SUFFERING

The Son of man must **suffer** many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day. Luke 9:22

First must he **suffer** many things, and be rejected of this generation. Luke 17:25

Ought not Christ to have **suffered** these things, and to enter into his glory? ... Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to **suffer**, and to rise from the dead the third day. Luke 24:24, 46

Those things, which God before had shewed by the mouth of all his prophets, that Christ should **suffer**, he hath so fulfilled. Acts 3:18

They departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to **suffer** shame for his name. Acts 5:41

I will shew him how great things he must suffer for my name's sake. Acts 9:16

Opening and alleging, that Christ must needs have **suffered**, and risen again from the dead; and that this Jesus, whom I preach unto you, is Christ. Acts 17:3

Christ should **suffer**, and that he should be the first that should rise from the dead, and should shew light unto the people, and to the Gentiles. Acts 26:23

If children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together. For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us. Romans 8:17-18

We both hunger, and thirst, and are naked, and are buffeted, and have no certain dwellingplace; And labour, working with our own hands: being reviled, we bless; being persecuted, we **suffer** it: 1 Corinthians 4:11-12

Whether one member **suffer**, all the members **suffer** with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it. 1 Corinthians 12:26

Charity **suffereth** long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up... 1 Corinthains 13:4

For as the **sufferings** of Christ abound in us, so our consolation also aboundeth by Christ. Whether we be afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effectual in the enduring of the same **sufferings** which we also **suffer**: or whether we be comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. And our hope of you is stedfast, knowing, that as ye are partakers of the **sufferings**, so shall ye be also of the consolation. 2 Corinthians 1:5-7

In nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition...for unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to **suffer** for his sake...I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have **suffered** the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ... That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his **sufferings**, being made conformable unto his death; Philippians 1: 28-29, 3:8, 10

Who now rejoice in my **sufferings** for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church: Colossians 1:24

For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have **suffered** like things of your own countrymen, even as they have of the Jews: 1 Thessalonians 2:14

When we were with you, we told you before that we should **suffer** tribulation; even as it came to pass, and ye know. 1 Thessalonians 3:4

We ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure...that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also **suffer**. 2 Thessalonians 1:4-5

I **suffer** trouble, as an evil doer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound...if we **suffer**, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: 2 Timothy 2:9, 12

Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall **suffer** persecution. 2 Timothy 3:12

We both labour and **suffer** reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Saviour of all men, specially of those that believe. 1 Timothy 4:10

We see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the **suffering** of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man. For it became him, for whom are all things, and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through **sufferings**. Hebrews 2:10

In all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest...For in that he himself hath **suffered** being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted. Hebrews 2:18

Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered... Hebrews 5:8

Remember them that are in bonds, as bound with them; and them which **suffer** adversity, as being yourselves also in the body...Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, **suffered** without the gate. Hebrews 13:3, 12

Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of **suffering** affliction, and of patience. James 5:10

The prophets...searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the **sufferings** of Christ, and the glory that should follow. 1 Peter 1:10-11

For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully. For what glory is it, if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye take it patiently? But if, when ye do well, and suffer for it, ye take it patiently, this is acceptable with God. For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: 1 Peter 2:19-21

Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he **suffered**, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: 1 Peter 2:23

If ye **suffer** for righteousness' sake, happy are ye: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled...for it is better, if the will of God be so, that ye **suffer** for well doing, than for evil doing. For Christ also hath once **suffered** for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: 1 Peter 3:14, 17-18

Forasmuch then as Christ hath **suffered** for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath **suffered** in the flesh hath ceased from sin...Rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's **sufferings**; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy...Let none of you **suffer** as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. Yet if any man **suffer** as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf...Let them that **suffer** according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator. 1 Peter 4:1, 13, 15-16, 19

The elders which are among you I exhort, who am also an elder, and a witness of the **sufferings** of Christ, and also a partaker of the glory that shall be revealed... The God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have **suffered** a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you. 1 Peter 5:1, 10
