## FREEDOM & LIBERTY

*Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy **free** spirit. Psalm 51:12*

*I will **freely** sacrifice unto thee: I will praise thy name, O LORD; for it is good. Psalm 54:6*

*The king sent and loosed him; even the ruler of the people, and let him go **free**. Psalm 105:20*

*I will walk at **liberty**: for I seek thy precepts. Psalm 119:45*

*Accept, I beseech thee, the **freewill** offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me thy judgments. Psalm 119:108*

*Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go **free**, and that ye break every yoke? Isaiah 58:6*

*The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the broken hearted, to proclaim **liberty** to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound... Isaiah 61:1*

*I will heal their backsliding, I will love them **freely**: for mine anger is turned away from him. Hosea 14:4*

*As ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: **freely** ye have received, **freely** give. Matthew 10:7-8*

*Of whom do the kings of the earth take custom or tribute? Of their own children, or of strangers? Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, Then are the children **free**. Matthew 17:26*

*The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at **liberty** them that are bruised... Luke 4:18*

*For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified **freely** by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Romans 3:24*

*Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the **free** gift came upon all men unto justification of life. Romans 5:18*

*Being then made **free** from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were **free** from righteousness. What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now being made **free** from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 6:18-23*

*For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me **free** from the law of sin and death... The creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious **liberty** of the children of God. Romans 8:2, 21*

*He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also **freely** give us all things? Romans 8:32*

*Take heed lest by any means this **liberty** of yours become a stumblingblock to them that are weak. 1 Corinthians 8:9*

*For why is my **liberty** judged of another man's conscience? For if I by grace be a partaker, why am I evil spoken of for that for which I give thanks? Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God. Given none offence... 1 Corinthians 10:29-32*

*Unto this day, when Moses is read, the veil is upon their heart. Nevertheless, when it shall turn to the Lord, the veil shall be taken away. Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is **liberty**. But we all with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:17-18*

*Because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our **liberty** which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage: Galatians 2:4*

*He who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the **freewoman** was by promise. Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants...this Agar is mount Sinai...Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children. But Jerusalem which is above is **free**, which is the mother of us all... We are not children of the bondwoman, but of the **free**. Galatians 4:23, 25-26, 31*

*Stand fast therefore in the **liberty** wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage...For, brethren, ye have been called unto **liberty**; only use not **liberty** for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. Galatians 5:1, 13*

*For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. Whoso looketh into the perfect law of **liberty**, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed. James 1:23-25*

*If ye fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself, ye do well... So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of **liberty**. James 2:8, 12*

*For so is the will of God, that with well-doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men: As free, and not using your **liberty** for a cloak of maliciousness, but as the servants of God. 1 Peter 2:15-16*

*For when they speak great swelling words of vanity, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. While they promise them **liberty**, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage. 2 Peter 2:18-19*

*He said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life **freely**... The Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life **freely**. Revelation 21:6, 22:17*
