## HEALING

*If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in his sight, give ear to his commandments and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that **healeth** thee. Exodus 15:26*

*See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I **heal**: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand. Deuteronomy 32:39*

*If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves, and pray and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and **heal** their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14*

*Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, **heal** me; for my bones are vexed: Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh save me for thy mercies' sake. Psalm 6:2-3*

*O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast **healed** me. Psalm 30:2*

*God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause his face to shine upon us; Selah. That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving **health** among all nations. Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. Psalm 67:2-3*

*Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; Who **healeth** all thy diseases; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies. Psalm 103:1-4*

*They cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses. He sent his word and **healed** them, and delivered them from their destructions. Psalm 107:19-20*

*He **healeth** the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds. Psalm 147:3*

*Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. It shall be **health** to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones. Proverbs 3:6-7*

*My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and **health** to all their flesh. Proverbs 4:20-22*

*There is that speaketh like the piercings of a sword: but the tongue of the wise is **health**. Proverbs 12:18*

*He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief, and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are **healed**. Isaiah 53:3-5*

*Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine **health** shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy rereward. Psalm 58:6-8*

*The spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to **bind up the brokenhearted**, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; to appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called the trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified. Isaiah 61:1-3*

*A voice was heard upon the high places, weeping and supplications of the children of Israel: for they have perverted their way, and they have forgotten the LORD their God. Return, ye backsliding children, and I will **heal** your backslidings. Behold, we come unto thee; for thou art the LORD our God. Jeremiah 3:21-22*

***Heal** me, O LORD, and I shall be **healed**; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise. Jeremiah 17:14*

*For I will restore **health** unto thee, and I will **heal** thee of thy wounds, saith the LORD...I will bring it **health** and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and truth. Jeremiah 30:17, 33:6*

*Come, and let us return unto the LORD; For he has torn, and he will **heal** us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up...I will **heal** their backsliding, I will love them freely: for mine anger is turned away from him. Hosea 6:1, 14:4*

*Unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with **healing** in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall. Malachi 4:2*

Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing** all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people. Matthew 4:23

When evening had come, they brought to him many who were demon-possessed. And he cast out the spirits with a word, and **healed** all who were sick. Matt 8:16

When he had called his twelve disciples to him, he gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to **heal** all manner of sickness and all manner of disease. Matthew 10:1

When Jesus went out he saw a great multitude; and he was moved with compassion for them, and **healed** their sick. Matthew 14:14

The power of the Lord was present to **heal** them. And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought means to bring him in, and to lay him before him...and when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee...and immediately he rose up... Luke 5:17-20, 25

A great multitude of people...came to hear him, and to be **healed** of their diseases; and they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were **healed**. And the whole multitude sought to touch him, for there went virtue out from him and **healed** them all. Luke 6:17-19 (power went out from him)

Whatever city you enter, and they receive you...**heal** the sick there, and say unto them, The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you. Luke 10:8-9

Then Peter said...In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with them into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God...And as the lame man which was **healed** held Peter and John, all the people ran together unto them in the porch that is called Solomon's greatly wondering. Acts 3:6-8

Grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, by stretching forth thine hand to **heal**; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. Acts 4:29-30

Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: and the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.
