QUIET and STILL

Moses said unto them, Stand **still**, and I will hear what the LORD will command concerning you. Numbers 9:8

Sit **still**, my daughter, until thou know how the matter will fall: for the man will not be in rest, until he have finished the thing this day. Ruth 3:18

Samuel said to Saul, Bid the servant pass on before us, (and he passed on,) but stand thou **still** a while, that I may shew thee the word of God... Now therefore stand **still**, that I may reason with you before the LORD of all the righteous acts of the LORD, which he did to you and to your fathers. I Samuel 9:27, 12:7

Go forth and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; but the LORD was not in the wind and after the wind an earthquake; but the LORD was not in the earthquake: And after the earthquake a fire; but the LORD was not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice. and it was so, when Elijah heard it, that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out...1 Kings 19:11-14

They found fat pasture and good, and the land was wide, and quiet, and peaceable; for they of Ham had dwelt there of old. 1 Chronicles 4:40

Ye shall not need to fight in this battle: set yourselves, stand ye **still**, and see the salvation of the LORD with you, O Judah and Jerusalem: fear not, nor be dismayed; to morrow go out against them: for the LORD will be with you...So the realm of Jehoshaphat was **quiet**: for his God gave him rest round about. 2 Chronicles 20:17, 30

So the Levites **stilled** all the people, saying, Hold your peace, for the day is holy; neither be ye grieved. Nehemiah 8:11

I was not in safety, neither had I rest, neither was I quiet... Job 3:26

Hearken unto this, O Job: stand **still**, and consider the wondrous works of God. Job 37:14

Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be **still**. Selah. Psalm 4:4

Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings hast thou ordained strength because of thine enemies, that thou mightest **still** the enemy and the avenger. Psalm 8:2

He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the **still** waters. Psalm 23:2

They speak not peace: but they devise deceitful matters against them that are quiet in the land. Psalm 35:20

By terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; who art the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off upon the sea: Which by his strength setteth fast the mountains; being girded with power: which **stilleth** the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the people. Psalm 65:5-7

Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was **still**... Psalm 76:8

Be **still**, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth. Psalm 46:10

Thou rulest the raging of the sea: when the waves thereof arise, thou stillest them...He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven. Psalm 89:9, 107:29-30

Surely I have behaved and **quieted** myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul is even as a weaned child. Psalm 131:2

Whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be **quiet** from fear of evil. Proverbs 1:33

The whole earth is at rest, and is **quiet**: they break forth into singing. Isaiah 14:7

My people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places... Isaiah 32:18

Look upon Zion, the city of our solemnities: thine eyes shall see Jerusalem a **quiet** habitation, a tabernacle that shall not be taken down; not one of the stakes thereof shall ever be removed, neither shall any of the cords thereof be broken. Isaiah 33:20

Therefore fear thou not, O my servant Jacob, saith the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will save thee from afar, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make him afraid. Jeremiah 30:10

O thou sword of the LORD, how long will it be ere thou be **quiet**? put up thyself into thy scabbard, rest, and be **still**. Jeremiah 47:6

Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not **still**: remember the LORD afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind. Jeremiah 51:50

It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD. Lamentations 3:26

The sun and moon stood **still** in their habitation: at the light of thine arrows they went, and at the shining of thy glittering spear. Habakkuk 3:11

They answered the angel of the LORD that stood among the myrtle trees, and said, We have walked to and fro through the earth, and behold, all the earth sitteth **still**, and is at rest. Zechariah 1:11

And Jesus stood **still**, and called them, and said, What will ye that I shall do unto you? Matthew 20:32

He arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be **still**. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm Mark 4:39

Jesus stood **still**, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; he calleth thee. Mark 10:49

Then Martha, as soon as she heard that Jesus was coming, went and met him: but Mary sat still in the house. John 11:20

We beseech you, brethren, that ye increase more and more; and that ye study to be **quiet**, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you; that ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing. 1 Thessalonians 4:10-12

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.
