THIRST

THIRST

*Thou... gavest them bread from heaven for their hunger, and broughtest forth water for them out of the rock for their **thirst**, and promisedst them that they should go in to possess the land which thou hadst sworn to give them... Thou gavest also thy good spirit to instruct them, and withheldst not thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their **thirst**. Nehemiah 9:15, 20*

*As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God. My soul **thirsteth** for God, for the living God: when shall I come and appear before God? Psalm 42:1-2*

*O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul **thirsteth** for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and **thirsty** land, where no water is; To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary. Psalm 63:1-2*

*Reproach hath broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, but there was none; and for comforters, but I found none. They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my **thirst** they gave me vinegar to drink. Psalm 69:20-21*

*He sendeth the springs into the valleys, which run among the hills. They give drink to every beast of the field: the wild asses quench their **thirst**... He watereth the hills from his chambers: the earth is satisfied with the fruit of thy works. Psalm 104:10-11, 13*

*O give thanks unto the LORD, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever. Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy; And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south. They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in. Hungry and **thirsty**, their soul fainted in them. Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them out of their distresses. And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness. Psalm 107:1-9*

*I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the work of thy hands. I stretch forth my hands unto thee: my soul **thirsteth** after thee, as a **thirsty** land. Selah. Psalm 143:5-6*

*If thine enemy be hungry, give him bread to eat; and if he be **thirsty**, give him water to drink: For thou shalt heap coals of fire upon his head, and the LORD shall reward thee. Proverbs 25:21*

*As cold waters to a **thirsty** soul, so is good news from a far country. A righteous man falling down before the wicked is as a troubled fountain, and a corrupt spring. Proverbs 25:25-26*

*Then shall the lame man leap as an hart, and the tongue of the dumb sing: for in the wilderness shall waters break out, and streams in the desert. And the parched ground shall become a pool, and the **thirsty** land springs of water... Isaiah 35:6-7*

*When the poor and needy seek water, and there is none, and their tongue faileth for **thirst**, I the LORD will hear them, I the God of Israel will not forsake them. I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water. Isaiah 41:17-18*

*For I will pour water upon him that is **thirsty**, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water course. Isaiah 44:3-4*

*The LORD hath redeemed his servant Jacob. And they **thirsted** not when he led them through the deserts: he caused the waters to flow out of the rock for them: he clave the rock also, and the waters gushed out. Isaiah 48:20-21*

*They shall not hunger nor **thirst**; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them. Isaiah 49:10*

*Ho, every one that **thirsteth**, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Isaiah 55:1*

*Behold, the days come, saith the Lord GOD, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a **thirst** for water, but of hearing the words of the LORD: And they shall wander from sea to sea, and from the north even to the east, they shall run to and fro to seek the word of the LORD, and shall not find it. In that day shall the fair virgins and young men faint for **thirst**. Amos 8:11-13*

*Blessed are they which do hunger and **thirst** after righteousness: for they shall be filled. Matthew 5:6*

*For I was an hungered, and ye gave me meat: I was **thirsty**, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in... Matthew 25:35*

*Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall **thirst** again: But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never **thirst**; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life. The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I **thirst** not, neither come hither to draw. John 4:13-15*

*For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world. Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread. Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never **thirst**. John 6:33-35*

*In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man **thirst**, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:37-39*

*After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, I **thirst**. Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to his mouth. When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished: and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost. John 19:28-30*

*Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he **thirst**, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. Romans 12:20*

*Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned...In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and **thirst**, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness. 2 Corinthians 11:27*

*They shall hunger no more, neither **thirst** any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. Revelation 7:16*
