MERCY

Thou in thy **mercy** hast led forth the people which thou hast redeemed: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy holy habitation. Exodus 15:13

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great **mercy**, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy **mercy**, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. Numbers 14:18-19

Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that the LORD thy God shall keep unto thee the covenant and the **mercy** which he sware unto thy fathers: Deuteronomy 7:12

Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great **mercy**, according as he walked before thee in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day...and he said, LORD God of Israel, there is no God like thee, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keepest covenant and **mercy** with thy servants that walk before thee with all their heart: 1 Kings 3:6, 8:23

It came even to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his **merc**y endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD; 2 Chronicles 5:13

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his **mercy** endureth for ever. 2 Chronicles 7:3

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his **mercy** he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour...being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:2-7

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain **mercy**, and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:16

The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of **mercy** and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. James 3:17

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant **mercy** hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you. 1 Peter 1:3-4
