OVERCOME

Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the last days...Hear ye sons of Jacob; and hearken unto Israel your father...Gad, a troop shall **overcome** him: but he shall **overcome** at the last. Genesis 49:1-2, 19

Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to **overcome** it. But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they are stronger than we...and there we saw the giants, the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshoppers, and so we were in their sight. Numbers 13:30-31, 33

Behold, there is a people come out of Egypt, which covereth the face of the earth: come now, curse me them; peradventure I shall be able to **overcome** them, and drive them out. And God said unto Balaam, Thou shalt not go with them; thou shalt not curse the people: for they are blessed. Numbers 22:11-12

Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they beseiged Ahaz, but could not **overcome** him. 2 Kings 16:5

Turn away thine eyes from me, for they have **overcome** me: thy hair is as a flock of goats that appear from Gilead. Song of Solomon 6:5

Woe to the crown of pride, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty is a fading flower, which are on the head of the fat valleys of them that are **overcome** with wine! Isaiah 28:1

Mine heart within me is broken because of the prophets; all my bones shake; I am like a drunken man, and like a man whom wine has **overcome**, because of the LORD, and because of the words of his holiness. ... Their course is evil, and their force is not right. For both prophet and priest are profane; yea, in my house have I found their wickedness, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 23:9-11

When a strong man armed keepth his palace, his goods are in peace: But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and **overcome** him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils. Luke 11:21-22

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have **overcome** the world... I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. John 16:33, 17:14-16

And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? The man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and **overcame** them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified. Acts 19:15-17

For what if some did not believe? Shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect? God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest **overcome** when thou art judged. Romans 3:3-4

Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. Be not overcome of evil, but **overcome** evil with good. Romans 12:21

While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is **overcome**, of the same is he brought in bondage. For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and **overcome**, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered unto them. 2 Peter 2:19-21

I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have **overcome** the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father. I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have **overcome** the wicked one. 1 John 2:13-14

Ye are of God, little children, and have **overcome** them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world. They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them. We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth us not. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error. 1 John 4:4

For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous. For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God? This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood...it is the Spirit that beareth witness... 1 John 5:3-6

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that **overcometh** will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God. Revelation 2:7

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that **overcometh** shall not be hurt of the second death. Revelation 2:11

He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that **overcometh** will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it. Revelation 2:17

He that **overcometh**, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: Revelation 2:26

He that **overcometh**, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. Revelation 3:5

Him that **overcometh** will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is New Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon him my new name. Revelation 3:12

To him that **overcometh** will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also **overcame**, and am set down with my Father in his throne. Revelation 3:21

When they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottonless pit shall make war against them, and shall **overcome** them, and kill them. Revelation 11:7

And they **overcame** him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11
