## SACRIFICES

When ye will offer a *sacrifice* of thanksgiving unto the LORD, offer it at your own will. Leviticus 22:29

They shall call the people unto the mountain; there they shall offer *sacrifices* of righteousness: for they shall suck of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hid in the sand. Deuteronomy 33:19

*Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD. Psalm* 4:5

Now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle **sacrifices** of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD. Psalm 27:6

*Sacrifice* and offering thou didst not desire; mine ears hast thou opened: burnt offering and sin offering hast thou not required. Psalm 40:6

Gather my saints together unto me; those that have made a covenant with me by **sacrifice**. Psalm 50:5

O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth thy praise. For thou desirest not **sacrifice**; else would I give it: thou delightest not in burnt offering. The **sacrifices** of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise... Then shalt thou be pleased with the **sacrifices** of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering... Psalm 51:15-19

*I will freely sacrifice unto thee: I will praise thy name, O LORD; for it is good. Psalm 54:6* 

Let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing. Psalm 107:22

I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD. I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people, In the courts of the LORD'S house, in the midst of thee, O Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD. Psalm 116:17-19

That day they offered great **sacrifices**, and rejoiced: for God had made them rejoice with great joy: the wives also and the children rejoiced: so that the joy of Jerusalem was heard even afar off. Nehemiah 12:43

LORD, I cry unto thee: make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto thee. Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening **sacrifice**...mine eyes are unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust... Psalm 141:1-2, 8

The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright is his delight. Proverbs 15:8

To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the LORD than *sacrifice*. Proverbs 21:3

I will sacrifice unto thee with the voice of thanksgiving; Jonah 2:9

Even them will I bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their **sacrifices** shall be accepted upon mine altar; for mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people. Isaiah 56:7

They shall come from the cities of Judah, and from the places about Jerusalem, and from the land of Benjamin, and from the plain, and from the mountains, and from the south, bringing burnt offerings, and sacrifices, and meat offerings, and incense, and bring sacrifices of praise, unto the house of the LORD. Jeremiah 17:26

The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: for the LORD is good; for his mercy endureth for ever: and of them that shall bring the **sacrifice of praise** into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 33:11

Go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance...If ye had known what this meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless. Matthew 9:13, 12:7

The scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he: And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. Mark 12:32-33

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living **sacrifice**, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. Romans 12:1

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is **sacrificed** for us: 1 Corinthians 5:7

Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; and walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour. Ephesians 5:2

Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain. Yea, and if I be offered upon the **sacrifice** and service of your faith, I joy, and rejoice with you all. For the same cause also do ye joy, and rejoice with me. Philippians 2:14-18

I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a **sacrifice** acceptable, well pleasing to God. Philippians 4:18

Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto him without the camp, bearing his reproach. For here we have no continuing city, but we seek one to come. By him therefore let us offer **the sacrifice of praise** to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name. But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such **sacrifices** God is well pleased. Hebrews 13:12-16

Laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, as newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious. To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious. Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up **spiritual sacrifices**, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:3-5
