## UPRIGHTNESS

I am the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that ye should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go **upright**. Leviticus 26:13

Then Achish called David, and said unto him, Surely, as the LORD liveth, thou hast been **upright**, and thy going out and thy coming in with me in the host is good in my sight: for I have not found evil in thee... 1 Samuel 29:6

For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from God. For all his judgments were before me: and as for his statutes, I did not depart from them. I was also **upright** before him, and have kept myself from mine iniquity. Therefore the LORD hath recompensed me according to my righteousness; according to my cleanness in his eye sight. With the merciful thou wilt shew thyself merciful, and with the **upright** man thou wilt shew thyself **upright**. 2 Samuel 22:23-26

If thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in **uprightness**, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, and wilt keep my statutes and my judgments: Then I will establish the throne of thy kingdom upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David thy father... 1 Kings 9:4-5

I know also, my God, that thou triest the heart, and hast pleasure in **uprightness**. As for me, in the **uprightness** of mine heart I have willingly offered all these things and now have I seen with joy thy people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto thee. 1 Chronicles 29:17

*The Levites were more upright in heart to sanctify themselves than the priests. 2 Chronicles 29:34* 

There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and **upright**, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil...and the LORD said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an **upright** man, one that feareth God, and escheweth evil? And still he holdeth fast his integrity... Job 1:1, 8

My words shall be of the **uprightness** of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly. Job 33:3

My defence is of God, which saveth the **upright** in heart. God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day. Psalm 7:10-11

The LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment. He shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in **uprightness**. Psalm 9:7-8

For, lo, the wicked bend their bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the **upright** in heart. Psalm 11:2

For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the **upright**. Psalm 11:7

Lord, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? ... He that walketh **uprightly**, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart. Psalm 15:1,2

Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be **upright**, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression. Psalm 19:13

They are brought down and fallen: but we are risen, and stand upright. Ps 20:8

Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will he teach sinners in the way. Ps 25:8

Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee. Psalm 25:21

Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, ye righteous: and shout for joy, all ye that are **upright** in heart. Psalm 32:11

Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright. Ps 33:1

O continue thy lovingkindness unto them that know thee; and thy righteousness to the **upright** in heart. Psalm 36:10

The LORD knoweth the days of the **upright**; and their inheritance shall be for ever...Mark the perfect man, and behold the **upright**: for the end of that man is peace. Psalm 37:18, 37

The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in him; and all the **upright** in heart shall glory. Psalm 64:10

For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk **uprightly**. Psalm 84:11

Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the **upright** shall be blessed ... Unto the **upright** there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteousness. Psalm 112:1-2, 4

*I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous judgments. Psalm 119:7* 

Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of **uprightness**. Psalm 143:10

The way of the LORD is strength to the **upright**: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. Proverbs 10:29

The integrity of the **upright** shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them... They that are of a froward heart are abomination to the LORD: but such as are **upright** in their way are his delight. Proverbs 11:3, 20

*He that walketh in his uprightness feareth the LORD: but he that is perverse in his ways despiseth him. Proverbs 14:2* 

*The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the upright shall flourish. Proverbs* 14:11

The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the **upright** is his delight. Proverbs 15:8

The highway of the **upright** is to depart from evil: he that keepth his way preserveth his soul. Proverbs 16:17

The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and that which was written was **upright**, even words of truth. Ecclesiastes 12:10

*The way of the just is uprightness: thou, most upright, dost weigh the path of the just. Isaiah 26:7* 

He shall enter into peace: they shall rest in their beds, each one walking in his *uprightness*. Isaiah 57:2

Now as he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep on my face toward the ground: but he touched me, and set me **upright**. Daniel 8:18

They hate him that rebuketh in the gate, and they abhor him that speaketh *uprightly*. Amos 5:10

O thou that art named the house of Jacob, is the spirit of the LORD straitened? Are these his doing? Do not my words do good to him that walketh **uprightly**? Micah 2:7

Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not **upright** in him: but the just shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 2:4

When I saw that they walked not **uprightly** according to the truth of the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews? Galatians 2:14
