PRAYER

Have respect therefore to the **prayer** of thy servant, and to his **supplication**, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and the **prayer** which thy servant **prayeth** before thee: 2 Chronicles 6:19

Then the king said unto me, For what dost thou make request? So I prayed to the God of heaven. Nehemiah 2:4

Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my **prayer**. Psalm 4:1

Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray. My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up. Psalm 5:2-3

The LORD hath heard my supplication; the LORD will receive my prayer. Psalm 6:9

Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my **prayer**, that goeth not out of feigned lips. Psalm 17:1

We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all thy **petitions**. Psalm 20:5

As for me, my **prayer** is unto thee, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation. Psalm 69:13

Give ear, O LORD, unto my **prayer**; and attend to the voice of my supplications. In the day of my trouble I will call upon thee: for thou wilt answer me. Psalm 86:6

Unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my **prayer** prevent thee. Psalm 88:13

I love the LORD, because he hath heard the voice of my **supplications**. Psalm 116:1

I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my **supplication**. Psalm 142:1

Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, and in thy righteousness. Psalm 143:1

And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in **prayer**, believing, ye shall receive. Matthew 21:22

I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine...I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. They are not of this world, even as I am not of this world. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; That they all may be one; as thou, Father art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: John 17:9, 15-16, 20-21

Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, thou we be as reprobates. 2 Corinthians 13:7

Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: **Praying** always with all **prayer** and **supplication** in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and **supplication** for all saints... Ephesians 6:18

And this I pray, that your love may abound ye more and more in knowledge and in all judgment; Philippians 1:9

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, **praying** always for you... Colossians 1:3

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to **pray** for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; Colossians 1:9

Wherefore also we **pray** always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power: 2 Thessalonians 1:11

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, **supplications**, **prayers**, **intercessions**, and **giving of thanks**, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. 1 Timothy 2:1-2

Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to life honestly. Hebrews 13:18

But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto **prayer**. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:7-8
