REDEMPTION

Thou in thy mercy hast led forth the people which thou hast **redeemed**: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy holy habitation. Exodus 15:13

I prayed therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not thy people and thine inheritance, which thou hast **redeemed** through thy greatness, which thou hast brought forth out of Egypt with a mighty hand. Deuteronomy 9:26

Christ hath **redeemed** us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: Galatians 3:13

When the fulness of the time was come, God sent forth his Son, made of a woman, made under the law, To **redeem** them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. Galatians 4:4-5

Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself...In whom we have **redemption** through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace... Ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the **redemption** of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. Ephesians 1:5, 7, 14

Grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. Ephesians 4:30

Giving thanks to the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear son: In whom we have **redemption** through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: Colossians 1:12-14

Who gave himself for us, that he might **redeem** us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Titus 2:14

Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal **redemption** for us...And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the **redemption** of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. Hebrews 9:15

Ye were not **redeemed** with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ...a lamb without blemish... 1 Peter 1:18-19

For thou wast slain, and hast **redeemed** us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation... They sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were **redeemed** from the earth.
