*He hath filled him with the spirit of God, in **wisdom**, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship; Exodus 35:31*

*I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me...Keep therefore and do them; for this is your **wisdom** and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a **wise** and understanding people. Deut 4:6*

*God gave Solomon **wisdom** and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. 1 Kings 4:29*

*Jonathan David's uncle was a counsellor, a **wise** man, and a scribe: 1 Chr 27:32*

*Whence then cometh **wisdom**? And where is the place of understanding?...And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is **wisdom**; and to depart from evil is understanding. Job 28:20, 28*

*The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making **wise** the simple. Psalm 19:7*

*The fear of the LORD is the beginning of **wisdom**: a good understanding have all they that do his commandments: his praise endureth for ever. Psalm 111:10*

*The **wise** shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools. Pro 3:35*

*The tongue of the **wise** useth knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools poureth out foolishness. Proverbs 15:2*

*A **wise** man scalesh the city of the mighty, and casteth down the strength of the confidence thereof. Proverbs 21:22*

*She openeth her mouth with **wisdom**; and in her tongue is the law of kindness. She looketh well to the ways of her household, and eateth not the bread of idleness. Her children rise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praiseth her. Many daughters have done virtuously, but thou excellest them all. ***Wisdom** strengtheneth the **wise** more than ten mighty men which are in the city. Ecclesiastes 7:19*

*The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. **Wisdom** and knowledge shall be the stability of their times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure. Isaiah 33:5-6*

*He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his **wisdom**, and hath stretched out the heaven by his understanding. When he uttereth his voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens; and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth: he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures. *Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for **wisdom** and might are his: And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth **wisdom** unto the **wise**, and knowledge to them that know understanding: Daniel 2:20-21*

*Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the **wise** shall understand. Daniel 12:10*

*Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a **wise** man, which built his house upon a rock: Matthew 7:24*

*When the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing him were astonished, saying, From whence hath this man these things? And what **wisdom** is this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands? Mark 6:2*

*Therefore also said the **wisdom** of God, I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they shall slay and persecute: Luke 11:49*

*For I will give you a mouth and **wisdom**, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. Luke 21:15*

*Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and **wisdom**, whom we may appoint over this business. Acts 6:3*

*O the depth of the riches both of the **wisdom** and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! Romans 11:33*

*Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all **wisdom** and prudence; That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of **wisdom** and revelation in the knowledge of him: Ephesians 1:17*

*See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as **wise**... Ephesians 5:15*

*That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; In whom are hid all the treasures of **wisdom** and knowledge. Colossians 2:3*

It is written, I will destroy the **wisdom** of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. Where is the **wise**? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Hath not God made foolish the **wisdom** of this world? For after that in the **wisdom** of God the world by **wisdom** knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after **wisdom**. But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the **wisdom** of God. Because the foolishness of God is **wiser** than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. For ye see your calling, brethren, how that not many **wise** men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble are called: but God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the **wise**; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty. 1 Corinthians 1:19-27

Who is a **wise** man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of **wisdom**. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This **wisdom** descendeth not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the **wisdom** that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace. James 3:13-18
