REJOICE

Hannah prayed, and said, My heart **rejoiceth** in the Lord, mine horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I **rejoice** in thy salvation. 1 Samuel 2:1

Then the people **rejoiced**, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also **rejoiced** with great **joy**. 1 Chronicles 29:9

That day they offered great sacrifices, and **rejoiced**: for God had made them **rejoice** with great joy; the wives also and the children **rejoiced**: so that the **joy** of Jerusalem was heard even afar off. Nehemiah 12:43

David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved: therefore did my heart **rejoice**, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope: Because thou wilt not leave my soul in hell, neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to see corruption. Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of **joy** with thy countenance. Acts 2:25-28

They departed from the presence of the council, **rejoicing** that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name. Acts 5:41
