HIS LIGHT IN HEARTS

*Why is **light** given to a man whose way is hid, and whom God hath hedged in?
Job 3:23*

*For then shalt thou have thy delight in the Almighty, and shalt lift up thy face unto God. Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows. Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and **the light** shall shine upon thy ways. Job 22:27-28*

*For God speaketh once, yea twice, yet man perceiveth it not. In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed; Then he openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction, That he may withdraw man from his purpose, and hide pride from man. He keepeth back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword...He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness. He looketh upon men, and if any say, I have sinned, and perverted that which was right, and it profiteth me not; He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see **the light**. Lo, all these things worketh God oftentimes with man, to bring back his soul from the pit, to be enlightened with **the light** of the living. Job 33:14-18, 26-30*

*Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still...there be many that say, who wilt shew us any good? LORD, lift thou up the **light** of thy countenance upon us. Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than in the time that their corn and their wine increased. Psalm 4:4-7*

*For thou wilt **light** my candle: the LORD my God will **enlighten** my darkness. Psalm 18:28*

*My times are in thy hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me. Make thy face to **shine** upon thy servant: save me for thy mercies' sake. Psalm 31:15-16*

*Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart. Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass. And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as **the light**, and thy judgment as the noonday. Psalm 37:4-6*

*Lord, all my desire is before thee; and my groaning is not hid from thee. My heart panteth, my strength faileth me: as for **the light** of mine eyes, it also is gone from me...For I will declare mine iniquity; I will be sorry for my sin. Psalm 38:9-10, 18*

*He shall go to the generation of his fathers; they shall never see **light**. Man that is in honour, and understandeth not, is like the beasts that perish. Psalm 49:19-20*

*Thy vows are upon me, O God: I will render praises unto thee. For thou hast delivered my soul from death: wilt not thou deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the **light** of the living? Psalm 56:12-13*

*Turn us again, O God, and cause thy face to **shine**; and we shall be saved... Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause thy face to **shine**; and we shall be saved... Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to **shine**; and we shall be saved. Psalm 80:3, 7, 19*

*For we are consumed by thine anger, and by thy wrath are we troubled. Thou hast set our iniquities before thee, our secret sins in the **light** of thy countenance. Psalm 90:7-8*

*Ye that love the LORD, hate evil: he preserveth the souls of his saints; he delivereth them out of the hand of the wicked. **Light** is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in heart. Psalm 97:10-11*

*The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous. The **light** of the eyes rejoiceth the heart: and a good report maketh the bones fat. The ear that heareth the reproof of life abideth among the wise. Proverbs 15:29-31*

*The spirit of man is the **candle** of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly. Proverbs 20:27*

*Truly the **light** is sweet, and a pleasant thing it is for the eyes to behold the sun: ...Rejoice, O young man, in thy youth; and let thy heart cheer thee in the days of thy youth, and walk in the ways of thine heart, and in the sight of thine eyes: but know thou, that for all these things God will bring thee into judgment. Therefore remove sorrow from thy heart, and put away evil from thy flesh: for childhood and youth are vanity. Ecclesiastes 11:7, 9-10*

*Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no **light**? Let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. Behold, all ye that kindle a fire, that compass yourselves about with sparks: walk in the **light** of your fire, and in the sparks that ye have kindled. This shall ye have of mine hand; ye shall lie down in sorrow. Isaiah 50:10-11*

*I will look unto the LORD; I will wait for the God of my salvation: my God will hear me. Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a **light** unto me. I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the **light**, and I shall behold his righteousness. Micah 7:7-9*

The **light** of the body is the eye: if therefore thine eye be single, thy whole body shall be full of **light**. But if thine eye be evil, thy whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the **light** that is in thee be darkness, how great is that darkness! Matthew 6:22-23

No man, when he hath **lighted** a candle, putteth it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the **light**. The **light** of the body is the eye: therefore when thine eye is single, thy whole body also is full of **light**; but when thine eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness. Take heed therefore that the **light** which is in thee be not darkness. If thy whole body therefore be full of **light**, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of **light**, as when the bright shining of a candle doth give thee **light**. Luke 11:33-36

Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? If any man walk in the day, he stumbleth not, because he seeth the **light** of this world. But if a man walk in the night, he stumbleth, because there is no **light** in him. John 11:9-10

As he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there **shined** round about him a **light** from heaven: and he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me? And he said, Who art thou, Lord? And the Lord said, I am Jesus whom thou persecutest: it is hard for thee to kick against the pricks. Acts 9:3-5

The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of **light**. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife or envying. But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof. Romans 13:12-14

He that judgeth me is the Lord. Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to **light** the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: 1 Corinthians 4:4-5

All things that are reprov'd are made manifest by **the light**: for whatsoever doth make manifest is **light**. Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee **light**. See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:13-15

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a **light** that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts: 2 Peter 1:19
