## FAITH

*Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the **faithful** God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations. And repayeth them that hate him to their face, to destroy them: he will not be slack to him that hateth him, he will repay him to his face. Thou shalt therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the judgments, which I command thee this day, to do them. Deuteronomy 7:9-11*

*I will raise me up a **faithful** priest, that shall do according to that which is in mine heart and in my mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before mine anointed for ever. 1 Samuel 2:35*

*O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the **faithful**, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer. Psalm 31:23*

*Thy mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; and thy **faithfulness** reacheth unto the clouds. Thy righteousness is like the great mountains; thy judgments are a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast. Psalm 36:5-6*

*A **faithful** man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent. Proverbs 28:20*

*O LORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are **faithfulness** and truth. Isaiah 25:1-3*

*The presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he was **faithful**, neither was there any error or fault found in him. Daniel 6:4*

*Jesus...said, daughter, be of good comfort; thy **faith** hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. Matthew 9:22*

*He said unto the sea, Peace, be still. The wind ceased, and there was a great calm. He said... Why are ye so fearful? How is it that ye have no **faith**? Mark 4:40*

*Jesus answering saith unto them, Have **faith** in God. Mark 11:22*

*When he saw their **faith**, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee. Luke 5:20*

*Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little...thy **faith** hath saved thee; go in peace. Lk 7:47,50*

He that is **faithful** in that which is least is **faithful** also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore ye have not been **faithful** in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? And if ye have not been **faithful** in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own? Luke 16:10-12

I have prayed for thee, that thy **faith** fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren. Luke 22:32

There sat a certain man at Lystra, impotent in his feet, being a cripple from his mother's womb, who never had walked. The same heard Paul speak: who stedfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had **faith** to be healed, said with a loud voice, Stand upright on thy feet. And he leaped and walked. Acts 14:8-10

When she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be **faithful** to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us. Acts 16:15

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from **faith** to **faith**: as it is written, The just shall live by **faith**. Romans 1:16-17

Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? Nay: but by the law of **faith**. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by **faith** without the deeds of the law... Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by **faith**, and uncircumcision through **faith**. Do we then make void the law through **faith**? God forbid: yea, we establish the law. Romans 3:27-28, 30-32

For the promise, that he should be heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of **faith**. For if they which are of the law be heirs, **faith** is made void, and the promise is made of none effect... therefore it is of **faith**, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed... Romans 4:13-14, 16

Therefore being justified by **faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by **faith** into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope: and hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly... while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:1-6, 8

**Faith** cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. Romans 10:17

We, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another. Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of **faith**... Romans 12:5-6

My speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: that your **faith** should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is **faithful**, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way of escape, that ye may be able to bear it. 1 Corinthians 10:13

Now abideth **faith**, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:13

If Christ be not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your **faith** is in vain...and if Christ be not raised, your **faith** is vain; ye are yet in your sins. 1 Cor 15:14, 17

Watch ye, stand fast in the **faith**, quit you like men, be strong. Let all things be done with charity. 1 Corinthians 16:13-14

Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the **faith**; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobate? 2 Corinthians 13:5

We through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by **faith**. Galatians 5:5

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, **faith**, meekness, temperance: Galatians 5:22-23

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one **faith**, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:4-6

As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the **faith**, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving...Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the **faith** of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.
