UPRIGHTNESS

*I am the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that ye should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go **upright**. Leviticus 26:13*

*Then Achish called David, and said unto him, Surely, as the LORD liveth, thou hast been **upright**, and thy going out and thy coming in with me in the host is good in my sight: for I have not found evil in thee... 1 Samuel 29:6*

*For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from God. For all his judgments were before me: and as for his statutes, I did not depart from them. I was also **upright** before him, and have kept myself from mine iniquity. Therefore the LORD hath recompensed me according to my righteousness; according to my cleanness in his eye sight. With the merciful thou wilt shew thyself merciful, and with the **upright** man thou wilt shew thyself **upright**. 2 Samuel 22:23-26*

*If thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in **uprightness**, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, and wilt keep my statutes and my judgments: Then I will establish the throne of thy kingdom upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David thy father... 1 Kings 9:4-5*

*I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in **uprightness**. As for me, in the **uprightness** of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things and now have I seen with joy thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee. 1 Chronicles 29:17*

*The Levites were more **upright** in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests. 2 Chronicles 29:34*

*There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and **upright**, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil...and the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an **upright** man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? And still he holdeth fast his integrity... Job 1:1, 8*

*My words shall be of the **uprightness** of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly. Job 33:3*

*My defence is of God, which saveth the **upright** in heart. God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day. Psalm 7:10-11*

*The LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment. He shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in **uprightness**. Psalm 9:7-8*

For, lo, the wicked bend their bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the **upright** in heart. Psalm 11:2

For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the **upright**. Psalm 11:7

*The integrity of the **upright** shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them...They that are of a froward heart are abomination to the LORD: but such as are **upright** in their way are his delight. Proverbs 11:3, 20*

*He that walketh in his **uprightness** feareth the LORD: but he that is perverse in his ways despiseth him. Proverbs 14:2*

*The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the **upright** shall flourish. Proverbs 14:11*

*The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the **upright** is his delight. Proverbs 15:8*

*The highway of the **upright** is to depart from evil: he that keepeth his way preserveth his soul. Proverbs 16:17*

*The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and that which was written was **upright**, even words of truth. Ecclesiastes 12:10*

*The way of the just is **uprightness**: thou, most **upright**, dost weigh the path of the just. Isaiah 26:7*

*He shall enter into peace: they shall rest in their beds, each one walking in his **uprightness**. Isaiah 57:2*

*Now as he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep on my face toward the ground: but he touched me, and set me **upright**. Daniel 8:18*
