RIGHTEOUSNESS

*Have respect therefore to the prayer of thy servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and the prayer which thy servant prayeth before thee: that thine eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place whereof thou hast said that thou wouldst put thy name there; to hearken unto the prayer which thy servant prayeth toward this place. Hearken therefore unto the supplications of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear thou from thy dwelling place, even from heaven; and when thou hearest, forgive. If a man sin against his neighbour, and an oath be laid upon him to make him swear, and the oath come before thine altar in this house; then hear thou from heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, by requiting the wicked, by recompensing his way upon his own head; and by justifying the **righteous**, by giving him according to his **righteousness**.* 2 Chronicles 6:19-23

The **righteous** cry, and the LORD hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles...Many are the afflictions of the **righteous**: but the LORD delivers him out of them all.* Psalm 34:15-17, 19

*The wicked watches the **righteous**, and seeks to slay him...The salvation of the **righteous** is of the LORD: he is their strength in the time of trouble.* Psalm 37:32, 39

*Cast your burden on the LORD, and he shall sustain you: he shall never suffer the **righteous** to be moved.* Psalm 55:22

*Deliver me in your **righteousness**, and cause me to escape: incline your ear to me, and save me...My tongue also shall talk of your **righteousness** all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought to shame, that seek my hurt. Psalm 71:2, 24*

*They gather themselves together against the soul of the **righteous**, and condemn the innocent blood. Psalm 94:21*

*The mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting on them that fear him, and his **righteousness** to children's children...Blessed are they that keep judgment, and he that does **righteousness** at all times. Psalm 103:17, 106:3*

*He has dispersed, he has given to the poor; his **righteousness** endures for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honor. Psalm 112:9*

*I will praise you with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned your **righteous** judgments... Your **righteousness** is an everlasting **righteousness**, and your law is the truth... Your word is true from the beginning: and every one of your **righteous** judgments endures for ever...My tongue shall speak of your word: for all your commandments are **righteousness**. Psalm 119:7, 142, 160, 172*

*Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but **righteousness** delivers from death. The LORD will not suffer the soul of the **righteous** to famish: but he casts away the substance of the wicked. Proverbs 10:2-3*

*The fear of the wicked, it shall come on him: but the desire of the **righteous** shall be granted. As the whirlwind passes, so is the wicked no more: but the **righteous** is an everlasting foundation. Proverbs 10:24-25*

*The fruit of the **righteous** is a tree of life; and he that wins souls is wise. Proverbs 11:30*

*The **righteous** man hates lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and comes to shame...The LORD is far from the wicked: but he hears the prayer of the **righteous**. Proverbs 13:5, 15:28*

*The way of the slothful man is as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the **righteous** is made plain. Proverbs 15:19*

*The **righteous** perishes, and no man lays it to heart: and merciful men are taken away, none considering that the **righteous** is taken away from the evil to come. Isaiah 57:1*

*Therefore has the LORD watched on the evil, and brought it on us: for the LORD our God is **righteous** in all his works which he does: for we obeyed not his voice. Daniel 9:14*

*Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after **righteousness**: for they shall be filled...Blessed are they which are persecuted for **righteousness**' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:6, 10*

*Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his **righteousness**; and all these things shall be added to you. Matthew 6:33*

*Lord, when saw we thee an hungered, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee? Then shall he answer them, saying, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye did it not to one of the least of these, ye did it not to me. And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the **righteous** into life eternal. Matthew 25:44-46*

*He spoke this parable to certain which trusted in themselves that they were **righteous**, and despised others: Luke 18:9*

*Judge not according to the appearance, but judge **righteous** judgment. John 7:24*

*In every nation he that fears him, and works **righteousness**, is accepted with him. Acts 10:35*
