## GOODNESS

*I will make all my **goodness** pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy...and the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in **goodness** and truth. Exodus 33:19, 34:6*

*The LORD thy God will make thee plenteous in every work of thine hands, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy land, for **good**: for the LORD will again rejoice over thee for **good**, as he rejoiced over thy fathers: if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law... Deuteronomy 30:9-10*

*On the eighth day he sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went unto their tents joyful and glad of heart for all the **goodness** that the LORD had done for David his servant, and for Israel his people. 1 Kings 8:66*

*Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in **goodness**. 2 Chronicles 6:41*

*Asa did that which was **good** and right in the eyes of the LORD his God: for he took away the altars of the strange gods, and the high places, and brake down the images, and cut down the groves: and commanded Judah to seek the Lord God of their fathers, and to do the law and the commandment. 2 Chronicles 14:3-4*

*For thou preventest him with the blessings of **goodness**: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head. Psalm 21:3*

*Surely **goodness** and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever. Psalm 23:6*

*I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the **goodness** of the LORD in the land of the living. Psalm 27:13*

*Depart from evil, and do **good**; and dwell forevermore. For the LORD loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever. Ps 37:27-28*

*Oh how great is thy **goodness**, which thou hast laid up for them that fear thee; which thou hast wrought for them that trust in thee before the sons of men! Psalm 31:19*

*Truly God is **good** to Israel, even to such as are of a clean heart. Psalm 73:1*

*Oh that men would praise the LORD for his **goodness**, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with **goodness**. Psalm 107:8-9*

*Thou art **good**, and doest **good**; teach me thy statutes. Psalm 119:68*

*Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is **good**; lead me into the land of uprightness. Psalm 143:10*

*Blessed be the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, and my fingers to fight: My **goodness**, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and he in whom I trust; Psalm 144: 1-2*

*They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great **goodness**, and shall sing of thy righteousness. Psalm 145:7*

*How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth **good** tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth **good** tidings of **good**, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, Thy God reigneth! Isaiah 52:7*

*Behold, there went out a sower to sow...other fell on **good** ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred. Mark 4:3, 8*

*A certain ruler asked him, saying, **Good** Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? And Jesus said unto him, Why callest thou me **good**? None is **good**, save one, that is, God. Luke 18:18-19*

*He said unto him, Well, thou **good** servant: because thou hast been faithful in a very little, have thou authority over ten cities. Luke 19:17*

*Despise thou the riches of his **goodness** and forbearance and longsuffering, not knowing that the **goodness** of God leadeth thee to repentance? Romans 2:4*

*Behold therefore the **goodness** and severity of God: on them which fell, severity; but toward thee, **goodness**, if thou continue in his **goodness**: otherwise thou also shalt be cut off. Romans 11:22*

*Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is **good**. Romans 12:9*

*Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with **good**. Romans 12:21*

*Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost. And I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of **goodness**, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another. Romans 15:13-14*

*For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be **good** or bad. Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences. 2 Corinthians 5:10-11*

*God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every **good** work: (As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever. 2 Corinthians 9:8-9*

*The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, **goodness**, faith, meekness, temperance: Galatians 5:22-23*

*Let us not be weary in well-doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. As we have therefore opportunity, let us do **good** unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of faith. Galatians 6:9-10*

*For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto **good** works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10*

*For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light: (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all **goodness** and righteousness and truth;) Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord. And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. Ephesians 5:8-11*

*For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his **good** pleasure. Do all things without murmurings and disputings. That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world. Philippians 2:13-15*

*For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all understanding; that ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every **good** work, and increasing in the knowledge of God... Col 1:9-10*

*Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the **good** pleasure of his **goodness**, and the work of faith and power: that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12*
