PRAYER

*Have respect therefore to the **prayer** of thy servant, and to his **supplication**, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and the **prayer** which thy servant **prayeth** before thee: 2 Chronicles 6:19*

*Then the king said unto me, For what dost thou make **request**? So I **prayed** to the God of heaven. Nehemiah 2:4*

*Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my **prayer**. Psalm 4:1*

*Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I **pray**. My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my **prayer** unto thee, and will look up. Psalm 5:2-3*

*The LORD hath heard my **supplication**; the LORD will receive my **prayer**. Psalm 6:9*

*Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my **prayer**, that goeth not out of feigned lips. Psalm 17:1*

*We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all thy **petitions**. Psalm 20:5*

*Hear the voice of my **supplications**, when I cry unto thee, when I lift up my hands toward thy holy oracle...Blessed be the LORD, because he hath heard the voice of my **supplications**. Psalm 28:2, 6*

*I cried to thee, O LORD; and unto the LORD I made **supplication**... Psalm 30:8*

*Hear my **prayer**, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I am a stranger with thee, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were. Psalm 39:12*

*Hear my voice, O God, in my **prayer**: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked... Psalm 64:1-2*

*As for me, my **prayer** is unto thee, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation. Psalm 69:13*

Give ear, O LORD, unto my **prayer**; and attend to the voice of my supplications. In the day of my trouble I will call upon thee: for thou wilt answer me. Psalm 86:6

Unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my **prayer** prevent thee. Psalm 88:13

I love the LORD, because he hath heard the voice of my **supplications**. Psalm 116:1

I know, O LORD, that thy judgments are right, and that thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me. Let, I **pray** thee, thy merciful kindness be for my comfort, according to thy word unto thy servant. Psalm 119:75-76

Let my **supplication** come before thee: deliver me according to thy word. Psalm 119:170

Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my **supplications**. Psalm 130:2

I said unto the LORD, Thou art my God: hear the voice of my **supplications**, O LORD. Psalm 140:6

I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my **supplication**. Psalm 142:1

Hear my **prayer**, O LORD, give ear to my **supplications**: in thy faithfulness answer me, and in thy righteousness. Psalm 143:1

And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in **prayer**, believing, ye shall receive. Matthew 21:22

I **pray** for them: I **pray** not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine...I **pray** not that thou shouldst take them out of the world, but that thou shouldst keep them from the evil. They are not of this world, even as I am not of this world. Neither **pray** I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: John 17:9, 15-16, 20-21

Now I **pray** to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, thou we be as reprobates. 2 Corinthians 13:7

*Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: **Praying** always with all **prayer** and **supplication** in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and **supplication** for all saints... Ephesians 6:18*

*And this I **pray**, that your love may abound ye more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; Philippians 1:9*

*We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, **praying** always for you... Colossians 1:3*

*For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to **pray** for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; Colossians 1:9*

*Wherefore also we **pray** always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power: 2 Thessalonians 1:11*

*I exhort therefore, that, first of all, **supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks**, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. 1 Timothy 2:1-2*

***Pray** for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. Hebrews 13:18*

*But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto **prayer**. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:7-8*

*This is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the **petitions** that we desired of him. 1 John 5:14-15*

*But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, **praying** in the Holy Ghost, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. Jude 1:20-21*
