand? Revelation 6:15-17

The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb...and the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. Revelation 14:10, 19

Out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. Revelation 19:15
